Tywain McKee, who led the Eagles with 15 points, connected on a short jumper with 6:55 to play in the game which trimmed the Mount St. Mary's lead to 57-55. When Antwan Harrison finally broke the scoring drought on a running one-hander at the 1:20 mark of the second period the Eagles trailed 64-57. Mount St. Mary's, which won its first NCAA Tournament game in three appearances, also used a big advantage from the free throw line to earn the win. The Mount outscored the Eagles 26-6 from the charity stripe and had 32 attempts to Coppin State's 13. The Eagles (16-21) saw their remarkable season come to a close despite out-shooting Mount St. Mary's.

## 1976 NAIA National Champions

Coppin State achieved its first taste of national success in 1976, when the Baltimore school won the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) Championship behind the play of center Joe Pace.

The Eagles, under second-year head coach John Bates, had six four-year transfers on the roster, including Mickey Heard (LSU) and Pace (UMES), who followed Bates when he left Maryland-Eastern Shore. Tony Carter was one of three junior college transfers on the squad.

Coppin State, which achieved its milestone in its first and only trip to the national tournament, opened its adventure in Kansas City with a 78-55 win over Dowling, as Pace had 29 points and 14 rebounds.

In the second round, the Eagles overcame a seven-point deficit in the final three and a half minutes to squeak by Wisconsin-Parkside, 68-67. Pace sank two free throws with 16 seconds left for the decisive points.

Coppin State followed with an 88-77 victory over Texas Southern behind Pace's 31 points, 17 rebounds and nine blocks.

In the semifinals, Pace continued his outstanding performance, despite injuring his ankle in the second half. The 6-11 senior had 29 points, including a game-winning 25-foot jumper with five seconds to play, to lift Coppin State to an 82-81 win over fourth-seeded Marymount.

Pace, hobbling on a sprained ankle, saved his best for last, totaling 43 points, 12 rebounds and six blocks as the Eagles topped Henderson State, 96-91, in the championship game for their 30th straight win.

Carter finished with 26 points, while Heard added 14 points and 13 rebounds.

Pace, who led the NAIA in rebounding, was named the tournament's most valuable player. He also earned berths on the NAIA All-America first team and the Associated Press College Division All-America second team.

Carter joined Pace on the NAIA All-Tournament squad.
