Head Coach Earl Grant, 39, was named the 23rd men's basketball head coach at College of Charleston in September of 2014.

A former Lowcountry prep star out of R.B. Stall High School, Grant joined the company of CofC coaching greats Alfred von Kolnitz (1924-26), Ernest Wehman (two tenures from 1933-42, 1957-58), Willard Silcox, Sr. (three tenures: 1943-44, 1948-53, 1955-56), Fred Daniels (1968-70), Alan LeForce (1970-79), the program's all-time winningest coach John Kresse (1979-2002) and Bobby Cremins (2006-12).

In his second season with the Cougars, he and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

The Cougars also finished the 2015-16 season ranked No. 8 in the nation in scoring defense holding opponents to an average of 62.0 points per game - the seventh-lowest average in the program's NCAA Division I era. They also limited 16 of their 18 CAA opponents to 65 points or less and allowed a league-low 59.2 points per game in conference play. In addition, CofC went 9-4 in non-conference action including an upset of preseason Top-25 ranked LSU and projected No. 1 NBA Draft pick Ben Simmons on November 30, 2015 at TD Arena.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has also signed back-to-back recruiting classes that will help the Cougars contend for CAA Championships. He previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, a 2001 College of Charleston graduate receiving a degree in elementary education, have three sons: Trey (9), Eyziah (8) and Elonzo (5).

GAME PREVIEW

Two of the nation's top defenses will collide in a non-conference showdown between College of Charleston (7-3) and East Carolina (7-3) on Thursday, Dec. 15 at 7 p.m. (ET) at Minges Coliseum in Greenville, N.C. The game will be televised live nationally on the American Sports Network and ESPN3. The Cougars are holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, which ranks No. 18 in the nation, while the Pirates have held opponents to 60.9 (No. 16). Both teams have also limited opponents from good shot opportunities around the perimeter - CofC 28.5% (No. 27) and ECU 29.4% (No. 40) in three-point field-goal percentage defense. The Cougars have wrapped-up their final exams and have won four in a row including a 59-45 rout of Anderson University on Dec. 11 at the North Charleston Coliseum. The Pirates have won three of their last four contests and are an undefeated 6-0 at home this season. This is the first road trip to ECU for the Cougars since 1990. Last year, Charleston edged the Pirates, 77-73, on Dec. 7, 2015 at TD Arena.

THE PIRATES AT-A-GLANCE

East Carolina is looking to rebound from a 76-53 loss at No. 14-ranked Virginia on Nov. 6 and has enjoyed a nine-day layoff from competition for finals. The Pirates have three players averaging double figures in scoring in Caleb White (14.0 ppg), B.J. Tyson (13.6 ppg) and Kentrell Barkley (12.0 ppg). While they have limited to opponents in scoring and long-range shooting, ECU also ranks No. 10 in the country in field-goal percentage defense (36.6%).

COUGARS RANKED IN MID-MAJOR TOP 25 POLL

College of Charleston is ranked No. 25 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll released on Dec. 12. The Cougars are making their third all-time appearance in the poll under third-year head coach Earl Grant. Last season, they were ranked as high as No. 22 among the top mid-major programs in the country. With one of the nation's toughest schedules, the program is also rated No. 51 in the latest NCAA Men's Basketball RPI rankings with just three losses on the season to UCF (No. 25 NCAA RPI), Wake Forest (No. 12 NCAA RPI) and defending national champion and top-ranked Villanova (No. 2 NCAA RPI) as of Dec. 12.

SERIES NOTES

College of Charleston leads 2-1 in the all-time series with East Carolina. The series first began during the 1991-92 season - CofC's first year as a NCAA Division I member. Under legendary head coach John Kresse, the Cougars claimed a four-point decision (72-68) on Feb. 3, 1992 at John Kresse Arena to avenge a 14-point road loss (51-65) to the Pirates in both teams' first meeting in the series back in 1990 in Greenville, N.C.

MAKING IT COUNT

Two of the Top 100 free throw shooters in the country reside in Lowcountry in Grant Riller (No. 63) and Joe Chealey (No. 117). Riller has made 35-of-40 from the free throw line this season for an 87.5 percent accuracy, while Chealey has made 49-of-58 (84.5%). As a team, the Cougars are shooting an improved 73.1 percent from the charity stripe with seven of their 10 games over 70%.

MR. CONSISTENCY

Just as he did during his rookie season, which earned him CAA Rookie of the Year honors, Jarrell Brantley has been constant force for the Cougars in his sophomore campaign. He currently ranks No. 44 nationally in defensive rebounds per game (6.50) and No. 82 in rebounds per game (8.3). Brantley has registered double figures in nine of the team's 10 contests this season including his third double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 points in the team's 76-61 victory over Davidson on Dec. 4. He is also shooting 43 percent from the field, 41 percent from beyond the arc and 80 percent from the free throw line this year.

COUGARS PICKED FOURTH IN CAA POLL

College of Charleston was picked to finish fourth in the preseason Colonial Athletic Association Poll. The Cougars were picked behind preseason favorite and defending champion UNCW (37 first-place votes), Towson and William & Mary in a vote by the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. CofC returns all five starters from last year's 17-14 squad. Sophomore forward Jarrell Brantley was selected to the preseason All-CAA First Team, while junior guard Cameron Johnson earned an All-CAA Second Team nod.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF CHARITY

The Cougars took advantage of charity at Coastal Carolina on Nov. 14. They went to the line 23 times and made 21 free throws for a 91.3 accuracy rate from the line. It was the second-highest free throw percentage in the last three years under head coach Earl Grant next to a making 13-of-14 attempts (92.9%) at UNCW on Jan. 30, 2015. Joe Chealey went 5-for-5, while Jarrell Brantley went 4-for-4 against the Chanticleers.

THE ORLANDO CONNECTION

Orlando natives Joe Chealey (24 points) and Riller (21 points) combined for 45 of the team's 81 points versus The Citadel. Both missed the 2015-16 season due to preseason injuries and are former hometown stars at Apopka High School and Ocoee High School respectively. Chealey and Riller are currently the team's top and third-leading scorers.

OFF TO A GOOD START

The Cougars started the season off at 3-0 for the first time since 2011-12 where they last defeated Holy Cross, Morehead State and Clemson in a row. Ironically, current CofC assistant coach Milan Brown was the head coach at Holy Cross and head coach Earl Grant was an assistant coach at Clemson during CofC's run.

DESTINATION CITY, DESTINATION CAMPUS

College of Charleston is one of only three NCAA Division I schools in the country to host an ESPN tournament on its campus next to the University of Hawai'i and Cal State Fullerton. The Cougars, however, can only participate in the Charleston Classic every four years. The city of Charleston has been consistently ranked the No. 1 destination city in the United States and world, while "The College" is also the 13th-oldest institution of higher learning in the U.S.

DEFENSE, COUGARS, DEFENSE

The CofC defense has frustrated eight of its 10 early opponents to under their scoring average from a year ago as well as their scoring average entering the ballgame versus the Cougars. The Citadel, who ranked No. 2 in the nation in scoring offense last season, was held to 68 points and an opponent season-low 29.9 percent shooting from the field on Nov. 11 at TD Arena.

ANDERSON RECAP

College of Charleston 59, Anderson 45

- The Cougars are now 34-10 all-time (.773) when playing games at the North Charleston Coliseum since 1993. It was the team's first game in the venue since 2010.
- College of Charleston is now tied in the all-time series with Anderson, 1-1, and it marked only the second meeting between both schools since the first in 2012.
- Grant Riller registered a team-high 13 points, which marked his fourth double-figure scoring game of the season.
- Jarrell Brantley recorded a stat line of nine points, five rebounds and a career-high tying four assists including two dishes for three-pointers made by Grant Riller and Marquise Pointer.
- Evan Bailey turned in a season-high seven points and a career-high nine rebound versus Anderson. It marked the third time in his career to lead the Cougars in the rebounding column. He also went a career-best 7-of-10 from the free throw line.
- The CofC defense held Anderson to an opponent season-low 45 points and 20 percent shooting from beyond the arc (4-of-20). The Cougars previously held an opponent to 40 points against Boise State (47 points) in the first round of the ESPN Gildan Charleston Classic on Nov. 17.

COUGARS AGAINST THE TOP 25

CofC faced its first ranked team of the season in No. 2/2-ranked and defending national champion Villanova on Nov. 23. The Cougars are 6-22 all-time versus teams ranked in The Associated Press Top 25 Poll having last faced No. 15 Miami as part of the last game in a 2-for-1 series a year ago with the Hurricanes (L, 63-85) in Coral Gables, Fla. Of the program's six all-time wins over Top-25 foes, all but one have occurred on the road or at a neutral-site tournament (preseason and postseason).
