FIRST TOUCH

▶ The Cornell women's soccer team looks to keep its season-opening unbeaten streak alive as it kicks off a three-match road swing this weekend. The Big Red travels to Newark, Del., to face Delaware on Thursday before returning to Central New York for a Sunday clash with regional rival Syracuse at SU Soccer Stadium.

WEEKEND REWIND

- ▶ Cornell extended its unbeaten start to the season with a win over La Salle and a draw with Kent State at Berman Field last week, moving its record to 2-0-2 on the year.
- ▶ In Thursday's win over La Salle, senior midfielder MARIANA KESSINGER netted her first collegiate goal to lift the Big Red to a 1-0 victory over La Salle. Kessinger buried a right-footed strike into the top left corner in the 27th minute after a failed clearance by La Salle, while freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY and the Cornell defense locked down the clean sheet. Qureshey made three first-half saves before the Explorers were held without a shot attempt over the final 67 minutes.
- ▶ The Big Red returned to action on Sunday, battling to a 1-1 draw against Kent State, highlighted by junior midfielder BROOKE BROWN's first career goal. After the Golden Flashes struck early in the 10th minute, Cornell controlled much of the match and finally broke through in the 63rd when Brown intercepted a back pass and chipped into an open net. Despite late chances generated by Cornell, Kent State goalkeeper Leah Shaffer made nine saves to preserve the draw.
- Qureshey once again stood strong in net for Cornell, matching her season high with four saves to help the Big Red remain unbeaten through its first four matches for the 10th time in program history.

STARTING STRONG

- ▶ Cornell is unbeaten through four matches for the 10th time in program history (1986, 1990, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, 2015, 2019, 2023, 2025).
- A result at Delaware on Thursday would mark the Big Red's eighth five-match unbeaten start (1986, 1991, 1992, 2004, 2005, 2015, 2023), and its first since 2023 (2-0-3).
- ▶ With a win over Delaware, Cornell would be off to its best five-match start since 2019, when it began the season with a 4-1-0 record.
- ▶ Avoiding defeat in both contests this weekend would mark Cornell's sixth time not having a loss through its first six matches (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023).
- ▶ Wins over Delaware and Syracuse would give Cornell its best six-match start since 2015, when it also began with a 4-0-2 record.

- Thursday will serve as the second-ever meeting between the Big Red and Blue Hens in women's soccer, as Delaware posted a 2-1 victory in the inaugural meeting on Sept. 3, 2010, in Ithaca.
- ▶ Cornell is playing a match in the state of Delaware for the second time in program history, and the first time since defeating Delaware State, 1-0, on Oct. 6, 2013, in Dover.
- ▶ The match against Delaware will serve as the Big Red's first time facing an opponent from Conference USA, which Delaware joined as a full-time member on July 1.
- ▶ Delaware was picked to finish seventh in the Blue Hens' first year competing in the CUSA, joining Missouri State as a full-time member in the now-12-team conference.
- ▶ Through the completion of Monday's matches, Delaware has committed the 13th-fewest fouls (5.33) while owning the 34th-most assists per match (2.50) and 65th-most goals per match (2.17).
- ▶ Maggie Groh has the seventh-best shot accuracy (.813) while Sophia Hall is tied for the most minutes played (540:00) and the eighth-most clean sheets (3) for a goalkeeper.

- Syracuse is seeking to keep its home unbeaten streak against Cornell intact, as the Orange are 6-0-3 all-time at SU Soccer Stadium against the Big Red. Sunday will be the first time Syracuse is hosting Cornell since 2022, when it posted a 3-0 clean sheet.
- ▶ In the ACC Preseason Women's Soccer Coaches' Poll announced Aug. 7, Syracuse was picked to finish in last place out of the 17 programs that sponsor women's soccer.
- ▶ The Orange are one of 28 Division I programs with multiple goals scored off penalty kicks this season.
- Syracuse has scored the 25th-most goals (14) and has the 53rd-best scoring offense in the country (2.33).
- Shea Vanderbosch has made the most saves of any ACC goalkeeper, stopping 22 shots through six matches. Her 3.67 saves per match ranks third in the conference, behind Pittsburgh's Ellie Breech and Virginia's Victoria Safradin (4.00).

- ► The contest will be the first time Cornell and Providence are meeting since the Big Red posted a win in penalty kicks on Nov. 16, 2002, in the ECAC Tournament in Queens, N.Y.
- ► Cornell's last victory over Providence came on Oct. 31, 1993, in the Big Red's lone time playing the Friars in Providence, as AMY DUESING capped a three-point game by breaking a 1-1 tie with 2:03 remaining in regulation to lead Cornell to a 2-1 victory. SUE DELONG made eight saves in goal for the Big Red.
- ▶ Providence was picked to finish sixth in the 11-team 2025 BIG EAST Preseason Women's Soccer Coaches' Poll, announced Aug. 12. Defender Ella McBride was the lone Friar named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team.
- The Friars, who open a four-match homestand on Wednesday against Sacred Heart, will also host Rutgers (Sept. 6) before welcoming Cornell to Chapey Field at Anderson Stadium next Thursday. The homestand will conclude against Brown on Wednesday, Sept. 17, before commencing BIG EAST play against St. John's in Queens, N.Y., on Sept. 24.

- Cornell will be playing on Sept. 11 for the eighth time in program history, entering the date with a 2-4-1 record and winless in its last four outings (0-3-1).
- ▶ The Big Red's only victories on Sept. 11 came in consecutive years, defeating Lafayette in overtime, 1-0, in 2004, and edging Buffalo, 2-1, in 2005.
- ▶ This year's contest also marks the earliest Cornell has ever played its seventh match of a season, surpassing the previous mark of Sept. 14 set in 2022.

FRESHMAN IN FOCUS

- ▶ Freshman goalkeeper SAMANTHA QURESHEY has made an immediate impact in her first collegiate season. By starting the season opener match at Boston College on Aug. 22, she became just the eighth true freshman in program history to start in goal, joining a group that includes LISA BRIGHAM (1982), KATE THOMPSON (1983), KATE ALEXANDER (1992), KATIE THOMAS (2001), JODI **PALMER** (2007), **NICOLE SHULMAN** (2019), and **ERICA FOX** (2021).
- Qureshey's clean sheet against the Eagles placed her among a selective group, becoming only the fifth Cornell freshman goalkeeper to post a shutout in a season opener, alongisde Thompson (1983), Alexander (1992), Thomas (2001), and Fox (2021).
- Qureshey followed with another shutout in last Thursday's win over La Salle, making her the ninth true freshman goalkeeper in program history with multiple solo clean sheets, and the first since KELSEY TIERNEY (2 in 2013).
- ▶ One more shutout would make Qureshey just the fifth Cornell rookie to post three or more in a season, joining Brigham (3 in 1982), Thompson (9 in 1983), SHERRIE CHOCOLA (5 in 1984), and Alexander (6 in 1992).
- ▶ Through four matches, Qureshey owns a 0.50 goalsagainst average, ranking among just five freshmen nationally with a sub-0.50 mark this season. She is joined by Michigan State's Kennedy Zorn (0.29), Stanford's Caroline Birkel (0.33), Georgia's Hannah Folliard (0.41), and Abilene Christian's Bella Medrano (0.44).
- ▶ Qureshey's .875 save percentage is tied for third among Division I freshman goalkeepers, alongside Zorn and Niagara's Julia Poissant, trailing only Bellarmine's Anna Jenkins (.917) and Medrano (.909).

NO 'L' IN BIG RED

- ▶ Following Monday's matches, Cornell is one of just three unbeaten Ivy League teams — and one of only 45 Division I programs nationally — still without a loss this season, joining Dartmouth and Penn, both with 2-0-1 records.
- ▶ The Ivy League is one of only five conferences nationally with at least three unbeaten programs, while standing as the sole non-Power Four conference to reach that mark, alongside the Big 12, ACC, SEC, and Big Ten. Among non-Power Four conferences, it is also one of five with multiple unbeaten teams, joining the Big East (Georgetown and Seton Hall), Big West (Cal Poly and Cal St. Fullerton), Mountain West (Colorado State and New Mexico), and WCC (San Diego and Seattle), who all have two unbeaten programs.

AGAINST POWER FOUR OPPONENTS

- ▶ Sunday's match at Syracuse will Cornell's second and final contest this season against a Power Four opponent. The Big Red opened the year with a scoreless draw at Boston College on Aug. 22, in Newton, Mass.
- ▶ The meeting with the Orange will be Cornell's 25th match against a Power Five program (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC), with the Big Red entering with a 4-17-3 (.229) record in such contests.
- ▶ This marks the second straight season in which Cornell has faced multiple Power Five opponents, with both slates featuring Syracuse and Boston College. In program history, the Big Red has played multiple Power Five foes in a single season just six times: 1990 (Duke, N.C. State), 1995 (Penn State, Maryland), 1997 (Florida, Penn State), 2000 (Colorado, Penn State), 2024 and 2025 (Syracuse, Boston College).

THE FINISHING TOUCH

- ▶ Junior forward **SYDNEY ALLEN** continues to showcase her ability to be a difference-maker, logging her fourth career game-winning goal in the Big Red's victory over Colgate on Sunday. All four of Allen's collegiate goals have not only come on Berman Field, but have been game-winners.
- ▶ With another decisive strike, Allen will enter a tie with **DINA GROSSMAN** (1988-91), **AMY DUESING** (1991-94), **JEN TIDSBURY** (1991-94), and **EMILY KNIGHT** (2000-03) for the 10th-most career game-winning goals in Cornell program history. LAURIE COLLIER (1984-87) owns the record with 11 game-winners.
- ▶ After her game-winning goal against Yale last year, Allen became just the 12th player in program history (14th instance) to notch at least three game-winning goals in a single season and the first to do so since MANEESHA CHITANVIS (three) in 2010. Allen was tied for the Ivy League lead in game-winning goals with Harvard's Josefine Hasbo and Princeton's Brooke Dawahare and Pietra Tordin, while ranking 94th nationally.
- ▶ Allen's clutch finishing has contributed to a broader offensive trend for Cornell, which has scored in 45 of its 67 matches under head coach ROB FERGUSON (67.2 percent) since the start of the 2021 season. That clip is the second-highest in program history, trailing only the

68.1 percent mark set by founding head coach RANDY MAY across his 18-year tenure (1982-99).

A GLANCE AT WHAT'S BACK

- Cornell returns 18 players who saw action last season, including four of its top six scorers, and brings back half of its offensive production (17 of 34 points — six goals, five assists).
- ▶ Junior forward SYDNEY ALLEN, who tied LAKEN GALLMAN for the team lead in goals (three) and finished with six points, is the Big Red's leading returning scorer. Also back are senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON and junior forward ALANNA COLBERT, each of whom contributed one goal and one assist.
- ▶ Bishara, a Second Team All-Ivy selection in 2024, is among 13 All-Ivy honorees returning across the Ivy League this fall, with all eight programs represented.
- ▶ The Big Red's 18 returners are tied with Columbia and Penn for the second-most in the Ivy League, trailing only Brown (19). Cornell is also one of four lvy programs to return at least half of its scoring output from 2024, alongside Brown (64.4 percent), Penn (64.1 percent), and Princeton (56.3 percent).
- ► Senior goalkeepers **NATALIE MEDUGNO** and HANNAH GRIMES are the Big Red's two goalkeepers returning who appeared in at least one match last season. Medugno logged 11 appearances last season (10 starts), posting a 2-4-4 overall record. Grimes made her

collegiate debut against Pepperdine, entering for the final 9:27 after starter ERICA FOX was issued a red card.

► Cornell also welcomes back senior forward SYDNEY MALAGA, who missed the 2024 campaign due to injury. In 2023, Malaga tied Gallman, MIA GONZALEZ, and AVA LADEN for the team lead in goals (3), highlighted by her game-winning strike against Colgate (Sept. 26, 2023).

GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE

- ▶ Cornell's 2025 roster also reflects the program's broad national reach, featuring 14 different states across all four U.S. contiguous time zones.
- New York leads the way with eight representatives, followed by California, Pennsylvania, and Texas (three). Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, and New Jersey each have two residents, while Massachusetts, Maryland, Michigan, South Carolina, Vermont, and Washington are each represented once.

GETTING THE CAPTAIN'S BAND

- Leadership this season will come from a three-player captaincy, with senior midfielders ABIGAIL BISHARA and TANUM NELSON joined by senior defender GABY GONZALEZ.
- ▶ Bishara is in her third year in a leadership role after serving on the team's leadership council the past two seasons, while Nelson and Gonzalez are in leadership roles for the first time.

- ▶ Delaware (5-0-1), off to its best start in nearly two decades, welcomes Cornell to Stuart and Suzanne Grant Stadium on Thursday evening to begin a four-match homestand.
- ▶ The Blue Hens enters Thursday's contest averaging 2.17 goals per match, which includes scoring multiple goals in four of its first six matches. Maggie Groh, who has nine points (three goals, three assists), and is tied with Lilli Lubic for the team lead in goals (three). Brooke Vogel, Adiat Olaogun-Dickson, and Taisiya Reid have added two goals apiece.
- ▶ In goal, freshman Sophia Hall has played every minute this season, posting a 5-0-1 record with a 0.83 goals-against average and .808 save percentage. Hall has already recorded three clean sheets this season, blanking George Mason (Aug. 21), Navy (Aug. 24), and UMBC (Aug. 31).

LAST TIME AGAINST DELAWARE

SCOUTING SYRACUSE

- ► Syracuse (3-1-2) enters this week's slate riding a four-match unbeaten streak, including draws in its last two matches against Quinnipiac (1-1 on Aug. 28) and Princeton (0-0 on Aug. 31).
- ▶ Despite being held scoreless by Princeton, the Orange are averaging 2.33 goals per game, highlighted by a five-goal season opener against Charleston Southern (Aug. 15), followed by four goals versus Canisius (Aug. 21) and three against Holy Cross (Aug. 24).
- ▶ Ashley Rauch leads Syracuse with three assists and 11 points and is tied with Mia Klammer for the team lead in goals (four). Rauch and Klammer are two of seven players who have scored for the Orange this season and two of three players with multiple goals, joined by Maya McDermott (two).
- ▶ In goal, Shea Vanderbosch has played 495 minutes, posting a 3-1-2 record with a 0.73 goals-against average and .846 save percentage. Vanderbosch has 2.5 clean sheets, including a split shutout of Charleston Southern (Aug. 15).

LAST TIME AGAINST SYRACUSE

- ▶ ITHACA, N.Y. (SEPT 1, 2024) SYDNEY ALLEN picked an opportune time to record her first collegiate goal as the sophomore forward headed in a cross from the right side of the penalty area by classmate ALANNA COLBERT to guide Cornell to a 2-1 victory over its Central New York rival Syracuse on Berman Field.
- ▶ The victory for Cornell, which was its second consecutive triumph over the Orange, extended the Big Red's unbeaten streak in non-conference matches to 14, establishing a program record that bested the previous record of 13 set initially on two instances across the 2001-03 (8-0-5) and 2014-16 (10-0-3) seasons.
- ▶ Joining Allen in the scoring column was senior forward LAKEN GALLMAN, who opened the scoring with a 22nd-minute tally. Junior goalkeeper NATALIE MEDUGNO also factored in the decision for Cornell, making a season-high five saves in between the pipes.
- ▶ Julia Dening potted the lone tally for the Orange, who had its five-match unbeaten streak to open the season halted. Shea Vanderbosch made five saves in goal for the visitors.

SYRACUSE'S LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ PRINCETON, N.J. (AUG. 31, 2025) Syracuse senior goalkeeper Shea Vanderbosch made a season-high 10 saves, aiding the Orange to a scoreless draw with Princeton.
- ▶ The Orange had a chance to score late in the contest as a goal kick by Vanderbosch was headed in the midfield, but Princeton goalkeeper Cecilia Cerone challenged Mia Klammer, whose shot sailed over the crossbar as time expired.
- Princeton owned a 31-9 advantage in shot attempts and held a 10-4 edge in shots on goal.
- ▶ Vanderbosch made her 300th career save in the 19th minute, stopping a shot by Barry Alexander, to become Syracuse's fourth keeper to reach 300 career saves, joining Courtney Brosnan (344), Eliza Bennett-Hattan (331), and Brittany Anghel (303).

27 YEARS, 53 MILES, 15 MEETINGS

- ► Syracuse and Cornell will be meeting for the 16th time on Sunday afternoon. Cornell has won each of the last two meetings after Syracuse opened the series unbeaten in the first 13 contests (10-0-3).
- ► Cornell will be making the trip north on Interstate 81 to play Syracuse for the first time since Sept. 11, 2022, when the Orange used a pair of first-half goals scored by Erin Flurey and Gianna Savella, to defeat the Big Red, 3-0.
- ▶ Each of the last two and three of the last four meetings against the Orange have been decided by one goal or less.
- ▶ The Orange are unbeaten at SU Soccer Stadium against Cornell, having a 6-0-3 record.

SIXTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH (FIFTH SEASON)

Season at Cornell: Seventh Season College: University of Manchester

ROB FERGUSON, who is entering his sixth year as the head coach of the Cornell women's soccer team, was hired as the sixth head coach in program history in February 2020. Prior to his appointment as head coach, Ferguson served as an assistant coach for the Big Red during the 2019 campaign under previous head coach **DWIGHT HORNIBROOK**.

His most recent season in 2024 saw Cornell have an overall record of 3-9-4 and a 2-5-0 mark in Ivy League action, matching the most conference wins by the Big Red under Ferguson (2-3-2 in 2022). The Big Red had two Second Team All-Ivy honorees in junior midfielder ABIGAIL BISHARA and senior defender LILY ELLINGSON.

Cornell opened the 2024 campaign without a loss in its first three matches, highlighted by a 2-1 victory over Syracuse (Sept. 1, 2024), the second consecutive year the Big Red defeated its Central New York rival. It marked the 12th instance in program history and the first time since 2014 and 2015 that it did not lose any of its first three matches in back-to-back years.

The 2023 campaign saw Cornell go 4-5-6 overall and 0-5-2 in Ivy League action. The Big Red had its highest offensive production in a season since 2015, as the Big Red recorded 21 goals and 58 points. **REAGAN PAUWELS** was named a Second Team All-Ivy selection for a second consecutive season while MIA GONZALEZ (forward) and CECILY POKIGO (defender) earned Honorable Mention All-Ivy honors. The trio of Big Red players marked the first time Cornell has had at least three players earn All-Ivy honors in consecutive seasons since 2014 and 2015.

Cornell also opened the 2023 campaign unbeaten over its first six matches of the season (2-0-4), marking the fifth time in program history that the Big Red had not lost any of its first six matches of a season (1986, 1991, 2005, 2015, 2023). The Big Red also went 2-0-3 in its first five home games to register a program-record 11-game home unbeaten streak that dated back to 2022 (5-0-6).

Posting a 4-7-5 record with a 2-3-2 lvy League ledger in 2022, both of Cornell's conference victories - the most in a season since 2016 - came in the program's final two matches of the season. It was the first time Cornell had won consecutive lvy League matches since the last match in 2014 and the first fixture in 2015. The Big Red had a 3-1-3 record on Berman Field, which included going unbeaten in its final six matches (3-0-3). The Big Red also had a trio of All-Ivy award winners, including Pauwels and Pokigo receiving Second Team All-Ivy honors.

After Ferguson's first year as head coach in 2020 was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cornell had a 3-11-2 mark in 2021, including a 1-6-0 lvy League record. The Big Red recorded its first conference win at home against Columbia, its first Ancient Eight win since 2016.

In his first season on East Hill as an assistant coach on Hornibook's staff in 2019, Ferguson guided the Big Red to four consecutive victories to start the season – including three straight clean sheets over Siena, Bucknell, and St. Bonaventure. Cornell ultimately finished the season with a 4-10-1 record after the rigors of one some of the strongest Ivy League competition seen in recent years. Ferguson helped get the Big Red's impact freshman class acclimated to collegiate competition, a group that included 2019 All-Ivy League honorable mention selection Ashley Durik.

Ferguson joined the Big Red following a very successful stint as the director of coaching with the WNY Flash Academy. He helped turn the program into a player development leader in Western New York, expanding the program's footprint from 15 teams to 34 teams, and moving them into national recognition in Elite Clubs National League (ECNL).

Under Ferguson's leadership at the Flash, their 03G ECNL and 02G ECNL advanced into the Elite 8 in June 2018, and the club had their first US Youth National Team Camp call-up.

Before joining the WNY Flash Academy, Ferguson was the head coach of both the men's and women's soccer programs at Huston-Tillotson University, an NAIA institution based in Austin, Texas Prior to that, he served as the executive director of business for the Lonestar Soccer Club for eight years, spanning from 2008 to 2015.

One of the largest and most successful youth soccer clubs in the country, Ferguson coached the Lonestar 96B Red, 93G Red, 94G Red and 95G Red, helping advance the 95G Red to the USYSNC Region III Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Previous stops for Ferguson included a stint as the head coach with Albion Hurricanes FC in Houston, where he guided the AHFC 94G Blue to the USYSNC Regionals for the first time in their history. Before that, he was the director of coaching for FC Arsenal for three years in Bastrop, Texas, and was a regional manager for Brittania Soccer/ProExcel, based in Seattle.

Ferguson is a graduate of the University of Manchester, where he received a bachelor of arts degree in sports studies and business management. He lives with his wife, Kelsey, their two children, Maxwell and Mirann, and their two dogs, Bonsai and Charlie.
