5TH SEASON AS HEAD COACH

▶ The Cornell women's soccer team rounds out its three-match homestand with a contest against Boston College on Thursday at Berman Field before making the trip to Bethlehem, Pa., for a match against Patriot League rival Lehigh on Sunday afternoon at the Ulrich Sports Complex.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (SEPT. 1, 2024) SYDNEY ALLEN picked an opportune time to record her first collegiate goal as the sophomore forward headed in a cross from the right side of the penalty area by classmate ALANNA COLBERT to guide Cornell to a 2-1 victory over its Central New York rival Syracuse on a picturesque Sunday afternoon on Berman Field.
- ▶ Joining Allen in the scoring column was senior forward **LAKEN GALLMAN**, who opened the scoring with a 22nd-minute tally. Junior goalkeeper Natalie Medugno also factored in the decision for Cornell, making a season-high five saves.

STARTING STRONG

- ▶ Cornell has an unbeaten record through its first three matches for a second consecutive season and 12th overall time in the program's 42 seasons of competition. The other instances in which Cornell did not lose any of its first three matches came in 1986, 1990, 1991, 1992, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2014, 2015, 2019,
- ▶ With a win or tie against Boston College on Thursday, it would mark the 10th time Cornell has not lost any of its first four matches in a season (1986, 1990, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, 2015, 2019, 2023).
- ▶ If the Big Red win or tie against Boston College and Lehigh, it would be the eighth time in program history that Cornell went unbeaten over its first five matches of a season (1986, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, 2015, 2023).

NON-LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- ▶ Cornell is riding a program-record 14-match unbeaten streak against non-conference opponents, dating back to the 2022 season. During the streak, Cornell has a 6-0-8 record (.714) against non-lvy League competitors.
- ▶ With its win over Syracuse last Sunday on Berman Field, the Big Red broke its tie for the longest unbeaten streak in nonconference contests in program history, besting 13-match streaks set across 2001-03 (8-0-5) and 2014-16 (10-0-3).
- ▶ Cornell's last setback in non-league play came against

Syracuse, 3-0, on Sept. 11, 2022, at SU Soccer Stadium in Syracuse. The previous instance in which Cornell dropped a non-conference match at Berman Field came against Marist, 2-1, on Aug. 28, 2022.

KNACK FOR THE NET

- ▶ Cornell has scored at least one goal in 36 of its 50 matches played under ROB FERGUSON, dating back to the 2021 campaign.
- ▶ The 72.0 percent of contests with a goal ranks as the highest clip in Cornell program history, surpassing **RANDY MAY**, the first head coach in program history, who saw his teams score in 67.7 percent of the 282 matches he coached during his 18-year tenure at the helm of the Big Red (191 games with a goal).
- ▶ As of late, the Big Red has displayed its scoring prowess by scoring at least one goal in each of its last nine contests, 19 of its previous 20 matches, and 22 of its latest 25 fixtures, dating back to 2022.
- ▶ With a goal against Boston College on Thursday, Cornell will have scored in 10 consecutive matches for the fifth time in program history. A 10-match goal streak would be tied for the second-longest in program history and be the first instance since scoring in 10 consecutive matches across the 2022 and 2023 seasons (Oct. 29, 2022 to Sept. 27, 2023).
- ▶ Entering Thursday's match with Boston College, Cornell has scored in 12 consecutive home contests, tied for the longest stretch of home fixtures with a goal

scored. Cornell's previous record was initially set between the 2013 and 2014 seasons from Sept. 13, 2013, and Oct. 3, 2014, where Cornell scored 32 goals in 12 consecutive home matches.

▶ The Big Red's current 12-match streak of home games with a goal is the third instance in which Cornell has scored a goal in 10-plus consecutive home fixtures, also joined by a 10-match span between the 1985-87 seasons (Oct. 16, 1985 to Sept. 30, 1987).

EMPIRE STATE OF MIND

- ▶ Six of Cornell's first seven matches will feature the Big Red playing a contest within the Empire State, with the lone exception being this Sunday's contest against Lehigh in Bethlehem, Pa.
- ▶ Dating back to Sept. 4, 2022, the Big Red has a 9-4-11 record (.604) in matches played within New York State.
- ▶ Across its last 18 matches within New York, Cornell is unbeaten in 16 contests, posting an 8-2-8 record (.667). The lone setbacks came last season in Ivy League matchups on Berman Field against Harvard (3-1 — Oct. 7) and Brown (2-1 — Oct. 21).

Sept. 5, 2010: MEGAN CROWELL and **MARY KEROACK** each scored two goals as Cornell posted a 7-0 victory over Delaware State. **RACHEL NICHOLS** added a pair of assists and **XANDRA HOMPE** had a goal and an assist. **KELLY MURPHY** and **TORI CHRIST** combined for the clean sheet for the Big Red.

NOT MISSING HER SHOT

- ▶ Senior forward **AVA LADEN** has attempted seven shots through the Big Red's first three matches with six being on target. Laden's .857 shot accuracy ranks as the fifth-best average in Division I soccer entering Tuesday's matches.
- ▶ Only Howard's Mimi Richards (12-of-13 .923), Radford's Lilly Short (10-of-11 .909), Mount St. Mary's Sydoney Clarke (8-of-9 .889), Duquesne's Mackenzie Muir (8-of-9 .889), and Alabama State's Rachel Mull (7-of-8 .875) have higher averages than Laden.

LEADERSHIP GROUP

- ▶ For the third consecutive season, Cornell will deploy a multi-person leadership team, featuring a trio of captains and a leadership council consisting of two juniors and two sophomores.
- ► Earning spots as captains on this year's team include seniors AVA LADEN, MADDIE LEROY, and CECILY POKIGO. Members of the leadership council include juniors ABIGAIL BISHARA and IZZY SCOTT, and sophomores KAYLA RISTIANTO and ISABEL CHAPMAN.

GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE

- ► Cornell women's soccer does not generally recruit a specific area of the nation, which is exemplified with the makeup of this year's roster.
- ▶ A total of 17 states are represented this season, spanning all four contiguous U.S. time zones. New York leads the way with six players while California is right behind with five. Texas ranks third with three student-athletes.
- ► Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, Maryland, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania all have two representatives, while Colorado, Massachusetts, Michigan, North Carolina, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, and Washington are represented once.

RISTIANTO REPRESENTS INDONESIA

- ► This past summer, rising sophomore defender **KAYLA RISTIANTO** suited up for the Indonesian Women's National Team in a pair of friendlies in Hong Kong.
- ▶ The pair of contests between the Asian-based countries were held on July 11 and July 14 at the Hong Kong Football Club Ground, with Hong Kong taking both contests by 3-2 and 4-1 scores, respectively.
- ▶ "Very proud of Kayla for earning this opportunity to learn and grow, and incredibly excited for her to continue to shine on this next stage with the Indonesia National Team," said Cornell women's soccer head coach ROB FERGUSON.

EUROPEAN TRIP REWIND

- ▶ Upon the conclusion of classes last spring, Cornell took a trip to Europe, where the Big Red participated in three exhibition contests.
- ▶ A roster of 30 players and four staff left the United States on May 27, playing a trio of exhibitions against Spanish-based clubs.
- ▶ The Big Red claimed a 4-1 victory against its first opponent, Girona FC, which competes in the Preferente Catalana, the fifth tier of Spanish soccer. Cornell's middle match of the trip saw the Big Red play Levante Las Planas of Liga F, the top division of Spanish football, before wrapping its trio of contests was a 6-2 victory against Fontsanta Fatjó.

IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ Cornell was picked to finish eighth in this year's Ivy League women's soccer preseason poll, the conference office announced on Aug. 19.
- ▶ Harvard, which won the inaugural Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament title last November, was tabbed the preseason favorite after garnering 10 of 16 first-place votes. The Crimson concluded with a point total of 120, 12 points ahead of Brown (108), which received four first-place votes. Right behind Brown was Princeton with its 103 points and the other two first-place votes.
- ▶ Rounding out the eight-team poll ahead of Cornell's 22 points was Columbia (77 points) in fourth, Dartmouth (57 points) in fifth, Yale (48 points) in sixth, and Penn (41 points) in seventh.

Cornell is 2-4-0 all-time on Sept. 8



Sept. 8, 2019: KAILI GREGORY's goal in the 74th minute, and a two-save clean sheet by MIRANDA IANNONE, aided Cornell to a 1-0 victory over St. Bonaventure. The win was Cornell's third consecutive clean sheet and fourth straight triumph to open the season, which marked its best start to a season since 2005.

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- ▶ Boston College enters Thursday's match with an overall record of 5-1-0 after UMass halted its season-opening five-match win streak on Sunday.
- ▶ The Eagles have scored in all six of their matches so far, highlighted by a 6-0 victory over LIU (Aug. 25) and a 5-1 triumph over Merrimack (Aug. 18).
- Sydney Segalla paces the Eagles' offense with her nine points (four goals, one assist). Aislin Streicek is behind Segalla with seven points (three goals, one assist). Paige Peltier is the only Boston College player with multiple goals scored on the season, potting markers against Merrimack and Gardner-Webb (Aug. 22).
- ▶ Wiebke Willebrandt has started all six matches in goal for Boston College, playing 530:20 minutes of action and posting a 0.68 goals-against average and .692 save percentage.
- ▶ As of Monday, Boston College owned the ninth-highest corner kicks per match average (8.83), 16th-highest shots on goal per match (9.67), and its plus-12 goal differential ranked as the 17th-best in Division I soccer.

BOSTON COLLEGE'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ NEWTON, Mass. (SEPT. 1, 2024) A pair of second-half goals scored by UMass handed Boston College its first loss of the season on Sunday at the Newton Campus Lacrosse and Soccer Field.
- ▶ Bella Recinos (48th minute) and Nia Haslop (81st minute) tallied the markers for the Minutewomen before Sophia Lowenberg trimmed UMass' lead in half with an 85th-minute marker.
- ▶ Wiebke Willebrandt made one save in goal for Boston College, while UMass' Bella Mendoza stopped four shots in the victory.
- ▶ Boston College owned an 11-7 advantage in shot attempts and a 5-3 edge in shots on goal. The Eagles also won the corner kicks battle, 9-7.

LAST TIME AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- ► CAMBRIDGE, Mass. (OCT. 2, 1994) JEN TIDSBURY and LORI PENNY tallied goals for Cornell, while AMY FINKELSTEIN assisted on Big Red both markers in its 2-2 double-overtime draw with Boston College at the Harvard Invitational.
- ▶ Dierdre Burns scored both of Boston College's goals, which came two minutes apart of each other in the second half. Allison David assisted on the first marker and April Parker aided in the latter tally.
- ► Cornell goalkeeper SUE DELONG made 15 saves in the draw while her counterpart, Boston College's Karen Devoe, logged 11 saves.

35 YEARS, 325 MILES, 6 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell and Boston College will meet on Thursday for the seventh time in program history. It will be the first time the two programs face each other in 10,931 days (Oct. 2, 1994).
- ▶ After registering 1-0 victories in the first two contests, Boston College has gone unbeaten over its last four contests with Cornell (2-0-2).
- ▶ A victory over Boston College would be Cornell's first since logging a 1-0 overtime victory on Oct. 8, 1989, at adjacent Robison Alumni Field. JENNIFER SMITH potted the game-winning marker for Cornell 11:48 into overtime, aiding MELISSA GAMBRELL to log a 10-save clean sheet.
- ▶ Five of the six contests between the two programs have been decided by one goal or less.

- ▶ Maggie Ousouljoglou has played all 360 minutes for Lehigh so far, posting a 2.50 goals-against average and .655 save percentage over her four outings in goal.

LEHIGH'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ PHILADELPHIA (SEPT. 1, 2024) Despite Lehigh staking a 4-0 lead in the opening 40-plus minutes, Drexel responded with four unanswered goals to force a draw between the two Pennsylvania-based schools at Vidas Field.
- First-year student Esther Brossard opened the scoring for the Mountain Hawks just 45 seconds into the contest before Sophia Lis (32nd minute), Dakota Russell (40th minute), and Cyndea Labissiere (41st minute) also found the back of the net for Lehigh.
- ▶ Drexel responded quickly to Labissiere's goal, scoring 20 seconds later to make it a 4-1 contest. A trio of second-half goals led to the draw between the teams.
- ▶ Maggie Ousouljoglou made three saves in goal for Lehigh and Sammy Widnick stopped six shots for Drexel.

LAST TIME AGAINST LEHIGH

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (AUG. 27, 2023) LAKEN GALLMAN recorded her first collegiate multi-assist game, assisting on ABIGAIL BISHARA and MADDIE LEROY's second-half tallies to aid Cornell to a 2-2 draw over Lehigh in its season-opening match.
- ▶ The goals by Bishara and Leroy were the first in both players' collegiate careers.
- ► Goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO made one save in her second collegiate start for the Big Red.
- Lehigh's Faith Dobosiewicz and Aminah Baruwa were the goal scorers for the Mountain Hawks, who had a four-save performance by Maggie Ousouljoglou. Ava Schaller assisted on both goals.

- ▶ Cornell and Lehigh will meet on Sunday for the fourth time in program history. Lehigh owns the all-time series lead, 2-0-1.
- ▶ The last time the two programs met in Bethlehem, Pa., Lehigh registered a 4-1 victory on Sept. 11, 2009, also held at the Ulrich Sports Complex.
- ► SIDRA BONNER scored the lone marker of the contest for the Big Red, while Lehigh had four different goal scorers in the victory. Liz Carlos tallied the Mountain Hawks' lone pair of assists in the match. KELLY MURPHY made six saves in the setback for Cornell.

ROB FERGUSON

FIFTH YEAR (FOURTH SEASON) AS HEAD COACH

Years at Cornell: Sixth Year College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his fifth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

Ferguson's most recent campaign in 2023 saw Cornell register an overall record of 4-5-6 and an 0-5-2 mark in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its most offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. REAGAN PAUWELS was named a Second Team All-lvy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

During the 2022 season, Cornell had a 4-7-5 overall record and a 2-3-2 ledger in Ivy League play. Both of Cornell's conference victories — the most by the Big Red since 2016 — came in the program's final two matches of the season against Princeton and Dartmouth. The victory over Princeton was Cornell's first since 1995, snapping a 25-match losing streak to the Tigers.

The consecutive victories over Princeton and Dartmouth marked the first time Cornell had registered back-to-back wins in Ivy League contests since the final conference fixture in 2014 and the first league bout in 2015.

Cornell had a 3-1-3 record on its home turf at Berman Field in 2022, featuring the Big Red going unbeaten across its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo earning Second Team All-Ivy honors.

Ferguson's first year as Cornell's head coach did not see the Big Red play in any contests with the cancelation of all matches due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In his second year at the helm, Ferguson's first year of competition as head coach saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-11-2 and a 1-6-0 lvy League mark. The lone league victory was the Big Red's first over an Ancient Eight opponent since defeating Columbia in 2016.

In his first overall season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season — including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection ASHLEY DURIK.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
