#### **FIRST TOUCH**

▶ Cornell kicks off its 43rd season of women's soccer this weekend with a two-match slate, opening the 2025 season on Friday at Boston College in Newton, Mass., before returning to Berman Field for its home opener against Central New York rival Colgate on Sunday afternoon.

## **SEASON OPENERS**

- ▶ Cornell holds a 23-12-7 (.631) all-time mark in season openers, which includes having a 6-2-3 (.682) record in the last 11.
- ▶ The Big Red are seeking for its first opening-day win since defeating Canisius, 2-0, in 2021. Since then, Cornell has lost to Canisius, 2-1, in 2022 and recorded back-to-back draws against Lehigh (2023 in Ithaca) and Colgate (2024 in Hamilton, N.Y.).
- ▶ Entering Friday evening's match against Boston College, Cornell has scored in six straight season openers and in 19 of its last 23 season-opening matches, dating back to 2001. The lone instances where the Big Red were held scoreless to begin a season since 2001 was in 2004 (at Stony Brook), 2009 (vs. Binghamton), 2015 (vs. Siena), and 2017 (at Syracuse).
- ▶ Should Cornell and Boston College play to a tie on Friday, it would be the first time in program history that the Big Red has played to a draw in three consecutive season openers. Along with the active two-year streak, the only other instance where Cornell played to ties in successive season openers was in 2003 and 2004, when it played to 2-2 and 0-0 draws against Stony Brook.
- Friday marks Cornell's first-ever season opener against Boston College and just the second time the Big Red are opening play against an ACC opponent (Syracuse in 2017). It will be the fifth instance in program history where the Big Red are playing a Power Four opponent in a season opener, also joining matches against Penn State (Big Ten) in 1994 and 1995 and Colorado (Big 12) in 2000.

#### **HOME OPENERS**

- ▶ Since Berman Field opened prior to the 1997 season, Cornell is 7-12-8 (.407) all-time in home openers on its current home pitch and has a 17-16-9 (.512) overall record in the first home match of a season.
- ▶ The Big Red are unbeaten in its last two (0-0-2) home openers, playing to 2-2 and 1-1 draws against Lehigh (Aug. 27, 2023) and Buffalo (Aug. 29, 2024), respectively.
- A win or tie against Colgate on Sunday, would serve as Cornell's longest unbeaten streak in home openers since having a 2-0-3 record between 2003 and 2007, where the Big Red defeated Buffalo (2-1 in 2005) and Hartford (1-0 in double overtime in 2007), and tied with Stony Brook (2003), Binghamton (2004), and St. Bonaventure (2006). With a victory, Cornell would have its first victory in a home opener since 2021 (2-0 win over Canisius).
- ▶ Sunday's match with Colgate will mark the fourth time Cornell is hosting the Raiders in its home opener, with the other instances coming on Sept. 12, 1989 (4-1 Cornell win), Sept. 26, 2001 (1-1 draw), and Sept. 8, 2013 (3-0 Colgate win).

- Friday evening will mark the ninth meeting on the pitch between the Big Red and Eagles, with Boston College owning a slight 3-2-2 lead in the series.
- ▶ Boston College defeated Cornell, 3-2, last season on Sept. 5 on Berman Field in Ithaca, which extended the Eagles' unbeaten streak over the Big Red to five games (3-0-2), dating back to 1990.
- ► Cornell is facing Boston College on its home turf for the third time in program history and the first instance since Oct. 11, 1992, when the Big Red fell by a 2-1 decision as Jessica David netted the game-winning goal fore the Eagles at the 55:00 mark of the second half. LORI PENNY scored Cornell's lone tally off an assist by AMY SNOW.
- Seven of the previous eight matches between Cornell and Boston College have been decided by one goal or less.
- The Big Red will be seeking to snap its 14-match road winless streak (0-9-5) on Friday evening as Cornell's last road victory came in a 2-0 shutout of Marist in Poughkeepsie, N.Y., on Aug. 30, 2023, as AVA LADEN and SOPHIE WEETER each scored, aiding NATALIE MEDUGNO to a one-save clean sheet.

#### **NEWS AND NOTES**

- Sunday afternoon will be 46th all-time meeting between Central New York rivals. Colgate leads the series, 22-18-5, despite Cornell riding a four-match unbeaten streak (3-0-1) into Sunday's contest.
- Cornell's four-match unbeaten streak is its longest stretch without a loss against Colgate since it posted seven consecutive victories over the Raiders between 1986 and 1992.
- ▶ The Big Red have won its last two home matches against Colgate and is seeking for its first three-match home win streak over the Raiders since posting victories in 1987, 1989, and 1991, as part of its seven-match win streak.
- In last year's meeting in Hamilton, N.Y., ABIGAIL BISHARA potted the game-tying goal in the 85th minute, aiding Cornell to its 1-1 draw at Beyer-Small '76 Field. NATALIE MEDUGNO made three saves between the pipes for the Big Red in the season's match. Medugno is 1-0-1 with 1.5 clean sheets, a 0.49 goals-against average, and .875 save percentage in three career appearances (two starts) against the Raiders.
- ► Each of the last five contests and nine of the previous 10 matches have been decided by one goal or less.

- Cornell will play an Atlantic 10 opponent for the first time since Sept. 8, 2019, when KAILI GREGORY'S 74th-minute goal proved to be the difference as MIRANDA IANNONE and NICOLE SHULMAN split the clean sheet in the Big Red's 1-0 shutout of St. Bonaventure on Berman Field.
- ▶ The Big Red has won three out of its last four matches against A-10 opposition, all of which have come against St. Bonaventure, dating back to 2015.
- ► La Salle was picked to finish seventh out of 14 programs in the Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll, which was released on Aug. 13.

#### **HOME, SWEET, HOME**

- ► Cornell opens a three-match homestand on Sunday afternoon when it hosts Central New York rival Colgate at Berman Field.
- ▶ It marks the second straight season the Big Red will play three consecutive matches on its home pitch, following a stretch last season that featured contests against Buffalo (Aug. 29), Syracuse (Sept. 1), and Boston College (Sept. 5).
- ▶ An unbeaten run through the homestand would mark just the 10th time in program history that Cornell has gone undefeated during a single-season homestand of at least three matches. The Big Red last accomplished the feat in 2013, when it defeated three in-state foes in Marist, UAlbany, and Binghamton.

#### **STARTING EARLY AND STRONG**

- ▶ Friday's contest at Boston College marks the earliest season opener in the 43-year history of Cornell women's soccer. The previous earliest start came in 2018, when the Big Red began play on Aug. 24 in Olean, N.Y., against at St. Bonaventure, which featured Cornell registering a 2-1 overtime victory secured by KAILI GREGORY's goal in the 100th minute.
- ► Cornell enters Friday unbeaten in its last four August matches (1-0-3), which includes a 2-0 shutout of Marist (Aug. 30, 2023) in Poughkeepsie, along with draws against Lehigh (2-2 on Aug. 27, 2023, in Ithaca), Colgate (1-1 on Aug. 25, 2024, in Hamilton), and Buffalo (1-1 on Aug. 29, 2024, in Ithaca).

#### A GLANCE AT WHAT'S BACK

- ► Cornell returns 18 players who saw action last season, including four of its top six scorers. Collectively, the Big Red brings back half of its offensive production from 2024 (17 of 34 points six goals, five assists).
- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN, who tied LAKEN GALLMAN for the team lead in goals (three) and finished with six points, is the Big Red's leading returning scorer. Also back are senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON and junior forward ALANNA COLBERT, each of whom contributed one goal and one assist.
- ▶ Bishara, a Second Team All-Ivy selection in 2024, is among 13 All-Ivy honorees returning across the Ivy League this fall, with all eight programs represented.
- ▶ The Big Red's 18 returners are tied with Columbia and Penn for the second-most in the Ivy League, trailing only Brown (19). Cornell is also one of four Ivy programs to return at least half of its scoring output from 2024, alongside Brown (64.4 percent), Penn (64.1 percent), and Princeton (56.3 percent).
- ▶ Senior goalkeepers NATALIE MEDUGNO and HANNAH GRIMES are the Big Red's two goalkeepers returning who appeared in at least one match last season. Medugno logged 11 appearances last season (10 starts), posting a 2-4-4 overall record. Grimes made her collegiate debut against Pepperdine, entering for the final 9:27 after starter ERICA FOX was issued a red card.

**MOST POINTS RETURNING FROM 2024** 

► Cornell also welcomes back senior forward **SYDNEY MALAGA**, who missed the 2024 campaign due to injury. In 2023, Malaga tied Gallman, **MIA GONZALEZ**, and **AVA LADEN** for the team lead in goals (3), highlighted by her game-winning strike against Colgate (Sept. 26, 2023).

#### AGAINST POWER FOUR OPPONENTS

- ► Friday's match against Boston College will be the first of two contests against Power Four opponents this fall, with the Big Red also set to travel to Syracuse on Sept. 7.
- ▶ The meeting with the Eagles will mark Cornell's 23rd all-time match against a Power Four program (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC) with the Big Red holding a 4-16-2 (.227) record in the previous 22 contests.
- ▶ The 2025 campaign is the second consecutive season in which Cornell faces multiple Power Four opponents, with both slates featuring matchups against Syracuse and Boston College. It is just the fifth time in program history the Big Red will play multiple Power Four opponents in a single season, joining the 1990 (Duke and N.C. State), 1995 (Penn State and Maryland), 1997 (Florida and Penn State), and 2000 (Colorado and Penn State) campaigns.
- ► Cornell has enjoyed recent success against Power Four opponents, claiming a victory in each of the past two years both against Syracuse in Ithaca (1-0 in 2023 and 2-1 in 2024).
- ▶ Prior to that stretch, the Big Red's only other wins over Power Four competition came against Duke (4-1 win on Oct. 13, 1990) and Penn State (2-1 overtime win on Sept. 9, 1994).

#### THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward **SYDNEY ALLEN** proved to be a difference-maker last season, recording all three of Cornell's game-winning goals. Each came on Berman Field in victories over Syracuse (Sept. 1), Dartmouth (Oct. 5), and Yale (Oct. 19).
- ▶ With her decisive strike against Yale, Allen became just the 12th player in program history (14th instance) to notch at least three game-winning goals in a single season and the first to do so since MANEESHA CHITANVIS (three) in 2010.
- ▶ Allen's three game-winning goals tied for the Ivy League lead with Harvard's Josefine Hasbo and Princeton's Brooke Dawahare and Pietra Tordin, while ranking 94th nationally.
- ▶ Her clutch finishing contributed to a broader offensive trend for Cornell, which has scored in 42 of its 62 matches under head coach **ROB FERGUSON** (67.7 percent) since the start of the 2021 season. That clip is the second-highest in program history, trailing only the 68.1 percent mark set by founding head coach **RANDY MAY** across his 18-year tenure (1982-99).
- ▶ Although Princeton halted Cornell's program-record 14-match goal-scoring streak last Sept. 28, the Big Red has continued to generate consistent offense, finding the back of the net in six of its last seven matches, 16 of

its past 18, and 19 of its previous 23, dating back to the final two matches in 2022.

▶ Over its last 18 matches, Cornell is averaging 1.39 goals per game and has scored multiple goals on seven occasions — highlighted by a 4-0 victory over UAlbany on Oct. 17, 2023.

#### **CLEAN SHEET CLUB**

- ▶ At the other end of the pitch, senior goalkeeper **NATALIE MEDUGNO** continues to climb the program's record book, as her clean sheet against Lehigh on Sept. 8, 2024, raised her career total to 5.5.
- ▶ Medugno enters the weekend just half a clean sheet away from tying MEGHAN CAUZILLO (1997-00) and MEGHAN KENNEDY (2015-18) for the 10th-most clean sheets in program history.
- ▶ One more full shutout would move Medugno into a tie with KATRINA MATLIN (6.5, 2003-06) for ninth, while two clean sheets would elevate her into sole possession of eighth place and surpassing KATE ALEXANDER (7, 1992-93).

#### **GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE**

- ► Cornell's 2025 roster also reflects the program's broad national reach, featuring 14 different states across all four U.S. contiguous time zones.
- New York leads the way with eight representatives, followed by California, Pennsylvania, and Texas (three). Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, and New Jersey each have two residents, while Massachusetts, Maryland, Michigan, South Carolina, Vermont, and Washington are each represented once.

#### **GETTING THE CAPTAIN'S BAND**

- ► Leadership this season will come from a three-player captaincy, with senior midfielders **ABIGAIL BISHARA** and **TANUM NELSON** joined by senior defender **GABY GONZALEZ**.
- ▶ Bishara is in her third year in a leadership role after serving on the team's leadership council the past two seasons, while Nelson and Gonzalez are in leadership roles for the first time.

#### **IVY PRESEASON POLL**

- ▶ In the Ivy League preseason poll released Aug. 18, Cornell was projected to finish eighth. Princeton, the reigning Ivy League Tournament champion, was tabbed the favorite with nine of 16 first-place votes, followed by Brown (six) and Harvard (one). Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth, and Penn rounded out the poll ahead of the Big Red.
- ▶ The top four teams at the conclusion of the regular season will appear in the 2025 Ivy League Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be held at the site of the No. 1 overall seed. Semifinal matches will be held on Thursday, Nov. 6, with the championship match being played on Sunday, Nov. 9.

#### SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- ▶ Boston College (2-0-0) enters Friday's match riding momentum from a strong start to its seasonopening three-match homestand. The Eagles opened the 2025 season with a 4-1 victory over Stonehill on Aug. 14 before posting a 4-0 clean sheet of Fairleigh Dickinson three days later.
- Against Stonehill, Boston College erupted for four goals in an 11-minute second-half span, then carried that offensive rhythm into the first half against Fairleigh Dickinson, where it scored all four of its goals before halftime.
- ▶ The Eagles are led by the trio of Amalia Dray, Sophia Lowenberg, and Milla Lee, who have each scored in both matches. Lowenberg paces the team with five points (two goals, one assist). In goal, Olivia Shippee has earned both wins, posting a 2-0-0 record and turning aside all seven shots on target she has faced.
- ▶ Boston College was picked to finish 13th in the ACC preseason coaches poll, released Aug. 5. North Carolina, the defending national champions, was tabbed the league favorite after garnering 10 of 17 first-place votes.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (SEPT. 5, 2024) Boston College's Paige Peltier scored twice in a five-plus-minute stretch of the second half to break open a 1-1 tie and aid the visiting Eagles to a 3-2 victory over the Cornell women's soccer team on Berman Field.
- ▶ The victory for Boston College snapped Cornell's 14-match non-conference unbeaten streak, as the Big Red were dealt its first loss outside of Ivy League play since Sept. 11, 2022, when it fell to Syracuse, 3-0, at SU Soccer Stadium. Cornell dropped its first contest on Berman Field to a non-lvy League opponent since losing to Marist, 2-1, on Aug. 28, 2022.
- ▶ Joining Peltier in the scoring column for the Eagles was Ella Richards, who opened the scoring with a goal in the seventh minute. Boston College's goalkeeping duties were split between Wiebke Willebrandt and Olivia Shippee, with Shippee earning the victory after making a pair of second-half saves. Willebrandt, who started the match, made three saves in the opening 45 minutes.
- ► AVA LADEN and TANUM NELSON registered the goals for the Big Red, as NATALIE MEDUGNO made two saves while playing all 90 minutes between the pipes for Cornell.

#### 36 YEARS, 325 MILES, 7 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell and Boston College will meet for the eighth time on Friday, as the Big Red makes its first visit to Boston College's home pitch since Oct. 11, 1992. Boston College is unbeaten in its last five meetings with Cornell (3-0-2), including a 3-2 victory at Berman Field last Sept. 5, that snapped the Big Red's 14-match non-conference unbeaten streak.
- ▶ Six of the seven all-time matchups between the two programs have been decided within one goal.
- ► Cornell's last victory in the series came on Oct. 8, 1989, when JENNIFER SMITH netted the overtime game-winner in a 1-0 decision at Robison Alumni Field in Ithaca. MELISSA GAMBRELL recorded 10 saves en route to the clean sheet.

#### **SCOUTING COLGATE**

- ▶ Colgate (0-0-1) enters Sunday's home opener for Cornell coming off a season-opening two-match homestand where the Raiders played to a 1-1 draw with Buffalo (Aug. 17) and faced Marist on Thursday.
- less Urena scored her first collegiate goal in the 61st minute in the draw against Buffalo, after the Bulls struck late in the first half. Goalkeeper Ella Poppinga made six saves in the draw.
- ▶ The Raiders were picked sixth in the Patriot League preseason poll announced Aug. 7. Boston University, which claimed eight of 10 first-place votes, was tabbed the preseason favorite.
- ▶ Colgate's attack is headlined by Ari Bezanson, the reigning Patriot League and ECAC First Team selection, who scored 14 goals and tallied 29 points last season. Bezanson also earned a spot on the 2025 Preseason All-Patriot League Team.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST COLGATE

- ► HAMILTON, N.Y. (AUG. 25, 2024) ABIGAIL BISHARA's strike from 30 yards out in the 85th minute aided the Cornell women's soccer team to a season-opening 1-1 draw against its Central New York rival Colgate at a sun-soaked Beyer-Small '76 Field.
- ▶ Colgate's Ari Bezanson tallied the opening marker for the Raiders in the 10th minute, capitalizing on a rebound of her initial shot that ricocheted off the crossbar.
- ▶ NATALIE MEDUGNO made three saves in the draw for the Big Red, while Alli Popham (six saves) and Ella Poppinga (one save) split goalkeeping duties for Colgate.

#### **42 YEARS, 64 MILES, 45 MEETINGS**

- ▶ Cornell and Colgate will meet for the 46th time on Sunday, with the Raiders leading the all-time series, 22-18-5. The Big Red, however, carries a four-match unbeaten streak into the fixture (3-0-1), its longest against Colgate since winning seven straight between 1986 and 1992.
- ▶ Each of the last two meetings on Berman Field have favored Cornell and a victory this weekend would give the Big Red three consecutive home wins over tge Raiders for the first time since 1987-91.
- ▶ The Central New York rivalry has been closely contested as of late with nine of the last 10 meetings being decided by one goal or fewer, including last year's 1-1 draw in the season opener in Hamilton, which featured ABIGAIL BISHARA scoring from 30 yards out in the 85th minute to secure the draw.
- ► Cornell senior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO has a career 1-0-1 record with a 0.49 goals-against average and .875 save percentage in three appearances (two starts) against the Raiders, which includes 1.5 clean sheets. Senior forward SYDNEY MALAGA is the only other active Big Red player to have scored against Colgate, netting the game-winning marker for the Big Red in its 1-0 victory on Sept. 27, 2023.

## ROB FERGUSON

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. REAGAN PAUWELS was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 lvy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive lvy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
