#### PUCK DROP

▶ The no. 9-ranked Cornell women's ice hockey team will return from hiatus to host unbeaten no. 5-ranked Clarkson and no. 10-ranked St. Lawrence.

## D1 IN DC REWIND

- ▶ vs St. Thomas: The Cornell women's ice hockey team cruised to a 4-1 victory over the St. Thomas Tommies at Medstar Capitals Iceplex on Friday night. The Big Red improved to 11-2-1, while the Tommies dropped to 5-11-0 on the year.
- ▶ vs St. Thomas: Piper Grober scored the first Big Red goal of her career, accompanied by Katie Chan, Avi Adam, and Izzy Daniel (extended point-streak to 14) who netted the puck as well. Daniel, Grober, Kaitlin Jockims, Grace Dwyer, Mckenna Van Gelder (two), and Lily Delianedis (two) earned helpers on the night.
- ▶ vs Minnesota: Cornell fell to the Minnesota Golden Gophers 5-1 in the final contest of the D1 in DC games on Saturday evening. Cornell dropped to 11-3-1, while the Gophers improved to 11-2-0.
- ▶ vs Minnesota: Katie Chan registered the lone Big Red goal of the game. The tally was assisted by Alexa Davis.

#### **THE SERIES**

- ► Cornell leads the series with Clarkson, 29-25-6
- ▶ The squads met five times last year, most recently in an exciting three game ECAC Hockey playoff series where the Golden Knights prevailed in game three to advance to the semifinals.
- ▶ Cornell leads the the series with St. Lawrence, 45-35-8.
- ▶ The squads split games last season with the Big Red taking the first meeting at Lynah Rink in a barn-burning 7-6 victory, and the Saints taking the latter of the games 3-2 in a match that needed an extra period.

#### **OPPONENT BREAKDOWN**

- ▶ Clarkson will enter the night with a 18-0-1 record overall. The Golden Knights are on a five game winning-streak and has yet to lose a game all year.
- ▶ Darcie Lappan (23- 11g, 12a), Nicole Gosling (22- 7g, 15a), Haley Winn (22- 3g, 19a), and Anne Cherkowski (19-10g, 9a) are at the top of the team's leader board in points. Michelle Pasiechnyk has played and started in 15 games between the pipes for the Golden Knights, registering 262 saves and a .942 save percentage.
- ▶ St. Lawrence will enter the weekend with a 13-6-0 record, and is coming off of a weekend split with Harvard (loss) and Dartmouth (win).
- Julia Gosling (29-13g, 16a), Abby Hustler (23-12g, 11a), Sarah Marchand (22-9g, 13a), and Anna Segedi (17 -7g, 10a) are at the top of the team's leader board in points. Emma-Sofie Nordstrom has played 19 games in net for the Saints, registering 450 saves and a .922 save percentage.

#### **PATTY KAZ WATCH**

- ▶ Daniel exploded for a six-point weekend in the opener versus no. 13 Penn State, registering her points on one goal and five assists. She eclipsed her 100th-career point in the process of sweeping the Nittany Lions, and has not slowed down since, now having 132.
- ▶ Daniel opened the season with a 14-game point-streak, 13 of which the standout Minnesotan scored at least two points. She has earned ECAC Hockey Player of The Week three times this year, as well as ECAC Hockey Player of the Month.

#### POTENT TOP LINE

- ▶ The line of Izzy Daniel, Katie Chan, and Lily Delianedis accounts for 71 Big Red points (30 goals, 41 assists) through the opening 15 games of the season.
- ▶ These linemates combine for 65 points (27 goals, 38 assists) through the opening 13 games of the season.
- Daniel ranks first in the nation in assists per game with 1.33, fifth in goals per game with .87 per contest, and first in points per game with 2.20.
- ▶ Chan has exploded onto the scene for the Big Red, currently marking 17th in the nation in goals per game with 0.60.
- ▶ Delianedis has been the anchor to those explosive wingers, collecting 166 wins during her faceoff duties, and lighting the lamp three times during Big Red power-play opportunities.

#### **IIHF RIVALRY SERIES**

- ▶ During game one of the 2023 USA vs Canada Rivalry Series, Big Red blue-liner Rory Guilday fired a deep shot which was collected on a rebound and led to the game-winning-goal in the United States 3-1 victory over Canada.
- ▶ The U.S. also took game two over the Canadians, winning by a count of 5-2 in front of a sell out crowd at Crypto.com Arena.
- ▶ Team USA claimed game three in OT by a score of 3-2. The Canadians took game four 3-2 in shootouts, which was aided by a clutch Kristin O'Neill assist on the game-tying-goal for Canada.

#### **GOALIES BY COMMITTEE**

- ▶ Annelies Bergmann and Deanna Fraser have both seen action between the pipes this season.
- ▶ Bergmann has started in 10 games, earning 195 saves (high 28) with a .920 save percentage.
- ▶ Fraser has started three games, earning 50 saves (high 23) with a .926 save percentage to go along with a shutout victory over Syracuse.
- ▶ Bergmann holds a 7-2-1 record while Fraser is 3-0-0.

#### NATIONAL POLLS

- ▶ Cornell comes into the weekend ranked no. 8, dropping a few places after falling in two games this past weekend.
- ▶ 50% of the USCHO top-ten, and seven of the top-15 is represented by ECAC Hockey members.

# DOUG DERRAUGH

Everett Family Head Coach of Women's Ice Hockey

Years at Cornell: 18th Season College: Cornell University

Having now spent 17 seasons directing the Cornell women's hockey program, Doug Derraugh has brought the Big Red to their place among the nation's elite. Taking a program that won just four games in the season prior to his arrival, Derraugh guided the Big Red to the national title game in his fifth season and back-to-back-to-back NCAA Frozen Four appearances in 2010, 2011 and 2012, completely turning around the culture of the women's hockey program at Cornell. Derraugh once again guided the Big Red to Frozen Four in 2019. He became the first Everett Family Head Coach of Women's Ice Hockey when the position was endowed in December 2020.

Derraugh has a 325-180-49 record in his first 17 seasons as the head coach of the Big Red. He led the team to five consecutive 20-win seasons for the first time in program history in 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-2014. Cornell has made the ECAC Hockey Tournament each of the last 15 seasons, won the tournament four times and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament seven times.

Serving the team in some capacity since the 2012 IIHF Women's Worlds, Derraugh most recently served as an assistant coach with the team during Canada's championship run at the 2021 IIHF Women's Worlds in Calgary. On Aug. 31, 2021, Canada won their first title since 2012 after passing the United States in a 3-2 overtime thriller. Along with Derraugh, five Cornell alumnae were also members of Team Canada (Rebecca Johnston '12, Brianne Jenner '15, Jill Saulnier '15, Jaime Bourbonnais '20 and Kristin O'Neill '20). Lenka Serdar '19 (Czech Republic) and Sarah Knee '18 (Hungary) also competed in the 2021 Women's Worlds. Derraugh was behind the bench as an assistant coach with Team Canada during the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics.

A 1991 graduate of Cornell, Derraugh took over the Big Red program after a 13-year career playing professionally in Europe, seeing action with nine different teams in some of the top leagues in Norway, Germany, Austria and Finland. He scored more than 100 points in a season twice and posted 30 points or more 10 times. He ended his professional career with 257 goals and 347 assists in 637 professional contests. In his final season, Derraugh also served as special teams coach for his team.

While a student at Cornell, Derraugh played in all 119 contests for the Big Red over his four years, helping to lead the Big Red to an NCAA tournament appearance and a second-place finish in the ECAC as a senior co-captain. He led the team in scoring in his final season with 30 goals and 36 assists, earning second-team All-Ivy League and honorable mention All-ECAC honors. His 30 goals in the 1990-91 season are the most ever scored by a senior at Cornell. Overall, he ranks 10th all-time at Cornell in career scoring with 153 points on 66 goals and 87 assists.
