Fast Break Points About College of Charleston

- The Cougars fell 60-47 at home to North Florida on Sunday. Tanisha Brown recorded her fourth double-double of the season with a 13-10 night. She ranks second in the CAA in rebounds with 9.3 per game.

- The College notched the 65-62 road-win over App State despite incurring 31 team fouls, 41 FT attempts by ASU, and four Cougars fouling out. Bre Bolden logged an 18-8, while Tanisha Brown secured a 17-10, her third double-double of the year.

- CofC suffered a 71-61 loss to Virginia Tech last week. The Cougars went down by as many as 16 points in the second quarter, but slowly chipped into the deficit, finally pulling within one in the fourth quarter before the Hokies finally pulled away for the eventual win. Bolden scored her second consecutive double-double (16-10), while Tanisha Brown (17), Darien Huff (12) and Dajah Logan (12) all logged double-digit scoring for CofC.

- The Cougars decimated the Winthrop Eagles on Nov 16, pulling out the 95-64 win in Winthrop Coliseum. Tanisha Brown picked up her second consecutive double-double (20-10) and added five steals. Bolden had 22 points and six steals to move up to No. 20 on the CofC All-Time scoring list, and Darien Huff set career-highs in scoring (19 Pts), assists (5) and blocks (2). It was the second-most FGM (38) and the fourth-most points (95) the Cougars have scored in their Division I Era.

- Two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year Breanna Bolden had an excellent start to the season in The College's 62-49 loss to Charlotte. Bolden pawed away a career-high eight steals, which propelled her to 243 in her career to break the CofC Division I Era career steals record. The senior also tacked on a team-high 16 points, as well as eight rebounds.

- The Cougars come off a 2015-16 campaign during which they went 11-20, more than doubling their win total from the previous season.

- The Cougars made the CAA Tournament as an 8 seed, and went on to defeat the UNCW Seahawks in the first round. That pitted them against the No. 1 seed James Madison Dukes, and the Cougars rose to the challenge. CofC hammered them inside, and led the game for nearly its full duration. But the Dukes seized the lead with 67 seconds left in the game and escaped with the 53-50 win.

- The Cougars add six newcomers to the roster, two redshirts and four freshman. RS-junior transfers Tanisha Brown (Charlotte) and Bri Boyd (Winthrop), as well as freshman Baileigh Larson (Orange Park, Fla.) will help bolster the front court. Cailin Dorsey (Raleigh, N.C.), Deja Ford (White Plains, Md.) and Dee Heath (Hanahan, S.C.) will all look to create a spark in the CofC back court.

The Cougars vs. Houston: Series History

- Sunday will mark the second time in history that the Cougars of the Lowcountry and the Cougars of the Lone Star State have gone at it in women's basketball. The one previous meeting came last season when CofC hosted Houston in their home-opener. Bolden posted a 19-6-4 wit two steals, while Huff cracked double-digits with 11 points, as the College prevailed 55-48.

Scouting the Cougars

- UH comes off a 6-24 season in 2015-16, going 2-16 against American Conference foes. They fell 76-38 in the opening round of the conference tournament to No. 6 Tulsa.

- Through six games, Houston has posted a 2-4 record thus far. They won their opener against Southeastern Louisiana by a score of 83-80, and then proceeded to lose their next four in a row. Their most recent game was a 68-52 road-win on the road against UTRGV.

- Angela Harris is Houston's best player, coming off the bench to average 12.5 points per game, while also racking up 15 steals and 14 assists through six games. Serithia Hawkins is a dynamic player in her own right, averaging an 8-10 with three steals per game.

Big Third Quarter Propels The College Past Houston 55-48

CHARLESTON, S.C. – The College of Charleston women's basketball team picked up the start to the season they were looking for Friday, pulling away from the Houston Cougars (0-1) with a 55-48 win.

"It feels really, really good," head coach Candice M. Jackson said. "I'm really proud of the team and the effort they put in. Just the way we played together and communicated...I think it's a big weight lifted off our shoulders."

The game got off to a slow start, with both teams tied 15-15 in the waning minute of the second quarter. A three followed by a go-ahead layup to close out the half gave Houston a 20-15 lead heading in to the locker room. The College responded with a huge third quarter, going on a seven-minute run in which CofC outscored UH 22-8 to take the 39-31 lead with 1:05 to go in the period.

Breanna Bolden scored 19 points on the night, going 3 of 4 from deep and a perfect 4 of 4 from the line. In addition, the junior picked up six boards, and matched her career-high in assists with four. She added two steals to complete the well-rounded display.

"She was classic Bre, her shooting performance says a lot," Jackson said. "Four assists to one turnover wasn't what she's known for, and that's big. I think having Darien (Huff) and Kelsey (Booth) and some of the new girls around her allow her to be a lot more comfortable out on the floor."

The College as a team was perfect from the line, converting all 15 of their attempts. Darien Huff led the way in that department with six, as the freshman scored 11 points with four rebounds and four assists in her first collegiate start. Also of note, CofC was commendable from deep, going 8-for-12. That stood in stark contrast to Houston's 7-of-29.

On the glass, both teams were somewhat evenly matched, with The College edging out the 42-40 advantage thanks in large part to a team-high seven-rebound night from senior Kelsey Booth. Houston thrived patrolling the interior with eight blocks, but losing the turnover battle 21-15 proved too large an obstacle.

"We recognized their size and their three point shooting, and we knew that they were going to take a lot of threes," Jackson said. "We wanted them to take more outside shots and prevent the ball from getting inside, and we were going to see what we got from there. We did a good job."

The Cougars (1-0) will treasure the momentum they've picked up with the win, because they're in for a challenging early-season three-game road trip this coming week. They'll fly to the Mountain Time Zone for a Monday showdown with Boise State (22-11 in 2014/15), followed by a Wednesday matchup with Weber State (11-18 in 2014/15). They'll finish things off by coming back out east to face off with Virginia Tech (12-20 in 2014/15) on Nov. 22 before finally returning home to play Charleston Southern (5-25 in 2014/15) on Nov. 28.

Since taking the helm of the College of Charleston women's basketball program on April, 24, 2014, Candice M. Jackson has done a remarkable job at setting the program on a winning trajectory. Jackson inherits the mantle looking to build on the foundations for success set forth by former coaching greats at The College in former Tennessee Director of Women's Athletics Joan Cronan (1974-76), Nancy Wilson (two tenures from 1976-84 and 2003-12), Scooter Barnette (1984-94), Kathy McCaskill-Rhein (1994-98), Melissa Slone (1998-2003) and Natasha Adair (2012-14).

In 2015-16, the native of Lansing, Mich. more than doubled her win total from year one, going 11-20 overall and 5-13 in conference action. She secured her first-ever CAA Tournament victory by way of a 71-62 win over the UNCW Seahawks, and came within 67 seconds of shocking the No. 1 seeded James Madison Dukes in the second round. She is responsible for coaching two-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year Breanna Bolden, who achieved All-Conference acclaim during both years of Jackson's tenure. Prior to the end of the season, Coach Jackson led the Cougars to a 68-24 win over UNCW, which set the all-time CofC record for fewest points allowed in a game.

A rising star in the coaching profession, Jackson previously spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Duke University under head coach Joanne P. McCallie. She worked mainly with the guards and was a part of back-to-back NCAA Elite Eight appearances in 2012 and 2013.

During her time on the Blue Devils' staff, Jackson helped sign three of the top recruiting classes in the nation. In 2012, Duke inked the seventh-best recruiting class in the country which included the No. 3 overall prospect in Alexis Jones, and the No. 2 signing classes in 2013 and 2014. In all, she worked with 12 McDonald's High School All-Americans, two WNBA First Round draft picks, two USBWA All-Americans, three Associated Press All-Americans and 15 ACC All-Academic Team selections.

Prior to Duke, Jackson spent two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Wake Forest University under head coach Mike Petersen. There, she aided in the signing of the program's first Top 100 signee and mentored two All-ACC selections. Jackson also helped lead the Demon Deacons to an 18-14 overall record and a WNIT appearance in 2009-10.

Prior to her arrival at Wake Forest, Jackson spent four successful seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Richmond under head coach Michael Shafer, where she helped take the team from a 13-17 record in 2005-06 to a 24-10 finish and WNIT berth in 2008-09. While at Richmond, Jackson oversaw summer camps in addition to scouting, recruiting and coordinating video operations. Jackson was also in charge of community service efforts for the Spiders. She worked closely with Spider guard Amber Pettillon, who blossomed during her senior year under Jackson's guidance and has enjoyed an extremely successful career overseas.

A four-year letter-winner at Michigan State University from 2000-04, Jackson played for McCallie and was Coach P's first recruit at MSU. Jackson served as team captain during her junior and senior years and led the team to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003 and 2004. She was also named a Big Ten Conference Scholar-Athlete twice and volunteered with the Boys & Girls Club of Lansing and St. Vincent's Home for Children.

A 2004 graduate of Michigan State, the former guard earned her bachelor's degree in family community service. She remained at her alma mater to serve as a graduate assistant coach for the 2004-05 squad that advanced all the way to the National Championship Game.

Originally from Lansing, Mich., Jackson was a three-time MVP at Lansing Everett High School, the same alma mater as Earvin "Magic" Johnson, and guided her team to the state title game as a senior. She is the daughter of Teresa B. Jackson and the late Larry Jackson, and has two sisters, Tedra Jackson and Tracy Jackson, Esq.
