Hayward was named team MVP this season and his career save total of 2,225 is a new Cornell record. Brian also moved into eighth place on the Cornell all-time goaltender list with his career 3.82 goals against average, and seventh on the save percentage list with a .893. He is second in games played to Ken Dryden, having appeared in 78 games, five less than Dryden. His career record at Cornell is 42-27-2...Kerling became the second-leading goal scorer on the Cornell all-time list with 93. His 200 points (93-107) rank him third on the all-time point scoring list. His 107 assists is also third on the Cornell list. He averaged two points per contest as he played in 100 games at Cornell. Olds became the Cornell record holder for most games played in a career with 114...He also set the record for penalty minutes in a career with 267...Kerling and Hayward were selected to play in the senior all-star game at Bloomington...
