WHAT TO WATCH FOR

- The University of Maine men's hockey team will face off against Cornell University on Thursday night in the first round of the NCAA Tournament
- The Black Bears are playing in the program's first NCAA Tournament in 12 years, last having appeared in 2012, and the 19th overall ... Maine earned an at-large bid and enters the tournament as the fifth overall seed.
- Cornell earned ECAC Hockey's automatic bid with the program's 13th Whitelaw Cup win ... this is the second consecutive and 24th overall NCAA Tournament bid for the Big Red.

A WIN ON THURSDAY WOULD...

- Bump Maine to 24-11-2 on the year for the most wins in a season since 2005-06.
- Give the Black Bears the first NCAA Tournament win for the program since March 24, 2007.
- Move Maine to 31-20 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
- Bump Maine to 8-7-3 all-time against Cornell.

SERIES HISTORY vs CORNELL

- Maine holds an all-time record of 7-7-3 against the Big Red, including a mark of 6-1-2 in neutral site games.
- This is the first meeting between the two squads since the 2013 Florida College Classic championship game on Dec. 29, 2013 ... Maine and Cornell's last seven meetings came at the annual Florida College Classic tournament.
- This is the first-ever NCAA Tournament meeting between the two teams.
- Cornell and Maine squared off for the first time ever on Dec. 28, 1979 at Lynah Rink, with the Big Red pulling out a 3-1 win.

MAINE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Maine is playing in its 19 NCAA Tournament ... the program has appeared in 11 Frozen Fours.
- The Black Bears have won two titles, doing it in 1993 and 1999.
- The Black Bears are 30-20 all-time in the tournament, including a mark of 14-7 in the regional round.
- Maine appeared in its first national title game in 1993, topping Lake Superior State, 5-4, for the program's first title ... the Black Bears are 2-3 in the championship game.

BETTER THAN PREDICTED

- Maine was picked to finish ninth in the Hockey East Preseason Coaches' poll but went on to earn third place in the regular season standings.
- The Black Bears are just the second team in the last 25 years to be picked to finish ninth or lower that has gone on to earn a top-3 finish, joining the 2011-12 UMass Lowell squad that was led by that season's head coach of the Year, Norm Bazin.
- With its third-place finish this season, Maine earned its best conference finish since tying for third place in 2009-10.

 • Nineteen of Maine's 36 games have been against ranked opponents, with the Black Bears going 11-7-1 in those games for the most ranked wins since 2003-04 (12).
 • Maine is 18-2-1 this season when captain Lynden Breen has a point ... Breen is the Hockey East active leader in scoring with 102 career points.
 • Josh Nadeau's five game-winning goals on the year ties for the rookie national lead and eighth overall ... he's the first Maine player to reach five game-winning goals in a year since Teddy Purcell in 2006-07.
 • Maine is second in Hockey East and 17th in the nation with a 52.1 face-off winning percentage.
 • Harrison Scott is third among Hockey East players and 18th in the nation with 383 face-off wins.
 • On the season, Josh Nadeau and Bradley Nadeau have assisted each other on 24 goals and they have combined on 31 total.
 • Maine led Hockey East with 11 sellouts at home ... Alfond Arena is above 98 percent capacity for all home games.
 • With Bradley Nadeau and Josh Nadeau, the Black Bears placed a rookie on the Hockey East All-Star teams for the first time since 1994-95.

SHOTS, SHOTS, SHOTS

• Maine is averaging 62.42 shots per game, the most of any Hockey East school.
 • The Black Bears tied ninth in the country with an average of 32.8 shots on goal per game.
 • At 55.6 percent, Maine is tied for the fifth-best Corsi For percentage in the country.
 • Bradley Nadeau has a team-leading 108 shots on goal and is 10th in Hockey East with a 3.00 shots on goal per game average.
 • Lynden Breen is the active shots on goal leader in Hockey East with 360.
 • Maine is also ninth nationally with an average of 25.3 shots on goal against per game.

BALANCED ATTACK

• Through 36 games, Maine has 23 different point getters and 20 different goal scorers.
 • Maine has received game-winning goals from 11 different players and power-play tallies from nine different players.
 • With Lynden Breen, Bradley Nadeau and Josh Nadeau, Maine has three 30-point players for the first time 2011-12.
 • Seven Black Bears have at least 22 points each ... this is the first time Maine has at least seven players with 20 points since 2017-18.
 • Seventeen players have at least five points each while 11 players have at least 11 points each.
 • Maine and Boston College are the only Hockey East schools that have at least three players with at least four game-winning goals each.

CAREER-HIGHS ALL AROUND!

• Several Black Bears have set new career-highs in goals, assists and/or points.
 • Lynden Breen has a career-high 21 assists.
 • Thomas Freeland has bests in goals (6), assists (16) and points (22).
 • Brandon Chabrier has single-season bests in goals (6), assists (16) and points (22).
 • Brandon Holt has new career highs in points (15) and assists (11).
 • Harrison Scott has new bests in goals (14), assists (12) and points (26) ... he also has a career-high 383 face-off wins,

BROTHERLY LOVE

TOP-3 FINISH

Maine is the first team picked to finish ninth or lower in the preseason coaches poll and finish in the top 3 of the league since UMass Lowell was picked ninth and finished tied second in 2011-12 under Coach of the Year, Norm Bazin.

RANKED WINS

- Maine has **11 wins** over ranked opponents this year for the most wins over a ranked opponent since 2003-04 (12 wins).
- Maine is 2-1-1 against top-5 opponents.
- The Black Bears' 4-2 win over #1 Boston College on Nov. 10, 2023 was Maine's first over a top-ranked team since defeating #1 Boston University on March 14, 2009.

- It's also the first time Maine has two freshmen with 35 points in the same season since 1992-93 (five players) and the first time since 1992-93 that Maine has two first-year players with 15 goals each (three players).
- The first weekend of December saw the Nadeau brothers combine for 13 points across two Maine wins, with both Josh and Bradley netting a hat trick ... on Dec. 1 against New Hampshire, Josh recorded his first career hat trick and game-winning goal, while Bradley earned the primary assist on each tally ... on Dec. 3, it was Bradley who net the hat trick with Josh recording the primary assist on each strike ... Bradley, who potted a short-handed game-winning goal, also added an assist for a career-high four points.
- Both brothers were members of the back-to-back BCHL Championship winning Penticton Vees squad last season, with Bradley earning 2023 Playoff MVP

HELLO, HARRISON SCOTT

- In his first season as a Black Bear, Harrison Scott has recorded career-highs in points (26), goals (14), assists (12), game-winning goals (4) and face-off wins (383).
- The junior transfer is third in Hockey East with his 383 face-off wins while his 10.64 per game average is fourth best.
- Scott recorded his first career hat trick against UMass Lowell on Jan. 20 and was named Hockey East Player of the Week.
- He's registered three multi-point games on the year.
- Maine is 10-2-0 when he scores a goal and 16-5-1 when he has at least one point.

THE #JOURNEYNORTH

- Maine's 22-10-2 regular season record marked the most wins in the regular season slate since going 24-10-2 in 36 regular season games in 2005-06 (the Black Bears finished that year 28-12-2 overall).
- Maine's 23 total wins this season marks the most since going 23-14-3 in the 2011-12 season.
- The Black Bears went 13-2-2 at Alford Arena this season to reach 13 wins at home for the first time since 2013-14.
- A 3-2 win at Vermont on March 2, Maine secured its first 20-win season since going 23-14-3 during the 2011-12 season.
- Maine reached 18 wins in the first 25 games of the season for the first time since 2003-04.
- With a 10-4-1 mark in the first 15 games of Hockey East play, Maine reached 10 wins in the first 15 conference games for the first time since going 10-4-1 in the first 15 Hockey East games in 2003-04.
- With a 2-1 win at Merrimack on Nov. 3, Maine won the Hockey East opener for the first time since the 2017-18 season.
- Maine went 3-0-1 in the first four league games, going unbeaten in the first four Hockey East games for the first time since 2010-11.

THE CHABRIER SHOW

- Blue liner Brandon Chabrier has set career-highs in points (22), goals (6), assists (16), power-play goals (2), game-winning goals (2), shots on goal (59) and blocked shots (24).
- He's one of seven Hockey East defensemen with at least six goals and 20 blocks.
- The sophomore has earned three Hockey East Defender of the Week honors this year and was December Defender of the Month.
- Against UConn on Dec. 3, Chabrier tallied a career-best four points on one goal and three assists ... it was the first four-point game by a Maine defender since Troy Barnes had five assists in a 6-0 win over Quinnipiac on Jan. 9, 2005.
- Chabrier scored the overtime game-winning goal against #5 Quinnipiac on Oct. 27 ... it was his first career game-winning goal.
- He has two power-play goals and two game-winning goals to go with four multi-point games.
- The Black Bears are 5-1-0 this season when Chabrier scores a goal and 12-4-0 when he has a point.

THE JOSH NADEAU NOTE

- Josh Nadeau leads Maine in power-play goals (8) and is tied for the team lead in assists (27) while sitting second in points (45).
- The forward is tied 16th in the country and is seventh among rookies with his 45 points.
- Nadeau's five game-winning goals on the year ties for the rookie national lead and is eighth overall ... he's the first Maine player to reach five game-winning goals in a year since Teddy Purcell in 2006-07.
- He is tied 13th nationally with eight power-play goals and has the most by a Black Bear since Ben Hutton had nine in 2013-14.
- On the year, he has 16 multi-point games, fourth in Hockey East ... he has four multi-goal and nine multi-assist games.
- Earlier this season, he became the first Maine freshman to reach 15 goals in a season since Teddy Purcell in 2006-07.
- He was named the National Player of the Month for December after putting up six and six for 12 points.

THE BRADLY NADEAU NOTE

- Brady Nadeau leads Maine in goals (19) and points (46).
- The forward is 15th in the country and fifth among rookies with his 46 points.
- He has 11 multi-point games, six multi-goal games and four multi-assist games.
- He recorded his first career hat trick on Dec. 3 against UConn as part of a career-best four-point night and potted his fourth career game-winning goal with a second-period short-handed tally ... the game before, he had the primary assist on each of his brother Josh's hat trick goals.
- He has been named the Hockey East Player of the Week, Rookie of the Week and Rookie of the Month once each.

OH BOIJA!

- Freshman Albin Boija earned his first career shutout with a 15-save performance in a 1-0 win at #11 UMass on Feb. 3.
- The Sundsvall, Sweden native is 10-6-1 on the year with a .916 save percent-

age and 2.01 goals against average.

- Boija earned his first career start and win with an 18-save game in a 5-2 win over #15/14 New Hampshire on Dec. 1.
- He has backstopped the Black Bears to six ranked wins.
- With an 18-save performance in the Hockey East Tournament quarterfinal, he gave Maine it's first postseason shutout since 2014.

THE POLLS

- When Maine was ranked in both polls on Oct. 23, it marked the first time back in the national rankings since March 2020.
- Maine has gone on to be ranked for 20 consecutive weeks for the first time since a 57-week stretch from January 2005 to March 2007.
- The Black Bears made their return to the national top 10 on Nov. 13 - the first time since March 2012.
- Additionally, the program has spent 18 weeks in the top 10 for the first time since the 2006-07 season.

THE CONNECTICUT COMEBACK

- In Maine's 5-3 win at UConn on Jan. 12, the Black Bears came back from a 2-0 deficit with five goals in the third period.
- It was Maine's first win this season when trailing after two periods.
- It was the first time Maine scored five goals in a period since Oct. 21, 2017 in a 6-3 win over Miami ... it was Maine's first five-goal road period since Nov. 28, 2009 in a 10-1 win at St. Lawrence.

- The Black Bears took home the 2023 Ledyard Bank Classic championship this past weekend ... Maine topped #18/19 RIT, 5-2, to earn the right to face Dartmouth in the title game ... the Black Bears earned a 5-1 win over the host Big Green.
- The victory marked Maine's first Ledyard Classic title in what was its sixth tournament ... Maine is now the ninth Hockey East school to win the Ledyard Classic.
- Harrison Scott was named the Most Valuable Player after finishing the weekend with two goals, including a game-winning goal, and 17 face-off wins.
- Victor Östman was named the Most Outstanding Goaltender after earning both wins on the weekend with a 1.50 goals against average and .923 save percentage.
- Sully Scholle (2-0-2) and Donovan Villeneuve-Houle (0-4-4) were named to the All-Tournament Team.
- It was the first time Maine won a trophy tournament since the Florida Classic in 2012.

WE #BEATBC

- With Maine's 4-2 win over a #1 Boston College squad on Nov. 10, the Black Bears earned their second-ever victory over a top-ranked squad at Alford Arena.
- It was the first win over a team ranked #1 since beating Boston University, 6-3, in the Hockey East Tournament quarterfinals on March 14, 2009.

MELTED ICE CHIPS...

- Lynden Breen led all of Hockey East with 21 goals last season ... it was the first 20-plus goal season for Maine since Spencer Abbott had 21 goals during the 2011-12 season.
- Luke Antonacci finished 12th in Hockey East in 2022-23 with 51 blocked shots.
- Nolan Renwick's 370 face-off wins a season ago ranked fourth in the conference while Breen was sixth with 330 ... Maine was the only school in the league to have multiple players in the top nine in face-off wins.
- Victor Östman's five shutouts last year were the most by a Maine goaltender in a single season since Jimmy Howard had six shutouts during the 2004-05 season.

WHAT'S BACK ON THE ATTACK

- The Black Bears return 17 players from last season's team, including the top four point getters.
- Overall, Maine returns 80 percent of goals, 75 percent of assists and 77 percent of the points from a season ago.
- Maine welcomes back captain and last year's leading scorer, Lynden Breen, who tallied 21 goals and 15 assists for 36 points to earn a spot on the Hockey East Second Team.
- Breen is joined by returning scorers Ben Poisson (9-17-26), Nolan Renwick (9-11-20), and Donovan Villeneuve-Houle (9-10-19).

THE 2022-23 RECAP

- The Black Bears finished the 2022-23 season with an overall mark of 15-16-5 and a Hockey East record of 9-11-4.
- Maine finished tied for sixth in the Hockey East standings and hosted Vermont in the quarterfinal round ... the Black Bears fell, 4-2.
- Lynden Breen and Victor Östman both earned Hockey East Second Team All-Star honors.
- The Black Bears return the top four scorers from a season ago and eight of the top 10 overall.
- Breen led the team in points (36) and goals (21) while Ben Poisson was second in points (26) and first in assists (17).
- Östman went 14-12-4 on the year with a .918 save percentage, 2.21 goals against average and five shutouts while being named a Mike Richter Award semifinalist ... he ended last season with career-highs in wins (14) and shutouts (5) while posting career-low figures in both goals against average (2.21) and save percentage (.918).

MEET THE CAPTAINS

- David Breazeale and Lynden Breen will serve as the captains of the 2023-24 Maine men's hockey team, with Ben Poisson and Nolan Renwick serving as alternate captains.
- Breazeale, a junior, and Breen, a senior, both served as alternate captains last year
- This marks the second consecutive season that Poisson is wearing an 'A' on his jersey and the first for Renwick.

OPENING NIGHT NHL ROSTERS

- With the start of the 2023-24 NHL season, four UMaine alums made NHL rosters while two alums were behind the bench ... additionally, Devin Shore was called up by Seattle early in the season.
- Defenseman Ben Hutton earned a spot on the Vegas Golden Knights while forwards Ryan Lomberg and Gustav Nyquist were named to Florida and Nashville, respectively.
- Goaltender Jeremy Swayman was named to the opening night roster for the Boston Bruins.
- Jim Montgomery enters his second season behind the bench of the Boston

NADEAU DRAFTED IN ROUND ONE

- Freshman forward Bradley Nadeau was selected in the first round of the 2023 National Hockey League Draft, going 30th overall to the Carolina Hurricanes.
- Nadeau was the first Black Bear to be selected in the first round since Barrett Heisten was selected 20th overall in the 1999 NHL Draft by the Buffalo Sabres.
- A native of Saint-François-de-Madawaska, New Brunswick, Nadeau was named the BCHL's Most Valuable Player and earned the Brett Hull Trophy as the BCHL scoring leader with 45 goals and 68 assists for 113 points in 54 games.
- Nadeau guided the Penticton Vees to back-to-back BCHL championships and was named the 2023 playoff MVP.

CARNEY CONNECTION

- Sophomore forward Aidan Carney is the second member of his family to skate for the Black Bears, joining his father Keith Carney.
- Keith Carney was a two-time All-American defenseman ... he recorded 126 points on 14 goals and 112 assists in his three seasons in Orono before going on to skate in 1,018 regular season NHL games.
- Aidan Carney skated in 19 games as a freshman, recording two goals and one assist for three points.

BEN BARR, HEAD COACH

Ben Barr enters his third season behind the bench in the 2023-24 season.

Barr arrived at UMaine with 15 years of assistant coaching experience in Division-I programs and a tradition of success at each of his stints at five different institutions. Prior to Maine, Barr spent five years at UMass as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator, where he helped guide the Minutemen to a 94-75-10 record, including a 72-26-6 mark over his last three seasons. His time at UMass included a Hockey East regular season and tournament title, three NCAA appearances, back-to-back NCAA title game appearances, and the 2021 National Championship.

In his first season at the helm of the Black Bears, Barr guided a transitioning program to two notable victories: on the road at #8 UMass and against #14 Boston University on Senior Night at Alfond Arena. David Breazeale was named to the Hockey East Pro Ambitions All-Rookie Team.

The second year of the Barr Era saw the Black Bears go 15-16-5 overall with a 9-11-4 record in Hockey East play to finish in sixth place and earn the right to host a Hockey East playoff game. The 2022-23 campaign included a 4-0 win over third-ranked and eventual National Champion Quinnipiac as well as ranked wins over #15 UMass Lowell, #15 Merrimack and a sweep of #16 Providence College. Lynden Breen and Victor Ostman earned Hockey East Second Team All-Star honors.

Barr began his coaching career at his alma mater, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, where he spent the 2004-05 and 2007-08 seasons as a volunteer assistant coach. Barr joined Union College in September of 2008 as a full-time assistant. In his three seasons at Union, Barr played a key role in developing Union into a national champion. In his final year on staff, the Dutchman captured their first-ever ECAC Regular Season Championship and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in school history. At the time, working under head coach Nate Leaman, Barr and the Union staff were named the 2011 Spencer Penrose NCAA Staff of the Year.

After three years at Union, Barr was hired as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Providence College. In his first year on staff, the Friars reached the Hockey East semifinals for the first time in 11 years. In his final year on staff, Providence advanced to the NCAA quarterfinal round in its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2001. Following his departure, with players both recruited and developed by Barr, the Friars went on to win the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In June of 2014, Barr accepted a role as the associate head coach at Western Michigan University where he would stay for two seasons. At Western Michigan, Barr again served as recruiting coordinator and assisted head coach Andy Murray in developing a championship culture. The team transformed into a top-10 program and reached the NCAA Tournament the year after Barr's departure.

The Faribault, Minn. native began his role at UMass in April of 2016 where he went on to serve five seasons as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator. In his first season at UMass, the team finished the year at 5-29-2. Just two seasons later, the program registered a 31-10 overall mark, a Hockey East regular season championship, and finished as the NCAA runners-up. Two years later, the Minutemen achieved greatness as they were crowned the Hockey East and NCAA Champions.

In his five seasons behind the bench at UMass, Barr led the charge in his recruiting coordinator role in recruiting the top producing freshman class in all of NCAA hockey in 2017-18. Under the leadership of Greg Carvel, Barr earned his second Spencer Penrose National Coaching Staff of the Year award. Barr played a key role in bringing several firsts to UMass as the Minutemen earned their first Hockey East regular season title in school history in 2019, their first Hockey East Tournament title in 2021, and the school's first-ever National Championship in April of 2021.

Barr attended Shattuck-St. Mary's Prep School in Faribault, Minn. where he served as Captain of the Shattuck-St. Mary's Midget hockey team in 1999. A Williams Cup recipient, Barr was named Shattuck-St. Mary's Best All-Around Athlete in 2000. Prior to his playing career at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Barr competed as a member of the 1999 USA National Championship team.

Barr earned a four-year athletic scholarship at RPI where he went on to achieve four letters for the men's ice hockey team from 2000-04. He served as the team's captain during the 2003-04 season, leading the program to a 22 win season. Barr earned the Rensselaer Coach's award in 2003 and 2004 and was named the team's Most Valuable Player for the 2002-03 campaign. Barr graduated from RPI in May of 2004 with a Bachelor of Science in Management and Technology with a Marketing concentration.

Barr and his wife, Tara, are the proud parents of a son, Brooks, and twins, Isla and Griffin.
