FIRST PITCH

► The top two teams in the Ivy League standings convene at Booth Field this weekend as Columbia (20-14, 12-3) makes its biennial trip to East Hill to face Cornell (13-14, 10-5).

WEEKEND REWIND

► For the fourth consecutive weekend, Cornell posted a series victory over an Ivy League rival as the Big Red took two of three games from Yale last weekend at Booth Field.

► Cornell has won its last four Ivy League series, the program's longest streak of consecutive series victories since posting a five straight series victories over Dartmouth (2-of-2), Brown (2-of-2), Yale (2-of-2), Columbia (3-of-4), and Penn (3-of-4) in 2012 — the last time the Big Red won the Ivy League title.

► Junior outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** continued his torrid hitting stretch, batting .571 (8-for-14) in the Yale series with three doubles, a home run, and four RBI, highlighted by his walk-off two-run double in the 10th inning of Cornell's 10-9 victory, avenging an 8-0 eighth-inning deficit in the series opener.

► Sophomore left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** allowed two runs and scattered four hits while striking out six Yale batters over six innings to guide Cornell to sweep last Saturday's doubleheader and ensure the series victory, 8-2.

► Yale took the finale, 6-3, despite freshman catcher **MARK QUATRANI** blasting his seventh home run of the season in the setback.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

► Junior outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** and freshman catcher **MARK QUATRANI** received weekly awards from the Ivy League on Monday afternoon.

► Cornell has had at least one player earn Ivy League weekly awards in each of the last four weeks, featuring Quatrani earning three of the last four Rookie of the Week awards.

► In Cornell's four-game week, which included the Big Red posting a 3-1 record, Quinlan posted a .588 batting average (10-for-17) with three doubles, two home runs, and five RBI, to go along with his 1.784 OPS (.667 on-base percentage and 1.118 slugging percentage).

► During his four appearances last week, Quatrani batted .357 (5-for-14) with a home run and five RBI and posted a 1.097 OPS (.526 on-base percentage and .571 slugging percentage).

OFF TO A GOOD START

► After its first five weekends of Ivy League play, Cornell has an 10-5 record against Ancient Eight opponents, featuring the Big Red winning 10 of its last 13 conference matchups.

► The Big Red's two victories over Yale last weekend marked the eighth time since 1930 — when the Big Red joined the EIBL, which disbanded in 1992 — that it has posted at least 10 wins by its 15th conference game, joining teams from 1940 (10-1), 1972 (8-4), 1977 (10-2), 1980 (10-4), 1982 (11-4), 1998 (10-5), and 2012 (13-2).

► With one win over Columbia this weekend, Cornell will have at least 11 conference victories for the first time since 2013 (11-9). It would also serve as the program's fourth time in the Ivy League era (since 1993), and sixth overall instance, it has amassed 11 wins within its 18th league game, also having been done in 1977 (11-3), 1982 (12-6), 1998 (11-7), 2012 (13-5), and 2013 (11-7).

► Should Cornell post two victories this weekend, it would be the Big Red's first 12-win season in conference play since 2012 (14-6), and the fourth time in program history it has had 12 wins in conference play, previously accomplished in 1982 (12-6), 1998 (12-8), and 2012 (14-6).

► A sweep of Columbia this weekend would not only give Cornell sole possession of first place in the Ivy League standings and a clinch a spot in the Ivy League Tournament, it would match the 2012 squad (13-5) for the best 18-game start in Ivy League play (since 1993) and be the second-most wins in conference play in program history.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

► Despite having its 12-game home run streak snapped against Penn on April 13, Cornell has hit a home run in 18 of its last 19 games, registering 33 of its 36 blasts during the span.

► Cornell's 36 home runs are the second-most in a season in program history, two round-trippers shy of matching the program record set in 2009 (38).

► Freshman infielder **KEVIN HAGER**'s first-inning, three-run home run against Penn on April 14 was Cornell's 30th home run of the season, marking the first time in program history the Big Red has hit 30-plus home runs in three consecutive seasons.

► Having a flair for the dramatic, Cornell has hit seven grand slams this year, the most in a season on record in program history. The seven grand slams matches the program's combined output over the previous nine years (eight seasons).

NEWS & NOTES ON KELLER

► **THIS WEEKEND:** Keller will be making his sixth start of 2024 while appearing in his 10th game ... appearance will be the 22nd of his collegiate career and 17th start.

► **LAST TIME OUT:** Recorded first victory of season, and first win since May 7, 2023 (at Dartmouth), after allowing just two runs and scattering four hits over his six quality innings of work and striking out six batters ... outing was his second quality start of the season (March 22 at Princeton) and fifth of collegiate career.

► **NO LONG BALLS:** Enters this weekend having yet to surrender a home run this season, holding opponents without a round-tripper over his last 41.1 innings pitched (last HR: April 29, 2023 vs. Penn — Wyatt Henseler).

► **NOT FUN FOR LEFTIES:** Despite having a much smaller sample size, left-handed hitters have had a tough time figuring out the sophomore southpaw this season as lefties are hitting just .172 (5-for-29) with a .445 OPS (.273 on-base percentage and .172 slugging percentage) off the Big Red southpaw compared to a .347 clip (35-of-101) with an .892 OPS (.446 on-base percentage and .446 slugging percentage) produced by righties ... all five hits allowed by Keller to left-handed hitters have gone for singles.

► **AGAINST COLUMBIA:** In lone career outing against the Lions last April 2, allowing two runs (one earned) and gave up four hits over his four-inning outing while issuing a trio of walks and fanning five.

► **2023:** Started all 11 appearances last season for the Big Red, tying **BRIAN WILLIAMSON** (1996), **BRIAN McAFEE** (2012), and **ETHAN HAMILL** (2023) for most starts in a season by a freshman pitcher in Cornell program history ... logged a 2-5 record with 5.37 ERA while striking out 50 in 52 innings of work ... registered three quality outings,

Q'S PROVIDING THE A'S

- Junior outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** and freshman catcher **MARK QUATRANI** have been two of Cornell's most reliable hitters since the beginning of Ivy League play.
- Quinlan is hitting an Ivy League-leading .449 (31-of-69) in Ivy play this season, ahead of Penn's Wyatt Henseler by 42 points (.407) for the conference lead in batting average.
- Quinlan's 31 hits are tied with former Big Red player **WILL SIMONEIT** for the most base hits in conference play in program history. Simoneit also had 31 hits during his senior campaign in 2019.
- Cornell is the lone Ancient Eight program to have three players with at least 23 hits in Ivy League play, highlighted by Quinlan's league-leading 31 base knocks. Behind Quinlan is junior infielder **MAX JENSEN** (24) and sophomore outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** (23).

- Quatrani has six home runs in Ivy League contests, standing as the second-most home runs in conference contests, only behind Henseler's seven blasts. Quatrani's 25 RBI leads the Ivy League and is one of two players with 20-plus ribbies, joined by Columbia's Skye Selinsky (23).
- Both Quatrani (1.235) and Quinlan (1.180) have OPS figures north of 1.000, while junior infielder **MAX JENSEN** (.984) and sophomore outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** (.940) have an OPS above .900.

QUINLAN'S HOT BAT

- Junior outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** enters this weekend's series holding a 1.73 hits per game average, ranking as the eighth-highest average among Division I hitters who have played in at least 75 percent of their team's games.
- Georgia phenom Charlie Condon is tied with Rutgers' Joshua Kuroda-Grauer for the top hits per game average with 1.85. Duke's Ben Miller (1.81), Fairfield's Dean Ferrara (1.76), Penn State's JT Marr (1.75), Austin Peay's Clayton Gray (1.74), and UTSA's Mason Lytle (1.74) have higher averages than Quinlan's 1.73 clip.
- Harvard's Ben Rounds has the second-highest hits per game average by an Ivy League player (1.58), which ranks 37th nationally.

SCOUTING COLUMBIA

- Columbia enters this weekend with an overall record of 20-14 and a 12-3 mark in Ivy League play. The Lions are currently riding a five-game win streak, which was extended Wednesday with their 31-0 victory over Seton Hall.
- Wednesday's scoring output was the second-most runs scored in a single game in Lions program history, only behind a 37-3 thrashing of Brooklyn Poly (now New York University) on an unidentified date in 1894.
- Griffin Palfrey and Jack Cooper each drove in seven runs apiece in the victory as the Lions pounded out 24 hits, 12 of which went for extra bases (seven doubles, one triple, four home runs). Jagger Edwards, Martin Zhang, Palfrey, and Brandon Madrigal combined to four-hit the Pirates in the seven-run contest.
- After opening the season with a 3-11 record, having played against the likes of No. 4-ranked Florida, No. 23-ranked UC Irvine, and No. 11-ranked East Carolina, the Lions have gone 17-4 and has scored 10-plus runs on 13 occasions during the stretch.
- Jack Cooper (13) and Cole Hage (11) both have double-digit home run totals this season, while Hage leads the team in batting average (.378) and OPS (1.249). Cooper has driven in a team-leading 51 RBI paired with his .336 average.
- Derek Yoo (4-1, 4.26 ERA) has logged the most innings of any Columbia pitcher, posting 44.1 IP over nine appearances, six of which were starts. Yoo has held opponents to hit just .226 off him this season, surrendering 37 hits against. Joe Sheets (3-3, 6.23 ERA) has made a team-high nine starts across his 10 appearances this season.

138 YEARS, 229 MILES, 251 MEETINGS

- Cornell leads the all-time series, 133-118, despite losing six of the last seven meetings against the Lions. The Big Red won the last game between the two teams, 13-8, to avoid being swept in a three-game series at Robertson Field at Satow Stadium.
- Over the last four trips to Ithaca, Columbia has posted a 7-4 record, which included posting a four-game sweep of the Big Red in 2014, taking two of three games in 2018, and winning all three games in 2022.
- With a series victory this weekend, it would be Cornell's first time taking a series over its Empire State rival since 2017 and the first time doing so on home turf since 2016.
- Senior catcher **NATHAN WAUGH** has succeeded against Columbia, posting a .500 batting average (9-for-18) with four doubles, a triple, a home run, and six RBI over five career outings. Junior infielder **MAX JENSEN** (8-for-23 — .348) has added three doubles, one home run, and four RBI in six career games against the Lions.

DAN PEPICELLI was named the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball on Aug. 10, 2015, and is currently in his ninth season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 97 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 21 All-Ivy League selections — including five First Team and eight Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
