FIRST PITCH

- ▶ The Cornell baseball team (1-9) plays its final three-game non-conference series of the season this weekend, traveling to Lexington, Va., to face VMI (15-2) at Lamore Field at Gray-Minor Stadium.
- ▶ Saturday will feature the Big Red and Keydets playing a doubleheader beginning at 1 p.m., before the series finale takes place Sunday at 11 a.m. All three games on the weekend will be streamed live on ESPN+.

WEEKEND REWIND

- ▶ Cornell snapped its season-opening eight-game losing streak with a 3-1 victory over Fordham in the nightcap of last Saturday's doubleheader, on the strength of freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER**'s go-ahead home run in the seventh inning.
- ▶ Junior left-handed pitcher **HUXLEY HOLCOMBE** earned the starting nod, allowing a leadoff single before retiring the next 15 batters as part of his five-plus-inning outing in which he allowed just one hit and one unearned run while striking out four and walking one. Sophomore right-hander **JOHN HEGARTY** earned his first collegiate victory with three scoreless, hitless innings of relief, and junior right-hander **MAX FOSTER** logged his first collegiate save.
- ▶ In the rubber match of the Big Red's three-game series with Fordham, the Big Red fell to the Rams 16-11, as the Rams' nine-run third proved to be the difference despite Cornell's nine-run sixth cut the deficit from 13 to four.

- ▶ Fordham tacked on an insurance run in the bottom of the eighth before halting Cornell's two-out rally in the ninth as the Big Red brought the game-tying run to the on-deck circle.
- ▶ Sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** went 5-for-6 on Sunday, logging Cornell's first five-hit game since **WILL SIMONEIT** in 2019. Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** went 4-for-6 with a double and two RBI. Senior first baseman **TJ SWIDORSKI** capped the nine-run sixth with a grand slam.

STARTING THE HIT PARADE

- ▶ Cornell erupted for 19 hits in the series finale against Fordham on Saturday — its most in a game since posting 20 at Towson last March — paced by a historic performance from sophomore catcher Mason Barela, who went 5-for-6 to record the program's first five-hit game since Will Simoneit at Army West Point on April 3, 2019.
- ▶ Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** complemented Barela's effort with a 4-for-6 outing, making it just the seventh time since 2003 that Cornell has had two players collect four or more hits in the same game.
- ▶ The last time Cornell had multiple players have four-hit games in the same game came in the Big Red's 27-14 victory at Towson on April 5, 2017, when **TREY BAUR** (6-for-7) and **PIERRE LE DORZE** and **COLE RUTHERFORD** (both 4-for-7) combined for 14 of the Big Red's 28 hits.

- ▶ The Keydets rank in the top 30 nationally in both runs per game (10.82, 14th) and fielding percentage (.983, 29th).
- ▶ Known for its knack in stealing bases, VMI has the most steals in Division I baseball (98), averaging 5.76 steals per game. Five players already have at least 11 steals this season.

- ▶ Cornell will play its 11th and 12th games on March 14 next weekend. The Big Red are 4-6 all-time on the date and have lost four of its last five March 14 contests.
- ▶ It will be the Big Red's second time playing in Virginia on March 14 after defeating Virginia Tech, 5-3, in 2003 in Blacksburg.

- ▶ The Tigers average 1.07 double plays turned per game, ranking seventh nationally.
- ▶ Cornell will be seeking its first series victory over Princeton since taking three out of four games from the Tigers in 2015.

ON THIS DATE: MARCH 21

- ▶ Cornell will be playing on March 21 for the 37th and 38th times next Saturday. The Big Red are 11-25 on the date, highlighted by a 4-2 win over Tennessee in 1972.
- ▶ Next Saturday will be the earliest the Big Red will ever play a conference opponent in program history, besting the previous record of March 22, set over each of the last two seasons.
- ▶ The Big Red have alternated results in each of the last five games played on March 21, dating back to 2009. Three of the last four March 21 games have been decided by one run.

- ▶ Next Sunday is slated to be the Big Red's 43rd all-time game on March 22, with Cornell having a 13-28-1 record.
- ▶ Cornell will be seeking its third consecutive win on March 22, matching the longest such streak since sweeping a 1979 twin bill from Hawai'i-Hilo and beating Clemson in 1980.
- ▶ Last year, Cornell swept a doubleheader at Yale, posting a 13-12 win in 10 innings before winning the nightcap 7-4.

CORNELL BASEBALL

BARELA-ZING HOT

► Sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .519 (14-for-27) with a home run over that span, including a 5-for-6 performance in last Sunday's rubber match against Fordham that marked the program's first five-hit game in seven years.

► Barela hit an Ivy League-leading .571 in the series against Fordham, joining junior infielder **KEVIN HAGER** (.545) as the only two Cornell players to bat over .500 in the three-game set. The Big Red were one of 10 programs nationally with at least two players batting .545 or better last week, joining CSU Bakersfield and LIU (three apiece) and Mercer, Nevada, Oregon State, Saint Joseph's, Texas State, Texas Tech and UAB.

► Barela's .571 batting average last week ranked 49th and his 2.67 hits per game (eight hits across three games) was the seventh-best per-game average among Division I hitters.

► Over his last 14 games — all starts, dating back to last season — Barela is slashing .351/.367/.544 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBI in 57 at-bats. He also leads the Ivy League in hits per game (1.60) on the season.

NO HIT, HEGARTY

► Sophomore right-hander **JOHN HEGARTY** has now turned in two hitless outings of three or more innings this season, bookending a rough one-inning stint against Richmond on March 1.

► Hegarty opened his season with four hitless innings against Northwestern in Spartanburg, S.C., in the Hub City Invitational on Feb. 21 before allowing three hits and three earned runs at Richmond. He rebounded in the nightcap of last Saturday's doubleheader at Fordham, tossing three scoreless, hitless innings of relief while walking none and striking out two across 43 pitches (27 strikes) to earn his first collegiate victory. He finished the week as one of 14 Division I pitchers to not allow a hit (minimum 1.0 IP per team game).

ON-BASE BRIGADE

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** and junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON** recently had their career-long on-base streaks snapped — Hager at 21 games and Carlson at 19 — making them the first Cornell teammates to each post on-base streaks of at least 15 games since **JOHN QUINLAN** '25 (35 games) and **JAKOBI DAVIS** '25 (24 games) across the 2024 and 2025 seasons.

► Despite the streaks ending, both have remained consistent producers, and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** has joined them as the Big Red's most reliable offensive contributors recently.

► Carlson has reached safely in 20 of his last 21 games, batting .299 with two home runs and 13 RBI over that span. Hager has reached safely in 56 of his last 60 games, slashing .294/.406/.422 with seven home runs, 35 RBI and six stolen bases. Wildman has reached safely in 24 of his last 27 games, slashing .324/.397/.451 with two home runs, 15 RBI and six stolen bases.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

► Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** each surpassed the century mark for strikeouts during the Big Red's three-game series against Penn last season on April 13-14, and the duo has continued to climb Cornell's all-time strikeout leaderboard since.

► Following his two strikeouts in the opening game of last Saturday's doubleheader at Fordham, Mayfield became the 22nd Cornell pitcher since 1947 to register at least 130 career strikeouts. He enters this weekend in sole possession of 22nd place with 131 career punchouts — the most by a Cornell pitcher since **TIM WILLITTES** concluded his career with 140 in 2018 — and is nine strikeouts away from matching **BLAKE HAMILTON** (140, 2004-07) for 17th place in program history.

► Keller enters the weekend tied with **BRIAN McAFEE** for 32nd place with 114 career strikeouts, having jumped ahead of six pitchers over his pair of appearances at Fordham last weekend, where four of his five outs recorded came via strikeout.

► Mayfield and Keller are the first pair of Cornell teammates to simultaneously reach at least 100 career strikeouts since Willittes (139) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (122) accomplished the feat together in 2017.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

▶ Cornell plated 229 runs in 34 games last season, averaging 6.74 runs per game — the fifth-highest mark in program history (minimum 25 games). Only the 1891 (9.28), 1900 (7.45), 2024 (7.11) and 1902 (6.96) teams averaged more, marking just the ninth time in program history Cornell averaged at least 6.50 runs per game.

▶ The Big Red have now averaged at least 6.74 runs per game in back-to-back seasons, as the 2024 squad averaged 7.11 runs per game — the first time Cornell has averaged at least 6.70 runs per game in consecutive seasons since a four-year stretch from 1899 to 1902.

▶ Cornell has excelled at scoring in bunches recently, as 174 of Cornell's 229 runs in 2025 came during multi-run innings (77.7 percent). Since the beginning of the 2024 season, 79.5 percent of Cornell's runs (431-of-542) have come in multi-run innings, a trend that has continued into 2026, as 11 of the Big Red's 15 runs scored in last weekend's three-game series at Fordham came in multi-run frames, including the nine-run sixth inning in last Sunday's rubber match.

▶ Entering this weekend, Cornell has scored 44 runs over its 10 games (averaging 4.40 runs per game) and another 200-plus-run season would mark the first time the Big Red have scored at least 200 runs in three straight seasons since a three-year stretch from 2008 to 2010.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

▶ Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first, and have hit at least one home run per game in each of the last two seasons — only the eighth and ninth times since 1947 that Cornell had averaged at least 0.75 home runs per game.

▶ Including six home runs through 10 games this season, the Big Red have hit a combined 101 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — four more than the program hit across the six seasons from 2018-23 combined (2018 — 18; 2019 — 13; 2020 — 3; 2022 — 33; 2023 — 30), which did not include a 2021 season due to the pandemic.

▶ In the opening game of Cornell's final regular-season series against Princeton last season at Booth Field in Ithaca, the Big Red launched six home runs in a 15-1 victory, highlighted by two home runs apiece from **MARK QUATRANI** and **KYLE MUSSER**. The output marked Cornell's third game with at least six home runs in program history, all of which have come in the last 10 years. Cornell posted its program-record seven-home run game against Dartmouth on March 30, 2024, also at Booth Field and a six-homer outing at Wofford on March 12, 2016.

▶ Cornell has hit at least five home runs in a game six times in program history, four of which have come since 2016.

JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

▶ Cornell's 11-inning contest against Northwestern on Feb. 21, as part of its season-opening four-game series in the Hub City Invitational in Spartanburg, S.C., was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since it defeated Navy in 11 innings, 3-2, in the nightcap of a March 9, 2019, doubleheader, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.

▶ In fact, Cornell has not gone to extra innings much since 2019, as the Big Red are tied with Alcorn State for the fifth-fewest games beyond the required inning total. Only Alabama A&M (seven), Saint Peter's (eight), Mississippi Valley State and Princeton (nine each) have played fewer extra-inning games over that span.

▶ Cornell's last extra-inning win came at Yale on March 22, 2025, a 13-12 slugfest, while its last win in a game that went at least 12 innings came on April 27, 2014, when it defeated Princeton, 4-2, in 14 innings. The Big Red's last time going at least 12 innings came on March 13, 2015, when it fell to LIU Brooklyn, 5-4, in the RussMatt Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla.

STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has established itself as one of the nation's most consistent defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons, despite committing six errors in last Sunday's series finale against Fordham.

► After setting a then-program record with a .975 fielding percentage in 2024 (35 errors in 1,407 chances), the Big Red improved to .976 last season, committing just 30 errors in 1,113 opportunities — the fewest in Division I baseball, two fewer than Charlotte (32). Cornell's .976 fielding percentage ranked 49th nationally last season, leading all Ivy League teams by four-plus points over second-place Dartmouth (.971).

► Posting at least a .975 fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons, Cornell is one of 22 Division I programs to reach that threshold, while being one of six that are not Power Four programs, joining Cal Poly, Dallas Baptist, Fresno State, San Diego and UC Irvine.

► Since 2024, Cornell's .972 fielding percentage (82 errors in 2,980 chances) ranks 94th nationally and leads all eight Ivy League programs by nearly five points over second-place Yale (.968).

► The Big Red's 82 errors over that span are tied with Notre Dame for the fewest in Division I baseball, and Cornell is one of six programs to commit fewer than 95 errors over that stretch, joining Dallas Baptist (89), Northwestern (90), Arkansas (92) and Auburn (93).

► Among Ivy League programs, Cornell's 82 errors are 32 fewer than Yale, who have committed the second-fewest miscues in the conference.

"14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

► Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

► Ford was hired as Cornell's 15th head coach on Jan. 21, 1991 — just one week before the Big Red began indoor workouts and seven weeks before the season opener. Despite the quick turnaround, Cornell posted a 23-17 record in Ford's debut season, including an 11-2 start — the best 13-game start in program history — and a come-from-behind victory over No. 6 Georgia Tech.

► During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

► Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990.

► In 67 career games (65 starts) for Cornell, Hager is hitting .277 with eight doubles, seven home runs and 37 RBI. This year, Hager is batting .361 with one home run and four RBI through 10 games.

► "Tom has been a tremendous representative of our program," said **DAN PEPICELLI**, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball. "Nobody has been more committed than Coach Ford to developing our guys into better players and men. He has been an absolute rock of stability and wisdom in our program."

ROAD WARRIORS

► Cornell is scheduled to begin its 2026 season playing its first 16 games away from Booth Field before its home opener, a doubleheader, against Harvard on March 28.

► If the Big Red ends up playing all 16 games before its home opener, it would be the program's longest season-opening road trip since 2023, when it played its first 18 games away from Ithaca.

► It would be tied for the fifth-longest road trip to begin a season, matching outputs from 2007 and 2013. Only the teams from 1984 (21 games), 2012, 2019 and 2023 (19 each) had to wait longer to play their first game in front of the Big Red faithful at home.

► In total, Cornell will register just under 4,000 miles of travel (3,859) over the opening five weekends of play before hosting Harvard.

LOOK AT WHO'S BACK

- ▶ Cornell returns 81.8 percent of innings pitched from 2025 — the seventh-highest percentage in Division I baseball. The Big Red bring back 10 of 12 wins, 234 2/3 of 287 innings pitched, and 82.7 percent of its strikeouts (186 of 225) from last season.
- ▶ Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** (2-2, 4.26 ERA) leads the returning rotation after striking out 56 batters in 61 1/3 innings while limiting opponents to a .191 batting average in 2025. Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** returns after missing all of 2025 to injury. In 2024, Hamill logged a team-high 58 1/3 innings pitched with a 5.71 ERA across 12 appearances (nine starts).
- ▶ Offensively, Cornell brings back 41.8 percent of its production from 2025, including four of eight primary starters. The Big Red return 41.0 percent of its hits (132 of 322), only 12 of its 45 home runs (26.7 percent) and 74 of 207 RBIs (35.7 percent). Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** leads all returning hitters after posting a .282 batting average with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, and nine stolen bases.
- ▶ Key departures include catcher **MARK QUATRANI**, who transferred to Notre Dame and had a .318 batting average with six home runs and 24 RBI; outfielders **JAKOBI DAVIS** (.246, 5 HR, 19 RBI, 9 SB) and **JOHN QUINLAN** (.246, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 11 SB); utility player **RYAN PORTER** (.324, 7 HR, 23 RBI); and infielder **MAX JENSEN**, who is playing at Vanderbilt after an injury cut his 2025 campaign short.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

- ▶ The Ivy League preseason poll was announced Feb. 12, with Columbia pitted as the favorite for a second consecutive season following a vote of 16 pollsters.
- ▶ The Lions, who edged out last year's regular-season champion, Yale, garnered nine first-place votes and had 118 points. The Bulldogs received the remaining seven first-place votes and had 116 points. Penn (100 points) finished behind both Columbia and Yale for third place, serving as the other Ancient Eight program to receive over 100 points.
- ▶ After Harvard (73 points) was picked to finish fourth, Princeton (49 points), Cornell (45 points) and Dartmouth (41 points) were only separated by eight points. Brown rounded out the eight-team poll with 34 points.

SCOUTING VMI

► Entering this weekend as one of the nation's hottest teams, VMI is sporting a 15-2 overall record after its midweek victory over Norfolk State, 15-10, on Wednesday. The Keydets have won their last six games — tied for the 12th-longest active win streak — and are one of 12 Division I programs with at least 15 wins.

► VMI ranks in the top 50 nationally in numerous offensive categories, highlighted by its .307 batting average (48th), doubles per game (2.18, 44th) and .472 on-base percentage, which ranks seventh. Known for its knack for stealing bases, the Keydets have only been caught stealing five times this season, swiping 98 bases (5.76 steals per game), both figures the best in Division I baseball.

► Senior first baseman Grayson Fitzwater paces VMI's offense behind his .386 batting average with six home runs and 24 RBI. Fitzwater, who became the Keydets' all-time home run leader last weekend, was named SoCon Player of the Week and to the *Baseball America's* Week 4 National College Team of the Week after going 8-for-11 with four home runs and nine RBI in VMI's four-game series sweep of Western Illinois.

► Sophomore outfielder Cole Cook leads the team with a .389 average and 26 RBI, while tied with Fitzwater for the team lead in home runs (six). Senior utility player Owen Prince has reached base safely in all 17 games and leads the nation with 19 stolen bases and ranks fifth nationally with 28 runs scored. Junior catcher Cole Raile has been perfect on stolen base attempts (11-for-11) and has thrown out 7 of 11 attempted base stealers behind the plate.

► On the mound, VMI carries a 4.76 ERA as a staff, highlighted by Hunter Sipe being the Keydets' most consistent arm, posting a 1.57 ERA with 21 strikeouts across 23 innings, while Buddy Baker leads the bullpen with a 1.46 ERA in 12.1 innings of relief.

103 YEARS, 448 MILES, 10 MEETINGS

► Cornell and VMI renew acquaintances this weekend for the first time in nearly 98 years, with the two programs having met just 10 times previously — the first coming 103 years ago on April 7, 1923, in what was the first of seven consecutive seasons the two sides faced each other.

► The most recent meeting came on April 1, 1929, also in Lexington, Va., where VMI edged the Big Red, 1-0, on a two-hit shutout from Keydets pitcher Lefty Williams, who struck out seven Cornell batters. Gilly Laughorn provided the game's only run with a two-out RBI single.

► It is worth noting that Cornell and VMI met in a three-game series in Lexington from March 26-28, 1957, though the results counted in VMI's official records but not Cornell's, as the Big Red considered the games exhibitions. The Big Red won two of the three contests, taking the opener 16-6 and the rubber match 9-1, with VMI claiming the middle game 5-3.

► The two programs were also scheduled to meet in a three-game series on March 14-15, 2020, but the Ivy League cancelled all spring practices and competitions on March 11 — a day before the NCAA cancelled all winter and spring championships due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

► Across the previous 10 official meetings, Cornell and VMI have split the series evenly at five wins apiece, though the Keydets have won each of the last three. The Big Red will be seeking its first victory over VMI since a 13-7 win on April 7, 1927, in which Cornell plated eight unanswered runs across the final three innings, capped by a six-run ninth that broke open a 7-7 tie. Shortstop **EUGENE BALDERSTON** led the way with three hits, including a triple, as one of four Cornell players with multi-hit performances.

► All five of Cornell's wins in the series have featured the Big Red scoring at least nine runs, with 10 or more in each of its last four victories over the Keydets.

BOOTH FIELD



► After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

► Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher **RICH BOOTH** '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

► The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

10TH SEASON AT CORNELL

Years in Role: 10th Season as Head Coach

DAN PEPICELLI, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball, was named the 17th head coach in Cornell baseball history on Aug. 10, 2015, and is entering his 11th season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 114 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
