#### Fast Break Points About College of Charleston

- The Cougars come off an extremely tight 79-72 home-loss to Coastal Carolina on Tuesday. The game featured 12 lead changes and was tied with less than two minutes to play before CCU put together its game-winning run. Breanna Bolden scored 20 points in the first half, while Dajah Logan notched a career-high 11 boards and Clay Brown matched career-bests in both points (14) and rebounds (6).
- Tanisha Brown has been a revelation for the Cougars in 2016-17, and has five double-doubles in ten games played, which ranks her 29th in the nation.
- At 3.8 steals per game, senior Breanna Bolden ranks 7th in the nation in that category, as well as 11th in total steals (38).
- The College notched the 65-62 road-win over App State despite incurring 31 team fouls, 41 FT attempts by ASU, and four Cougars fouling out. Bre Bolden logged an 18-8, while Tanisha Brown secured a 17-10, her third double-double of the year.
- CofC suffered a 71-61 loss to Virginia Tech. The Cougars went down by as many as 16 points in the second quarter, but slowly chipped into the deficit, finally pulling within one in the 4th quarter before the Hokies finally pulled away for the eventual win. Bolden scored her second consecutive double-double (16-10), while Tanisha Brown (17), Darien Huff (12) and Dajah Logan (12) all logged double-digit scoring for CofC.
- The Cougars decimated the Winthrop Eagles on Nov 16, pulling out the 95-64 win in Winthrop Coliseum. Tanisha Brown picked up her second consecutive double-double (20-10) and added five steals. Bolden had 22 points and six steals to move up to No. 20 on the CofC All-Time scoring list, and Darien Huff set career-highs in scoring (19 Pts), assists (5) and blocks (2). It was the second-most FGM (38) and the fourth-most points (95) the Cougars have scored in their Division I Era.
- Two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year Breanna Bolden had an excellent start to the season in The College's 62-49 loss to Charlotte. Bolden pawed away a career-high eight steals, which propelled her to 243 in her career to break the CofC Division I Era career steals record. The senior also tacked on a team-high 16 points, as well as eight rebounds.
- The Cougars come off a 2015-16 campaign during which they went 11-20, more than doubling their win total from the previous season.
- The Cougars made the 2015/16 CAA Tournament as an 8 seed, and went on to defeat the UNCW Seahawks in the first round. That pitted them against the No. 1 seed James Madison Dukes, and the Cougars rose to the challenge. CofC hammered them inside, and led the game for nearly its full duration. But the Dukes seized the lead with 67 seconds left in the game and escaped with the 53-50 win.

#### The Cougars vs. Charleston Southern: Series History

- Thursday will mark the 62nd time on record that the Cougars and Bucs have gone at it in women's basketball. The College has controlled the series, sporting a 49-12 record. The two teams met as recently as last season in TD Arena, where the Cougars earned the 81-66 win. Breanna Bolden scored a game-high 24 points, while Jackie Luna-Castro, Kelsey Booth and Darien Huff all reached double-digit scoring as well. The College ultimately secured the win by having a superior shooting night, going 48% from the field to CSU's 36%.

## **Scouting the Buccaneers**

- Charleston Southern went 14-17 overall and 8-12 against Big South opponents last year. They knocked off Longwood in the opening round of the conference tournament before falling to Liberty 68-53 in the quarterfinals.
- The Bucs are 6-3 to start the season, and were recently on a four-game winning streak, knocking off Lipscomb, S.C. State, Georgia Southern and Montreat. However, that was snapped at home on December 19 in the form of a 59-45 loss to Wofford. Charleston Southern struggled as a team in shooting, going a mere 15 of 58 from the field. Rachel Burns led the way with a 14-7.
- The Buccaneers have three players who average double digit scoring for them in Alyssa Mann, Ke'Asia Jackson, and Rachel Burns. Mann leads the way in both assists (4.9 APG) and steals (2.3 SPG) as well, while Elyse Kiploks is the team's primary interior threat, averaging 7 rebounds and 1.3 blocks per contest.

# **COUGARS KEELHAUL BUCCANEERS** 81-66, RISE TO 3-2

CHARLESTON, S.C. –After a challenging start to the game, the Cougars found their rhythm before half and coasted to an 81-66 win over Charleston Southern (4-2) to move to 3-2 on the season.

With their backs to the ropes after surrendering a 27-20 deficit through the first 14 minutes of play, the Cougars answered the bell, ripping off a 22-3 run to close out the half with a 42-30 lead. They would push the lead as far as 26, ultimately finishing with the 15-point win.

"Our defensive intensity picked up and we were better in our pressure," head coach Candice M. Jackson said. "We were able to force turnovers and we executed in transition. We were really looking to attack the basket more, and with these new rules we were able to get into the bonus and to the line."

Breanna Bolden bounced back from a rough night against Virginia Tech to lead the Cougars with 24 points on a highly efficient 10-of-13 from the field and 4-of-5 from the line. She added four steals, four rebounds, and matched a career-high four assists.

Not to be outdone, forward Jackie Luna-Castro had a career-day of her own, matching a best of three steals while scoring 15 points, just one off her career-record.

Kelsey Booth dropped 14 points of her own, finding her stroke with a 5-of-7 shooting night from the field, going 2-of-3 from deep while adding two steals and five boards. Freshman Darien Huff chipped in ten points of her own, while Courtney Gardner led the squad in rebounds with eight.

"We've put emphasis on taking what we learn in practice and taking it out onto the court," Jackson said. "It's really starting to come together. Our team chemistry has gotten better over these last five games, and things are starting to click."

Though they were out-rebounded 45-40, the Cougars came through with an advantage in the turnover battle (17 vs. 23) as well as going 28-of-58 (48.3%) from the field. Not only that, CofC found its way to the free throw line with ease all game long, earning 33 attempts.

Alyssa Mann kept CSU in the game with a 25-point afternoon on 9-of-19 shooting from the field. Monique Maximilien was involved as well, nearly snagging a double-double with ten points and nine rebounds.

The College will have three days off to prepare for the second half of their home-stand, a Wednesday night affair against former SoCon rival Appalachian State (1-4). Tipoff is scheduled for 6:30 p.m.

# **Head Coach**

Since taking the helm of the College of Charleston women's basketball program on April, 24, 2014, Candice M. Jackson has done a remarkable job at setting the program on a winning trajectory. Jackson inherits the mantle looking to build on the foundations for success set forth by former coaching greats at The College in former Tennessee Director of Women's Athletics Joan Cronan (1974-76), Nancy Wilson (two tenures from 1976-84 and 2003-12), Scooter Barnette (1984-94), Kathy McCaskill-Rhein (1994-98), Melissa Slone (1998-2003) and Natasha Adair (2012-14)

In 2015-16, the native of Lansing, Mich. more than doubled her win total from year one, going 11-20 overall and 5-13 in conference action. She secured her first-ever CAA Tournament victory by way of a 71-62 win over the UNCW Seahawks, and came within 67 seconds of shocking the No. 1 seeded James Madison Dukes in the second round. She is responsible for coaching two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year Breanna Bolden, who achieved All-Conference acclaim during both years of Jackson's tenure. Prior to the end of the season, Coach Jackson led the Cougars to a 68-24 win over UNCW, which set the all-time CofC record for fewest points allowed in a game.

A rising star in the coaching profession, Jackson previously spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Duke University under head coach Joanne P. McCallie. She worked mainly with the guards and was a part of back-to-back NCAA Elite Eight appearances in 2012 and 2013.

During her time on the Blue Devils' staff, Jackson helped sign three of the top recruiting classes in the nation. In 2012, Duke inked the seventh-best recruiting class in the country which included the No. 3 overall prospect in Alexis Jones, and the No. 2 signing classes in 2013 and 2014. In all, she worked with 12 McDonald's High School All-Americans, two WNBA First Round draft picks, two USBWA All-Americans, three Associated Press All-Americans and 15 ACC All-Academic Team selections.

Prior to Duke, Jackson spent two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Wake Forest University under head coach Mike Petersen. There, she aided in the signing of the program's first Top 100 signee and mentored two All-ACC selections. Jackson also helped lead the Demon Deacons to an 18-14 overall record and a WNIT appearance in 2009-10.

Prior to her arrival at Wake Forest, Jackson spent four successful seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond under head coach Michael Shafer, where she helped take the team from a 13-17 record in 2005-06 to a 24-10 finish and WNIT berth in 2008-09. While at Richmond, Jackson oversaw summer camps in addition to scouting, recruiting and coordinating video operations. Jackson was also in charge of community service efforts for the Spiders. She worked closely with Spider guard Amber Petillon, who blossomed during her senior year under Jackson's guidance and has enjoyed an extremely successful career overseas.

A four-year letter-winner at Michigan State University from 2000-04, Jackson played for McCallie and was Coach P's first recruit at MSU. Jackson served as team captain during her junior and senior years and led the team to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003 and 2004. She was also named a Big Ten Conference Scholar-Athlete twice and volunteered with the Boys & Girls Club of Lansing and St. Vincent's Home for Children.

A 2004 graduate of Michigan State, the former guard earned her bachelor's degree in family community service. She remained at her alma mater to serve as a graduate assistant coach for the 2004-05 squad that advanced all the way to the National Championship Game.

Originally from Lansing, Mich., Jackson was a three-time MVP at Lansing Everett High School, the same alma mater as Earvin "Magic" Johnson, and guided her team to the state title game as a senior. She is the daughter of Teresa B. Jackson and the late Larry Jackson, and has two sisters, Tedra Jackson and Tracy Jackson, Esq.
