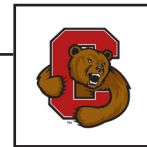

FIRST TOUCH

🦊 Cornell returns to Berman Field tonight for a non-conference match against its Empire State foe Canisius. First touch is slated for 7 p.m., with game action broadcast on ESPN+.

NIAGARA RECAP

🦊 Senior midfielder **BRANDON MORALES** broke a 1-1 tie in the 85th minute with his second goal of the match, leading Cornell to a 2-1 victory over Niagara at Niagara Field on Saturday night.

🦊 Morales recorded his first collegiate brace as fifth-year forward **EMEKA ENELI** assisted on both of Morales' goals in the win for Cornell.

🦊 Freshman goalkeeper **RYAN FRIEDBERG** recorded a pair of saves while earning his fourth victory of the season.

ABOUT THE BIG RED

🦊 Sophomore forward **ALIOUNE KA** has a team-leading five points (two goals, one assist). Freshman midfielder **WESTIN CARNEVALE** (two goals), senior midfielder **BRANDON MORALES** (two goals), and fifth-year forward **EMEKA ENELI** (four assists) have four points apiece.

🦊 Freshman goalkeeper **RYAN FRIEDBERG** has been Cornell's go-to goalkeeper. He has played all of the Big Red's 450 minutes in goal this season, posting a 4-1-0 record with a 0.80 goals-against average and a .714 save percentage.

ASSISTING THE TEAM

🦊 Fifth-year forward **EMEKA ENELI** has assisted four of Cornell's last five goals scored over the Big Red's previous three games. Eneli assisted on both of Cornell's goals against Saint Joseph's on Sept. 10 before doing the same a week later against Niagara on Saturday.

🦊 He is Cornell's first player to register multiple games with two-plus assists since 2011 when **JIMMY LANNON** had two multi-assist games.

FRIEDBERG'S STRONG START

🦊 Freshman goalkeeper **RYAN FRIEDBERG** has shined for the Big Red between the pipes this season.

🦊 His four victories make him the third Cornell freshman goalkeeper with four-plus wins. The record is seven, set by **STEPHEN BOTT** in 1983 and **QUINN O'SULLIVAN** in 1992.

🦊 Friedberg's 0.80 goals-against average is the best by any Ivy League goalkeeper, edging Penn's Nick Christoffersen (0.84). His .714 save percentage is third, trailing Dartmouth's Costi Christodoulou (.769) and Yale's Elian Haddock (.727).

🦊 A two-time Ivy League Rookie of the Week, Friedberg is the first Ivy League keeper to be the top newcomer at least twice in a season since Dartmouth's James Hickok in 2013. Friedberg is Cornell's first player to be Rookie of the Week multiple times since **EMEKA ENELI** in 2018.

🦊 Friedberg's pair of clean sheets has him tied with **RICK PFLASTERER** (2009) for the third-most shutouts by a Cornell freshman goalkeeper. Only Bott (7 in 1983) and O'Sullivan (4.5 in 1992) had more clean sheets in their first year with the Big Red.

WHAT'S AT STAKE

A victory tonight would be the Big Red's best six-game start to a season since 2013, when Cornell opened its first six matches with a 5-0-1 record. That season, Cornell opened the year on an eight-game unbeaten streak (6-0-2) before concluding the year with an 8-5-4 mark.

Cornell would have a 4-1-1 record through its first six games for a second consecutive season with a draw tonight. Last year's squad was 4-1-1 after its first six games before going 11-3-2.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

The Cornell men's soccer team was tabbed to finish third in the 2022 Ivy League Men's Soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 23.

Princeton was named the preseason favorite, garnering 12 of the 16 possible first-place votes, finishing with 123 points. Right behind the Tigers was Yale, who received the remaining four first-place votes and had 103 points.

Cornell was third with 97 points, while Harvard (89 points), Penn (56), Brown (45), Dartmouth (39), and Columbia (27) rounded out the poll.

ROAD WARRIORS

After Saturday's victory at Niagara, Cornell improved to 22-9-1 on the road since the beginning of the 2018 season, good for a .703 win percentage.

Cornell is one of six Division I schools to post a win percentage north of .700 on the road over the last four-plus seasons. Only Missouri State (.821), Saint Mary's (.776), Washington (.721), Georgetown (.714), and UCF (.707) have higher percentages.

The Big Red are one of 19 programs to be undefeated on the road this season. Cornell's four road victories are the most for any Division I program, while 14 teams are behind with three road wins.

BERMAN FIELD ADVANTAGE

Vermont snapped Cornell's 15-game unbeaten streak at Berman Field last Tuesday in the Big Red's 2-1 loss. It was Cornell's first setback at home since Nov. 3, 2018, in a 2-1 defeat to Dartmouth.

Since 2019, Cornell has a 12-1-3 record (.844) on its home turf. The Big Red's .844 win percentage ranks as the 12th-best of any Division I school with at least 15 home games during that stretch.

Cornell is just one of two Division I programs with at least 15 home games played to have just one home loss over the last three-plus seasons. Yale is the other program to lose just one home game since 2019, as the Bulldogs have a 13-1-2 record.

LEADERSHIP TEAM ANNOUNCED

Fifth-year forward **EMEKA ENELI**, senior defender **CONNOR DROUGHT** and sophomore defender **WILSON EISNER** were named the tri-captains for the 2022 season.

Eneli is serving as captain for a third consecutive season. He earned a leadership role in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic canceled the season. Last year was the first time Eneli wore the armband during game action.

For Drought and Eisner, it will be the first time in their careers wearing the armband for the Big Red.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN GRIFFINS

Tonight is Canisius' final non-conference contest before opening Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) play next Wednesday against its bitter Western New York rival, Niagara.

The Golden Griffins enter Tuesday's contest on a four-game unbeaten streak (1-0-3). It is the team's longest string of games without a loss since a seven-game streak in 2017 (4-0-3).

Reilly Boyer and Julius Schoner have scored the lone goals for Canisius this season. William Howard has been the bright spot of the Griffs' defense, posting a 1.00 goals-against average and an .846 save percentage, which ranks 22nd in Division I.

SERIES VS. CANISIUS

Tonight's match marks the fifth all-time meeting between Canisius and Cornell, all of which have occurred since 2009. Cornell leads the series, 2-1-1, and won the last match in Buffalo in 2019, 2-0. **HARRY FULLER** scored both of the Big Red's goals, one of which came on a penalty kick in the first half. **RYAN SHELLOW** earned the clean sheet, making four saves.

Canisius is playing at Berman Field for the first time since Sept. 16, 2017, when the Golden Griffins beat the Big Red, 2-1.

JOHN SMITH

Dr. Daniel P. Wood Head Coach of Men's Soccer
Seventh Season as Head Coach

Smith enters his seventh season at the helm of the Cornell men's soccer team in 2022 and can be credited with the resurrection of a program that went 1-14-2 during his first season.

Cornell is aiming for its fourth consecutive season with double-digit victories following a 10-win season bookended by 11-win seasons.

Since arriving on East Hill, Smith has led the Big Red to victories over perennially strong programs such as Akron, Michigan State, and Syracuse. During his six-year tenure, Smith has coached 16 players that went on to earn All-Ivy designations and four that earned United Soccer Coaches All-Region honors. Two Cornell student-athletes have reached the professional ranks of American soccer under Smith's tutelage.

Prior to joining the Big Red in 2016, Smith served on the Stanford University coaching staff for four seasons, helping the Cardinal to its first national title in program history, when Stanford defeated Clemson, 4-0, marking the most goals scored in an NCAA final since 1996 and the largest margin of victory since 1975. In 2015 alone, Smith coached two First-Team All-Americans, a program-record five All-Far West Regional selections, the Hermann Award winner, four Major League Soccer draft picks and two U.S. Men's National Team players. He helped lead the program to an 18-2-3 record in 2015 – the team's most wins since 2002 – and a 7-1-2 mark in Pac-12 play, establishing a then-program record.

Before joining Stanford, Smith made two stops as an assistant coach at CSU Bakersfield beginning in 1999 before leaving to become the head coach at Incarnate Word before the 2006 season. He returned to Bakersfield in 2011. While at Incarnate Word from 2006-10, Smith amassed a 62-26-10 record and won three conference championships.

As a player, Smith was drafted in the second round (13th overall) by the Columbus Crew in the 1997 MLS College Draft. A two-time All-American at Rollins College, Smith was inducted into the Sunshine State Conference Hall of Fame in 2004.

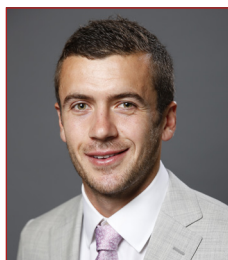

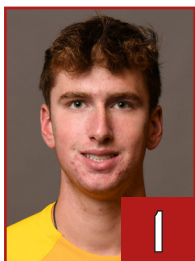

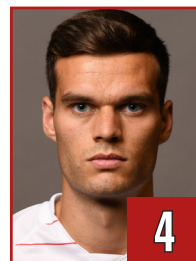
