2ND SEASON AS HEAD COACH

▶ The Cornell women's soccer team plays its penultimate regular-season home match when the Big Red hosts Empire State rival UAlbany in the program's final non-conference matchup of the 2023 campaign this evening.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Senior forward MIA GONZALEZ scored a third-minute goal for Cornell and the Big Red led for the next 86:46 before Yale's Tanner Cahalan netted the game-tying goal with 42 seconds left in regulation, leading to a 1-1 draw at Reese Stadium last Saturday evening in New Haven, Conn.
- ▶ Gonzalez's goal at the 2:52 mark was the quickest goal by the Big Red this season, besting the previous season-high, also accomplished by Gonzalez, against Villanova on Sept. 17 (4:44). It was the fastest game-opening goal by the Big Red since EVANTHIA (eh-VAN-thee-uh) SPYREDES (spy-REE-dees) at 2:29 of a Sept. 18, 2019 match against Binghamton.
- ▶ Junior goalkeeper **ERICA FOX** stopped a game-high four shots, increasing her save total in lvy League contests to 22, while Yale's Kyla Holmes stopped a trio of Cornell shots.

STUCK IN THE MIDDLE

- ▶ After setting the single-season record for ties last season (4-7-5), Cornell established a brand-new program record on Saturday evening following its 1-1 draw with Yale.
- ▶ The Big Red's six draws are the most by any Ivy League program this season and are currently tied for the 28th-most among Division I programs following Sunday's contests.
- ► Cornell's six ties this season are tied with Columbia (2014) and Penn (2015) for the second-most by an Ancient Eight program in a single season.
- ▶ Should the Big Red record another tie this season, it would match Penn's squad from last year for the most ties by an Ivy League program, dating back to the first official Ancient Eight season in 1982.

WHAT DOES FOX SAY?

- ▶ Junior goalkeeper **ERICA FOX** has been stellar in goal for Cornell this season, posting a 1-2-3 record with a 1.18 goals-against average and a .806 save percentage during her six appearances.
- ▶ In each of Fox's last four matches all of which have been Ivy League contests the native of San Marcos, Calif., has made at least four saves.
- Over Fox's last five matches, dating back to her shared clean sheet with sophomore NATALIE MEDUGNO against Colgate on Sept. 26, Fox has a 1.21 goals-against average and a .806 save percentage.
- ▶ Of Fox's 29 saves the sixth-most by an Ivy League keeper 22 have come in conference play.



THANKS FOR THE HELP!

- ▶ Thanks to her assist in a 1-1 draw on Oct. 4 against Columbia, senior midfielder REAGAN PAUWELS registered her team-leading fifth assist.
- ▶ With her helper against the Lions, Pauwels became the 18th player (20th occurrence) in Cornell program history to have at least five assists in a single season.
- ▶ Pauwels also became the sixth Cornell player this century to log five-plus assists in a season. She became the first Big Red player to do so since **CAROLINE GROWNEY** also had five helpers in 2015.
- ▶ Should Pauwels log another helper this season, she would officially enter the Big Red's top 10 for the most assists in a season, matching DONNA EBERHARDT (1988), AMY SNOW (1991, 1992), REBECCA D'ALEO (1993), LORI PENNY (1993), and DEMPSEY BANKS (2013) for the fifth-most assists in a season.
- ▶ Two more assists would enable Pauwels to share Cornell's single-season assist record, accomplished previously by LAURIE COLLIER in 1986, JENNIFER SMITH in 1987, and JENNIFER DALY and AMY FINKELSTEIN in 1994.

TRIPLE THE FUN!

► Cornell currently has two players with at least three assists, as senior midfielder **REAGAN PAUWELS** has a team-leading five helpers, and senior forward LAKEN

GALLMAN recorded her third assist of the season on MIA GONZALEZ's third-minute goal on Saturday against Yale.

- ▶ No Cornell team has had multiple players with three-plus assists in the same season since CAROLINE GROWNEY (five) and CLAIRE MACMANUS (three) accomplished the feat during the 2014 campaign.
- Should Gallman log another assist this season, it would be the first time Cornell has had multiple players with four-plus assists in the same campaign since DEMPSEY BANKS (six), ELIZABETH CROWELL (five), and RACHEL NICHOLS (four) all did so in 2013.

THIS DAY IN CORNELL WOMEN'S SOCCER HISTORY

OCTOBER

Cornell is 4-4-0 all-time on Oct. 14; 0-0-0 under ROB FERGUSON

Oct. 17, 2015: ELIZABETH CROWELL converted a rebound of her own penalty kick, and KELSEY TIERNEY made three saves to tie a program record with her 12th shutout of the season in a 1-0 victory over Yale. The victory guaranteed Cornell its best finish in Ivy League play since 1995.

TEAM EFFORT

- ► Thanks to **SYDNEY MALAGA**'s game-winning goal against Colgate on Sept. 26, Cornell has five players with at least two goals scored this season. It is the most multi-goal scorers for the Big Red in a season since 2013, when it also had five players with two-plus goals.
- ► Should another Cornell player register a second goal this season, it would be the first time the Big Red has had six multi-goal scorers since 1999 (6).
- ▶ There have been eight prior instances of Cornell registering at least six players with multiple goals: 1986, 1988, 1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, and 1999.

ANCIENT EIGHT'S SUCCESS

- ▶ Through matches completed on Sunday, the Ivy League has excelled on the pitch, registering a combined 52-23-28 record, leading to a cumulative .641 win percentage, pacing all 31 Division I conferences sponsoring women's soccer.
- ► The Ivy League boasts a 21-point advantage over the SEC (103-54-47 - .620) and a 31-point lead over the Big Ten (110-62-46 - .610).
- ► Entering this weekend's Ivy League slate, seven Ancient Eight members have at least a .500 win percentage, while five programs boast win percentages of at least .650.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ Cornell was picked to finish sixth in the 2023 lvy League women's soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 24.
- ▶ Brown received 12 of 16 possible first-place votes, finishing with an Ivy League-best 123 points. Harvard earned three first-place votes, placing second with 113 points. Yale registered the final last-place vote, garnering 88 points to assume third place.
- ▶ Princeton (78 points) and Columbia (74 points) were picked fourth and fifth, respectively, while Cornell (35 points), Dartmouth (33 points), and Penn (32 points) rounded out the poll.

2023 LEADERSHIP TEAM

- ▶ Cornell has six student-athletes on its leadership team for the 2023 campaign, rotating captains each game.
- ▶ Two sophomore, junior, and senior members were named to this year's leadership team. Those named to the team were seniors JACKIE LASSETER and AVA LADEN, juniors MADDIE LEROY and SYDNEY MALAGA, and sophomores ABIGAIL BISHARA and IZZY SCOTT.

ACROSS THE NATION

- ▶ Cornell has no geographical recruiting base, as the Big Red has 16 states represented on this year's roster.
- ► California has the most representatives on this year's roster, as five student-athletes reside in the Golden State. New York has the second-highest total with four. Colorado and Texas are right behind with three apiece. Illinois, Maryland, and New Jersey each have two representatives.
- ▶ Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington are represented once on this year's roster.

SCOUTING UALBANY

- ▶ UAlbany enters this evening's contest with a 4-7-2 overall record and a 1-3-2 mark in America East action.
- ▶ Selma Elverum paces the Great Danes' offense with 11 points (five goals, one assist), nine of which have come over her last four contests.
- ▶ Megan Hart has been UAlbany's go-to goalkeeper, starting in all 10 of her appearances this season. Hart has a 2.11 goals-against average and a .718 save percentage. Gabriella Terranova has been the starting goalkeeper in UAlbany's last two contests, conceding two goals and making seven saves during the span.

UALBANY'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ UAlbany snapped a six-match winless streak with a 4-0 victory over UMBC in America East action at Bob Ford Field at Tom & Mary Casey Stadium last Thursday evening.
- ▶ Selma Elverum scored what proved to be the game-winning goal for the Great Danes with her 14th-minute marker. She tacked on another goal in the 47th minute before earning the primary assist on Iola Cotter's goal in the 73rd minute, which concluded the scoring. Brooke Pickett also found the back of the net for UAlbany, scoring in the 32nd minute.
- ▶ Gabriella Terranova stopped all four UMBC shots she faced during her 90 minutes between the pipes for UAlbany, earning her first clean sheet of the season.

17 YEARS, 160 MILES, 8 MEETINGS

- ▶ This evening's contest will be the ninth all-time meeting between the Empire State programs. Cornell has a slight edge in the previous eight contests, posting a 3-2-3 record over UAlbany.
- ▶ Each of the last five meetings has been decided by one goal or less, which includes three of the previous four concluding in draws.
- ▶ Cornell is unbeaten at Berman Field against the Great Danes, logging a 2-0-2 record on its home turf. Despite not losing to UAlbany at home, the Big Red will be looking for its first home win over its Empire State rival since registering a 5-4 win on Sept. 15, 2013.

FOURTH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

Years at Cornell: Fifth Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer program, was hired as the sixth head coach in the history of the Cornell women's soccer program in February 2020. Before being appointed head coach, Ferguson was an assistant coach for the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

Ferguson's most recent season as head coach featured Cornell going 4-7-5 overall and 2-3-2 in Ivy League play. The Big Red concluded Ancient Eight play tied for fifth place, marking the best finish for the program since 2015. Cornell's conference victories in 2022 came in its final two matches against Princeton and Dartmouth, marking the first time the Big Red won consecutive Ivy League matches since claiming wins in the final match of 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. Cornell also posted an impressive 3-1-3 record on its home pitch, Berman Field, which featured going unbeaten over its final six matches (3-0-3).

The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Second Team All-Ivy selections REAGAN PAUWELS and CECILY POKIGO. It was the most All-lvy players for Cornell women's soccer since having four players — including a pair of First Team All-Ivy selections — in 2015.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, he guided Cornell to a 3-11-2 overall mark in 2021, which included a 1-6-0 lvy League record.

Cornell's lone lvy League victory came against Columbia, 1-0, on Sept. 25, 2021, marking the program's first conference win since 2016.

FERGUSON'S FILE

In his first overall season on East Hill in 2019, Ferguson aided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season, including three clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of the most robust lvy League competition in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, including 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection ASHLEY DURIK.

Ferguson first joined the Big Red after a very successful stint as the Director of Coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding its footprint from 15 to 34 teams and moving them into national recognition in the Elite Clubs National League (ECNL). Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and Flash 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of the men's and women's soccer programs at NAIA Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas. Before that, he served as the Executive Director of Business for Lonestar Soccer Club from 2008 until 2015. One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red, and 95G Red, and he helped advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in June 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the Director of Coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and he was a Regional Manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.
