▶ After its scheduled home opener was postponed due to unfavorable weather forecasts, the Cornell baseball team continues its season-opening road trip this weekend at Princeton, where the Big Red opens Ancient Eight play from Clarke Field.

- Cornell went 1-2 in its three-game series against Richmond at Pitt Field, having a 9-3 win bookended by 8-4 Richmond victories.
- Senior second baseman MATT BARNHORST hit .462 (6-of-13) with two home runs and seven RBI. Barnhorst's classmate, senior catcher NATHAN WAUGH, also hit two home runs on the weekend and drove in four runs.
- ► CARSON MAYFIELD earned the victory for Cornell in its win last Saturday after a five-inning outing in which the sophomore right-hander allowed two runs on five hits.

WAUGH[TCHING] IT OFF THE BAT

- Senior catcher NATHAN WAUGH enters this weekend riding a 15-game hitting streak, dating back to last season.
- ▶ Waugh's 15-game hit streak is the longest active hit streak by an lvy League player. He is only one of two Ancient Eight players to register hits in at least 10 consecutive games, joining Dartmouth's Tyler Robinson (12 games).
- ▶ During Waugh's 15-game on-base streak, he has also registered at least one hit, making him the first Big Red player with a 15-game hit streak since former outfielder BRIAN BILLIGEN had a 16-game hit streak during the 2012 campaign. Billigen accomplished his feat from March 4-27, where he slashed .470/.527/.758 with five doubles, a triple, four home runs, and 16 RBI.
- ▶ Should Waugh surpass Billigen, he would have the longest hit streak by a Big Red player since MARSHALL YANZICK compiled a 19-game hit streak spanning the 2011 and 2012 campaigns.

LOOKING TO EXTEND THEIR STREAKS

- ▶ Waugh (15 games), junior outfielder JAKOBI DAVIS (14 games), and sophomore outfielder CADEN WILDMAN (11 games) all enter this weekend riding double-digit on-base streaks — the streaks for Waugh and Davis both date back to last season.
- ▶ Davis is slashing .265/.357/.367, dating back to April 28, 2023, while Wildman's is .293/.396/.415.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

- Cornell has shown a knack for scoring runs in bundles this season, as 40 of its 53 runs have come in multi-run innings (75.4 percent of its run production).
- Of the Big Red's 220 runs scored since the beginning of last season, 169 have come in innings that have featured at least two runs crossing home plate (74.6 percent of run production).
- ▶ Since the beginning of the 2022 season, Cornell has had at least one multi-run inning in 63 of its 82 games (76.8 percent). At one point, Cornell scored at least

two runs in 18 consecutive games from April 24, 2022 (final eight games of season) to March 18, 2023 (first 10 games of season).

▶ Cornell has had 12 multi-run innings through its first three weekends of play, highlighted by a season-high six-run inning in the opening game of the Big Red's doubleheader against Georgetown at Capital One Park in Tysons, Va., on March 10.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ The Ivy League preseason poll was announced on Feb. 19, with Penn pitted as the unanimous favorite following a vote of 16 panelists.
- Columbia was picked second, finishing as the only other program to reach the century mark in points (101). Harvard (97 points) and Princeton (87 points) were the other anticipated programs to round out this year's four-team ly League Tournament field.
- ▶ Yale was slotted to finish fifth behind its 66 points, while Cornell (37 points) and Brown (35 points) were separated by two points for sixth and seventh places. Dartmouth rounded out the eight-team league with 25 points.

WALK THIS WAY

- ▶ Junior infielder MAX JENSEN enters this weekend with a 0.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio, which is second behind Brown's Mark Henshon (0.40 — two walks to five strikeouts) among Ivy League hitters, according to data compiled by D1Baseball.com. Along with Henshon and Jensen, Harvard's Ben Rounds (0.55), Dartmouth's Elliot Krewson (0.71), Brown's Reece Rappoli (0.80), and Columbia's Hunter Snyder (0.91) have sub-1.00 strikeout-to-walk ratios.
- ▶ Jensen's 16.3 percent walk rate (seven walks in 43 plate appearances) is the third-best average by an Ivy League batter. Columbia's Hunter Snyder (26.2 percent — 11 walks in 42 PAs) and Princeton's Jake Bold (23.0 percent — 17 walks in 74 PAs) have higher clips.

After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher RICH BOOTH '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-squre foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

DAN PEPICELLI was named the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball on Aug. 10, 2015, and is currently in his ninth season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 85 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fifth-most in program history and is three victories shy of assuming sole possession of fourth place in head coaching victories, trailing TED THOREN (515), TOM FORD (264), and BILL WALKENBACH (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 21 All-Ivy League selections — including five First Team and eight Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with an ERA under 4.00. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling Baseball America's ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. In total, 10 Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.


