#### **FIRST TOUCH**

► The Cornell women's soccer team returns to action this afternoon when it faces Buffalo at UB Stadium for a 1 p.m. kickoff.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ A first-half goal by senior forward MIA GONZALEZ and a two-save clean sheet by sophomore goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO guided the Cornell women's soccer team to a 1-0 victory over its Central New York rival Syracuse at a muggy Berman Field last Sunday afternoon.
- ▶ Gonzalez's game-winning marker was her first collegiate goal, while Medugno registered her third career clean sheet in her fourth collegiate appearance on Sunday.
- ▶ The victory for Cornell was its first-ever win over its Central New York rival, snapping a 13-match winless streak against the Orange.
- ► Cornell's victory was its first over an ACC opponent since defeating Duke, 4-1, on Oct. 13, 1990, in the first of two games in the Cornell Classic, hosted at the program's first home field, Robison Alumni Fields

#### NO 'L' IN UNBEATEN

- ▶ Dating back to last season, Cornell is unbeaten over its last five matches, posting a 4-0-1 mark during the span.
- ▶ No Cornell team has recorded six non-losing results together since a 12-match streak over the final match of the 2014 season and the first 11 matches of the 2015 campaign, in which the program went 9-0-3. The 12-match unbeaten streak ranks second in program history, only behind a 13-match stretch that spanned the 1985 and 1986 seasons.
- ▶ With a win or tie this afternoon against Buffalo, it would mark the eighth time in Cornell program history in which it has recorded an unbeaten streak of at least six matches.

#### **STARTING OFF STRONG**

- ▶ Cornell's 2-0-1 record is the program's best three-match since coming out victorious in its first three contests in 2019. This year is the 11th time in program history in which the Big Red has gone unbeaten over its first three contests.
- ▶ With a non-losing result this afternoon to Buffalo, it would be Cornell's best four-match start to a season since 2019, when it won its first four contests.
- ► Cornell has had eight previous seasons in which it went unbeaten over its first four matches to begin a season (1986, 1990, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, 2015, 2019).

Cornell is 4-5-1 all-time on Sept. 10; 0-0-0 under ROB FERGUSON

Sept. 10, 2013: Cornell and Buffalo played to a scoreless draw at UB Stadium on this date 10 years ago. Goalkeepers TORI CHRIST, a native of Amherst, N.Y., and **KELSEY TIERNEY** combined to make five saves in the clean sheet. Buffalo's Ainsley Wheldon was on the other side of the scoreless decision.

#### **IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL**

- ▶ Cornell was picked to finish sixth in the 2023 lvy League women's soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 24.
- ▶ Brown received 12 of 16 possible first-place votes, finishing with an Ivy League-best 123 points. Harvard recorded three first-place votes, placing second with 113 points. Yale was the only other school to receive a first-place vote, garnering 88 points and the last first-place
- ▶ Princeton (78 points) and Columbia (74 points) were picked fourth and fifth, respectively, and Cornell (35 points) was picked sixth. Dartmouth (33 points) and Penn (32 points) rounded out the poll.

#### ACROSS THE NATION

- ▶ Cornell has no geographical recruiting base, as the Big Red has 16 states on this year's roster.
- ▶ California has the most representatives on this year's roster, as five student-athletes reside in the Golden State. New York has the second-highest total with four. Colorado and Texas are right behind with three apiece. Illinois, Maryland, and New Jersey each have two representatives.
- ▶ Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington are represented once on this year's roster.

#### CORNELL CONNECTIONS

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY MALAGA is the daughter of Cornell Athletics Hall of Famer SCOTT MALAGA, who was inducted in 1999. Scott concluded his Big Red football career with 1,925 rushing yards, which ranks fourth in program history. Sydney's twin brother, Luke, is also actively on the Big Red football team.
- ▶ Both senior defender MIA GONZALEZ and sophomore defender GABY GONZALEZ are third-generation Cornell students. Their father, Jack, and mother, Jodi, graduated from Cornell in 1991. Jack also played on the Cornell men's soccer team from 1988-90. The Gonzalez sisters also have a pair of uncles who graduated from the institution.
- ► Sophomore forward GRACE DIEHL is a third-generation Cornell student-athlete as her father, Jeff (1991-92), and grandfather, Thomas (1967-68), played two seasons on the Cornell football team.
- ▶ Fellow sophomore defender MARAN KINGSLEY is a third-generation Cornell student. Her mother received her MBA from the institution, and her grandfather was an undergraduate student in the College of Engineering.
- ► Senior midfielder **KENDALL PATTEN** is the fourth member of her family to attend Cornell, as her mother, CORRINE (CANTRALL) PATTEN, was a member of the Cornell soccer program from 1989-91, and her sister, Dillyn, is a sophomore on the Big Red women's lacrosse program. Kendall's great-uncle, Walter 'Bud' Patten, was a 1949 graduate from Cornell.
- ► MARIANA KESSINGER, a sophomore midfielder, is also following in both of her parent's footsteps as they both attended Cornell.
- ▶ Junior defender ALEX BROTHERTON is a second-generation Cornell student as her mother, Zela, graduated from Cornell in 2004.
- ► Senior forward LAKEN GALLMAN is the second member of her family to play a sport at Cornell, as her brother, Eric II, spent four years on Cornell's football team (2017-21) before playing a post-grad year at Duke in 2022.

#### **UP NEXT**

► Cornell will face a quick turnaround when it welcomes Central New York rival Binghamton to Berman Field on Wednesday for a 7 p.m. kickoff. The two programs played to a 1-1 tie last season on the Bearcats' home turf. Game action will be broadcast live on ESPN+.

#### **SCOUTING BUFFALO**

- ▶ Buffalo enters this afternoon's match with a 3-1-1 overall record, defeating Ohio State, Colgate, and Niagara.
- ▶ This afternoon is the Bulls' first home match since falling to then No. 14-ranked Pittsburgh, 2-1, in its season and home opener on Aug. 17.
- ▶ Lexie Thompson and Rebecca Winslow have combined to record three consecutive clean sheets for the Bulls, who have not conceded a goal in 334:42 since allowing a 26th-minute marker to Ohio State on Aug. 20. During that span, Buffalo has outscored its opponents by a 4-0 margin.
- ▶ Thompson posted clean sheets over Colgate and Niagara, while Winslow a transfer from Monmouth — made one save in her first start with the Bulls in a scoreless draw with Canisius last Thursday (Aug. 31).
- ▶ Katie Krohn has a Buffalo-leading seven points (three goals, one assist), while Leah Wengender has also chipped in a pair of goals for the Bulls. Arianna Zumpano has the only other tally for the Bulls this season.
- ▶ Thompson has played most of the minutes for Buffalo in goal, logging 360 minutes of action over four appearances. She has a 0.75 goals-against average and has made nine saves, good for a .750 save percentage.

#### **BUFFALO'S LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ Katie Krohn scored a pair of goals off feeds from Mika Marolly over the first 7:10 to guide Buffalo to a 2-0 victory over its Big Four rival Niagara last Sunday at Niagara Field in Lewiston, N.Y. Lexie Thompson stopped a career-high five shots to preserve the clean sheet for the Bulls.
- ▶ Buffalo dominated in shot attempts, logging a 27-13 advantage over Niagara. The Bulls doubled up the Purple Eagles in shots on goal, 10-5.

#### **19 YEARS, 123 MILES, 9 MEETINGS**

- ▶ Buffalo has a slight 4-3-2 edge on Cornell in the all-time series, despite the Big Red going unbeaten in four of its last five against the Bulls (2-2-1).
- ▶ The last time the two programs met was at Berman Field on Aug. 31, 2018, when the Bulls came away with a 2-0 victory thanks to second-half goals by Carissima Cutrona and Marcy Barberic. Emily Kelly logged the clean sheet, stopping all nine Big Red shots she faced.
- ▶ Today will be Cornell's first trip to UB Stadium since Sept. 8, 2017, when it defeated the Bulls in overtime, 2-1. Kennedy Yearby scored the game-winning goal on a feed from Jessica Ritchie 2:38 into the extra frame to give Cornell the victory.

#### RETURN OF THE MAC

- ▶ This afternoon will be Cornell's 12th all-time meeting with a program from the Mid-American Conference (MAC). Aside from the nine meetings with Buffalo, Cornell has played just two other MAC schools in Central Michigan (9/7/08 - L, 0-3) and Akron (9/6/15 - W, 2-0).
- ► Cornell has been successful against MAC schools lately, going 3-1-2 over its last six, dating back to 2008.

# ROB FERGUSON

FOURTH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

Years at Cornell: Fifth Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer program, was hired as the sixth head coach in the history of the Cornell women's soccer program in February 2020. Before being appointed head coach, Ferguson was an assistant coach for the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

Ferguson's most recent season as head coach featured Cornell going 4-7-5 overall and 2-3-2 in Ivy League play. The Big Red concluded Ancient Eight play tied for fifth place, marking the best finish for the program since 2015. Cornell's conference victories in 2022 came in its final two matches against Princeton and Dartmouth, marking the first time the Big Red won consecutive Ivy League matches since claiming wins in the final match of 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. Cornell also posted an impressive 3-1-3 record on its home pitch, Berman Field, which featured going unbeaten over its final six matches (3-0-3).

The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Second Team All-Ivy selections REAGAN PAUWELS and CECILY POKIGO. It was the most All-Ivy players for Cornell women's soccer since having four players — including a pair of First Team All-Ivy selections — in 2015.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, he guided Cornell to a 3-11-2 overall mark in 2021, which included a 1-6-0 lvy League record.

Cornell's lone lvy League victory came against Columbia, 1-0, on Sept. 25, 2021, marking the program's first conference win since 2016.

FERGUSON'S FILE

In his first overall season on East Hill in 2019, Ferguson aided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season, including three clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of the most robust lvy League competition in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, including 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection ASHLEY DURIK.

Ferguson first joined the Big Red after a very successful stint as the Director of Coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding its footprint from 15 to 34 teams and moving them into national recognition in the Elite Clubs National League (ECNL). Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and Flash 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of the men's and women's soccer programs at NAIA Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas. Before that, he served as the Executive Director of Business for Lonestar Soccer Club from 2008 until 2015. One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country. Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red. 93G Red. 94G Red. and 95G Red. and he helped advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in June 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the Director of Coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and he was a Regional Manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.
