FIRST TOUCH

- ▶ Coming off an impressive 4-0 road victory over Lafayette on Tuesday, the Cornell women's soccer team (4-4-4, 1-2-0 lvy) continues its three-match road trip this afternoon when it faces Princeton (2-5-3, 1-2-0 Ivy) at Myslik Field at Roberts Stadium.
- ▶ The current road trip marks a road-heavy finish to the Big Red's regular-season schedule, as Cornell will end up playing four of its final five matches, and five of its last seven, away from Ithaca.

WEEKEND REWIND

- ▶ The Big Red delivered its most dominant performance of the season, cruising past Lafayette on Tuesday evening, 4-0, at Gummeson Grounds. Cornell mainly controlled play from start to finish, outshooting the Leopards 15-4 while getting contributions throughout the lineup.
- ▶ Freshman defender RAYA LEIKIN was involved in both first-half goals, opening the scoring in the 37th minute before assisting on junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN's header seven minutes later. Senior forward TANUM NELSON and senior defender IZZY SCOTT added second-half markers to complete the rout.
- Leikin became the first Cornell player to have a three-point match since then-junior forward LAKEN GALLMAN scored twice against UAlbany, also in a 4-0 win, on Oct. 17, 2023.
- ▶ Four players earned their first collegiate points in the victory: Leikin and Scott with their respective goals, and freshman defender JESSICA ALESSI and sophomore midfielder LAUREN DIPIERRI, who tallied assists on Leikin's and Nelson's respective tallies.
- ► Senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO and junior goalkeeper NAOMI GLASSBERG combined for a two-save shutout, with each keeper making one save.
- ▶ The win came on the heels of a 2-1 loss to Harvard last Saturday at Berman Field during Homecoming and Alumnae Weekend, despite controlling possession for large stretches. The Crimson scored twice in a three-minute span midway through the second half to take command before senior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA trimmed the deficit with a spectacular 35-yard strike in the 68th minute.

EXCELLING ON THE ROAD

- ▶ Combined with its 1-0 victory at Yale on Sept. 27, Cornell's road win against Lafayette on Tuesday was its second straight victory away from Berman Field, marking the Big Red's first time posting consecutive road victories since beating Siena on Aug. 28, 2016, and Loyola (Md.) on Sept. 2, 2016, both by 1-0 scores.
- ▶ With a win over Princeton this afternoon, the Big Red will have won three consecutive road matches for the first time since winning its first three road contests in the 2014 campaign, when it registered a trio of 1-0 decisions against UMass (double overtime), Marist, and Binghamton (overtime).
- ▶ Should Cornell record a win or draw against Princeton, it would extend the program's road unbeaten streak to four, which would be its longest road unbeaten streak since having a 1-0-3 record in 2017. That year, Cornell defeated Buffalo, 2-1, in overtime before playing to a trio of scoreless draws against Fairleigh Dickinson (Sept. 24, 2017), Penn (Sept. 29, 2017), and Yale (Oct. 14, 2017).
- ▶ The three consecutive clean sheets against Fairleigh Dickinson, Penn, and Yale also mark the last time Cornell posted consecutive road clean sheets.
- ▶ Through Wednesday's matches, Cornell is one of 39 Division I women's soccer programs that own at least a two-match road win streak, with its streak tied for the 17th-longest active streak, TCU owns the longest road win streak, winning its last nine away matches.

- Cornell continues its three-match road trip this afternoon when it faces Princeton at Myslik Field at Roberts Stadium.
- The Tigers have won the last two meetings after Cornell snapped its 25-match losing streak in the series with a victory on Berman Field in 2022. Princeton has won each of its last 14 home matches against the Big Red, with Cornell's last road victory over Princeton coming on Sept. 23, 1995. MICHELLE LAUERMANN scored 4:57 into the match benefiting from a pass from KARYN ANDERER. MARYBETH BELL made eight saves for the clean sheet.
- Princeton's lone victories this season have been in 1-0 decisions against Villanova (Sept. 11) and Penn (Sept. 19).
- Zoe Markesini leads the team in goals (two) and points (four), serving as the lone Tiger with multiple goals.
- Fellow junior goalkeeper Cecilia Cerone has started all 10 of her appearances for Princeton this season, compiling a 1-3-2 record, 1.52 goals-against average, and .636 save percentage. Sophomore keeper Sydney Romano has a 1-2-1 record in four relief outings, paired with her 1.41 goals-against average, and .769 save percentage.

NEWS AND NOTES

- Cornell will conclude its three-match road trip next Saturday when it travels to Philadelphia to face Penn at Rhodes Field.
- Penn is unbeaten in the last nine meetings (6-0-3) and in 26 of the last 27 (22-1-4), dating back to 1997, after Cornell had won each of the first six contests.
- The Quakers are unbeaten in their last 14 home matches against Cornell (12-0-2), as the Big Red is seeking its first road victory over Penn since Sept. 16, 1995, when CAARKI SWEITZER and HEATHER OTT avenged an early second-half goal by Penn to lead the Big Red to a 2-1 victory.
- After opening the season with a 4-0-2 record, Penn is winless in its last five matches (0-3-2), which includes suffering 1-0 and 4-0 losses to Princeton and Brown, respectively, and playing to draws with Dartmouth (1-1) and NJIT (2-2).
- Junior forward Abbey Cook leads the team in goals (three) and points (six). In net, Annabel Austen has started all eight of her appearances, posting a 2-2-3 record, 1.12 goals-against average and .771 save percentage. Megan Graves (2-1-1, 1.82, .741) has started three of her four outings this year.

EVERYONE GETS A GOAL!

- ▶ Powered by its four different goal scorers on Tuesday at Lafayette, Cornell has now had 10 different goal scorers this season and 13 players with at least one point.
- ▶ The 10 goal scorers are the program's most since the 2023 campaign when 11 players found the back of the net, matching the program record that was initially set in 1991. It is the ninth instance in program history that at least 10 different players scored at least one goal in a single season. The 1984, 1987, 1994, 1999, 2010 and 2012 seasons also had 10 different goal scorers.
- Cornell's 13 different players with at least one point is tied for the sixth-highest total in program history and is the most since 2023, when 15 different players had

- ► Senior goalkeeper **NATALIE MEDUGNO** increased her career clean sheet total to seven on Tuesday after sharing the clean sheet with junior goalkeeper NAOMI **GLASSBERG** against Lafayette.
- ▶ Medugno's half-clean sheet helped her tie KATE **ALEXANDER** (seven, 1992-93) for the eighth-most career clean sheets by a Big Red goalkeeper.
- ▶ With her next clean sheet, Medugno would assume sole possession of eighth place, breaking her tie with Alexander and inching closer to KATE THOMPSON (nine, 1983-84), who currently stands in seventh place on Cornell's all-time clean sheet list.

THANKS FOR THE HELP!

- ► Senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER delivered her team-leading third assist of the season against Columbia on Sept. 20, whipping an in-swinging corner kick into the heart of the penalty area where senior defender GABY GONZALEZ connected with a perfectly timed header, opening the scoring in the 12th minute.
- ▶ Entering this weekend's action, Kessinger is in a six-way tie for fourth in assists in the Ivy League alongside Princeton's Dylan Jovanovic, Dartmouth's Stephanie Lathrop and Mary Lundregan, Columbia's Maia Tabion and Brown's Ella Weil. Only Brown's Joy Okonye (five), Harvard's Elsa Santos López (four) and Princeton's Brooke Birtwistle (four) have more helpers.
- ▶ Kessinger is tied with Weil for eighth in assists per game in the Ivy League (0.30), trailing Okonye (0.42), Santos López (0.40), Birtwistle (0.33), Jovanovic (0.30), Lathrop (0.27), Lundregan (0.27), and Tabion (0.27).
- ▶ One more assist would make Kessinger the ninth Cornell player since 2003 to register four assists in a season, marking the 11th such occurrence during the span. The most recent Cornell player to achieve the milestone was **REAGAN PAUWELS**, who recorded six assists in 2023.

KNOT AGAIN...

- ▶ Cornell's four draws are tied with 56 other Division programs for the 53rd-highest total through Wednesday's matches.
- ▶ The Big Red's draw total which is one more than Dartmouth (6-2-3), Penn (4-3-4), and Princeton (2-5-3) for the Ivy League lead — is tied for the third-most in a single season in program history, alongside the 2002 (8-5-4), 2015 (9-4-4), and 2024 (3-9-4) squads. Its next tie would match the 2022 team (4-7-5) for second, while the 4-5-6 mark in 2023 remains the single-season record.

► Cornell's 4-4-4 record makes the Big Red one of 25 Division I programs to have at least four wins, losses, and ties. Four of the 25 programs (Boston College, Colgate, Kent State, and Syracuse) were opponents the Big Red has already played.

FRESHMAN IN FOCUS

- ► Freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY has made quite an impact in her first collegiate season with the Big Red. After starting the season opener at Boston College (Aug. 22), Qureshey became just the eighth freshman goalkeeper in program history to start a season opener, joining LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI PALMER (2007), NICOLE SHULMAN (2019), and ERICA FOX (2021).
- ▶ Her clean sheet over the Eagles placed her among exclusive company, becoming the fifth Big Red freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, joining Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).
- ▶ After posting a clean sheet over Binghamton on Sept. 14, Qureshey became the fifth Cornell rookie to register at least three solo shutouts in a season while becoming the first to do so since Alexander (six) in 1992. Brigham (three in 1982), Thompson (nine in 1983), and SHERRIE CHOCOLA (five in 1984) are the other keepers with three-plus shutouts in their freshman campaigns.
- ▶ Through Wednesday's matches, Qureshey is one of 29 freshmen Division I goalkeepers with at least three clean sheets this season, and one of two lvy League first-year keepers matching the criteria (Dartmouth's Paige Knoth — three).
- ▶ Entering this weekend, Qureshey leads all Ivy League goalkeepers in save percentage (.7500 -22-of-33), ahead of Harvard's Rhiannon Stewart by five points (.7446 — 23-of-35). Qureshey's 1.222 goals-against average is ranks fourth in the Ancient Eight, only behind Brown's Bella Schopp (1.104), Stewart (1.200), and Columbia's Samantha Mahoney (1.200).

THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN has built a reputation as one of Cornell's most reliable clutch performers. She delivered again in the Big Red's home-opening win over Colgate on Aug. 24, netting her fourth career goal and game-winning goal.
- ▶ Another decisive strike would cement Allen into Cornell's record book, creating a five-way tie for 10th on the program's all-time list for game-winners alongside DINA GROSSMAN (1988-91), AMY DUESING (1991-94), JEN TIDSBURY (1991-94), and EMILY KNIGHT (2000-03). At the top stands LAURIE COLLIER (1984–87), who owns the program standard with 11.
- ▶ The finishing touch provided by Allen has fueled a broader offensive trend under head coach ROB **FERGUSON**. Since being named head coach, the Big Red has scored in 51 of the 75 matches (68.0 percent) coached by Ferguson, the highest rate in program history, ahead of **RANDY MAY**'s 67.7 percent mark set between 1982-99. Ferguson is one of four Cornell coaches to see their teams score in at least 60 percent of matches played a group featuring May, BERHANE ANDERBERHAN (66.0 percent, 2000-05), and PATRICK FARMER (62.2 percent, 2012-16).

IVY PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ When the Ivy League preseason poll was released on Aug. 18, Cornell found itself projected to finish eighth in the eight-team conference. Reigning Ivy League Tournament champion Princeton claimed the top spot with nine of 16 first-place votes, while Brown followed closely with six first-place votes and Harvard captured the remaining first-place vote. Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn all finished ahead of the Big Red in the preseason rankings.
- ▶ The stakes are clear for the Big Red's pursuit of reaching the Ivy League Tournament for the first time in program history, as the top four teams from the regular season will advance to the 2025 Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be hosted by the No. 1

overall seed. Semifinal matches are scheduled for Thursday, Nov. 6, with the championship match taking place on Sunday, Nov. 9.

SCOUTING PRINCETON

- ▶ Princeton enters this afternoon's match with a 2-5-3 overall record and 1-2-0 mark in Ivy League play. The Tigers have dropped its last two Ancient Eight contests and will be looking to avoid its first three-match conference losing streak since 2016.
- ▶ Both of Princeton's victories this season have come in 1-0 decisions against Villanova (Sept. 11) and Penn (Sept. 19).
- ▶ Zoe Markesini leads the Tigers in goals (two) and points (four), serving as Princeton's only player with multiple goals. Alexandra Barry (1-1-3), Nina Cantor (1-1-3), Dylan Jovanovic (0-3-3), and Ally Murphy (1-1—3) are right behind Markesini with three points apiece.
- ▶ Fellow junior goalkeeper Cecilia Cerone has started in all 10 of her appearances for Princeton this season, compiling a 1-3-2 record, 1.52 goals-against average, and .636 save percentage. Sophomore keeper Sydney Romano has a 1-2-1 record in four relief outings, paired with her 1.41 goals-against average, and .769 save percentage.

LAST TIME AGAINST PRINCETON

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (OCT. 13, 2024) A trio of first-half goals aided Princeton to a 3-0 clean sheet over Cornell to open Ivy League play on Berman Field.
- ▶ Kate Toomey led Princeton behind her three-point performance, scoring one goal and adding an assist. Isabella Garces and Alexandra Barry also scored for the Tigers. Tyler McCamey registered her third clean sheet of the season, making one save during her 90 minutes in goal.
- ► Senior forward LAKEN GALLMAN logged the lone shot on goal for the Big Red, as senior goalkeeper **ERICA FOX** made three saves in the setback.

PRINCETON'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ PRINCETON, N.J. (OCT. 4, 2025) Alex Chang scored in the 80th minute to lift Yale to a 1-0 victory over Princeton on Saturday at Myslik Field at Roberts Stadium.
- ▶ Chang's game-winner came off assists from Vienna Lundstedt and Anita Thorvaldsdottir, breaking a scoreless tie with just under 10 minutes remaining in the match.
- ▶ Yale held off a Princeton attack that outshot the Bulldogs 13-8. The Tigers put only one shot on goal despite generating four corner kicks to Yale's one.
- Goalkeeper Kyla Holmes made one save for Yale to preserve the clean sheet, while Princeton's Cecilia Cerone stopped three shots.

<u>43 YEARS, 219 MILES, 42 MEETINGS</u>

- ▶ Princeton has the advantage in the series, 30-8-4, dating back to the first meeting between the two Ivy League programs in 1982.
- ▶ Home field has greatly favored Princeton, which sports a 14-3-3 record against Cornell on its home pitch. All 14 Tigers victories over the Big Red have come since Cornell's last victory at Princeton on Sept. 23, 1995, at Lourie-Love Field. MICHELLE LAUERMANN scored 4:57 into the match benefiting from a pass from KARYN ANDERER. MARYBETH BELL made eight saves for the clean sheet.
- ▶ Nine of the last 12 results between Cornell and Princeton have been decided by multiple goals.

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season **College:** University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder **ABIGAIL BISHARA** and senior defender **LILY ELLINGSON**.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while **MIA GONZALEZ** (forward) and **CECILY POKIGO** (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 lvy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories — the most in a season since 2016 — came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive lvy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
