#### FIRST TOUCH

▶ The Cornell women's soccer team (5-6-4, 2-4-0 lvy League) concludes its regular-season slate this afternoon when it travels to Hanover, N.H., to face Dartmouth (8-3-4, 3-1-2 lvy League).

# LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (OCT. 25, 2025) Joy Okonye and Corine Gregory scored first-half goals to lead Brown to a 2-0 victory over Cornell on Senior Day at Berman Field on Saturday afternoon.
- ▶ Okonye opened the scoring in the 31st minute with a right-footed shot off passes from Angelina Vargas and Nadja Meite. The attempt deflected off Cornell senior defender GABY GONZALEZ inside the goal area to give the Bears a 1-0 lead.
- ▶ Gregory doubled the advantage just seven minutes later, finishing off a corner kick from Audrey Lam with a goal in a scramble inside the box.
- ▶ The two first-half goals proved to be all Brown would need, as freshman goalkeeper Addison Etter turned away all seven Cornell shots on target to earn her first career victory and solo clean sheet.
- ▶ Despite outshooting Brown 16-11 for the match, Cornell couldn't solve Etter. Big Red senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO made three saves in the losing effort.

# **MILESTONE SEASON**

- ▶ Cornell's five wins this season mark the program's highest total since 2016. One more victory would give the Big Red its most wins in a season since 2015 (9-4-4), while another Ivy League win would mark Cornell's first three-win conference season since 1995 (5-0-2), when the Big Red went unbeaten in Ivy play.
- ▶ With three road victories already this season, Cornell has matched its road win total from 2016 (3-4-2). Prior to this year, the Big Red had just five road wins combined over the previous seven seasons.
- ▶ A win this afternoon would give Cornell four road victories for the first time since 2015 (5-2-2) while also guaranteeing that Cornell finishes the season with at least a .500 record for the first time also since 2015 (9-4-4).

# **EVERYONE GETS A GOAL!**

- ▶ Powered by its four different goal scorers in its 4-0 victory at Lafayette on Oct. 7, Cornell enters this evening's match having 10 different goal scorers and 13 players with at least one point.
- ▶ The 10 goal scorers stand as the program's most since 2023, when 11 players found the back of the net, which matched the program record that was initially set in 1991. It is the ninth instance in program history the Big Red has had at least 10 different players score a goal in a season, also done in 1984, 1987, 1994, 1999, 2010 and 2012 — which all had 10 different goal scorers.
- ► Cornell's 13 different players with at least one point is tied for the sixth-highest total in program history and is the most since 2023, when 15 different players had at least one point.

#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

- Following last year's 1-0 victory at Berman Field, Cornell is looking to post consecutive wins over Dartmouth for the first time since 1995, when the Big Red won 3-1 in the regular season (Oct. 22) before recording a 3-0 triumph in the ECAC Tournament quarterfinals nearly three full weeks later (Nov. 11). Cornell's last time defeating Dartmouth in consecutive seasons dates back to a four-year win streak from 1984-87.
- Dartmouth has won the last 16 meetings in Hanover and is unbeaten in its previous 19 there against Cornell (17-0-2). The Big Red's lone road win over Dartmouth came in 1986 (3-0).
- ▶ The series has been tightly contested of late, with the last four meetings, six of the previous seven, and eight of the prior 10 having been decided by one goal or fewer.
- ▶ Stephanie Lathrop (7-4—18) leads the team in all three major scoring categories and is tied for the Ivy League lead in goals with Brown's Naya Cardoza and Joy Okonye. She trails Okonye (7-5—19) by one point for the conference scoring lead.
- Ola Goebel (5-1-3, 0.35 GAA, .900 SV%) leads the nation in goals-against average and save percentage among goalkeepers who have played in at least 75 percent of their team's matches. Her six clean sheets lead all lvy League netminders.

- ▶ Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER leads Cornell with three assists this season, most recently delivering an in-swinging corner kick against Columbia on Sept. 20 that senior defender GABY GONZALEZ headed home from the heart of the penalty area.
- ▶ Kessinger enters the weekend in a nine-way tie for ninth in the lvy League in assists. She trails Brown's Joy Okonye and Columbia's Maia Tabion (five each), and a group of six players with four assists: Brown's Brooke Birtwistle, Dartmouth's Stephanie Lathrop, Princeton's Drew Coomans and Dylan Jovanovic, and Harvard's Susie Long and Elsa Santos López.
- ▶ One more assist would make Kessinger the ninth Cornell player since 2003 to record four assists in a season, marking the 11th such occurrence in that span.

**REAGAN PAUWELS** was the most recent Big Red player to reach the milestone, recording six assists in 2023 to match totals by **DONNA EBERHARDT** (1988), **AMY SNOW** (1991 and 1992), **REBECCA D'ALEO** (1993), **LORI PENNY** (1993), and **DEMPSEY BANKS** (2013).

► The Cornell single-season assists record remains in a four-way tie between LAURIE COLLIER (1986), JENNIFER SMITH (1987), JENNIFER DALY (1994), and AMY FINKELSTEIN (1994).

# **KNOT AGAIN...**

- ▶ Cornell's four ties this season match the program's third-highest single-season total, equaling the outputs from the 2002 (8-5-4), 2015 (9-4-4), and 2024 (3-9-4) squads. The Big Red are tied with Brown (8-2-4) and Dartmouth (6-2-4) for the second-most draws in the Ivy League this season, trailing only Penn (4-4-5).
- ▶ Another tie would move Cornell into second place on the program's all-time single-season list, matching the 2022 team (4-7-5). The 2023 squad (4-5-6) holds the single-season record with six draws.
- ▶ With one more tie, Cornell would become at least the

17th Division I program this season to record five or more wins, losses, and draws. Currently, the Big Red are one of 41 Division I programs with at least five wins, five losses, and four ties — including three of Cornell's non-conference opponents from this year: Boston College, Kent State, and Syracuse.

#### **FRESHMAN IN FOCUS**

- ▶ After starting the season opener at Boston College (Aug. 22), freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY became just the eighth freshman goalkeeper in program history to start a season opener, joining LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI PALMER (2007), NICOLE SHULMAN (2019), and ERICA FOX (2021).
- ▶ Qureshey's clean sheet over the Eagles made her the fifth Big Red freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, joining Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).

## THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN has built a reputation as one of Cornell's most reliable clutch performers. She delivered again in the Big Red's home-opening win over Colgate on Aug. 24, netting her fourth career goal and game-winning goal.
- ▶ Another decisive strike would cement Allen into Cornell's record book, creating a five-way tie for 10th on the program's all-time list for game-winners alongside DINA GROSSMAN (1988-91), AMY **DUESING** (1991–94), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1991–94), and **EMILY KNIGHT** (2000–03). At the top stands LAURIE COLLIER (1984–87), who owns the program standard with 11.
- ▶ The finishing touch provided by Allen has fueled a broader offensive trend under head coach ROB FERGUSON. Since being named head coach, the Big Red has scored in 52 of the 78 matches (66.7 percent) coached by Ferguson, the second-highest rate in program history, trailing RANDY MAY's 67.7 percent mark set between 1982-99. Ferguson is one of four Cornell coaches to see their teams score in at least 60 percent of matches played — a group featuring May, BERHANE ANDERBERHAN (66.0 percent, 2000-05), and PATRICK FARMER (62.2 percent, 2012–16).

#### GETTING THE CAPTAIN'S BAND

- ▶ Leadership for the 2025 season will be guided by a three-player captaincy, with senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON joined by senior defender GABY GONZALEZ.
- ▶ Bishara enters her third year in a leadership role, having served on the team's leadership council the past two seasons. Nelson and Gonzalez assume leadership responsibilities for the first time this season.

#### IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ When the Ivy League preseason poll was released on Aug. 18, Cornell found itself projected to finish eighth in the eight-team conference. Reigning Ivy League Tournament champion Princeton claimed the top spot with nine of 16 first-place votes, while Brown followed closely with six first-place votes and Harvard captured the remaining first-place vote. Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn all finished ahead of the Big Red in the preseason rankings.
- ▶ The stakes are clear for the Big Red's pursuit of reaching the Ivy League Tournament for the first time in program history, as the top four teams from the regular season will advance to the 2025 Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be hosted by the No. 1

overall seed. Semifinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 6, with the championship match taking place on Sunday, Nov. 9.

# BLEEDING CARNELIAN RED

- Family ties run deep within the Cornell women's soccer program, where this year's roster features an impressive group of Big Red student-athletes, carrying legacies that span football fields, soccer pitches, and classrooms across campus.
- ▶ Senior forward **SYDNEY MALAGA** is one of those players, following in the footsteps of her father, SCOTT MALAGA, a Cornell Athletics Hall of Famer inducted in 1999. Scott concluded his standout career with the Big Red amassing 1,925 rushing yards, which still ranks ninth in program history. Sydney's twin brother, LUKE, also represented the Big Red on the gridiron from 2021-24.
- ▶ On the back line, senior defender GABY GONZALEZ continues her family's strong Cornell tradition. A third-generation student, she follows her parents, JACK and JODI (both Class of 1991). Jack, played for the men's soccer team from 1988-90, while Gaby's older sister, MIA, was a four-year member of the women's soccer team (2020-24) before completing her collegiate career at Vanderbilt last year. Gaby also had a pair of uncles who graduated from Cornell.
- ▶ Fellow senior forward GRACE DIEHL also represents a multi-generational Cornell Athletics legacy. Her father, JEFF (1991-92), and late grandfather, THOMAS (1967-68), each played football for the Big Red, with Thomas later serving as a faculty member in the Nolan School of Hotel Administration. Senior forward MARAN KINGSLEY is another third-generation Cornell student; her mother, Peggy, earned an MBA at Cornell, and her grandfather was an undergraduate student in the College of Engineering.
- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER is following the path of both parents, who attended Cornell, while sophomore defender JANE OFFIT is a third-generation Cornellian whose mother, Amanda, and grandfather also studied on East Hill. Freshman midfielder CHLOE BENIK joins the Big Red as the second member of her family to attend Cornell, alongside one of her cousins.

#### SCOUTING DARTMOUTH

- Dartmouth has clinched a spot in next weekend's Ivy League Tournament and can secure hosting rights with a win over Cornell and either a Brown victory over Princeton (provided Harvard-Columbia doesn't end in a draw) or a draw in the Brown-Princeton match.
- ▶ The Big Green boast the nation's 10th-best scoring defense, allowing just 0.533 goals per game, and rank 37th nationally in save percentage (.833). Dartmouth averages 6.33 corner kicks per contest, the 30th-highest average in the country.
- ▶ Stephanie Lathrop (7-4—18) leads the team in all three major scoring categories and is tied for the Ivy League lead in goals with Brown's Naya Cardoza and Joy Okonye. She trails Okonye (7-5—19) by one point for the conference scoring lead.
- ▶ Goalkeeper Ola Goebel (5-1-3, 0.35 GAA, .900 SV%) leads the nation in both goals-against average and save percentage among goalkeepers who have played in at least 75 percent of their team's matches. Her six clean sheets lead all Ivy League netminders.

# LAST TIME AGAINST DARTMOUTH

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (OCT. 5, 2024) Making her first collegiate start, sophomore forward SYDNEY ALLEN took advantage of her opportunity in Cornell's starting lineup, helping the Big Red secure a 1-0 clean sheet against Dartmouth at Berman Field.
- ▶ Allen broke open the scoreless contest in the 53rd minute with her second goal of the season. Both of Allen's goals have come at Berman Field and have served as game-winners for the Big Red.
- ▶ Senior goalkeeper ERICA FOX made a pair of saves to register her first clean sheet on the season for the Big Red, snapping its seven-match winless streak. Emily Hardy made four saves in the setback for the Big Green.

#### DARTMOUTH'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ NEW HAVEN, Conn. (OCT. 26, 2025) Hailey Rorick scored on a penalty kick in the 88th minute to give Dartmouth a 1-0 victory over Yale at Reese Stadium.
- ▶ Rorick's late goal came after Belle Golden was called for a foul in the box with just over two minutes remaining.
- ▶ Dartmouth outshot Yale 12-6 and held a 12-5 edge in corner kicks. The Big Green had a penalty kick saved in the first half when Yale goalkeeper Kyla Holmes stopped Stephanie Lathrop's attempt in the 27th minute.
- ▶ Holmes finished with five saves before Rorick's penalty kick. Dartmouth goalkeeper Ola Goebel made two saves for the clean sheet.

#### **42 YEARS, 299 MILES, 44 MEETINGS**

- Dartmouth holds a commanding 28-11-5 advantage in the all-time series against Cornell. Recent meetings have been tightly contested, with the last four decided by a single goal — including three consecutive 1-0 results. This trend extends further back: six of the last seven and eight of the last 10 matchups have also been one-goal games.
- After defeating Dartmouth 1-0 at Berman Field last year, Cornell is seeking its first back-to-back wins over the Big Green since 1995, when the Big Red swept both the regular season (3-1 on Oct. 22) and ECAC Tournament quarterfinals (3-0 on Nov. 11). The last time Cornell won in consecutive seasons came during a four-year run from 1984-87.
- ▶ Road contests against Dartmouth have been rather daunting with the Big Green winning 16 straight home games against Cornell and are unbeaten in its last 19 at home in the series (17-0-2). Cornell's only road victory in Hanover came in 1986 (3-0).

# ROB FERGUSON

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 lvy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive Ivy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
