Big Red, in Ted Thoren's 13th season, missed a winning record for the first time in 10 years...In '71 and '72 the team lost one-run decisions in playoff games to Harvard for the league title...Cornell also set an all-time record for season victories (22) in '71; the '69 club was likewise runnerup in the league, losing to Dartmouth in the final game.

Stocke won MVP award; Crowell and Hoffman named club's most improved players, and Brink won the "most durable player" award.

Thoren's overall record is 207-179-7, including a 50-56-4 mark in spring recess games prior to the start of the regular season...From 1966 Cornell has won 157 games, lost 120 and tied five...In '73 the Big Red finished 3-2-1 in the Hurricane Classic for 2nd place behind Miami whom it defeated twice. At the time Miami was ranked No. 3 in the nation...In '72 Cornell scored a 3-1 win over Arizona State, then the No. 1 team in the country, in the Riverside (Calif.) Tournament.

All-Eastern Intercollegiate League selections by the coaches were Crowell to the 1st team, Hamrick and Stocke to the 2nd...All-Ivy selections: Crowell 1st team, Hamrick, Stocke, Brink and Ryan 2nd...Hamrick among national leaders in strikeouts with ave. of 13.6.
