### FIRST TOUCH

- ▶ The Cornell women's soccer team (4-5-4, 1-3-0 lvy) concludes its three-match road trip this afternoon when it travels to Philadelphia to take on Penn (4-3-5, 0-2-2 lvy) at Rhodes Field.
- ▶ Cornell is wrapping up the 2025 regular-season slate with a road-heavy schedule, as the Big Red will play four of its final five matches, and five of its last seven, away from Berman Field.

# LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ PRINCETON, N.J. (OCT. 11, 2025) Alexandra Barry scored in the ninth minute to put Princeton ahead, and the Tigers never looked back in a 2-0 victory over Cornell Saturday afternoon at Myslik Field at Roberts Stadium.
- ▶ Drew Coomans finished her three-point day with an insurance goal in the 88th minute for Princeton, which snapped a two-match conference losing streak. Sydney Romano and Cecilia Cerone combined for the clean sheet, with Romano making two first-half saves to earn the victory in her first career start.
- ▶ Senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO also made two first-half saves for the Big Red. Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER and senior defender GABY GONZALEZ recorded Cornell's shots on goal.
- ▶ Barry opened the scoring after Medugno punched away a cross to the left side, where Ally Murphy corralled the ball and set up Barry for a left-footed one-touch.
- ▶ Cornell had two dangerous set pieces near the midpoint of the second half. The Big Red earned a free kick on the edge of the penalty area in the 72nd minute after senior midfielder TANUM NELSON was fouled 20 yards from goal. Sophomore defender ELLA KOSCHINEG's attempt sailed over the crossbar.
- ▶ Three minutes later, junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN was fouled on a near-breakaway by Julia Johnson, who received a yellow card. Kessinger's free kick narrowly missed over the crossbar.
- ▶ With less than three minutes remaining, Coomans stole the ball from a Cornell player after the Big Red gained possession following a Princeton corner kick. Her 35-yard shot caromed off the crossbar and into the goal.

# **EVERYONE GETS A GOAL!**

- ▶ Powered by its four different goal scorers in last Tuesday's victory at Lafayette, Cornell enters this afternoon's match having 10 different goal scorers and 13 players with at least one point.
- ▶ The 10 goal scorers stand as the program's most since 2023, when 11 players found the back of the net, which matched the program record that was initially set in 1991. It is the ninth instance in program history the Big Red has had at least 10 different players score a goal in a season, also done in 1984, 1987, 1994, 1999, 2010 and 2012 — which all had 10 different goal scorers.
- ▶ Cornell's 13 different players with at least one point is tied for the sixth-highest total in program history and is the most since 2023, when 15 different players had at least one point.

- Cornell concludes its three-match road trip this afternoon when it travels to Philadelphia to face Penn at Rhodes Field.
- Penn is unbeaten in the last nine meetings (6-0-3) and in 26 of the last 27 (22-1-4), dating back to 1997, after Cornell had won each of the first six contests.
- The Quakers are unbeaten in their last 14 home matches against Cornell (12-0-2), as the Big Red is seeking its first road victory over Penn since Sept. 16, 1995, when CAARKI SWEITZER and HEATHER OTT avenged an early second-half goal by Penn to lead the Big Red to a 2-1 victory.
- After opening the season on a six-match unbeaten streak (4-0-2), Penn is winless in its last six matches (0-3-3).
- ▶ Penn has committed the 13th-fewest fouls per match this season, averaging 6.08 fouls per contest, ranking second in the Ivy League, only behind Columbia (6.00 — T-11th).
- ▶ Junior forward Abbey Cook leads the team in goals (three) and points (six). In net, Annabel Austen has started all eight of her appearances, posting a 2-2-3 record, 1.12 goals-against average and .771 save percentage.

- ▶ Entering next Saturday's match on Berman Field, Brown owns a commanding 31-7-4 lead in the all-time series over Cornell. The Bears have won each of the last 13 meetings and are unbeaten in the last 15 (14-0-1).
- ▶ The Big Red will be vying for its first home victory over the Bears since Oct. 31, 1998, and its first overall win over Brown since Oct. 26, 2008.
- ▶ Through Wednesday's matches, Brown is one of 18 Division I women's soccer programs to rank in the top 50 in both scoring offense (2.23) and scoring defense (0.77).
- ▶ Joy Okonye (6-5—17) is tied with Naya Cardoza (6-0—12) for the team lead in goals (six) and is one of three players with at least 10 points, accompanied by Ayla Sahin (5-1—11). Brooke Birtwistle (0-4—4) has a team-high four assists, while Ella Weil (2-3-7) is right behind three three helpers.
- ▶ Bella Schopp (5-2-3, 0.99, .655) has started 11 of her 12 appearances on the season and has registered factored in six of the Bears' seven clean sheets on the season (two solo, four shared). Gurleen Toor (3-0-0, 0.00, 1.000) is the only other keeper to have started matches this season (two of four).

- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER delivered her team-leading third assist of the season against Columbia on Sept. 20, whipping an in-swinging corner kick into the heart of the penalty area where senior defender GABY GONZALEZ connected with a perfectly timed header, opening the scoring in the 12th minute.
- Entering this weekend's action, Kessinger is in a sevenway tie for fifth in assists in the Ivy League alongside Princeton's Dylan Jovanovic, Dartmouth's Stephanie Lathrop and Mary Lundregan, Harvard's Susie Long, Brown's Ella Weil, and Dartmouth's Nadia Young. Brown's Joy Okonye (five), Princeton's Brooke Birtwistle, Harvard's Elsa Santos López, and Columbia's Maia Tabion (four each) have more helpers.
- ▶ One more assist would make Kessinger the ninth Cornell player since 2003 to register four assists in a season, marking the 11th such occurrence during

The most recent Cornell player to achieve the milestone was REAGAN PAUWELS, who recorded six assists in 2023, matching totals by DONNA EBERHARDT (1988), AMY SNOW (1991 and 1992), REBECCA D'ALEO (1993), LORI PENNY (1993), and DEMPSEY BANKS (2013). The Cornell singleseason assists record remains in a four-way tie between LAURIE COLLIER (1986), JENNIFER SMITH (1987), JENNIFER DALY (1994), and AMY FINKELSTEIN (1994).

- ▶ Cornell's four draws are tied with 57 other Division I programs for the 67th-highest total through Wednesday's matches.
- ▶ The Big Red's draw total tied with Dartmouth (6-2-4) for second in the Ivy League while trailing Penn (4-3-5) matches the outputs from the 2002 (8-5-4), 2015 (9-4-4), and 2024 (3-9-4) squads for third in program history. Its next tie would match the 2022 team (4-7-5) for second, while the 4-5-6 mark posted during the 2023 campaign remains the single-season record.
- ► Cornell's 4-5-4 record makes the Big Red one of 44

Division I programs to have at least four wins, losses, and ties. Four of the programs (Boston College, Colgate, Kent State, and Syracuse) are opponents the Big Red has already played.

### FRESHMAN IN FOCUS

- ▶ After starting the season opener at Boston College (Aug. 22), freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY became just the eighth freshman goalkeeper in program history to start a season opener, joining LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI PALMER (2007), NICOLE SHULMAN (2019), and ERICA FOX (2021).
- Qureshey's clean sheet over the Eagles made her the fifth Big Red freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, joining Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).

# ▶ With her clean sheet over Binghamton on Sept. 14, she became the fifth Cornell rookie to register at least three solo shutouts in a season, becoming the first to do so since Alexander (six) in 1992 while joining Brigham (three in 1982), Thompson (nine in 1983), and SHERRIE CHOCOLA (five in 1984).

Goals

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN has built a reputation as one of Cornell's most reliable clutch performers. She delivered again in the Big Red's home-opening win over Colgate on Aug. 24, netting her fourth career goal and game-winning goal.
- ▶ Another decisive strike would cement Allen into Cornell's record book, creating a five-way tie for 10th on the program's all-time list for game-winners alongside DINA GROSSMAN (1988-91), AMY **DUESING** (1991–94), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1991–94), and **EMILY KNIGHT** (2000–03). At the top stands LAURIE COLLIER (1984–87), who owns the program standard with 11.
- ▶ The finishing touch provided by Allen has fueled a broader offensive trend under head coach ROB **FERGUSON**. Since being named head coach, the Big Red has scored in 51 of the 76 matches (67.1 percent) coached by Ferguson, the second-highest rate in program history, trailing RANDY MAY's 67.7 percent mark set between 1982-99. Ferguson is one of four Cornell coaches to see their teams score in at least 60 percent of matches played a group featuring May, BERHANE ANDERBERHAN (66.0 percent, 2000–05), and **PATRICK FARMER** (62.2 percent, 2012-16).

### **GETTING THE CAPTAIN'S BAND**

- ▶ Leadership for the 2025 season will be guided by a three-player captaincy, with senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON joined by senior defender GABY GONZALEZ.
- ▶ Bishara enters her third year in a leadership role, having served on the team's leadership council the past two seasons. Nelson and Gonzalez assume leadership responsibilities for the first time this season.

#### IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ When the Ivy League preseason poll was released on Aug. 18, Cornell found itself projected to finish eighth in the eight-team conference. Reigning Ivy League Tournament champion Princeton claimed the top spot with nine of 16 first-place votes, while Brown followed closely with six first-place votes and Harvard captured the remaining first-place vote. Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn all finished ahead of the Big Red in the preseason rankings.
- ▶ The stakes are clear for the Big Red's pursuit of reaching the Ivy League Tournament for the first time in program history, as the top four teams from the regular season will advance to the 2025 Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be hosted by the No. 1

overall seed. Semifinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 6, with the championship match taking place on Sunday, Nov. 9.

# BLEEDING CARNELIAN RED

- Family ties run deep within the Cornell women's soccer program, where this year's roster features an impressive group of Big Red student-athletes, carrying legacies that span football fields, soccer pitches, and classrooms across campus.
- ▶ Senior forward **SYDNEY MALAGA** is one of those players, following in the footsteps of her father, SCOTT MALAGA, a Cornell Athletics Hall of Famer inducted in 1999. Scott concluded his standout career with the Big Red amassing 1,925 rushing yards, which still ranks ninth in program history. Sydney's twin brother, LUKE, also represented the Big Red on the gridiron from 2021-24.
- ▶ On the back line, senior defender GABY GONZALEZ continues her family's strong Cornell tradition. A third-generation student, she follows her parents, JACK and JODI (both Class of 1991). Jack, played for the men's soccer team from 1988-90, while Gaby's older sister, MIA, was a four-year member of the women's soccer team (2020-24) before completing her collegiate career at Vanderbilt last year. Gaby also had a pair of uncles who graduated from Cornell.
- ▶ Fellow senior forward GRACE DIEHL also represents a multi-generational Cornell Athletics legacy. Her father, JEFF (1991-92), and late grandfather, THOMAS (1967-68), each played football for the Big Red, with Thomas later serving as a faculty member in the Nolan School of Hotel Administration. Senior forward MARAN KINGSLEY is another third-generation Cornell student; her mother, Peggy, earned an MBA at Cornell, and her grandfather was an undergraduate student in the College of Engineering.
- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER is following the path of both parents, who attended Cornell, while sophomore defender JANE OFFIT is a third-generation Cornellian whose mother, Amanda, and grandfather also studied on East Hill. Freshman midfielder CHLOE BENIK joins the Big Red as the second member of her family to attend Cornell, alongside one of her cousins.

# SCOUTING PENN

- ▶ Penn (4-3-5, 0-2-2 lvy) is winless over its last six matches (0-3-3) after beginning the season on a six-match unbeaten streak (4-0-2).
- ▶ The Quakers have committed the 13th-fewest fouls per match this season, averaging 6.08 fouls per contest, ranking second in the Ivy League, only behind Columbia (6.00 — T-11th).
- ▶ Junior forward Abbey Cook leads the team in goals (four) and points (nine). Magali Capdevila, Kylie Emanuel, Taylor Ferraro, and Mallory Lucas are all tied for the team lead in assists (two each).
- ▶ In net, Annabel Austen has started all nine of her appearances on the season, posting a 2-2-4 record, 1.23 goals-against average and .778 save percentage.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST PENN

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (NOV. 2, 2024) Janae Stewart's 79th-minute goal proved to the be the difference as visiting Penn secured a 1-0 clean sheet victory over Cornell at Berman Field.
- ▶ Stewart one-touched a left-side cross from Mila Maltby into the net off her right boot to break a scoreless tie and lift the Quakers to the victory.
- ▶ Annabel Austen was stellar in goal for Penn, registering seven saves en route to her fourth clean sheet of the season. The visiting goalkeeper faced a season-high 22 shot attempts from the Big Red, stopping all seven that reached her.
- ▶ Cornell dominated the opening 45 minutes, out-shooting Penn 8-0 before the match opened up in the second half. The Big Red ultimately doubled up the Quakers in shot attempts, 14-7, though Penn held a slight edge in shots on goal, 4-3.
- ▶ Senior forward LAKEN GALLMAN led Cornell with three shots on goal, while senior forward MADDIE LEROY, junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON, and sophomore forward ALANNA COLBERT each added one shot on goal.
- ► Cornell threatened late when senior midfielder PEYTON NICHOLS had a shot blocked in the 86th minute, with Nelson's follow-up attempt going wide of goal.
- ▶ ERICA FOX made three second-half saves in the setback for the Big Red.

# PENN'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ NEW YORK (OCT. 12, 2025) Penn could not hold onto its first-half advantage, falling short of a victory as Columbia rallied to secure a 2-2 tie at Rocco B. Commisso Soccer Stadium.
- ▶ The Quakers came out strong, building a 2-0 lead by halftime behind goals by Abbey Cook and Magali Capdevila. Cook's 26th-minute opening goal came off assists from Kylie Emanuel and Eden Veenema, while Capdevila added to the margin nine minutes later on a Cook assist.
- ▶ Penn's defensive efforts faltered in the second half as Columbia mounted its comeback. Annie Faraone scored twice to knot the match, first unassisted in the 70th minute and again in the 81st minute with an assist from Maia Tabion.
- ▶ Annabel Austen made eight saves for the Quakers, keeping Penn in position to earn its first Ivy League victory of the season before Faraone's late-match heroics.

# 33 YEARS, 230 MILES, 33 MEETINGS

- ▶ Penn enters this afternoon's match with a 22-7-4 series lead and is unbeaten in the last nine meetings (6-0-3) and 26 of the last 27 (22-1-4), dating back to 1997, after Cornell posted victories in the first six contests.
- ▶ The Quakers are unbeaten in their last 14 home matches against Cornell (12-0-2), as the Big Red is seeking its first road victory over Penn since Sept. 16, 1995, when CAARKI SWEITZER and HEATHER **OTT** avenged an early second-half goal by Penn to lead the Big Red to a 2-1 victory.

# ROB FERGUSON

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 Ivy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive Ivy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
