FIRST PITCH

- ▶ The Cornell baseball team will host its final three regular season home games of the 2023 campaign this weekend when it welcomes Penn to Booth Field.
- ▶ For the third straight weekend, Cornell is slated to play a single game on Friday followed by a doubleheader on Saturday. First pitch on Friday is scheduled for 12 p.m., while Saturday's pair of games will begin at 11:30 a.m. All games will air live on ESPN+.

LAST WEEKEND REWIND

- ▶ Cornell was swept by Princeton in its first three games at Booth Field last weekend. The Tigers took the inaugural game at the Big Red's brand-new off-campus facility, 11-8, before taking both games of a doubleheader, 8-5 and 11-0 in seven innings.
- ▶ Princeton hit 11 home runs on the weekend, taking advantage of the apparent hitter-friendly dimensions of Booth Field. Cornell hit two home runs on the weekend, but did record eight extra-base hits (five doubles, one triple, two home runs).
- ▶ Junior catcher NATHAN WAUGH had a weekend to remember for the Big Red, batting .615 (8-of-13) with three doubles, three runs scored and an RBI. Thanks to his impressive weekend at the plate, he increased his batting average by 51 points.

WAUGH(TCH) IT FLY!

- ▶ Speaking of Waugh, the junior backstop has been Cornell's hottest hitter as of late. During his six-game hit streak — which matches his career long — Waugh has a .542 batting average with three doubles, one home 5/6 run and five RBI. His OPS (on-base-plus-slugging percentage) in that timeframe is 1.384.
- ▶ Dating back to the start of his first six-game hit of the season earlier this year (beginning with the nightcap of a March 26 twin bill at Yale), Waugh has posted a .444/.500/.778 slash line, going 24-of-54 at the plate with six doubles and four home runs.
- ▶ Waugh's 18 RBI currently ranks second on the team, trailing sophomore infielder MAX JENSEN (19). Of Waugh's 18 RBI this season, 16 have come in his last 14 appearances.

- Last weekend, Cornell recorded 18 of its 20 runs on the weekend in innings that featured at least two runs scored.





NEWS & NOTES ON EDWARDS

► THIS WEEKEND: Slated to make 33rd career appearance, 18th career start, and third start of the season ... Edwards will also be pitching in his 17th game of the season, tying TOM MACLEOD (1970), JOHN O'CONNOR (1988), and PETER LANNOO (2017) for the 13th-most games played by a Big Red hurler in a single season.

- ▶ LAST TIME OUT: Gave up nine hits and six runs both of which were season highs in a four-inning outing against Princeton last Friday ... allowed four home runs to Tigers batters, the most in his collegiate career.
- ▶ TOUGH TO TOUCH: According to the Cornell record book, Edwards' .231 batting average against is the 13th-best figure in program history with a minimum of 30 innings pitched, dating back to 1977 ... his .231 batting average against ranks as the fourth-best by an Ivy League pitcher this season, trailing a trio of pitchers from Penn (see list right).

- ▶ Should Cornell hit three home runs over its final seven regular season contests, it would be the first time Cornell registered at least 25 home runs in consecutive seasons since 2009 and 2010. The Big Red hit a program-record 38 home runs in 2009 before logging 30 in 2010. Last year, the Big Red blasted 33 round-trippers, which stands as the fourth-most in program history.



- ▶ Should the Big Red register at least four stolen bases this weekend against Penn, it would be Cornell's first 50-steal season as a program since 2013 when it had 62 steals, which is tied for the fifth-most stolen bases in a single season.
- ► Sophomore center fielder **JAKOBI DAVIS** has 12 stolen bases this season, the most by a Big Red player since JD WHETSEL (19) and SPENSER SOUZA (12) in 2013. Davis'

12 steals this season are tied for the 24th-most by a Cornell player.

▶ If sophomore catcher/designated hitter JOHN QUINLAN or sophomore shortstop RYAN PORTER — who both have seven steals this year — post three steals this weekend, they would join Davis in having a double-digit steal total. The last time Cornell had multiple players with 10-plus steals in a season was in 2014 when TOM D'ALESSANDRO had a team-high 17 stolen bases and JD WHETSEL was right behind with 15.

SEEING DOUBLE (PLAYS)

- ► Cornell turned three doubles plays in the first three innings of its first game against Princeton last Friday in the inaugural game at Booth Field.
- It was the third time this season in which Cornell turned a trio of twin killings in a game, joining the March 5 contest against then-No. 5-ranked Wake Forest and in the following game against VCU on March 10.
- ▶ The Big Red is averaging 0.79 double plays turned per game, which is ranked 69th nationally. Only Columbia (0.94) is the lone lvy League program to average more double plays per game than Cornell.
- ▶ The trio of games with three double plays turned in a game are the most since having four games with three double plays turned in 2019.

The facility will feature many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room will also be included at the facility, which is still under construction and is scheduled to be completed before to the beginning of the 2024 season.

CORNELL • 2016 - PRESENT

- ► Entering his eighth season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program, Pepicelli is just the fourth Cornell head coach over the last 60 years, joining **TED THOREN** (1962-90), **TOM FORD** (1991-08), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (2009-15).
- ► Earned his 300th career head coaching victory with a 13-3 win over crosstown rival Ithaca at Hoy Field on April 4.
- ▶ His 81 career victories with the Big Red is already the fifth-most in program history. With seven more victories this season, Pepicelli would be in sole possession of the fourth-most wins on East Hill.
- ▶ Under his tutelage, Cornell has produced 19 All-Ivy League selections including five First Team and six Second Team selections and four selections in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.
- ▶ In Pepicelli's second season with the program in 2017, he helped guide the Big Red to its first winning season in four years, posting a 21-17 overall record. The Big Red finished 9-11 in Ivy League play.
- Cornell has won at least 14 games in all but one season, excluding the shortened 2020 season.

CLEMSON • 2010-15

- ▶ Following a successful nine-year tenure at St. John Fisher in suburban Rochester, N.Y., Pepicelli headed to Clemson, S.C., to join the Tigers staff.
- ▶ He was an assistant coach for one year, an assistant head coach for two years, and an associate head coach for three years. All six years on staff Pepicelli aided Clemson to an appearance in the NCAA Tournament
- ▶ The Tigers had a 231-149 (.608) record in his time with the program. Pepicelli became the first pitching coach to lead a staff to the College World Series in his first season with the team.
- ► For four consecutive seasons from 2011-14, Pepicelli guided the Tigers to have a team ERA below 4.00. He recruited and developed MATT CROWNOVER, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and was named the ACC's Pitcher of the Year in 2015.
- ▶ Played instrumental in assembling Baseball America's ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015.
- ▶ Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball's Amateur Draft during tenure.

ST. JOHN FISHER • 2001-09

- ▶ Spent nine seasons as the head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher from 2001-09. During his time with the Cardinals, he was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001 and 2007), with the latter coming during the Cardinals' first-ever run to the Division III College World Series.
- ▶ In final seven seasons with St. John Fisher, the Cardinals posted winning seasons leading to Pepicelli being the program's all-time winningest head coach at the time of his departure.
- ▶ Team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 following the ECAC Championship, in which a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head. Despite St. John Fisher trailing in the ninth inning, Pepicelli and his team conceded the game, ending any hope of reaching the NCAA Tournament. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA's All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award for its decision.
- ▶ In addition to serving as the team's head coach, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach, where he served on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified Strength & Conditioning Specialist and is a member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association.

HARTWICK • 1996-00

▶ Opened collegiate coaching career at Hartwick, where he was an assistant coach for three years before being promoted to head coach for two seasons.

PERSONAL

- ▶ A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli graduated from Cicero-North Syracuse HS, and played at three colleges in the Central New York region.
- Named an all-region selection in two seasons with Mohawk Valley Community College, Pepicelli then earned his bachelor of sciences degree in Economics and Management from SUNY Cortland after playing one year with the Red Dragons. He was also an all-conference selection in his one year at Oneonta State.
- ▶ Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with Syracuse's women's soccer team. She also earned national titles as a player and coach at Monroe Community College. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
