Brock Tredway, Roy Kerling and Geoff Roeszler were named to the All-Ivy first team, and Darren Eliot was the most valuable player in the ECAC playoffs. Tredway set a school record for most power play goals in a career with 34. He tied a school record for most hat tricks in a career with 10. Tredway, John Olds, Roeszler and Joe Gallant set school records for most games played in one season with 31.
