COUGARS OPEN CAA PLAY WITH WIN AT TOWSON

The Cougars opened CAA play on Thursday with a come-from-behind 53-48 win at Towson.

Alexis Andrews scored all 14 of her points in the third quarter as Charleston turned a 14-point deficit into a tie going into the final stanza. Anika McGarity tallied 10 of her 13 points in the fourth quarter as the Cougars outscored the Tigers, 20-15.

Jada Logan was the third Cougar in double figures with 12 points and added a team-high nine rebounds and three assists.

COUGARS FEATURE BALANCED SCORING

With her team-high 14 points against Towson, Alexis Andrews became the fifth different player to lead the Cougars in scoring this season.

Jada Logan has paced the team in scoring five times, Jazmyn Stone has done so three times and Andrews and Jaila Roberts have been the top scorer once each. Jenna Annechiarico led the Cougars in the opener against Meredith before suffering a season-ending knee injury in practice the following week.

Three Cougars are averaging in double figures including Logan (17.2), Stone (12.5) and Anika McGarity (10.9). Roberts is right behind at 9.9 followed by Andrews at 7.8.

Logan, Stone, McGarity and Roberts all have at least one 20-point game this season and have combined to reach that mark 10 times.

CHARLESTON IN THE CAA

The win over Towson was the second in 10 CAA openers since the Cougars joined the conference in 2013-14. Charleston is 4-5 in its first CAA home game of the season.

Last season the Cougars finished 9-9 in the CAA, their most conference wins since going 9-7 in their debut season. Charleston was picked to finish second in the preseason poll.

LOGAN MAKES HISTORY IN WIN OVER BERRY

Jada Logan recorded just the second triple-double in Charleston history with 22 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists in an 84-38 win over Berry. It was her fourth 20-point outing of the season, including a career-high 33 vs. Coastal.

STONE AMONG TOP FRESHMAN SCORERS IN NATION

Jazmyn Stone ranks 24th in the nation among freshmen with her average of 12.5 points per game. That includes a stretch of four straight 20-point games in which she had a total of 100 points.

Stone began her scoring run with 27 vs. Gardner-Webb followed by 21 vs. Radford, 20 vs. Coastal Carolina and a season-high 32 vs. city rival Charleston Southern. She was named the CAA Player of the Week on December 5.

Only four freshmen have scored more points in a game than Stone's 32 vs. Charleston Southern.

LOGAN AND STONE BOTH REACH 30-POINT MARK

For the second time in Charleston's Division I history, two different players have scored 30 points in a game in the same season. Jada Logan scored 33 vs. Coastal Carolina, and Jazmyn Stone tallied 32 vs. Charleston Southern.

The only other time that different players reached 30 points in the same season came in 1997-98 when Missy Peterson and Jodie Olofson both reached that plateau.
