PUCK DROP

Coming off its six-game road trip to open the 2022-23 regular season, the Cornell men's hockey team returns to Lynah Rink for its first pair of home games when it welcomes Ivy League rivals Yale and Brown this weekend.

WEEKEND REWIND

- For the second consecutive weekend, Cornell split its pair of weekend games against ECAC opposition.
- Cornell scored a season-high five goals matching the output produced in the previous three games combined — against St. Lawrence in a 5-1 victory over the Skating Saints at Appleton Arena in Canton, N.Y.
- Clarkson scored two power-play goals to lift the Golden Knights to a 4-1 victory over the Big Red at Cheel Arena in Potsdam, N.Y., handing Cornell its first loss in St. Lawrence County since Jan. 2016.

LYNAH FAITHFUL

- Playing at Lynah Rink in front of the Lynah Faithful has favored Cornell since MIKE SCHAFER '86 took over as head coach prior to the 1995-96 season
- Under Schafer, Cornell has a 261-102-48 record at Lynah Rink, good for a .693 win percentage. According to data from CollegeHockeyNews.com's database, the Big Red has the sixth-best home win percentage over the last 28-plus seasons.
- Only Michigan (.754), North Dakota (.726), Quinnipiac (.720), Boston College (.713), and Denver (.703) have higher win percentages on home ice than the Big Red.
- Over the last five-plus years, Cornell has been one of the more hostile places to play college

hockey, as Cornell is 47-12-6 (.769), dating back to the 2017-18 season. Only Minnesota State (.887 - 89-10-3) and Denver (.770 - 64-16-9) have higher win percentages. Cornell is 22-4-5 at Lynah Rink over its last 31 games, dating back to the 2018-19 season.

- After playing its first six regular-season games on the road, Cornell will play its first two home games of the season this weekend.
- It is the fifth time in program history that the Big Red have played at least six games before having its home opener. The other four instances occurred in the 1912-13, 1939-40, 1959-60 and 2016-17 seasons.
- Both the 1912-13 and 1939-40 seasons featured seven road games played before its lone home game of their respective seasons on Beebe Lake, located next to the Cornell Botanic Gardens. The 1959-60 season had a program-record nine games away from Lynah Rink before its home opener on Jan. 16, 1960. Like this year, the 2016-17 season had six road games before its Nov. 18 home opener against Quinnipiac.

SCHAFER REACHES MILESTONE

MIKE SCHAFER '86, the Jay R. Bloom '77 Head Coach of Men's Hockey, reached a historic milestone on Nov. 4 at Hobey Baker Memorial Rink in Princeton, N.J.

With the Big Red's 3-1 victory over Princeton, Schafer notched his 500th career head coaching victory, becoming the 21st Division I hockey head coach to reach 500 career wins.

Schafer is the seventh active head coach, and the fourth at the Division I level, to register 500 career coaching victories.

The other Division I coaches with at least 500 career wins include Mercyhurst's Rick Gotkin (589),

🥵 Schafer's 501 career wins stand as the most by a Cornell hockey head coach and is the most by any active head coach of Cornell's 37 varsity sports.

KILLING (PENALTY) TIME

Cornell enters this weekend in the top 10 for top penalty killing units at the Division I level. After last weekend's games, the Big Red has the 10th-best penalty kill unit nationally, successfully killing 23 of its opponent's 27 power plays (85.2 percent).

Of the teams currently ranking in the top-10 in penalty killing units, Cornell is currently scheduled to play Harvard (Dec. 2 at Lynah Rink and Jan. 28 at Bright-Landry Hockey Center) and UConn (Nov. 26 at Madison Square Garden).

The four power-play goals allowed is tied with Ohio State, Michigan Tech, and Minnesota State for the third-fewest by a Division I program this season. Harvard (one goal) and Dartmouth (three goals) have allowed fewer goals when down a man.

ECAC PRESEASON POLL

ECAC Hockey announced Sept. 21 during its annual Media Day call that the Cornell hockey team was slated to finish fourth.

Quinnipiac was dubbed the preseason favorite after receiving eight first-place votes, finishing with 118 points. Harvard received the remaining four first-place votes, logging a 109-point total. Clarkson was the only other program to have a point total over the century mark (105).

Cornell followed Clarkson with its 90 points, while Colgate finished in fifth with 77 points. RPI (70), St. Lawrence (57), and Union (45), Dartmouth (43), Yale (32), Brown (26), and Princeton (20) rounded out the poll.

LEADERSHIP GROUP ANNOUNCED

Senior defensemen SAM MALINSKI and TRAVIS MITCHELL were named co-captains, while fifth-year forward MAX ANDREEV and senior forward MATT STIENBURG were tabbed co-alternate captains on Sept. 29.

All four players are assuming leadership roles for the first time with the Cornell hockey program.

PUTTING THE BODY ON THE LINE

Cornell defensemen TRAVIS MITCHELL and HANK KEMPF both rank in the top 10 in ECAC Hockey for blocked shots per game.

Mitchell has blocked 13 shots over Cornell's first six games, good for fourth among ECAC players with an average of 2.17 blocks per game. Kempf is tied for fifth with his average of two blocked shots per game.

The Big Red are just one of three ECAC Hockey programs to have multiple players in the top 10 in blocked shots, joined by Brown and Princeton.

ECAC ACTIVE LEADERS

■ After spending his first three seasons at Union — a fellow ECAC school — junior GABRIEL SEGER has the fourthmost faceoff wins by an active player in the conference (583). Quinnipiac's Skyler Brind'Amour has the most with 1,002. Senior forward MAX ANDREEV has won 513 draws, ranking as the sixth-most faceoffs won by an active ECAC player.

The tandem of Seger and Andreev give Cornell a pair of players with at least 500 career faceoff wins, making the Big Red one of two teams in ECAC Hockey to accomplish the feat. Only Quinnipiac (Brind'Amour – 1,002 – and Desi Burgart – 731) is the other program.

Along with being in the top 10 for most faceoffs won, Andreev is tied with Dartmouth's Tanner Palocsik for the fourth-most assists by an active ECAC player (39). Quinnipiac's Ethan de Jong has the conference's lead with 66 helpers.

Fellow senior forward BEN BERARD is tied with Clarkson's Alex Campbell for the eight-most goals scored by an active ECAC player with 22 career tallies. de Jong also has the active goals lead with 46 goals in 151 games. Berard also has the most hat tricks by an ECAC player with two.

© Cornell defensemen TRAVIS MITCHELL and SAM MALINSKI, along with Andreev, rank in the top 10 in highest plus-minus figures among active ECAC players.

Andreev and Malinski are tied with Clarkon's Mathieu Gosselin for the fourth-highest plus-minus rating (plus-34).

Malinski has the second-highest plus-minus rating by a defenseman, trailing Quinnipiac's Zach Metsa, who has an ECAC Hockey-leading plus-65 rating. Mitchell is tied with Harvard blueliner Henry Thrun for the third-highest rating by a defenseman.

• Of the forwards currently listed in the top 10, Andreev and Gosselin are tied for the third-highest rating by a forward. Only Quinnipiac's Ethan de Jong (plus-50) and Michael Lombardi (plus-48) having higher career plus-minus ratings.

Colorado College and North Dakota round out the top 10 with their 80 percent totals.

Of the seven programs ahead of Cornell, the Big Red are slated to play four of the teams this season (Dartmouth, Sacred Heart, St. Lawrence, and Yale).

The Bulldogs have been shutout in each of its last four games and have not scored over its last 249:28 of game action. It is the third time in Yale's history that they have been shutout in at least three consecutive games (1908-09 and 1920-21 — three-game streaks).

Ryan Stevens is the son of Kevin Stevens, who played 874 NHL games with Pittsburgh, N.Y. Rangers, Los Angeles, Boston, and Philadelphia, before becoming a scout for Pittsburgh from 2005-21.

SCOUTING BROWN

Brown enters the weekend with a 1-4-1 overall record, which is identical to its ECAC Hockey mark.

The Bears are currently on a four-game winless streak (0-3-1), which features a shootout victory over Dartmouth on Nov. 5.

Cole Quisenberry has four points (two goals, two assists) to pace Brown's offense. James Crossman (two goals) is the only other Bear with multiple goals on the year.

Mathieu Caron has been the Bears' go-to goaltender this year, having played all 362:11 that Brown has played. Caron has a 2.48 goalsagainst average and a .919 save percentage.

SERIES HISTORY

Saturday will be the 135th all-time meeting between Cornell and Brown. The Big Red own the series lead, 82-44-8, including a 44-15-4 mark at Lynah Rink against its Ivy League foe.

Cornell had its 17-game unbeaten streak to the Bears snapped in the last meeting with a 2-1 loss at Meehan Auditorium.

Over the previous 36 meetings against Brown, Cornell has dominated the series by posting a 27-6-3 record over the Bears and has a plus-59 advantage in goals scored (125-66).

It will be third time Cornell and Brown will be playing on Nov. 19, and will be the second time in as many years. Cornell lost the first meeting on the date to Brown, 4-2, in 1994, before posting a 3-2 overtime victory last year at Lynah Rink.

MIKE SCHAFER '86

Jay R. Bloom '77 Head Coach of Men's Ice Hockey 28th Season as Head Coach • 35th Season at Cornell

The longest-tenured head coach in Cornell men's hockey history, MIKE SCHAFER '86, enters his 28th season at the helm of the Cornell men's hockey program.

When Schafer returned to his alma mater in the summer of 1995 to become Cornell's 12th head coach in men's hockey history, Schafer's goal was to bring the Big Red to a position of national prominence.

Already the winningest head coach in Cornell men's hockey history, Schafer has accomplished that objective with his 501-275-103 record. His 501 wins rank fourth among active Division I coaches and his .629 win percentage is good for fifth among active Division I coaches.

Schafer has guided the Big Red to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances and a berth to the 2003 NCAA Frozen Four — the program's first since 1980. That year, Cornell set a school record for wins (30), finishing with one more victory than the 1969-70 national championship squad, who went undefeated (29-0-0). The 2002-03 team's 19-2-1 record in ECAC Hockey play was Cornell's best mark in league play since 1969-70 when Cornell was 21-0 in league action.

In 2020, Schafer was named a co-winner of the Spencer Penrose Award, given to the nation's top head coach. It was the first time Schafer won the award after being a finalist on five occasions after being named ECAC Hockey's Coach of the Year.

The Big Red have been regularly ranked among the nation's elite during Schafer's tenure, including being named No. 1 in both the USCHO.com and the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine polls at the time the 2019-20 postseason was halted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Cornell has claimed five Whitelaw Cup (ECAC Hockey tournament titles), which surpassed the legendary NED HARKNESS for the most in program history. Schafer has also led the Big Red to three Cleary Cups (ECAC's top regular-season team) in three of the last four years of competition.

In 2002-03, Schafer led the Big Red to the NCAA Frozen Four, setting a school record with 30 wins, one better than the 1969-70 squad who went 29-0-0. Cornell's 19-2-1 mark in ECAC Hockey in 2002-03 was Cornell's best since the 1969-70 team went 21-0 in league play.

Over his career, Schafer has coached 10 different players to First Team All-America status 11 times, seven Ivy League Players of the Year, 5 ECAC Hockey Ken Dryden Award winners (league's best goaltender), five ECAC Hockey Rookies of the Year, and five Ivy Rookies of the Year, and three ECAC Hockey Players of the Year.

A native of Durham, Ontario, Schafer played junior hockey with the Guelph Jr. A Holody Platers, who were finalists in the Centennial Cup for the National Championship in 1982.

Schafer and his wife, Diane, have two sons, Luke and John '18, and a daughter, Michelle.

BEN SYER

11th Season as Associate Head Coach; 12th Season at Cornell Western Ontario '98

Serving as the Big Red's recruiting director and manager of the team's vaunted defensive

unit, BEN SYER's efforts were perhaps no more celebrated than during the 2017-18 season. He helped Cornell lead the nation in team defense with a paltry 1.58 goals-against average and was named the winner of the American Hockey Coaches Association's 2018 Terry Flanagan Award.

One of the AHCA's major annual awards, the Terry Flanagan Award is presented to the assistant coach whose career body of work best honors that of the award's name sake.

"He can hold court with a group of assistant coaches on the road with the best of them," said MIKE SCHAFER, adding that this is the first time he's nominated anyone for a major AHCA award in his 23-year tenure at the helm of the Big Red. "He knows the elder statesmen, but he also knows the young guys like Terry did. He would make sure to say hello to everyone in the rink and lend a helping hand to young assistants. I admired Terry for this. He and his family are of the highest character, upfront and honest."

Syer joined Cornell in June 2011 as an assistant coach, then was promoted to associate head coach the following summer. He previously served as associate head coach during his 12 seasons at Quinnipiac under head coach Rand Pecknold. During that run, the Bobcats posted a 242-168-46 record with one NCAA tournament appearance (2002) and nine 20-win seasons.

A native of Kitchener, Ontario, Syer arrived at Quinnipiac after serving one season as an assistant coach at Ohio University. A 1998 graduate of Western Ontario, Syer earned a bachelor's degree in urban development. He earned his master's degree in physical education with a concentration in athletic administration in 2000.



SEAN FLANAGAN

Seventh Season as Assistant CoachSt. Lawrence '10

Flanagan enters his seventh season as an assistant coach on head coach MIKE SCHAFER's

staff. During his previous six seasons, Flanagan helped guide the Big Red to post a 108-38-19 record, good for a .712 win percentage. In his first three years on Schafer's staff, Flanagan aided Cornell in going 3-for-3 in advancing to the NCAA Tournament (and likely would have been 4-for-4, if the 2019-20 season had not ended prematurely). Prior to arriving on East Hill prior to the 2016-17 season, Flanagan made a couple of stops after his four-year playing career at St. Lawrence. After playing professionally in the ECHL with the Las Vegas Wranglers and Quad City Mallards, he became an assistant coach at Division III Hobart from 2012-15. While working under former Cornell assistant coach Mark Taylor, he helped

build a team who won the ECAC West titles in 2015 and 2016, leading the Statesmen to NCAA Tournament appearances. After Hobart, Flanagan spent one season as the Director of Hockey Operations at UMass Lowell, during the 2015-16 season. Flanagan is no stranger to ECAC Hockey, as he played 121 career games with St. Lawrence up to the 2010-11 season, where he racked up 12 goals and 40 assists for 52 points, helping the Saints advance to the league's championship weekend twice over his four years with the Saints. Flanagan graduated from St. Lawrence with a bachelor of arts degree in history with a minor in sports studies and exercise sciences in 2010 before receiving his master of education degree from St. Lawrence the following year.



MITCH STEPHENS

Fourth Season as Volunteer Assistant Coach; SUNY Geneseo '07

Stephens returns to Cornell after serving as an assistant coach at Geneseo for five years. In his time behind the bench with his alma mater, Stephens helped the Knights win two

SUNYAC conference championships (2016, 2018) and make three NCAA Tournament appearances (2014, 2016, and 2018), including two trips to the national semifinals. As a senior, Stephens was named runner-up for USCHO Division III Player of the Year, an AHCA Division III First Team, and All-America selection, while being a finalist for the AHCA Sid Watson Memorial Award as the NCAA Division III Player of the Year.



BEN RUSSELL

First Season as Director of Hockey Operations; Cornell '20

Russell rejoined the Cornell men's hockey program in Aug. 2022 to serve as the team's Director of Hockey Operations, after spending the last two seasons as an assistant coach

at St. Olaf College, a Minnesota-based Division III school. At St. Olaf, Russell helped the 2021-22 squad to a Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) tournament title and an NCAA Tournament appearance. While attending Cornell for his undergraduate studies, Russell served as an Assistant Director of Hockey Operations, helping coordinate video, analyzing film, and preparing scouting reports, while incorporating advanced analytics into game preparation.





MACDONALD '15 BECOMES THIRD CORNELLIAN TO HOIST STANLEY CUP

ITHACA, N.Y. (JUNE 26, 2022) — JACOB MacDONALD '15 became the third player in Cornell history to lift the Stanley Cup when his Colorado Avalanche defeated the Tampa Bay Lightning, 2-1, in Game 6 of the 2022 Stanley Cup Playoffs at Amalie Arena in Tampa, Fla.

MacDonald joined six-time winner KEN DRYDEN and three-time champion JOE NIEUWENDYK in hoisting the oldest existing trophy awarded to a professional sports franchise in North America.

Since graduating from Cornell, MacDonald has played in the ECHL with the Elmira Jackals and Toledo Walleye, the AHL with the Springfield Falcons, Albany and Binghamton Devils, Springfield Thunderbirds and Colorado Eagles around NHL stints with

the Florida Panthers in 2018-19 and the Avalanche in both 2020-21 and 2021-22.

He played eight regular-season games with Colorado this season and has two goals and eight assists in 43 regular season NHL games.

MacDonald was called up from Colorado of the AHL in early June to provide the Avalanche with some additional depth at the defenseman position.

The three-year starter for the Big Red accumulated four goals and 17 assists for 21 points in 104 career games. His plus-6 rating as a senior ranked second on the club.


