FIRST TOUCH

- ▶ The Cornell women's soccer team (3-3-4, 1-1-0 lvy) hosts Harvard (3-4-2, 1-1-0 lvy) at Berman Field on Saturday afternoon during Homecoming and Alumnae Weekend before embarking on a three-match road trip, starting at Lafayette (3-3-5, 1-0-2 Patriot) on Tuesday night.
- ► Cornell's three-match road trip marks the start of a road-heavy finish to the regular season for the Big Red, who will play four of its final five matches away from Ithaca.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ NEW HAVEN, Conn. (SEPT. 27, 2025) Junior forward ALANNA COLBERT scored just 58 seconds into the match to lead Cornell to a 1-0 victory over Yale at Reese Stadium last Saturday evening.
- ► Colbert's early goal supported senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO, who made four saves to earn a clean sheet in her season debut for the Big Red and earn Ivy League Defender of the Week honors on Monday afternoon (Sept. 29).
- ▶ The victory marked Cornell's first road win since defeating Marist, 2-0, on Aug. 30, 2023, and its first Ivy League road victory since a 1-0 decision at Yale on Oct. 17, 2015. Colbert opened the scoring in the first minute, finishing a through-ball from junior forward EMILY GIBBONS that split two defenders. Her right-footed shot sailed just over sliding goalkeeper Kyla Holmes, who had come out to narrow the angle.
- ▶ Yale applied consistent pressure in the second half, outshooting the Big Red, 9-1, and holding a 5-0 edge in corner kicks. Six of the Bulldogs' nine second-half shots came in the final 12-plus minutes, including attempts that forced Medugno to make saves in the 81st and 89th minutes. Senior defender GABY **GONZALEZ** also blocked a last-second shot by Phebe Ryan to preserve the clean sheet.
- ▶ Medugno's composure in those closing moments proved decisive and ultimately earned her recognition from the Ivy League.

CHASING HISTORY IN IVY PLAY

- ► Cornell enters Saturday's match having posted one loss or fewer through its first two Ivy League contests for the eighth time in the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2013.
- A victory over Harvard would give the Big Red two wins in its first three Ivy League matches for the first time since 1995, when Cornell opened conference play with a 2-0-1 record. It would mark just the 11th time in program history that Cornell has won at least two of its first three Ivy League matches in a season. All 10 previous occurrences came between 1986 and 1995.

- ▶ Harvard has won the last seven meetings against Cornell while owning a 30-match unbeaten streak (25-0-5) entering Saturday's contest. The Big Red are winless in its last 15 home matches against the Crimson (0-12-3) and has lost the last six meetings at Berman Field.
- ► The Big Red's last victory over Harvard came on Oct. 2, 1993, in double overtime, 1-0, at Robison Alumni Fields in thaca. AMY DUESING scored the go-ahead goal in the 119th minute, aiding SUE DeLONG to an 11-save clean sheet.
- After opening the campaign winless over its first five matches (0-3-2), Harvard has won three of its last four (3-1-0) and has scored multiple goals in each win during the span.
- Ólöf Kristinsdóttir paces Harvard's offense with three goals and is tied with Elsa Santos López for the team lead in points (six). All three of Kristinsdóttir's goals have come in the last three matches, leading her to be tied for the sixth-most goals scored in the Ivy League this season.
- Elsa Santos López is tied for the second-most assists (four) in the lvy League this season, one shy of matching the output of Brown's Joy Okonye (five).

- Cornell continues its three-match road trip Saturday, Oct. 11, when it faces Princeton at 1 p.m. at Myslik Field at Roberts Stadium. The match will be streamed on ESPN+.
- ▶ The Tigers have won the last two meetings after Cornell snapped its 25-match losing streak in the series with a victory on Berman Field in 2022. Princeton has won each of its last 14 home matches against the Big Red, with Cornell's last road victory over Princeton coming on Sept. 23, 1995. MICHELLE LAUERMANN scored 4:57 into the match benefiting from a pass from KARYN ANDERER. MARYBETH BELL made eight saves for the clean sheet.
- ▶ Princeton's Ione victories this season have been in 1-0 decisions against Villanova (Sept. 11) and Penn (Sept. 19).
- ▶ Junior defender Zoe Markesini leads the team in goals (two) and points (four), serving as the lone Tiger with multiple goals.
- ▶ Fellow junior goalkeeper Cecilia Cerone has started all nine matches for Princeton, compiling a 1-2-2 record, 1.60 goals-against average, and .621 save percentage. Sophomore keeper Sydney Romano has a 1-2-1 record in four relief outings, paired with her 1.41 goals-against average, and .769 save percentage.

- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER delivered her third assist of the season against Columbia on Sept. 20, whipping an in-swinging corner kick into the heart of the penalty area where senior defender GABY GONZALEZ connected with a perfectly timed header, opening the scoring in the 12th minute.
- ▶ Entering this weekend's action, Kessinger is currently situated in a five-way tie for the fourth-most assists in the Ivy League alongside Princeton's Dylan Jovanovic, Dartmouth's Stephanie Lathrop and Mary Lundregan, and Columbia's Maia Tabion. Only Brown's Joy Okonye (five), Harvard's Elsa Santos López (four), and Princeton's Brooke Birtwistle (four) have more helpers.

- Kessinger is tied with Lathrop, Lundregan, and Tabion for the fifth-best assists per game average in the Ivy League (0.30), trailing Okonye (0.45), Santos López (0.44), Birtwistle (0.36), and Jovanovic
- One more assist would make Kessinger the ninth different Cornell player since 2003 to register four assists in a season, marking the 11th such occurrence during the span. The most recent Cornell player to achieve the milestone was **REAGAN PAUWELS**, who recorded six assists in 2023, matching totals by DONNA EBERHARDT (1988), AMY SNOW (1991 and 1992), REBECCA D'ALEO (1993), LORI PENNY (1993), and DEMPSEY BANKS (2013). The Cornell single-season assists record remains in a four-way tie between LAURIE COLLIER (1986), JENNIFER SMITH (1987), JENNIFER DALY (1994), and **AMY FINKELSTEIN** (1994).

FRESHMAN IN FOCUS

- ► Freshman goalkeeper **SAMANTHA QURESHEY** has made quite an impact in her first collegiate season with the Big Red. After starting the season opener at Boston College (Aug. 22), Qureshey became just the eighth freshman goalkeeper in program history to start a season opener, joining LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI PALMER (2007), NICOLE SHULMAN (2019), and ERICA FOX (2021).
- ▶ Her clean sheet over the Eagles placed her among exclusive company, becoming the fifth Big Red freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, joining Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).
- ▶ After posting a clean sheet over Binghamton on Sept. 14, Qureshey became the fifth Cornell rookie to register at least three solo shutouts in a season while becoming the first to do so since Alexander (six) in 1992. Brigham (three in 1982), Thompson (nine in 1983), and SHERRIE **CHOCOLA** (five in 1984) are the other keepers with three-plus shutouts in their freshman campaigns.
- ▶ Through the completion of Wednesday's matches,

Qureshey is one of 25 freshmen Division I goalkeepers with at least three clean sheets this season, and one of two Ivy League first-year keepers matching the criteria (Dartmouth's Paige Knoth — three).

▶ Entering this weekend, Qureshey leads all lvy League goalkeepers in save percentage (.750 — 22-of-33), ahead of Yale's Kyla Holmes by 19 points (.731 — 36-of-57). Qureshey's 1.222 goals-against average is tied with Harvard's Rhiannon Stewart and Columbia's Samantha Mahoney for second in the Ancient Eight, only behind Brown's Bella Schopp (1.218) by four-thousandths of a point.

KNOT AGAIN..

- Cornell's four draws are tied with 41 other Division I programs for the 31st-highest total through the completion of Wednesday's matches.
- ▶ A total of 30 programs have more draws than the Big Red, highlighted by Drexel (2-2-8) having the most ties in Division I, followed by Cal Poly (4-1-7), Hofstra (3-1-7), and Stephen F. Austin (4-2-7).
- ▶ The Big Red's total, which is the highest among all Ivy League programs, is tied for the third-most in a single season in program history, alongside the 2002 (8-5-4), 2015 (9-4-4), and 2024 (3-9-4) squads. With its next tie,

it would match the 2022 team (4-7-5) for second ansd the 4-5-6 mark during the 2023 campaign

remains the single-season record.
THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN has built a reputation as one of Cornell's most reliable clutch performers. She delivered again in the Big Red's home-opening win over Colgate on Aug. 24, netting her fourth career goal and game-winning goal.
- ▶ Another decisive strike would cement Allen into Cornell's record book, creating a five-way tie for 10th on the program's all-time list for game-winners alongside DINA GROSSMAN (1988-91), AMY **DUESING** (1991–94), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1991–94), and **EMILY KNIGHT** (2000–03). At the top stands LAURIE COLLIER (1984–87), who owns the program standard with 11.
- ▶ The finishing touch provided by Allen has fueled a broader offensive trend under head coach ROB FERGUSON. Since being named head coach, the Big Red has scored in 48 of the 72 matches (66.7 percent) coached by Ferguson, standing as the second-highest rate in program history, only behind RANDY MAY's 67.7 percent mark set between 1982-99. Ferguson is one of four Cornell coaches to see their teams score in at least 60 percent of matches played — a group featuring May, BERHANE ANDERBERHAN (66.0 percent, 2000-05), and PATRICK FARMER (62.2 percent, 2012-16).

A GLANCE AT WHAT'S BACK

- ▶ Cornell brings back a strong returning group in 2025, with 18 players who saw action last fall. The Big Red also return four of its top six scorers and half of the team's offensive production (17 of 34 points: six goals, five assists).
- Leading the way is junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN, the Big Red's top returning scorer after tying LAKEN GALLMAN for the team lead in goals (3) and finishing with six points. She is joined by senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON, and junior forward ALANNA COLBERT, each of whom added a goal and an assist last season.
- ▶ Bishara, a Second Team All-Ivy selection in 2024, is one of 13 all-conference honorees returning across the Ivy League this fall — with all eight programs represented.
- ▶ Cornell's 18 returners are tied with Columbia and Penn for the second-most in the Ivy League, trailing only Brown (19). The Big Red is also one of four Ivy programs bringing back at least half of last year's scoring output, alongside Brown (64.4 percent), Penn (64.1 percent), and Princeton (56.3 percent).
- In goal, seniors NATALIE MEDUGNO and HANNAH GRIMES return as experienced options. Medugno made 11 appearances (10 starts) in 2024, compiling a 2-4-4 record, while Grimes saw her first collegiate action against Pepperdine, playing the final 9:27 of the contest.
- ▶ The Big Red also regains senior forward SYDNEY MALAGA, who missed the 2024 campaign due to injury. In 2023, Malaga finished in a four-way tie with LAKEN GALLMAN, MIA GONZALEZ, and AVA LADEN for the team lead in goals (three), which included scoring the game-winning goal against Colgate (Sept. 26, 2023).

IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ When the Ivy League preseason poll was released on Aug. 18, Cornell found itself projected to finish eighth in the eight-team conference. Reigning Ivy League Tournament champion Princeton claimed the top spot with nine of 16 first-place votes, while Brown followed closely with six first-place votes and Harvard captured the remaining first-place vote. Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn all finished ahead of the Big Red in the preseason rankings.
- ▶ The stakes are clear for the Big Red's pursuit of reaching the Ivy League Tournament for the first time in program history, as the top four-finishing teams from the regular season will advance to the 2025 lvy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which the regular-season champion will host the three-game slate, with semifinal matches being played on Nov. 6, and the championship on Nov. 9.

SCOUTING HARVARD

- ▶ Harvard (3-4-2, 1-1-0 lvy) comes into Saturday afternoon's match fresh off a 2-0 clean sheet over Princeton at Jordan Field, which concluded the Crimson's seven-match homestand.
- ▶ After opening the year winless in its first five matches (0-3-2), the Crimson have won three of their last four fixtures (3-1-0) and has netted multiple goals in each of the wins during the span, highlighted by Harvard netting a season-high three goals in a 3-2 win over New Hampshire (Sept. 14).
- ▶ Junior forward Ólöf Kristinsdóttir paces Harvard's offense with her team-leading three goals, all of which have come over the last three matches. Two of Kristinsdóttir's three goals came last Saturday in the victory over Princeton. First-year midfielder Elsa Santos López (one goal, four assists) is tied with Kristinsdóttir for the team lead in points (six).
- In net, Rhiannon Stewart has played all played all 810 minutes in goal for the Crimson, posting a 1.22 goals-against average and .725 save percentage with two clean sheets.

LAST TIME AGAINST HARVARD

- ▶ CAMBRIDGE, Mass. (OCT. 13, 2024) Áslaug Gunnlaugsdóttir tallied one goal and three assists to lead Harvard to a 5-0 victory over Cornell at Jordan Field.
- ▶ The Crimson scored three times in a span of 4 minutes, 12 seconds during the first half to seize control. Gunnlaugsdóttir, Josefine Hasbo and Audrey Francois all found the net between the 15th and 20th minutes. Gunnlaugsdóttir had a hand in all three first-half goals for Harvard.
- ▶ Nicola Golen and Írena Héðinsdóttir Gonzalez added second-half insurance goals in the 65th and 77th minutes, respectively. Hasbo finished with a goal and an assist, while Jade Rose recorded two assists. Rhiannon Stewart made three saves to post her fifth clean sheet.
- ▶ Cornell controlled the early tempo with four of the first six shots over the opening 15 minutes before Harvard's offensive burst. The Big Red managed 12 shot attempts, including four on goal from LILY ELLINGSON, MARIANA KESSINGER, REINNA GABRIEL and SYDNEY ALLEN.

HARVARD'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ CAMBRIDGE, Mass. (SEPT. 27, 2025) Ólöf Kristinsdóttir scored twice to lead Harvard to a 2-0 victory over Princeton last Saturday afternoon at Jordan Field.
- ▶ The Crimson earned its first conference win of the season as Rhiannon Stewart made two saves to record her eighth career shutout.
- ▶ Kristinsdóttir broke through in the 16th minute after Audrey Francois sent a cross into the box that was deflected by the Princeton defense. Kristinsdóttir cleaned up the loose ball and slotted a low shot past the goalkeeper for her second goal of the season. Harvard's lead was extended in the 60th minute when Kristinsdóttir converted a penalty kick after a Princeton defender was called for handball in the penalty area.

42 YEARS, 328 MILES, 42 MEETINGS

- ▶ Harvard holds a 30-3-9 all-time record against Cornell since the series began in 1982 and is 25-0-5 over the last 30 meetings. The Crimson has outscored the Big Red 80-12 during the unbeaten stretch and recorded multiple goals in 24 of those 30 contests, including each of the last seven meetings.
- Cornell's last victory over Harvard came on Oct. 2, 1993, when AMY DUESING scored at the 118:42 mark of double overtime to lift the Big Red to a 1-0 win at Robison Alumni Fields. Goalkeeper SUE **DELONG** made 11 saves to record her only clean sheet of the year.

SCOUTING LAFAYETTE

- ▶ Before playing Cornell on Tuesday night, Lafayette (3-3-5, 1-0-2 Patriot) enters its match against Patriot League preseason favorite Boston University (4-4-3, 1-1-1 Patriot) riding a three-match unbeaten streak (1-0-2).
- ▶ Since suffering a 7-1 setback to Texas A&M on Aug. 31, the Leopards have dropped just one contest over its last six matches (2-1-3), which includes outscoring its opponents by a 10-5 margin, highlighted by a 5-0 clean sheet of Iona (Sept. 3).
- ▶ Senior forward Katrina Santelli and junior midfielder Nadia Zaffanella are tied for the team lead with four goals apiece, while Santelli has a team-best 10 points. Santelli is also tied with junior midfielder Heather Plowright and junior goalkeeper Catherine Apker for the team lead in assists (two).
- ▶ Apker has started all 11 matches in goal for the Leopards, playing in 945 minutes of action and compiling a 3-3-5 record, 1.14 goals-against average, and .750 save percentage.

LAST TIME AGAINST LAFAYETTE

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (OCT. 2, 2012) XANDRA HOMPE recorded a goal and three assists, and Maneesha Chitanvis scored twice to lead Cornell to a 4-1 victory over Lafayette, snapping the Big Red's 14-game losing streak.
- ▶ Lafayette took a 1-0 lead in the 42nd minute, but Cornell answered just 40 seconds before halftime when Hompe set up **MOONIE MANCHO** for the equalizer.
- ▶ The Big Red seized control early in the second half, scoring thrice in a nine-minute span. Hompe gave Cornell the lead 2:21 after halftime before Chitanvis scored twice in a span of 6:02 to put the game away.
- ▶ Chitanvis' first goal came in the 51st minute when she converted a rebound after Hompe's shot hit the post. Her second tally came in the 57th minute after Lafayette's goalkeeper spilled a ball from Hompe into the box.
- ► TORI CHRIST earned her first collegiate victory, making one save in 45 minutes of relief. CAROLINE QUENTIN made her first collegiate start, recording one first-half save. Christ made a diving stop on Laura Zito's close-range shot with 10 seconds remaining.

LAFAYETTE'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ LEWISBURG, Pa. (OCT. 1, 2025) Lafayette and Bucknell played to a 0-0 tie Wednesday night at Emmitt Field.
- ▶ Junior goalkeeper Catherine Apker notched her fourth clean sheet of the season after matching her season high for saves (six), which included making four first-half stops.
- Senior Katrina Santelli recorded the Leopards' lone shot on goal in the contest, forcing Bucknell goalkeeper Reese Dolan to make a diving save in the 83rd minute. Junior Nadia Zaffanella led Lafayette with three shot attempts.

26 YEARS, 164 MILES, 9 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell holds a perfect 9-0-0 all-time record against Lafayette, with all nine victories coming between 1998 and 2012. The Big Red is 5-0-0 at home and 4-0-0 on the road in the series.
- ▶ The Big Red has outscored Lafayette 23-7 in the series, averaging 2.56 goals per game. Six of the nine meetings have been decided by one goal, including a pair of 3-2 Cornell victories in 2006 (Easton) and 2007 (Ithaca).



ROB FERGUSON

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 lvy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive Ivy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
