### FIRST TOUCH

► The Cornell women's soccer team travels to Providence, R.I., for a pivotal Ivy League match this afternoon when it battles Brown at Stevenson-Pincince Field. First touch is scheduled for 4 p.m.

### LAST TIME OUT

► ITHACA, N.Y. (OCT. 19, 2024) — Sophomore forwards **ALANNA COLBERT** and **SYDNEY ALLEN** scored first-half goals to provide enough cushion for Cornell as it defeated Yale, 2-1, at Berman Field last Saturday afternoon.

► Joining Colbert and Allen in the scoring column for the Big Red was senior forward **LAKEN GALLMAN** and senior defender **LILY ELLINGSON**, who assisted on the respective goals for the Big Red. Junior goalkeeper **NATALIE MEDUGNO** notched her second victory of the season, halting a trio of Bulldog shots.

► Cornell owned a 14-8 advantage in shot attempts and a 9-4 edge in shots on goal.

### THE MATCH IS ON HER FOOT

► Sophomore forward **SYDNEY ALLEN** has recorded all three of Cornell's game-winning goals this season, which have come against Syracuse (Sept. 1), Dartmouth (Oct. 5), and in last Saturday's victory over Yale.

► With her game-winning goal against Yale last Saturday, Allen became the 12th Cornell player (14th instance) to record three game-winning goals in a season. It is the first time Cornell has had a player net three game-winners in a season since **MANESHA CHITANVIS** (three) in 2010.

► Allen's three game-winning goals is tied with Princeton's Brooke Dawahare for the Ivy League lead in game-winning goals this season.

► Should Allen register another game-winning goal this season, she would be the first Cornell player with at least four game-winning goals in a season since **AMY DUESING** in 1993. Allen would also be tied with **MEAGAN MCMAHAN** (1983 and 1984), **AMY FINKELSTEIN** (1990), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1992) and Duesing for the second-most game-winning goals in a single season. **LAURIE COLLIER** (five in 1987) currently assumes the Cornell single-season record.

### KNACK FOR THE NET

► Cornell has scored at least one goal in 42 of its 61 matches played under head coach **ROB FERGUSON**, dating back to the first season played under Ferguson in 2021.

► The 68.9 percent of contests with a goal ranks as the highest clip in Cornell program history, surpassing **RANDY MAY**, the program's first head coach. May saw his teams score in 67.7 percent of the 282 matches he coached (191 matches with a goal) during his 18-year tenure as head coach between 1982 and 1999.

► As of late, the Big Red has displayed its scoring prowess, scoring a goal in 14 of its last 19 contests, 24 of its previous 30 matches, and 27 of its latest 35 fixtures, dating back to 2022.

## SEEKING HISTORY

► With a victory over Brown this afternoon, Cornell will have won at least three Ivy League matches in a season for the first time since posting a 5-0-2 conference record during the 1995 campaign.

► Since the Cornell women's soccer program was elevated to varsity status prior to the 1982 campaign, the Big Red has registered at least three conference wins in a season on nine occasions — all of which came during a 10-year stretch between 1986 and 1995 (1986, 1987, 1988, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995).

► Since 1996, the Big Red has won two Ivy League matches in a campaign eight times, five of which have come over the last 10 seasons (1996, 1999, 2002, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2022, 2024).

## CLEAN SHEET CLUB

► With her clean sheet against Lehigh on Sept. 8, junior goalkeeper **NATALIE MEDUGNO** increased her career total for clean sheets to 5.5.

► Medugno is one-half of a clean sheet away from tying **MEGHAN CAUZILLO** (1997-00) and **MEGHAN KENNEDY** (2015-18) for the 10th-most shutouts in program history.

► Should Medugno record a full clean sheet this afternoon, she would surpass Cauzillo and Kennedy and match **KATRINA MATLIN** (2003-06) for the ninth-most clean sheets by a Cornell goalkeeper.

## NOBODY WINS

► Cornell's four draws are tied for the third-most in a single season, matching the outputs by the squads from 2002 and 2015. The Big Red's next draw would match the 2022 squad for the second-most ties in program history. Only last year's team, which concluded the year with a 4-5-6 mark, had more draws in a single season.

► The Big Red's four ties are tied with Columbia (6-3-4) for the third-most draws by an Ivy League program, trailing Penn (1-7-6) and Harvard (5-3-5).

Cornell is 3-3-1 all-time on Oct. 26

Oct. 26, 2008: First-half goals by **EVA DIXON** and **ABAGEAL VONDERWEIDT** aided freshman goalkeeper **KELLY MURPHY** to her first collegiate clean sheet as the Big Red defeated Brown, 2-0, at Stevenson-Pincince Field, to snap an 11-match winless streak (0-10-1).

LEADERSHIP GROUP

► For the third consecutive season, Cornell will deploy a multi-person leadership team featuring a trio of captains and a leadership council consisting of two juniors and two sophomores.

► Earning spots as captains on this year's team include seniors **AVA LADEN**, **MADDIE LEROY**, and **CECILY POKIGO**. Leadership council members include juniors **ABIGAIL BISHARA** and **IZZY SCOTT** and sophomores **KAYLA RISTIANTO** and **ISABEL CHAPMAN**.

GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE

► Cornell women's soccer does not generally recruit a specific area of the nation, exemplified by the makeup of this year's roster.

► Seventeen states are represented this season, spanning all four contiguous U.S. time zones. New York leads the way with six players, while California is right behind with five. Texas ranks third with three student-athletes.

► Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, Maryland, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania have two representatives, while Colorado, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington are once represented.

RISTIANTO REPRESENTS INDONESIA

► This past summer, sophomore defender **KAYLA RISTIANTO** suited up for the Indonesian Women's National Soccer Team for a pair of friendlies against Hong Kong.

► The pair of contests between the Asian-based countries were held on July 11 and July 14 at the Hong Kong Football Club Ground, with the hosts claiming victories in both contests by respective 3-2 and 4-1 scores.

► "If anyone gets to be called up for a national team, it's obviously a big deal," Ristianto said, "but for me, it just felt more surreal. Indonesia has always been a part of my home. Even though I didn't grow up there, I was very grateful to experience it. There was definitely nerves. There's always a saying, 'If you're nervous, you care.' I thought it was very special and an opportunity nobody really gets ever."

EUROPEAN TRIP REWIND

► Upon concluding classes last spring, Cornell took a trip to Europe, where the Big Red participated in three exhibition contests.

► A roster of 30 players and four staff left the United States on May 27, playing a trio of exhibitions against Spanish-based clubs.

► The Big Red claimed a 4-1 victory against its first opponent, Girona FC, which competes in the Preferente Catalana, the fifth tier of Spanish soccer. Cornell's middle match of the trip saw the Big Red play Levante Las Planas of Liga F, the top division of Spanish football, before wrapping its trio of contests with a 6-2 victory against Font Santa Fatjó.

► While there was certainly a focus on performance and continuing to improve on the field, the trip was about much more than playing soccer. There was a real focus on 'team' and building relationships, and appreciating the opportunity and experience to dive in to local cultures in Girona, Barcelona, and Sitges, the three places where the team will spend time sightseeing.

► "There is a lot to be gained from a trip like this, both on an individual and team level from a soccer perspective," Ferguson said before embarking on the trip. "The additional training and game opportunities is a huge plus, and the opportunity for players to deal with the challenges of playing abroad, against older and more experienced teams, who have very clear and varied styles of play is a huge growth opportunity."

IVY PRESEASON POLL

► Cornell was picked to finish eighth in this year's Ivy League women's soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 19.

► After claiming last year's inaugural Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament title, Harvard was tabbed the preseason favorite upon receiving 10 of the 16 first-place votes. The Crimson concluded with a point total of 120, 12 points ahead of Brown (108), which received four first-place votes. Behind Brown was Princeton, which finished with 103 points and the other two first-place votes.

► Rounding out the eight-team poll ahead of Cornell's 22 points was Columbia (77 points) in fourth, Dartmouth (57 points) in fifth, Yale (48 points) in sixth, and Penn (41 points) in seventh.

SCOUTING BROWN

- Brown enters this afternoon’s match with a 5-3-5 overall record and 2-1-2 mark in Ivy League play. The Bears currently assume third place in the Ivy League table with its eight points, one point ahead of fourth-place Yale and two points ahead of fifth-place Cornell.
- Entering Thursday’s matches, Brown is one of 47 Division I programs to not have a loss on its home pitch this season.
- The Bears enter today’s contest riding an seven-match home unbeaten streak (5-0-2) and is unbeaten over its last 20 regular-season home matches (15-0-5). Brown’s last regular-season home loss came on Sept. 8, 2022, against then-No. 22-ranked Ohio State, 3-2, and its last home regular-season loss to an Ivy League opponent came in a 3-2 setback against Harvard on Oct. 13, 2018.
- Ella Weil, the reigning Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week, leads Brown’s offense behind her team-leading five goals and 13 points, both figures ranking as the fourth-most in the Ivy League this season. Karlie Schlosser has a team-high four assists, which has her in a five-way tie for the second-most helpers in the Ancient Eight.
- Bella Schopp has started in all 13 of her appearances this season, logging a 5-3-5 record with a 1.06 goals-against average and .735 save percentage. Schopp has four clean sheets on the season, tied with Columbia’s Lauren Rodriguez for the third-most in the Ivy League.

BROWN’S LAST TIME OUT

- PROVIDENCE, R.I. (OCT. 19, 2024) — Ella Weil’s team-leading fifth goal of the season gave Brown an early 1-0 lead, but the Bears conceded a marker in the 66th minute to Columbia as the Bears and Lions played to a 1-1 draw at Stevenson-Pincince Field.
- Weil’s goal came off a rebound of a shot by Layla Shell from outside the 18-yard box that hit the crossbar.
- Bella Schopp made both of her saves during first-half action while Columbia’s 66th-minute goal snapped her shutout streak at exactly 250 minutes.

42 YEARS, 325 MILES, 41 MEETINGS

- Cornell and Brown will be meeting for the 42nd time this afternoon. The Bears own the advantage in the series, 30-7-4, while owning a 14-match unbeaten streak (13-0-1) over the Big Red since Cornell’s last victory over its Ivy League rival in 2008.
- Brown has held Cornell scoreless in three of the last four meetings and 10 times during its 14-match unbeaten streak over the Big Red.
- Last year, then-No. 15-ranked Brown registered a 2-1 victory at Berman Field on Cornell’s Senior Day to solidify its fourth consecutive Ivy League regular-season title. Ava Laden scored the lone goal for Cornell, trimming Brown’s lead in half with her tally in the 67th minute. Erica Fox made four saves in the setback for the Big Red.

# ROB FERGUSON

FIFTH YEAR (FOURTH SEASON) AS HEAD COACH

**Years at Cornell:** Sixth Year

**College:** University of Manchester

**ROB FERGUSON**, who is entering his fifth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

Ferguson's most recent campaign in 2023 saw Cornell register an overall record of 4-5-6 and an 0-5-2 mark in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its most offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while **MIA GONZALEZ** (forward) and **CECILY POKIGO** (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

During the 2022 season, Cornell had a 4-7-5 overall record and a 2-3-2 ledger in Ivy League play. Both of Cornell's conference victories — the most by the Big Red since 2016 — came in the program's final two matches of the season against Princeton and Dartmouth. The victory over Princeton was Cornell's first since 1995, snapping a 25-match losing streak to the Tigers.

The consecutive victories over Princeton and Dartmouth marked the first time Cornell had registered back-to-back wins in Ivy League contests since the final conference fixture in 2014 and the first league bout in 2015.

Cornell had a 3-1-3 record on its home turf at Berman Field in 2022, featuring the Big Red going unbeaten across its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo earning Second Team All-Ivy honors.

Ferguson's first year as Cornell's head coach did not see the Big Red play in any contests with the cancelation of all matches due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In his second year at the helm, Ferguson's first year of competition as head coach saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-11-2 and a 1-6-0 Ivy League mark. The lone league victory was the Big Red's first over an Ancient Eight opponent since defeating Columbia in 2016.

In his first overall season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season — including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection **ASHLEY DURIK**.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas. Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Britannia Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
