OPENING FACEOFF

SETTING THE SCENE

Colgate will square off in a home-and-home series against local rival Cornell this weekend. The Raiders sit 5-7-2 overall, including a 2-3-1 mark in conference play after splitting a series with Niagara last weekend. The Big Red enters the weekend ranked No. 16 in both polls after defeating No. 5 Boston University 2-1 at Madison Square Garden last weekend. Cornell is 5-3-1 overall and holds a 2-3-1 ECAC record.

LAST TIME OUT

The Raiders fell 5-2 to Niagara last Friday despite cutting the lead to one twice. **Tommy Bergsland** scored both goals, and each came during four-on-four play. Colgate outshot the Purple Eagles 15-2 in the second period but struggled to put one in the back of the net. The Raiders finished the game with a 36-23 shot advantage.

On Saturday, **Ross Mitton** scored a power-play goal with 10:25 remaining in the third to lift Colgate to a 2-1 victory and earn a split in the series. **Reid Irwin** put the Raiders ahead 1-0 with just under four and a half minutes left in the first before the Purple Eagles tied it up four minutes into the second. **Andrew Takacs** earned his first career win in goal, making 22 saves. The sophomore stopped 11 of those shots in the second period

WE'VE GOT HISTORY

The Raiders and Big Red have faced off 165 times heading into the weekend, with Colgate holding a 61-87-17 record in the series. The Raiders are 4-4-2 in the previous 10 contests, three of which went into overtime, and four got decided by one goal.

Last season, the Raiders fell 3-2 in Ithaca, and the teams then played to a 4-4 tie in Hamilton the following night, but Colgate won the shootout 2-1. The Raiders have scored a combined seven goals in their previous two home games against the Big Red and have held Cornell to 2.0 goals per contest in the last three matchups at Lynah Rink.

LAST SEASON NOTES

- Colgate Men's Hockey won the ECAC Hockey championship for the first time in 33 years last season with a 3-2 defeat of Harvard in the title game.
- The Raiders did not lose a single game in the playoffs, winning five straight contests. Colgate defeated Dartmouth in the first round, swept St. Lawrence on the road in the quarterfinals, and beat top-seeded Quinnipiac in the semifinals.
- The team made a trip to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2014 but fell to Michigan in the regional semifinals. The Raiders finished with a 19-16-5 record, including an 11-8-3 mark in the conference.
- Head Coach Don Vaughan annouced his retirement at the end
 of the season after 30 seasons behind the Raiders' bench. He left
 with 470 victories, making him the winningest coach in program
 history. His feats included six 20-win seasons, four NCAA
 tournament berths, and two ECAC Coach of the Year awards.
- After graduation, seniors Matt Verboon and Colton Young both signed professional contracts. Young signed with the Greenville Swamp Rabbits of the ECHL, while Verboon went to his home country of Switzerland to play with HC Lugano of the National League.

SCOUTING THE BIG RED

Gabriel Sager leads Cornell in goals (six) and points (10). Ben Robertson has tallied a team-best nine assists thus far, dishing out at least one helper in all but one game. He also sits second on the team in points. Jonathan Castagna ranks second on the squad in assists with seven. He has tallied six points in the last six games with two goals and four assists.

Dalton Bancroft, Kyle Penney, and Ryan Walsh have all notched four goals. Bancroft has also recorded four helpers, ranking him third in points with eight. In goal, lan Shane has posted a 1.66 goals-against average, a .923 save percentage, and a 5-1-1 record. He leads the league and is second nationally in GAA.

The Big Red is the league leader and sits sixth nationally in scoring defense, holding opponents to 2.11 goals per game. Cornell also ranks second in the conference and falls 14th in the nation in faceoff win percentage at .529.

WHO'S HOT?

Junior **Ryan McGuire** has notched seven points in the previous five games, registering five goals and two assists. He has also gone +5 in that stretch. McGuire logged the first hat trick of his career at Princeton on Nov. 17.

Tommy Bergsland has tallied three points with two goals and an assist in the previous three contests. He recorded his third multi-point game this season last Friday with two goals. The junior is the team leader in assists (nine) and sits tied for first on the squad in points (12) with McGuire.

Daniel Panetta is riding a four-game assist streak and has tallied a point in six of the previous seven. He tied his career high with five shots last game against Niagara. Junior **Nick Anderson** has also dished out an assist in four straight. He also tied his career high in shots with six against Niagara Friday.

Pierson Brandon has gone +10 in the previous seven matchups and has logged six helpers during that stretch. **Simon Labelle** has gone +4 in the last five games, including a three-point performance with two goals and an assist against the Tigers.

IN THE RANKINGS

Ryan McGuire is the league leader and sits fourth in the nation in faceoff wins with 186. He ranks third in EACH in faceoff percentage at .579. McGuire is tied for third in the league in goals (seven).

Tommy Bergsland is tied for fourth in ECAC Hockey in assists and falls tied for fifth in points (12) with McGuire. **Pierson Brandon** has fired 46 shots, which leads the conference. He is also second in blocked shots with 25 and tied for second in power-play goals with two.

The team ranks second in the league in goals (45), assists (77), points (122), and shots (464). Nationally, Colgate is 13th in assists and 14th in points. The Raiders fall tied for first in shorthanded goals among league teams (three). Additionally, Colgate is second in the conference in shots per game (33.14) and sits third in blocked shots (146) and faceoff wins (424).

SOLID IN NET

Goaltender **Carter Gylander** has made 318 saves, second most in ECACH and 20th-most in the nation. The senior sits sixth in the conference in saves per game at 26.50. He tallied a season-high 38 stops at No. 7 Quinnipiac on Nov. 18.

BY THE NUMBERS

Colgate is averaging 34.25 shots per game in its previous four home games and has outshot its opponents 137-106. The Raiders have averaged 13.0 points per game in the last four road contests, tallying 19 goals and 33 assists.

Colgate has averaged 3.83 goals per game and 10.0 points per contest in conference action thus far. Six of Bergsland's assists and five of McGuire's goals have occurred in ECACH games.

BERGSLAND PICKS UP MONTHLY AWARD

HEAD COACH MIKE HARDER '97

THE DONALD F. VAUGHAN ENDOWED CHAIR OF COLGATE MEN'S HOCKEY FIRST SEASON (AS HEAD COACH) I COLGATE '97



Mike Harder '97 was named the Donald F. Vaughan Head Men's Hockey Coach in June 2023.

Harder makes his return to Colgate after spending six years (2013-2019) as an assistant coach for his alma mater. As a coach for the Raiders, he compiled 89 wins with a pair of ECAC Championship appearances and an NCAA tournament bid.

Decorated Playing Career

Harder, Colgate's all-time leading scorer, produced 214 points during his collegiate career. He graduated ranked fourth all-time in goals scored with 88 and second in assists for 126 points. He went on to earn 1997 All-America honors and was a Hobey Baker finalist. As one of the Raiders' greatest to lace up the skates, Harder was elected to the Colgate Athletics Hall of Honor in 2008.

One of 13 nominees for the The Hockey Humanitarian Award, Harder led the team in scoring for four straight seasons. A two-time All-ECAC All-Star, he won the Steve Riggs Memorial Award twice for gentlemanly play and a high standard of ability; the Rob Ries Memorial Award once for a player who provides inspiration and leadership; ECAC Merit Medal; and four times was named Colgate's Best Offensive Player. He was named to the ECAC All-Rookie Team in his first season when he led the nation with six shorthanded goals, and Colgate in scoring with 46 points.

Professional Hockey Experience

After earning his degree in international relations, Harder played 13 seasons professionally across North America and Europe. Included were stops in the American Hockey League (AHL) along with European League ventures in Germany, Austria, Finland, Sweden and Italy. He helped Hartford claim the AHL's Calder Cup in 2000, and was a key figure in a 2004 championship in the German Elite League of Deutsch Eishockey Liga.

Colgate Coaching Career

Harder began his coaching career at Colgate in 2013-14 as a volunteer assistant. He played a key role in the program's breakout campaign that saw the Raiders ranked 13th nationally in both major polls after advancing to the NCAA tournament as an at-large selection.

After being promoted to assistant coach in July 2014, Harder was instrumental in guiding the Raiders to a 22-12-4 overall mark and an appearance in the title game of the ECAC Hockey Championship for the second consecutive season.

During his time in Hamilton, Harder served five years as the director of recruiting. His first recruiting class led the nation in points and included a Hobey Baker finalist.

Leader, Mentor, Entrepreneur

As the founder and hockey director of Hockey Club Reno Ice, Harder spent the last four years building a program and community from the ground up. He spearheaded the Reno Hockey Academy, a membership-based skills program. Today, the program has over 500 youth players of all age levels, a para ice hockey team, and a semi-pro team.

Looking Ahead

Harder returns to Hamilton as the 15th head men's hockey coach in program history. He takes over a program coming off its first ECAC Hockey Championship since 1990 and first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2014.

The 2022-23 Raiders ranked No. 18 in the final USCHO poll of the season under Don Vaughan, who recently announced his retirement being the third longest tenured coach in Division I. In 30 years behind the bench, Vaughan has the most wins in program history (470).
