#### FIRST PITCH

- ▶ The Cornell baseball team opens the 2023 season this weekend when it travels to Harrisonburg, Va., to take on James Madison in a three-game series at Eagle Field at Veterans Memorial Park.
- ▶ Cornell is opening an 18-game road trip to begin the 2023 campaign this weekend. The Big Red will also make trips to Winston-Salem, N.C. to play a trio of opponents at Wake Forest before returning to Virginia to play VCU and George Mason in consecutive weekends. Ivy League will open with a pair of road matchups against Yale and Columbia.

#### RETURNING TO THE COMMONWEALTH

- Cornell's season-opening trip to the Commonwealth of Virginia this weekend will not be the Big Red's last. The program will return to Virginia for a pair of three-game series against VCU (March 10-12) and George Mason (March 18-19).
- ▶ Nine of the program's 16 non-conference contests this year will be played in Virginia. Four of the seven non-Ancient Eight contests in Virginia will be played in New York — two of which will be at home. The other three will be played in North Carolina.

## **TOURNAMENT TEAMS**

- ▶ This year, Cornell will face four teams which played in last year's NCAA Division I Baseball Championship.
- ▶ Columbia, the Ivy League representative last year, nearly made an appearance at Super Regionals, but fell to Virginia Tech in the championship of the Blacksburg Regional.
- ▶ VCU also made the championship of its regional in Chapel Hill, N.C., but could not advance to the Super Regionals after losing twice to the host, North Carolina.
- ▶ Wake Forest went 1-2 in the College Park Regional and Binghamton lost both of its games at Stanford.

### ALL-IVY RETURNERS

- ► Sophomore infielder MAX JENSEN and senior outfielder SAM **KAPLAN** were the lone pair of Cornell players to garner All-lvy honors last season. Both Jensen and Kaplan received All-Ivy Second Team honors following their successful 2022 campaigns.
- ▶ Jensen batted a Cornell-best .338 in his first collegiate season, recording 15 doubles, a pair of triples, three home runs and 26 RBI. He also registered an OPS of .957 (.403 on-base percentage and .554 slugging percentage).
- ▶ Kaplan hit .311 with six doubles, two triples, seven home runs, and 26 RBI. In addition to a team-leading 1.000 OPS, his seven home runs were the most by a Big Red batter last year. The 26 RBI by Kaplan was tied with Jensen for the team lead, while Kaplan's .656 slugging percentage was the sixth-highest in Cornell's modern era (since 1977).

#### **ABOUT JAMES MADISON**

- ▶ James Madison is coming off being swept in its season-opening series at Florida State last weekend and winning its home opener against George Mason on Tuesday.
- Last season the Dukes finished with an overall record of 27-26 and a 12-11 mark in its final season in the the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA).
- ▶ This is the Dukes' first season competed in the Sun Belt Conference (SBC), where it was picked to finish 10th in the 14-team conference. Southern Miss, one of three additions to the conference this academic year, was tabbed the preseason favorite after garnering 11 of the possible 14 first-place votes.
- ▶ The Dukes return roughly 72 percent of its offense from last season. Trevon Dabney was the team's leading hitter, posting a .303 average in 48 games last season. He had 14 doubles, two triples, and eight home runs with 38 RBI. Kyle Novak also returns a JMU-best 49 RBI last year.
- One key piece removed from this year's lineup is Chase DeLauter, who concluded his career at JMU with a .402 batting average.

## **SEASON OUTLOOK**

- ▶ Cornell is returning nearly 86 percent of its offense from last season. Eight of the team's nine main starters from last year also return to the lineup, highlighted by the trio of Big Red batters to hit over .300 last year in sophomore infielder MAX JENSEN (.338), senior outfielder SAM KAPLAN (.311), and junior catcher **NATHAN WAUGH** (.310).
- ▶ On the rubber, Cornell will look to some new faces this season. Of the 36 starts made last year, 22 of them return, highlighted by senior left-hander SPENCER EDWARDS. The Big Red will see just over 59 percent of its innings pitched return for the 2023 season.

#### **IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL**

- ▶ Cornell was picked to finish eighth in the eight-team preseason poll, the lvy League office announced last Friday, Feb. 17.
- ▶ Coming off its impressive 2022 campaign, Columbia finished with an Ivy League-leading 124 points after receiving 12 of the 16 first-place votes. Penn had three first-place votes and finished with a 113-point total, while Dartmouth had the other first-place vote and is slated to finish third after amassing with 91 points.
- ▶ Harvard (75), Yale (68), Brown (45), Princeton (31), and Cornell (29) rounded out the remainder of the poll.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- ► Cornell and James Madison have met five times prior to this weekend's three-game series in Harrisonburg. The Dukes have a slight 3-2 lead in the series, thanks to sweeping a brief two-game series during the 2011 season.
- ▶ In four of the five meetings, all of which have taken place in the Commonwealth of Virginia, Cornell has plated at least 12 runs. The Big Red have averaged 12.4 runs per game against the Dukes.
- ▶ This weekend will be the first time the Big Red and Dukes are playing each other since Cornell took two of three from JMU during a three-game series in 2014. Cornell scored at least 14 runs in all three games as the two programs combined for 78 runs in the three-game

# DAN PEPICELLI EIGHTH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

#### CORNELL · 2016 - PRESENT

- ▶ Entering his eighth season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program, Pepicelli is just the fourth Cornell head coach over the last 60 years, joining **TED THOREN** (1962-90), **TOM FORD** (1991-08), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (2009-15).
- ▶ His 75 career victories with the Big Red is already tied for the sixth-most in program history with DANIEL COOGAN (1907-12). With 13 wins in 2023, Pepicelli would be in sole posession of the fourth-most wins while on East Hill.
- ▶ Under his tutelege, Cornell has produced 19 All-Ivy League selections including five First Team and six Second Team selections and four selections in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.
- ▶ In Pepicelli's second season with the program in 2017, he helped guide the Big Red to its first winning season in four years, posting a 21-17 overall record. The Big Red finished 9-11 in Ivy League play.
- Cornell has won at least 14 games in all but one season, excluding the shortened 2020 season.

#### **CLEMSON • 2010-15**

- ► Following a successful nine-year tenure at St. John Fisher in suburban Rochester, N.Y., Pepicelli headed to Clemson, S.C., to join the Tigers staff.
- ▶ He was an assistant coach for one year, an assistant head coach for two years, and an associate head coach for three years. All six years on staff Pepicelli aided Clemson to an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.
- ▶ The Tigers had a 231-149 (.608) record in his time with the program. Pepicelli became the first pitching coach to lead a staff to the College World Series in his first season with the team.
- ► For four consecutive seasons from 2011-14, Pepicelli guided the Tigers to have a team ERA below 4.00. He recruited and developed MATT CROWNOVER, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and was named the ACC's Pitcher of the Year in 2015.
- ▶ Played instrumental in assembling Baseball America's ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015.
- ▶ Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball's Amateur Draft during tenure.

#### ST. JOHN FISHER • 2001-09

- ▶ Spent nine seasons as the head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher from 2001-09. During his time with the Cardinals, he was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001 and 2007), with the latter coming during the Cardinals' first-ever run to the Division III College World Series.
- ▶ In final seven seasons with St. John Fisher, the Cardinals posted winning seasons leading to Pepicelli being the program's all-time winningest head coach at the time of his departure.
- ▶ Team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 following the ECAC Championship, in which a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head. Despite St. John Fisher trailing in the ninth inning, Pepicelli and his team conceded the game, ending any hope of reaching the NCAA Tournament. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA's All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award for its decision.
- ▶ In addition to serving as the team's head coach, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach, where he served on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified Strength & Conditioning Specialist and is a member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association.

#### HARTWICK • 1996-00

▶ Opened collegiate coaching career at Hartwick, where he was an assistant coach for three years before being promoted to head coach for two seasons.

#### PERSONAL

- ▶ A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli graduated from Cicero-North Syracuse HS, and played at three colleges in the Central New York region.
- ▶ Named an all-region selection in two seasons with Mohawk Valley Community College, Pepicelli then earned his bachelor of sciences degree in Economics and Management from SUNY Cortland after playing one year with the Red Dragons. He was also an all-conference selection in his one year at Oneonta State.
- ▶ Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with Syracuse's women's soccer team. She also earned national titles as a player and coach at Monroe Community College. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
