### FIRST PITCH

- ▶ The Cornell baseball team (0-4) opens the first of six consecutive games against Atlantic 10 opposition this weekend when it travels to Richmond, Va., to face Richmond (5-4) in a three-game series at Pitt Field.
- ▶ Friday and Saturday's contests are slated for 1 p.m. first pitches before the series finale on Sunday will take place at noon. All three games will be streamed live on ESPN+.

### WEEKEND REWIND

- ▶ Cornell was on the losing end of all four of its games in its first weekend of play in Spartanburg, S.C., at the Hub City Invitational, hosted by the Hub City Spartanburgers, the Texas Rangers' High-A affiliate.
- ▶ After dropping last Friday's doubleheader to Northwestern, 13-5, and Boston College, 9-1, the Big Red lost a pair of heartbreaking one-run games against the Wildcats in 11 innings, 6-5, and to the Eagles, 7-6.
- ▶ In the final game against Northwestern, Cornell took a 4-1 lead into the bottom of the ninth before a two-RBI single and sacrifice fly tied the game before a two-out, two-RBI single allowed the Wildcats to walk off the Big Red.
- ▶ Against Boston College, the Big Red tied the game, 4-4, in the top of the eighth on a two-run home run by junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON**, but a pinch-hit, three-run home run by Boston College in the home half of the eighth put the Eagles ahead for good. Cornell threatened in the ninth, having runners at the corners with one out, but were unable to plate the tying run.
- ▶ Freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER** led the Big Red with his .357 batting average (5-for-14) with a double and two RBI. Carlson hit both of Cornell's home runs on the weekend, driving in a team-high four RBI.

### JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

- ▶ Last Saturday's 11-inning contest against Northwestern was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since defeating Navy, 3-2 in 11 innings, in the nightcap of a doubleheader on March 9, 2019, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.
- ▶ In fact, Cornell has not played many extra-inning games dating back 2019, as the Big Red are tied with Alcorn State and Dartmouth for the fifth-fewest games beyond the required inning total. Only Alabama A&M and Saint Peter's (seven apiece) and Mississippi Valley State and Princeton (nine each) have played fewer extra-inning games over that span. You would have to go back to March 13, 2015, for the Big Red's last 12-inning game, against LIU Brooklyn.

### NEWS AND NOTES

- ▶ Richmond, who took two of three games at home against Penn State last weekend, was one-hit by No. 17 NC State in a 27-0 loss in Raleigh on Tuesday.
- ▶ This weekend's three-game series is the first of 12 straight home games for the Spiders, who will not play a game away from Pitt Field until facing Fordham on March 20.
- ▶ Cornell and Richmond previously met back in 2024, where the Spiders took two out of three from the Big Red.
- ▶ Dylan Winebrenner (.424/.472/.879) paces the Spiders' offense behind his team-leading .424 batting average and four home runs. Winebrenner, the lone qualifying Richmond batter hitting over .300 this season, is one of three players (Khristopher Morris and Michael Elko) with six RBI.
- ▶ On the mound, Joey Giordano has a team-leading 3.48 ERA in 10 1/3 IP in his two starts, fanning 11 batters and holding opponents to a .189 average. Jackson Hinchcliffe (1-1, 8.00 ERA) has made three starts, totalling nine innings of action.

- ▶ Cornell is 0-2 all-time on Feb. 27.
- ▶ The Big Red's pair of losses have come against Seton Hall, 3-0, in 2015, and to Virginia in 2022, 19-1.

# CORNELL BASEBALL

## STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has established itself as one of the nation's premier defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons. After setting a then-program record with a .975 fielding percentage in 2024 (35 errors in 1,407 chances), the Big Red improved to .976 last season, committing just 30 errors in 1,113 opportunities.

► The Big Red's 30 errors last season were the fewest in Division I baseball, two fewer than Charlotte (32). Its .976 fielding percentage ranked 49th nationally, leading all Ivy League teams by four-plus points (Dartmouth, .971).

► Since 2024, Cornell's .975 fielding percentage (69E in 2,780 chances) ranks 48th nationally, while leading all eight Ivy League programs by nearly seven points (Penn, .968).

► Posting at least a .975 fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons, Cornell is one of 22 Division I programs to reach that threshold, while being one of six that are not Power Four programs, joining Cal Poly, Dallas Baptist, Fresno State, San Diego and UC Irvine.

► The 69 errors committed by Cornell over the past two-plus seasons are the fewest in Division I baseball, six fewer than Notre Dame (75). Cornell is one of four programs that have committed under 90 errors over the past two-plus years, joining Notre Dame, Arkansas (82), Northwestern (83) and Auburn and Dallas Baptist (85 apiece). Among Ivy League programs, Cornell's 69 errors committed are a staggering 37 fewer than second-place Brown (106).

## LOOK AT WHO'S BACK

► Cornell returns 81.8 percent of innings pitched from 2025 — the seventh-highest percentage in Division I baseball. The Big Red bring back 10 of 12 wins, 234 2/3 of 287 innings pitched, and 82.7 percent of its strikeouts (186 of 225) from last season.

► Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** (2-2, 4.26 ERA) leads the returning rotation after striking out 56 batters in 61 1/3 innings while limiting opponents to a .191 batting average in 2025. Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** returns after missing all of 2025 to injury. In 2024, Hamill logged a team-high 58 1/3 innings pitched with a 5.71 ERA across 12 appearances (nine starts).

► Offensively, Cornell brings back 41.8 percent of its production from 2025, including four of eight primary starters. The Big Red return 41.0 percent of its hits (132 of 322), only 12 of its 45 home runs (26.7 percent) and 74 of 207 RBIs (35.7 percent). Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** leads all returning hitters after posting a .282 batting average with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, and nine stolen bases.

► Key departures include catcher **MARK QUATRANI**, who transferred to Notre Dame and had a .318 batting average with six home runs and 24 RBI; outfielders **JAKOBI DAVIS** (.246, 5 HR, 19 RBI, 9 SB) and **JOHN QUINLAN** (.246, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 11 SB); utility player **RYAN PORTER** (.324, 7 HR, 23 RBI); and infielder **MAX JENSEN**, who is playing at Vanderbilt after an injury cut his 2025 campaign short.

## IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

► The Ivy League preseason poll was announced Feb. 12, with Columbia pitted as the favorite for a second consecutive season following a vote of 16 pollsters.

► The Lions, who edged out last year's regular-season champion, Yale, garnered nine first-place votes and had 118 points. The Bulldogs received the remaining seven first-place votes and had 116 points. Penn (100 points) finished behind both Columbia and Yale for third place, serving as the other Ancient Eight program to receive over 100 points.

► After Harvard (73 points) was picked to finish fourth, Princeton (49 points), Cornell (45 points) and Dartmouth (41 points) were only separated by eight points. Brown rounded out the eight-team poll with 34 points.

DYNAMIC DUO

- ▶ While junior infielders **OWEN CARLSON** and **KEVIN HAGER** have made their homes defensively at second base and shortstop, respectively, for the Big Red, but also found their second home — getting on base.
- ▶ Hager enters this weekend riding an 18-game on-base streak slashing .194/.325/.224 with two doubles and six RBI, while drawing 15 free passes (eight walks and been hit by five pitches). He has also reached safely in 33 of his last 34 and in 54 of his 61 games with at least one plate appearance.
- ▶ Carlson has reached safely in each of his last 15 contests and has been on base in 28 of last 29 and 34 of previous 36, dating back to the beginning of last season. During his current on-base streak, Carlson is slashing .281/.352/.375 with two home runs — both of which came last weekend, nine RBI and seven walks.
- ▶ Both Hager and Carlson are the first Big Red players with at least 15-game on-base streaks since **JOHN QUINLAN** '25 (35 games) and **JAKOBI DAVIS** '25 (24 games) each had their respective streaks span the 2024 and 2025 campaigns.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ Cornell is scheduled to begin its 2026 season playing its first 16 games away from Booth Field before its home opener, a doubleheader, against Harvard on March 28.
- ▶ If the Big Red plays all 16 games before its home opener, it would be Cornell's longest season-opening road trip since 2023, when it opened the season with 18 consecutive games away from Ithaca.
- ▶ It would be tied for the fifth-longest road trip to begin a season, matching outputs from 2007 and 2013. Only the teams from 1984 (21 games), 2012, 2019 and 2023 (19 each) had to wait longer to play their first game in front of the Big Red faithful at home.
- ▶ In total, Cornell will register just under 4,000 miles of travel (3,859) over the opening five weekends of play before hosting Harvard.

MAYFIELD EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** was named one of D1Baseball.com's top 200 starting pitchers in the nation on Feb. 5, becoming one of two Ivy League representatives on the preseason list alongside Yale sophomore Jack Ohman.
- ▶ After an injury-shortened 2024 season, Mayfield emerged as the ace of Cornell's rotation in 2025, posting a 2-2 record with a team-best 4.26 ERA over 61 1/3 innings. He struck out 56 batters while issuing just 26 walks and limited opponents to a .191 batting average — the 16th-lowest mark among qualifying Division I pitchers.

- ▶ Mayfield's dominance was further reflected in his nation-leading .213 BABIP (batting average on balls in play), which measures how often batted balls result in hits excluding home runs. His mark was six points lower than East Tennessee State's Brady Frederick, who ranked second nationally.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

- ▶ Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** each surpassed the century mark for strikeouts during the Big Red's three-game series against Penn last season on April 13-14.
- ▶ Following his two-strikeout outing in last Friday's season-opener against Northwestern, Mayfield enters this weekend assuming sole possession of 24th place with his 123 career punchouts. With multiple strikeouts this weekend, Mayfield would jump ahead of **JOHN O'CONNOR** (1985-88) for 23rd place in program history.
- ▶ With a seven-strikeout performance, Mayfield would become just the 22nd Cornell pitcher since the 1947 season to register at least 130 career strikeouts. Mayfield enters this weekend's series against Richmond 11 strikeouts away from matching **WILLIAM DeGRAAF** (134, 1954-56) from officially entering the top 20.

- ▶ Keller, who struck out five batters in his relief outing against Boston College last Friday, increased his career strikeout total to 107, matching **THOMAS MacLEOD** (1969-70) for 39th on the Big Red's strikeout list.
- ▶ Mayfield and Keller are the first pair of Big Red teammates to simultaneously have at least 100 strikeouts since **TIM WILLITTES** (139 — 2014-18) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (122 — 2014-17) in 2017.

## WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

► Cornell plated 229 runs in 34 games last season, averaging 6.74 runs per game — the fifth-highest mark in program history (minimum 25 games). Only the 1891 (9.28), 1900 (7.45), 2024 (7.11) and 1902 (6.96) teams averaged more. It marked just the ninth time in program history Cornell averaged at least 6.50 runs per game.

► The Big Red have excelled at scoring in bunches recently, as 174 of Cornell's 229 runs in 2025 came during multi-run innings (77.7 percent). Last weekend, 11 of the Big Red's 17 runs came in a multi-run frame. Since the beginning of the 2024 season, 80.2 percent of Cornell's runs (414-of-516) have come in multi-run innings.

► Another 200-plus-run season would be Cornell's first time with at least 200 runs in three successive seasons since a three-year span between 2008 and 2010.

## DIGGING THE LONG BALL

► Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first.

► Last year marked the second time in program history and in as many seasons it registered at least one home run per game. It was only the ninth time since 1947 that Cornell had averaged at least 0.75 home runs per game.

► The Big Red have hit a combined 99 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — two more than the total the program hit across 2018-23 combined (2018 — 18; 2019 — 13, 2020 — 3; 2022 — 33; 2023 — 30).

► In the opening game of Cornell's final regular-season series against Princeton last year, the Big Red launched six home runs in a 15-1 victory, highlighted by two home runs apiece from **MARK QUATRANI** and **KYLE MUSSER**. It marked Cornell's third game with at least six home runs in program history, joining a seven-home run effort against Dartmouth on March 30, 2024, and a six-homer outing at Wofford on March 12, 2016.

► Cornell has hit at least five home runs in a game six times in program history, four of which have come since 2016.

## "14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

► Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

► Ford was hired as Cornell's 15th head coach on Jan. 21, 1991 — just one week before the Big Red began indoor workouts and seven weeks before the season opener. Despite the quick turnaround, Cornell posted a 23-17 record in Ford's debut season, including an 11-2 start — the best 13-game start in program history — and a come-from-behind victory over No. 6 Georgia Tech.

► During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

► Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990.

► In 61 career games (59 starts) for Cornell, Hager has batted .256 with eight doubles, six home runs and 33 RBI. Last season, he hit .276 with seven doubles, two home runs and 21 RBI.

► "Tom has been a tremendous representative of our program," said **DAN PEPICELLI**, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball. "Nobody has been more committed than Coach Ford to developing our guys into better players and men. He has been an absolute rock of stability and wisdom in our program."

## ALL-IVY AWARDS

- Five Cornell players earned All-Ivy recognition last season — the program's most since 2018 — led by catcher **MARK QUATRANI**'s second consecutive First Team selection.
- Quatrani became the first Cornell player to repeat as a First Team All-Ivy honoree since **RYAN KRAINZ** (2017-18) and just the 10th Big Red player to earn consecutive first-team selections. He was also the first Cornell catcher to achieve back-to-back first-team honors since **ED COTT** did so in 1968 and 1969.
- Two-way player **RYAN PORTER** was named Second Team All-Ivy as a utility player and earned Academic All-Ivy honors with a 3.93 GPA as an applied economics and management major.
- Right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD**, first baseman **KYLE MUSSER** and outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** received Honorable Mention All-Ivy recognition.
- Of the five honorees from last season, only Mayfield returns for this season.

## FUN WITH GEOGRAPHY

- Senior utility player **T.J. SWIDORSKI** and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** are both from Woodbury, Minn., and attended East Ridge High School before arriving at Cornell in 2023. They are the second pair of Minnesota teammates in program history, joining a trio of Minnesotans — senior pitcher **TOM LAUGHLIN**, freshman infielder **JUSTIN MILO**, and freshman pitcher **MATT HILL** — who played together in 2007.
- The Big Red's nine New York natives are its most for a single season since having 10 New Yorkers on the 1994 roster. Cornell's seven Massachusetts natives on its 2026 roster, breaks the previous record for the most Bay Staters of four set on four occasions, which included last season (1950, 1980, 1990, and 2025).
- Staying in New England junior left-handed pitcher Andrew Houghton, who transferred from UMass, is the first New Hampshire native on the Big Red since right-handed pitcher **TAYLOR WOOD** in 2011.
- Sophomore right-hander **TAVIAN RAMOS** (Neenah, Wis.) is the fourth Wisconsin-born player in program history, joining infielders **THOMAS BOETTCHER** (1970-72, Madison) and **CURT STAUTZ** (1979, Madison), and right-hander **JONATHAN ZACHARIAS** (2019-22, Green Bay).
- Cornell has three sets of players who attended the same high school or prep school this season (seniors **CADEN WILDMAN** and **TJ SWIDORSKI** — East Ridge HS (Minn.); freshman right-handed pitcher **CONNOR NIEMIEC** and freshman infielder **AIDEN BARCLAY** — Deerfield Academy (Mass.); senior infielder **BECK UROFSKY** and freshman outfielder **TRENT LOPEZ** — Bethesda-Chevy Chase (Md.) HS), marking the program's first-ever time having at least a trio of graduates from the same high school on the same team.

## SCOUTING RICHMOND

- ▶ Richmond begins a 12-game homestand this weekend after being one-hit in its 27-0 loss to No. 17 NC State in Raleigh, N.C., in a midweek contest on Tuesday.
- ▶ The Spiders have won their first two weekend series of the season, eaching taking two out of three games against Monmouth and Penn State. Richmond has been shut out in both of its midweek contests, also losing to No. 10 North Carolina, 10-0, on Feb. 17.
- ▶ Dylan Winebrenner (.424/.472/.879) paces the Spiders' offense behind his team-leading .424 batting average and four home runs. Winebrenner, the lone qualifying Richmond batter hitting over .300 this season, is one of three players (Khristopher Morris and Michael Elko) with six RBI.
- ▶ On the mound, Joey Giordano has a team-leading 3.48 ERA in 10 1/3 IP in his two starts, fanning 11 batters and holding opponents to a .189 average. Jackson Hinchcliffe (1-1, 8.00 ERA) has made three starts, totalling nine innings of action.

## 88 YEARS, 433 MILES, 11 MEETINGS

- ▶ This weekend will be the third time in the last five years where Cornell and Richmond will be playing in a three-game series. The last time the Big Red and Spiders squared off on the baseball diamond was from March 15-17, 2024, also at Pitt Field in Richmond, Va.
- ▶ In the last three-game series with the Spiders, all 11 Cornell batters who registered at least one at-bat recorded a base hit as part of a 16-hit barrage that helped the Big Red to a 9-3 victory.
- ▶ Four of Cornell's 16 hits came via home runs from senior catcher **NATHAN WAUGH**, junior left fielder **JOHN QUINLAN**, sophomore right fielder **CADEN WILDMAN** and senior second baseman **MATT BARNHORST**.
- ▶ Barnhorst paced Cornell's offense with a three-hit day, going 3-for-5 with four RBI. Wildman crossed home plate on three occasions while going 2-for-3. Waugh (2-for-5) and freshman designated hitter **OWEN CARLSON** (2-for-4) also registered multi-hit days for the Big Red (2-8), which snapped a six-game losing streak.
- ▶ Sophomore right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** collected his first win of the season after pitching the first five innings and allowing a pair of runs on four hits. Mayfield issued just one walk and struck out a trio of Spider batters. Freshman southpaw **HUXLEY HOLCOMBE** hurled three shutout innings of relief while fanning two. Senior right-hander **STORY KIMURA** pitched the final inning.
- ▶ The Big Red victory was bookended by 8-4 victories by Richmond. Wildman is the lone active Cornell player with a home run against the Spiders, as he went 3-for-12 in the series in 2024. Carlson has a team-best .364 average against Richmond, where he went 4-for-11 with a double.
- ▶ Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** is the only other active Big Red player to have started against the Spiders, where he yielded five runs (three earned) on four hits in 4 1/3 innings of work.

► After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

► Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher **RICH BOOTH** '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

► The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

**D**AN PEPICELLI, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball, was named the 17th head coach in Cornell baseball history on Aug. 10, 2015, and is entering his 11th season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 112 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
