GAME 26 CHARLESTON (16-9, 9-3) vs. HOFSTRA (16-9, 7-5)

STORYLINES

- The College of Charleston men's basketball team welcomes Hofstra to TD Arena for the second meeting between the programs this season on Thursday, February 12. Action is set for 7:00 p.m. on FloCollege.
- The Cougars previously defeated Hofstra in Hempstead 66-64 on January 29. The Pride led by 11 four minutes into the second half before Jlynn Counter took over, scoring four straight from the field to make it a four-point game. A 7-0 Cougar run tied the game 47-47 with eight minutes to play before Charleston took their first lead since the opening possession on a pair of Counter makes from the line and never looked back.
- Counter had a game-high 22 points, scoring 20 in the second half. The graduate student added ten rebounds and five assists for his second career double-double. Christian Reeves recorded his fourth career double-double against the Pride, contributing 16 points and 13 rebounds.
- Charleston is coming off a 76-64 loss to UNCW on Monday night in Charleston, snapping the Cougars' five-game win streak. Counter and Reeves led Charleston again, with Counter contributing 20 points and six rebounds while Reeves recorded his fifth career double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds.
- Counter has recorded ten 20+ point performances this season and leads three Cougars in the starting lineup averaging double-digit points per game with 16.8. He is followed by Connor Hickman with 11.7 and Reeves with 10.5.
- Counter leads the CAA in total assists with 128 so far this season, the 20th most in a single season in school history.
- Redshirt sophomore Chol Machot currently ranks fourth in the nation in total blocks (64) and ninth in blocks per game (2.56). His 64 blocks on the year already are the sixth most in a single season in program history. Three against the Pride would move the Australia native to the fifth spot in the record book.
- The Cougars continue to be one of the top teams in the nation in getting to the free throw line, ranking 32nd in attempts per game (24.8) and 34th in makes per game (18.3). Chris Mack's program also ranks 34th in defensive rebounds per game (27.36).

GAME 26 - HOFSTRA

MACK BIO

Chris Mack, one of just 19 coaches in college basketball history to lead their team to a No. 1 ranking within the first two years at their school, has agreed to a five-year contract as the new men's basketball head coach at the College of Charleston entering the 2024-25 season.

Mack, whose teams have participated in the NCAA Tournament in nine of his 12 seasons as a head coach, returns to coaching collegiate basketball after a two-year hiatus. His 259 victories were the 12th most amassed by a coach in their first 11 seasons.

The Cincinnati native becomes the 8th head coach in the program's Division I history.

Mack guided Louisville to a 24-7 record and a 15-5 ACC mark in 2019-2020. It was the best overall record through 31 games for a Louisville team in six years and marked the most conference victories for the Cardinals in their six years in the ACC. The Cards achieved a Top 15 ranking throughout the season, including two weeks as the nation's top-ranked team in the AP and USA Today polls.

In his first season at Louisville, Mack guided the Cardinals to a 20-14 record and earned a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament while facing the nation's fourth-toughest schedule. Louisville ranked among the nation's top 30 teams in both offensive (27th) and defensive efficiency (24th).

Before joining Louisville, Mack spent nine seasons as the head coach at Xavier, guiding the Musketeers to a 215-97 record and eight NCAA Tournament appearances, including reaching the Sweet 16 on four occasions and the Elite Eight in 2017. His teams won or shared three conference regular season championships while compiling a 105-49 league record over nine seasons in the Big East and Atlantic 10.

His 2017-18 squad achieved a 29-6 record, won Xavier's first Big East Conference regular season championship, and earned the school's first-ever No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Mack was honored as the 2018 Big East Coach of the Year, NABC District 5 Coach of the Year, and became the all-time coaching wins leader with the Musketeers.

His 2016-17 Xavier team made an NCAA Tournament run to the Elite Eight after earning a No. 11 seed. His teams have reached the NCAA Sweet 16 on four occasions, in 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2017. As a player, assistant and head coach, Mack has been a part of 19 NCAA Tournament appearances.

He was the 2009-10 Basketball Times Rookie Coach of the Year and guided Xavier to a 26-9 record, shared the Atlantic 10 Championship and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.

In 10 seasons as an assistant or operations director, he helped his teams produce a 229-96 record (.705), win four regular season titles and one conference tournament championship, and secure eight NCAA Tournament appearances, advancing to three Sweet 16s and one Elite Eight.

A 1992 Xavier graduate with a degree in communication arts, Mack was a two-time team captain as a player at Xavier under then head coach Pete Gillen.

IT'S CHARLESTON AFTER ALL

- In his second season at the helm of program, Chris Mack leads the sixth winningest program in Division I men's basketball history in Charleston.
- Charleston's 68.7% all time winning percentage sits only behind Kentucky (76%), North Carolina (73.4%), Kansas (72.9%), and Duke (71.2%) and UCLA (69.1%). UNLV (68.5%), and Syracuse (67.2%) follow the Cougars.
- The Cougars have made seven NCAA tournament appearances and six NIT appearances in addition to winning the NAIA National Championship in 1983 under John Kresse. Since joining the CAA in 2013, Charleston has won three conference titles (2018, 2023, 2024).
- Cougar Nation is a big part of the sustained success. For the third consecutive season, the department has sold out men's basketball season tickets in TD Arena prior to the start of the 2025-26 season. This season was historic, selling out in quicker fashion than the 2024-25 season.
- Since the 2022 season, the Cougars are 97-26 overall and 53-7 at TD Arena with 52 consecutive sellouts. The streak is the eighth longest sellout streak in Division 1 men's basketball.
- Mack on season sellout- "Our program is fortunate to have felt such strong and consistent support from Cougar Nation. The energy and excitement from our team for this upcoming season is real. We're ready to represent the Charleston legacy every night. Go Cougs!"

PRESEASON RUMBLINGS

- The Cougars were picked to finish third by the league's coaches, receiving one first place vote and 130 total points. Towson was picked as the front runner, collecting seven first place votes and 136 points. UNCW received the remaining five first place votes with 132 points.
- Charleston joins Towson as the only two schools with more than one representative on the All-CAA First and Second teams with Colby Duggan earning a spot on the All-CAA First Team and Mister Dean being named to the All-CAA Second Team. Duggan was a unanimous first team selection after transferring to Charleston from CAA foe Campbell.
- The Cougars were ranked No. 13 in the preseason College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 and No. 8 in the preseason Field of 68 Mid-Major Top 25.
- Charleston started the 2025-26 season at 132 in the KenPom rankings and 136 in the Torvik rankings.

VETERAN PRESENCE

- Of the Cougars' nine upperclassmen transfers, seven averaged double figures points per game at their previous stop - Colby Duggan (15.7ppg, Campbell), Mister Dean (15.7 ppg, USC Upstate), Connor Hickman (14.5 ppg, Bradley), Chol Machot (11.6, Florida SouthWestern), Will Mortimore (11.0 ppg, Colorado Mesa), Kendall Taylor (24.4 ppg, Wingate), and Jlynn Counter (10.6 ppg, MTSU).
- The Cougars boast three 1,000 career point scorers in Jlynn Counter (1,191), Connor Hickman (1,009), Kendall Taylor (1,151).
- Charleston's average age for the 2025-26 season is 20.6 years old with the oldest Cougar being born in 2001 (Kendall Taylor) and youngest in 2007 (Chris Davis Jr.).

LOOK UP

- The Cougars add noticeable size presence in the paint with two seven-footers in Christian Reeves (7-2) and Chol Machot (7-0).
- Machot currently ranks ninth in the nation in blocks per game and fourth in total blocks. He notched a season-high seven vs. Elon, the second most in a single-game in school history.
- Charleston's average height for 2025-26 is 6-5. In 2024-2025, the average was 6-2. In the 2023-24 (under Pat Kelsey), it was 6-3.
- The Cougars are the only team in the CAA with two true seven-footers.

ROOKIES ON THE RISE

- True freshman Chris Davis Jr. , Chadlyn Traylor, and Martin Kalu will look to make an immediate impact for Charleston.
- Traylor, a 6-3 point guard from Charlotte, N.C., was a McDonald's All-American nominee at North Mecklenburg Hugh School. He averaged 3.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 1.7 steals per game and has been a part of three state title teams, his first coming at the 3A level as a freshman at West Charlotte. Traylor played for Team Curry on the Under Armour circuit.
- Davis Jr., a 6-4 guard from Madison, Wisconsin, comes to Charleston as the No. 5 all-time scorer in Wisconsin high school. The first ever Cougar basketball player from Wisconsin, Davis Jr. finished his high school career with 2,688 points.
- Kalu, a 6-6 guard from Quakenbrück, Germany represented Team Germany in the 2025 FIBA U20 Eurobasket, averaging 15.3 ppg, 7.9 rpg and 1.3 apg. The 20-year old played for Basketball Loewen Braunschweig in the BBL, the top tier of German basketball. He was the first Cougar in the program's Division I history to open his collegiate career with four straight double figure scoring performances.

COUNT ON COUNTER

- Through conference play, graduate student point guard Jlynn Counter is averaging 19.1 points per game, 5.5 rebounds per game, and 6.6 assists per game. He has earned three CAA Player of the Week honors so far this season.
- Chris Mack on Counter- "One of the best closers in the league". Counter went on a personal 13-2 run vs. Northeastern to close the game and seal the win.

COUGS FIND A WAY

- Charleston is 7-0 in games decided by less than five points so far this season and 14-1 overall in the Chris Mack era.
- The Cougars are undefeated this season when leading at halftime.

NEW COUGS ON THE BLOCK

- Charleston returns three players from the 2024-2025 season in Jaxon Prunty, Djole Curcic, and Joey Scarpitti. Both Prunty and Curcic's seasons were cut short due to season ending injuries, while Scarpitti's playing time was limited as a walk-on student-athlete.
- The Cougars welcome nine transfers to the 2025-26 roster - six from the Division I level, two from the Division II level, and one from the JUCO level.
