In seventh season under Dick Bertrand, Cornell finished third in Eastern championship tournament...Cornell won Ivy League championship in 1976-77; Bertrand's first three teams (1971-72-73) won Ivy titles to give Cornell an unprecedented eight straight championships...His overall record is 141-51-6 for a percentage of .722...For the season, the team averaged 7.03 goals per game, the highest in history.

Nethery was recipient of the Nicky Bawlf Award as the most outstanding member of the team, as selected by his teammates...He set a Cornell single season record for points (78), and tied the mark for hat tricks (5).
