FIRST TOUCH

► The Cornell women's soccer team looks to extend its eight-match home unbeaten streak this evening when it welcomes Central New York rival Binghamton to Berman Field for a 7 p.m. kickoff.

LAST TIME OUT

► Junior forward **MADDIE LEROY** scored her team-leading second goal of the season late in the first half as Cornell extended its unbeaten streak to six matches in a 1-1 draw with Buffalo on Sunday afternoon at UB Stadium.

► Fellow junior goalkeeper **ERICA FOX** made four saves — three of which came in the opening 20 minutes — in her season debut for the Big Red.

HOME, SWEET, HOME

► After losing to Marist, 2-1, in its home opener last year, the Big Red is unbeaten over its last eight home matches, posting a 4-0-4 mark (.750 win percentage) during the span.

► The Big Red's eight-match home unbeaten streak is tied for the second-longest in program history, with the 1995 squad posting a 6-0-2 mark over its final eight matches played at Robison Alumni Fields, adjacent to Cornell's current home pitch.

► With a non-losing result to Binghamton this evening, Cornell will match the program record for the longest home unbeaten streak initially set over the 1985 and 1986 seasons when the Big Red went 8-0-1 in contests played at Robison Alumni Fields.

NO 'L' IN UNBEATEN

► After concluding the 2022 campaign with Ivy League victories over Princeton and Dartmouth, Cornell is currently unbeaten over its last six matches, posting a 4-0-2 mark during the stretch.

► No Cornell team has registered seven non-losing results together since a 12-match streak that spanned the final match in 2014 and the first 11 matches of the 2015 campaign. During the 12-match stretch, the Big Red recorded a 9-0-3 record.

► The Big Red's 12-match unbeaten streak during the 2014 and 2015 seasons currently ranks second in program history, only trailing a 13-match stretch that spanned the 1985 and 1986 seasons in which Cornell went 9-0-4.

► With a win or tie this evening against Binghamton, it would mark the seventh time in Cornell program history in which it has recorded an unbeaten streak of at least seven matches (1985-86, 1987-88, 1989-90, 1991, 2004-05, 2014-15).

STARTING OFF STRONG

► Cornell's 2-0-2 record is the best four-match start to a season for the Big Red since it was victorious in its first four contests in 2019. This season marks the 11th instance in program history in which Cornell has not lost in any of its first four contests.

► With a non-losing result this evening to Binghamton, it would be Cornell's best five-match start to a season since 2015, when it went 8-0-3 over its first 11 fixtures.

► Cornell has gone unbeaten over its first five matches on six occasions, including the 1986, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, and 2015 campaigns.

ANCIENT EIGHT'S SUCCESS

► Through matches completed on Sunday, the Ivy League has excelled on the pitch, posting a combined 28-7-9 record, leading to a Division I-leading .739 win percentage.

► All eight members of the Ivy League have win percentages of at least .667, and seven programs currently have at least a .700 win percentage.

► The Ivy League is one of three conferences with at least a .700 win percentage this season, joined by the Big Ten (.726) and the SEC (.721).

POKIGO TABBED DEFENDER OF THE WEEK

► Junior defender **CECILY POKIGO** was named the Ivy League's Defender of the Week, the conference office announced on Sept. 5.

► Pokigo, who played all 180 minutes in the contests against Marist and Syracuse, spearheaded Cornell's defense to a pair of clean sheets over the Red Foxes and Orange. The Big Red's staunch defense conceded just 11 shot attempts and three shots on goal over the two shutouts.

► With the honor, Pokigo became Cornell's first non-attacking player to earn a Player of the Week honor since goalkeeper **KELSEY TIERNEY** shared the award on Sept. 14, 2015, with Dartmouth's Lucille Kozlov.

Cornell is 4-1-0 all-time on Sept. 13; 0-0-0 under **ROB FERGUSON**

Sept. 13, 1997: Cornell opened its 1997 campaign with a 6-2 victory over Ivy League rival Columbia at Berman Field. **CAARKI** (*CARE-ah-key*) **SWEITZER** (*SWITE-zer*) had a seven-point day, registering three goals and an assist. **MIKI AGRAWAL** (*AG-rah-all*) (two goals) and **BECKY D'ALEO** (one goal, two assists) each had four-point days.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

► Cornell was picked to finish sixth in the 2023 Ivy League women's soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 24.

► Brown received 12 of 16 possible first-place votes, finishing with an Ivy League-best 123 points. Harvard recorded three first-place votes, placing second with 113 points. Yale was the only other school to receive a first-place vote, garnering 88 points and the last first-place vote.

► Princeton (78 points) and Columbia (74 points) were picked fourth and fifth, respectively, and Cornell (35 points) was picked sixth. Dartmouth (33 points) and Penn (32 points) rounded out the poll.

ACROSS THE NATION

► Cornell has no geographical recruiting base, as the Big Red has 16 states on this year's roster.

► California has the most representatives on this year's roster, as five student-athletes reside in the Golden State. New York has the second-highest total with four. Colorado and Texas are right behind with three apiece. Illinois, Maryland, and New Jersey each have two representatives.

► Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington are represented once on this year's roster.

CORNELL CONNECTIONS

► Junior forward **SYDNEY MALAGA** is the daughter of Cornell Athletics Hall of Famer **SCOTT MALAGA**, who was inducted in 1999. Scott concluded his Big Red football career with 1,925 rushing yards, which ranks fourth in program history. Sydney's twin brother, Luke, is also actively on the Big Red football team.

► Both senior defender **MIA GONZALEZ** and sophomore defender **GABY GONZALEZ** are third-generation Cornell students. Their father, Jack, and mother, Jodi, graduated from Cornell in 1991. Jack also played on the Cornell men's soccer team from 1988-90. The Gonzalez sisters also have a pair of uncles who graduated from the institution.

SCOUTING BINGHAMTON

- Binghamton enters this evening's match with a 1-4-2 overall record. The Bearcats' lone victory of the season came on Aug. 31 when it defeated Le Moyne, a newly-minted Division I program, at the Bearcats Sports Complex by a 3-0 score.
- All six of the Bearcats' goals have come over its last four matches, including a pair of multi-goal outputs against Le Moyne and Wagner in a 2-2 tie on Sept. 3.
- Lexi Vegoda has a team-leading five points (two goals, one assist), while Olivia McKnight, Lauren Clark, Emma Colling, and Paige Luke have also found the back of the net once for Binghamton this season.
- Kaitlyn Williams has been Binghamton's go-to goalkeeper this season, as she has registered all of the Bearcats' decisions and has played all but 7:51 this season. Williams has a 1.45 goals-against average and a .706 save percentage.

BINGHAMTON'S LAST TIME OUT

- Binghamton fell to Maryland, 1-0, in its last contest on Sunday. The Terrapins scored its lone tally in the 82nd minute on a penalty kick by Ava Morales after a handball inside the 18-yard box. Williams made four saves for the Bearcats in the setback.
- Maryland doubled Binghamton in shot attempts, 12-6, which included a 7-1 ledger in shots on goal. Emma Colling had the Bearcats' lone shot on target in the contest.

21 YEARS, 36 MILES, 15 MEETINGS

- Cornell has a slight 6-5-4 advantage in the series over Binghamton, which dates back to the first meeting between the programs in the Bearcats' first year at the Division I level in 2001.
- Two of the last three meetings between the two programs have resulted in draws, including last year's meeting at the Bearcats Sports Complex in Vestal.
- The Big Red is looking for its first victory over Binghamton since Sept. 18, 2016, the last four consecutive wins over the Bearcats.

FOURTH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

Years at Cornell: Fifth Season
College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer program, was hired as the sixth head coach in the history of the Cornell women's soccer program in February 2020. Before being appointed head coach, Ferguson was an assistant coach for the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

Ferguson's most recent season as head coach featured Cornell going 4-7-5 overall and 2-3-2 in Ivy League play. The Big Red concluded Ancient Eight play tied for fifth place, marking the best finish for the program since 2015. Cornell's conference victories in 2022 came in its final two matches against Princeton and Dartmouth, marking the first time the Big Red won consecutive Ivy League matches since claiming wins in the final match of 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. Cornell also posted an impressive 3-1-3 record on its home pitch, Berman Field, which featured going unbeaten over its final six matches (3-0-3).

The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Second Team All-Ivy selections **REAGAN PAUWELS** and **CECILY POKIGO**. It was the most All-Ivy players for Cornell women's soccer since having four players — including a pair of First Team All-Ivy selections — in 2015.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, he guided Cornell to a 3-11-2 overall mark in 2021, which included a 1-6-0 Ivy League record. Cornell's lone Ivy League victory came against Columbia, 1-0, on Sept. 25, 2021, marking the program's first conference win since 2016.

In his first overall season on East Hill in 2019, Ferguson aided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season, including three clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of the most robust Ivy League competition in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, including 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection **ASHLEY DURIK**.

Ferguson first joined the Big Red after a very successful stint as the Director of Coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding its footprint from 15 to 34 teams and moving them into national recognition in the Elite Clubs National League (ECNL). Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and Flash 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of the men's and women's soccer programs at NAIA Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas. Before that, he served as the Executive Director of Business for Lonestar Soccer Club from 2008 until 2015. One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red, and 95G Red, and he helped advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in June 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the Director of Coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and he was a Regional Manager for Britannia Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.
