#### FIRST TOUCH

▶ The Cornell women's soccer team (5-5-4, 2-3-0 lvy League) returns to Berman Field this afternoon for Senior Day, hosting Brown (8-2-4, 2-1-2 lvy League) in a critical lvy League matchup. Sitting two points out of a tournament spot with two conference games remaining, Cornell is looking to snap its 13-match losing streak against the Bears in order to keep its postseason hopes alive.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ PHILADELPHIA (OCT. 18, 2025) Overcoming a halftime deficit, Cornell junior forwards SYDNEY **ALLEN** and **BROOKE BROWN** each scored in the second half to lift the Big Red to a 2-1 victory over Penn.
- ▶ Penn struck first in the 17th minute when Abbey Cook found the back of the net. Cornell responded after the break, ramping up its attack until Allen drew the match even in the 54th minute with an 18-yard strike from the right corner of the penalty area. Brown was credited with an assist on the goal.
- ▶ Ten minutes later, Brown buried the go-ahead goal, capitalizing on a rebound after freshman defender RAYA LEIKIN's shot off a service from junior forward Alanna Colbert struck the right post. Brown's threepoint performance earned her Ivy League Co-Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- ▶ Cornell controlled play throughout the second half, outshooting the Quakers 12-2 after the break and 21-8 overall. Senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO made four saves to match her season high.

## MILESTONE SEASON

- ▶ Cornell's five wins this season mark the program's highest total since 2016. One more victory would give the Big Red its most wins in a season since 2015 (9-4-4), while another Ivy League win would mark Cornell's first three-win conference season since 1995 (5-0-2), when the Big Red went unbeaten in Ivy
- ▶ With three road victories already this season, Cornell has matched its road win total from 2016 (3-4-2). Prior to this year, the Big Red had just five road wins combined over the previous seven seasons. A win at Dartmouth next Saturday would give Cornell four road victories for the first time since 2015 (5-2-2).
- ▶ A victory this afternoon would guarantee Cornell finishes the 2025 season with at least a .500 record for the first time since 2015 (9-4-4).

#### EVERYONE GETS A GOAL!

- ▶ Powered by its four different goal scorers in its 4-0 victory at Lafayette on Oct. 7, Cornell enters this afternoon's match having 10 different goal scorers and 13 players with at least one point.
- ▶ The 10 goal scorers stand as the program's most since 2023, when 11 players found the back of the net, which matched the program record that was initially set in 1991. It is the ninth instance in program history the Big Red has had at least 10 different players score a goal in a season, also done in 1984, 1987, 1994, 1999, 2010 and 2012 — which all had 10 different goal scorers.
- Cornell's 13 different players with at least one point is tied for the sixth-highest total in program history and is the most since 2023, when 15 different players had at least one point.

#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

- ▶ Entering this afternoon's match, Brown holds a commanding 31-7-4 all-time series lead over Cornell, which includes the Bears winning each of the last 13 meetings and are being unbeaten in the last 15 contests (14-0-1).
- Cornell is vying for its first home victory over the Bears since Oct. 31, 1998, and its first overall triumph against Brown since Oct. 26, 2008.
- ► Through Tuesday's matches, Brown is one of 22 Division I women's soccer programs to average at least two goals scored per match while conceding under one goal per contest.
- ▶ Joy Okonye (6-5—17) paces Brown's explosive offensive in both assists and points, while being one goal shy of matching Naya Cardoza (7-0-14) for the team lead. Ayla Sahin (5-1-11) is the only other Brown player to have registered at least 10 points on the season.
- In goal, Bella Schopp (5-2-4, 1.09, .647) has started 12 of her 13 appearances and has registered factored in six of the Bears' seven clean sheets on the season (two solo, four shared). Gurleen Toor (3-0-0, 0.00, 1.000) is the only other keeper to have started matches this season (two of four).

#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

- Cornell concludes its regular-season slate next Saturday, Nov. 1, when it travels to Hanover, N.H., to face Dartmouth (7-3-4, 2-1-2 lvy League). Kickoff is scheduled for 5 p.m.
- Following last year's 1-0 victory at Berman Field, Cornell is looking to post consecutive wins over Dartmouth for the first time since 1995, when the Big Red won 3-1 in the regular season (Oct. 22) before recording a 3-0 triumph in the ECAC Tournament quarterfinals nearly three full weeks later (Nov. 11). Cornell's last time defeating Dartmouth in consecutive seasons dates back to a four-year win streak from 1984-87.
- Dartmouth has won the last 16 meetings in Hanover and is unbeaten in its previous 18 there against Cornell (16-0-2). The Big Red's lone road win over Dartmouth came in 1986 (3-0).
- The series has been tightly contested of late, with the last four meetings, six of the previous seven, and eight of the prior 10 having been decided by one goal or fewer.
- ► Stephanie Lathrop (7-4—18) paces the team in all three major scoring categories, serving as the lone Big Green player with a double-digit point total. Lathrop is also tied with Brown's Naya Cardoza for the Ivy League lead in goals.

#### **KESSINGER CLIMBING ASSIST CHART**

- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER leads Cornell with three assists this season, most recently delivering an in-swinging corner kick against Columbia on Sept. 20 that senior defender GABY GONZALEZ headed home from the heart of the penalty area.
- ▶ Kessinger enters the weekend tied for ninth in the Ivy League in assists alongside Penn's Kylie Emanuel, Dartmouth's Mary Lundregan and Nadia Young, and Brown's Ella Weil. She trails Brown's Joy Okonye and Columbia's Maia Tabion (five each), and a group of six players with four assists: Brown's Brooke Birtwistle, Dartmouth's Stephanie Lathrop, Princeton's Drew Coomans and Dylan Jovanovic, and Harvard's Susie Long and Elsa Santos López.
- ▶ One more assist would make Kessinger the ninth Cornell player since 2003 to record four assists in a season, marking the 11th such occurrence in that span. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was the most recent Big Red player to reach the milestone, recording six assists in 2023 to

match totals by DONNA EBERHARDT (1988), AMY SNOW (1991 and 1992), REBECCA D'ALEO (1993), LORI PENNY (1993), and DEMPSEY BANKS (2013).

#### KNOT AGAIN...

- ▶ Cornell's four ties this season match the program's third-highest single-season total, equaling the outputs from the 2002 (8-5-4), 2015 (9-4-4), and 2024 (3-9-4) squads. The Big Red are tied with Brown (8-2-4) and Dartmouth (6-2-4) for the second-most draws in the Ivy League this season, trailing only Penn (4-4-5).
- ▶ Another tie would move Cornell into second place on the program's all-time single-season list, matching the 2022 team (4-7-5). The 2023 squad (4-5-6) holds the
- single-season record with six draws. ▶ With one more tie. Cornell would become at least the

17th Division I program this season to record five or more wins, losses, and draws. Currently, the Big Red are one of 41 Division I programs with at least five wins, five losses, and four ties — including three of Cornell's non-conference opponents from this year: Boston College, Kent State, and Syracuse.

#### FRESHMAN IN FOCUS

- ▶ After starting the season opener at Boston College (Aug. 22), freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY became just the eighth freshman goalkeeper in program history to start a season opener, joining LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI PALMER (2007), NICOLE SHULMAN (2019), and ERICA FOX (2021).
- Qureshey's clean sheet over the Eagles made her the fifth Big Red freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, joining Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).

#### ▶ With her clean sheet over Binghamton on Sept. 14, she became the fifth Cornell rookie to register at least three solo shutouts in a season, becoming the first to do so since Alexander (six) in 1992 while joining Brigham (three in 1982), Thompson (nine in 1983), and SHERRIE CHOCOLA (five in 1984).

#### THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN has built a reputation as one of Cornell's most reliable clutch performers. She delivered again in the Big Red's home-opening win over Colgate on Aug. 24, netting her fourth career goal and game-winning goal.
- ▶ Another decisive strike would cement Allen into Cornell's record book, creating a five-way tie for 10th on the program's all-time list for game-winners alongside DINA GROSSMAN (1988-91), AMY **DUESING** (1991–94), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1991–94), and **EMILY KNIGHT** (2000–03). At the top stands LAURIE COLLIER (1984–87), who owns the program standard with 11.
- ▶ The finishing touch provided by Allen has fueled a broader offensive trend under head coach ROB FERGUSON. Since being named head coach, the Big Red has scored in 52 of the 77 matches (67.5 percent) coached by Ferguson, the second-highest rate in program history, trailing RANDY MAY's 67.7 percent mark set between 1982-99. Ferguson is one of four Cornell coaches to see their teams score in at least 60 percent of matches played — a group featuring May, BERHANE ANDERBERHAN (66.0 percent, 2000-05), and PATRICK FARMER (62.2 percent, 2012–16).

#### **GETTING THE CAPTAIN'S BAND**

- ▶ Leadership for the 2025 season will be guided by a three-player captaincy, with senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON joined by senior defender GABY GONZALEZ.
- ▶ Bishara enters her third year in a leadership role, having served on the team's leadership council the past two seasons. Nelson and Gonzalez assume leadership responsibilities for the first time this season.

#### IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ When the Ivy League preseason poll was released on Aug. 18, Cornell found itself projected to finish eighth in the eight-team conference. Reigning Ivy League Tournament champion Princeton claimed the top spot with nine of 16 first-place votes, while Brown followed closely with six first-place votes and Harvard captured the remaining first-place vote. Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn all finished ahead of the Big Red in the preseason rankings.
- ▶ The stakes are clear for the Big Red's pursuit of reaching the Ivy League Tournament for the first time in program history, as the top four teams from the regular season will advance to the 2025 Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be hosted by the No. 1

overall seed. Semifinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 6, with the championship match taking place on Sunday, Nov. 9.

- Family ties run deep within the Cornell women's soccer program, where this year's roster features an impressive group of Big Red student-athletes, carrying legacies that span football fields, soccer pitches, and classrooms across campus.
- ▶ Senior forward **SYDNEY MALAGA** is one of those players, following in the footsteps of her father, SCOTT MALAGA, a Cornell Athletics Hall of Famer inducted in 1999. Scott concluded his standout career with the Big Red amassing 1,925 rushing yards, which still ranks ninth in program history. Sydney's twin brother, LUKE, also represented the Big Red on the gridiron from 2021-24.
- ▶ On the back line, senior defender GABY GONZALEZ continues her family's strong Cornell tradition. A third-generation student, she follows her parents, JACK and JODI (both Class of 1991). Jack, played for the men's soccer team from 1988-90, while Gaby's older sister, MIA, was a four-year member of the women's soccer team (2020-24) before completing her collegiate career at Vanderbilt last year. Gaby also had a pair of uncles who graduated from Cornell.
- ▶ Fellow senior forward GRACE DIEHL also represents a multi-generational Cornell Athletics legacy. Her father, JEFF (1991-92), and late grandfather, THOMAS (1967-68), each played football for the Big Red, with Thomas later serving as a faculty member in the Nolan School of Hotel Administration. Senior forward MARAN KINGSLEY is another third-generation Cornell student; her mother, Peggy, earned an MBA at Cornell, and her grandfather was an undergraduate student in the College of Engineering.
- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER is following the path of both parents, who attended Cornell, while sophomore defender JANE OFFIT is a third-generation Cornellian whose mother, Amanda, and grandfather also studied on East Hill. Freshman midfielder CHLOE BENIK joins the Big Red as the second member of her family to attend Cornell, alongside one of her cousins.

#### SCOUTING BROWN

- Brown enters this afternoon's match with an 8-2-4 overall record and 2-1-2 mark in Ivy League play, tied with Dartmouth for the coveted fourth spot in the Ancient Eight table. The Bears have dropped just one match in its last 10 outings (5-1-4) since losing a home contest against Minnesota, 2-0, on Sept. 1.
- ▶ Through Tuesday's matches, Brown is one of 22 Division I women's soccer programs (Colorado, Elon, Fairfield, Florida State, Georgetown, Georgia, Houston, Louisville, Memphis, Northern Kentucky, Northwestern State, Oral Roberts, Samford, South Alabama, South Dakota State, Stanford, Tennessee, Texas Tech, Vanderbilt, Virginia, and Xavier) that is averaging at least two goals scored per match (2.21) while conceding under one goal per contest (0.86).
- ▶ Joy Okonye (6-5—17) paces Brown's explosive offensive in both assists and points, while being one goal shy of matching Naya Cardoza (7-0—14) for the team lead. Ayla Sahin (5-1—11) is the only other Brown player to have registered at least 10 points on the season.
- ▶ In goal, Bella Schopp (5-2-4, 1.09, .647) has started 12 of her 13 appearances and has registered factored in six of the Bears' seven clean sheets on the season (two solo, four shared). Gurleen Toor (3-0-0, 0.00, 1.000) is the only other keeper to have started matches this season (two of four).

#### **LAST TIME AGAINST BROWN**

- ▶ PROVIDENCE, R.I. (OCT. 26, 2024) Naya Cardoza's goal in the 78th minute helped break open a scoreless tie to lead Brown to a 1-0 victory over Cornell at Stevenson-Pincince Field.
- Lexi Quinn assisted on Cardoza's tally to aid Bella Schopp in earning a four-save clean sheet, her fifth blanking on the season for the Bears.
- ▶ Senior goalkeeper ERICA FOX made five saves in the setback for the Big Red. Junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA recorded two shots on goal for the Big Red, while senior forward AVA LADEN and junior midfielder TANUM NELSON had the other two shots on goal.
- ▶ Brown owned a 17-6 advantage in shot attempts and a slight 6-4 edge in shots on target. Corner kicks favored the Bears, 7-5, which included a 6-0 total during second-half action.

#### BROWN'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ CAMBRIDGE, Mass. (OCT. 18, 2025) Brown and Harvard battled to a 2-2 draw at Jordan Field in Ivy League women's soccer action.
- Naya Cardoza opened the scoring for Brown in the 30th minute off an asssit from Audrey Lam, giving the Bears a 1-0 lead at halftime.
- ▶ Harvard responded quickly after the break when Anna Rayhill equalized in the 47th minute with assists from Susie Long and Ólöf Kristinsdóttir.
- Brown regained the lead in the 61st minute on Angelina Vargas' goal, assisted by Layla Shell. The Crimson answered back in the 73rd minute when Jasmine Leshnick found the net unassisted to level the match at 2-2.
- Brown controlled possession throughout, outshooting Harvard 17-7 and holding a 9-4 advantage in corner kicks. Harvard goalkeeper Rhiannon Stewart was busy in net, making seven saves compared to three for Brown's Bella Schopp.

#### 43 YEARS, 324 MILES, 42 MEETINGS

- ▶ Brown holds a commanding 31-7-4 all-time series lead over Cornell, which includes the Bears winning each of the last 13 meetings and are being unbeaten in the last 15 contests (14-0-1).
- ▶ Cornell is vying for its first home victory over the Bears since Oct. 31, 1998, and its first overall triumph against Brown since Oct. 26, 2008.

## ROB FERGUSON

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 Ivy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive Ivy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
