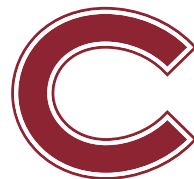

'Cats are Hot

Quinnipiac has won 11 of its last 12 outings, a stretch that dates back to a Nov. 8 overtime victory at Brown. The Bobcats are 11-1-0 over that span, the lone loss coming at Union to close out the first half.

Quinnipiac is outscoring teams 58-30, leading the country in both total goals and goals per game in that span. Their one loss since then is also the fewest in the country and they are one of four teams with double-digit wins.

The Point Is...

Both Ethan Wytenbach and Markus Vidicek have been consistent forces on the offensive end for the Bobcats this season, recording points on a regular basis.

Wytenbach has points in 19 of 22 contests, tied for the most games with a point in the country, currently sitting on 31 total. Vidicek is one game fewer, sitting on 14 goals and ten assists.

Chris Pelosi joins the crew just one game behind, totaling 17 games with a point this season. Quinnipiac is the only school in the country with three skaters with 17-plus games with a point.

New Year's #Goals

Saturday's matchup at Lynah Rink will feature two of the highest-powered offenses since the calendar turned to 2026, with Quinnipiac and Cornell taking to the ice.

The two teams have combined for 46 in their first four games, with the Bobcats (25) four ahead of the Big Red (21) on the overall leaderboard.

The two squads are also half of four total teams that have won all four games they've played coming into the new year, joining Western Michigan and Augustana.

Spengler Cup Medalists

Sophomore forward Chris Pelosi earned a runner-up medal at the 2025 Spengler Cup over the holiday break, with the 97th edition of the tournament being held in Davos, Switzerland.

After rallying but falling a goal short against Hockey Canada, the US Collegiate Selects went on a run of 13:15 of not trailing, defeating host HC Davos and Sparta Prague to go on a magical run to the final, only to see a 3-3 tie going into the third turn into a 6-3 victory for the host Davos to claim its record-setting 17th trophy.

Pelosi made two appearances in the tournament, playing 23 minutes and finishing with an even plus-minus and was part of a squad that took the country and European hockey world by storm.

Backing The Bank

The Bobcats are off to another unbeaten start at M&T Bank Arena, going 10-0-2 on home ice in their first 12 outings, most recently sweeping Union and RPI on home ice.

They have played the most home games this season (12) without a loss and are second in scoring (4.9 goals per game) on home ice this season, trailing only Michigan. They are one of two teams (Cornell) who have yet to lose at home.

Since 2020-21, the Bobcats are tied for first in scoring defense (1.8), third in scoring offense (4.2), first in wins (82) and third in losses (16) on home ice.

HEAD COACH RAND PECKNOLD



Rand Pecknold just finished his 31st season at the helm of the Quinnipiac men's ice hockey program in 2024-25 after being hired to the position on May 5, 1994, culminating in the school's first national championship.

To date, Pecknold features a career record of 666-359-107 and currently ranks first among all active NCAA Division I coaches in career victories and 10th all-time. He is one of three coaches to reach the 600-win milestone while only coaching at one school, joining Jack Parker from Boston University and Red Berenson at Michigan.

Quinnipiac's 2024-25 campaign earned them their fifth consecutive Cleary Cup, winning the ECAC's regular season championship on the final day of competition with a shutout victory at St. Lawrence. They also earned the program's sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the longest-active streak in the country.

They again were towards the top in numerous statistical categories, leading the country in faceoff percentage (55.2 percent), ranking second on the power-play (29.3 percent), third on the penalty kill (87.7 percent) and sixth in overall scoring (3.55 goals per game).

The Bobcats 2023-24 campaign saw them claim their fourth consecutive Cleary Cup as the ECAC's regular season champions, clinching the trophy with three games left in the league's regular season. It is the program's eighth overall trophy, all coming since the 2012-13 campaign.

Quinnipiac won a game in the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in the last five seasons, advancing to its sixth Elite Eight since 2012-13. Only Denver and Minnesota Duluth have more. Quinnipiac finished top five in the nation in faceoff percentage (.550), scoring defense (2.03), scoring margin (2.08), scoring offense (4.10), total assists (282), total points (442) and winning percentage (.718).

They also featured a Hobey Top 10 finalist for the third consecutive season in Collin Graf, who signed a three-year deal with the NHL's San Jose Sharks and made his pro debut days after signing his contract.

The New Hampshire native led the Bobcats to their first ever NCAA Division I Championship, boasting a record of 34-4-3 in the 2022-23 campaign. The squad earned its third trip to the Frozen Four since 2013, joining a club of six schools to have done that. They advanced to their third title game in that span, joining Minnesota Duluth as the only teams to reach three title games since 2013. The squad knocked off Michigan 5-2 in the semifinals and won the title with a thrilling, come-from-behind, 3-2 overtime victory over Minnesota.

The 34 wins are a new program record, besting the 33 the squad won in the 2015-16 and 2021-22 campaigns.

Pecknold was also earned the Tim Taylor Award, given to the ECAC Coach of the Year, for the third consecutive time and fifth time overall in his career. He joins Mike Schaefer as the only coach to win five awards, with all coming since the 2012-13 campaign. He led the Bobcats to a historic ECAC season in which the team won 20 of its 22 conference contests, something that hadn't been done since Harvard in 1987-88.

The Bobcats were amongst the nation's best in numerous statistical categories, leading the country in three and sitting inside the Top 3 in eight of the 13 major NCAA categories. The squad led the country in scoring defense (1.56), scoring margin (2.39) and winning percentage (.866). They were second in faceoff win percentage (.570) and team assists (287) and were third in penalty kill (.867), scoring offense (3.95) and total points (449).

Pecknold was named the head coach of the United States National Junior team for the 2023 Junior World Championships. Current and former Quinnipiac staff will join his U.S. staff, including Reid Cashman, Shawn Roche, Jared Waimon and Jessica Thibault.

Under his watch in 2021-22, Quinnipiac earned its sixth Cleary Cup in the last ten seasons and second in a row as the Bobcats claimed the ECAC Hockey Regular Season Championship. Only one other ECAC program has won as many Cleary Cups in a 10-year span. Pecknold was named ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year for the fourth time in his career. Winners of 32 games, the Bobcats reached the NCAA Tournament for the eighth time in program history, and seventh time in the past nine seasons that a tournament was held. Pecknold's squad defeated St. Cloud State to open the Allentown Regional, before falling to #1-overall seed Michigan in the Regional Final.

Pecknold guided Quinnipiac to its fifth Cleary Cup in the last nine seasons in the 2020-21 season as the Bobcats cruised to the ECAC Hockey Regular Season Championship. The Bobcats won 17 games in the pandemic-shortened season, the 21st time a Pecknold team has won 17-plus games and Quinnipiac has never finished with fewer than 16 wins in a season since joining ECAC Hockey in 2005-06. The Bobcats reached the NCAA Tournament for the seventh time in program history, and sixth time in the past eight seasons a tournament was held.

Pecknold was crowned the ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year for the third time in his career while Odeen Tufto was named the league's player of the year and Keith Petruzzelli earned the goaltender of the year honors. Tufto was also named a CCM/AHCA First Team All-American while both Tufto and Petruzzelli were named Top 10 Finalists for the Hobey Baker Award. Petruzzelli was also a finalist for the Mike Richter Award.

During the 2020-21 season, the Bobcats also placed three players on the ECAC Hockey First Team for the first time in program history in Tufto, Petruzzelli and Zach Metsa.

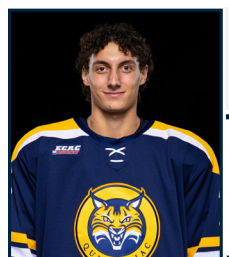
