### FIRST PITCH

► The Cornell baseball team (2-11) concludes its season-opening 16-game road trip this weekend when it begins Ivy League play at Princeton (5-11) in a three-game series at Clarke Field in Princeton, N.J.

### WEEKEND REWIND

► Cornell picked up its best win of the young season in Saturday's opener, rallying for five unanswered runs to knock off VMI 7-4 and snap the Keydets' six-game winning streak. Freshman forward **JAKE HOWER**'s two-run single staked the Big Red to an early lead, and a five-batter eruption in the fifth — featuring RBI singles from junior infielder **OWEN CARLSON**, sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA**, Hower and junior infielder **KEVIN HAGER** — put the game out of reach. Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** was sharp in his five-inning start (1 unearned run, 0 walks, 4 Ks), sophomore right-hander **JOHN HEGARTY** added 2 1/3 hitless innings of relief, and junior right-hander **MAX FOSTER** closed it with a game-ending double play to earn his second save of the season.

► The nightcap swung the other way in a hurry — VMI's Clark Driscoll limited Cornell to four hits over 6 1/3 innings, the Keydets capitalized on three Cornell throwing errors and 12 Big Red walks on the day, and a Cole Raile homer set the tone in an 8-0 VMI win to even the series heading into Sunday.

► The rubber match turned into a gut-punch. Cornell led 3-1 through five innings behind an efficient start by senior right-handed pitcher Ethan Hamill — yielding one run and no walks on 61 pitches — but the bullpen couldn't hold it. Grayson Fitzwater greeted reliever junior right-handed pitcher **ETHAN VAN SICE** in the sixth with a home run to tie the game and an Ayden Schnarrs RBI single gave VMI its first lead at 4-3. Freshman **ROSS YOSHIDA** steadied things, escaping a bases-loaded jam to keep it a one-run deficit, and Cornell managed to claw back with two outs in the ninth — Carlson's bloop single and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN**'s RBI double tied the game at 4-4 — but Bradley Garner ended it with a walk-off three-run blast to give VMI the series win.

### IVY LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

► Junior infielder **OWEN CARLSON** was named the Ivy League's Player of the Week on the Monday following his dominant performance in the Big Red's three-game weekend series at VMI.

► Carlson was a force at the plate, reached base safely in 10 of his 14 plate appearances and did not strike out once. Overall, the Los Angeles native went 6-for-10 (.600) with a double, drawing four walks and scoring five runs, while posting a .714 on-base percentage and .700 slugging percentage for a 1.414 OPS.

► His .600 batting average was the best figure among all eligible Ivy League batters and ranked 23rd nationally, while his .714 OBP also led all Ancient Eight hitters and ranked 17th across Division I baseball.

► The Los Angeles native recorded a pair of three-hit games over the weekend, finishing in a tie with fellow junior infielder **LUKE JOHNSON** for the team lead in hits (six).

- ▶ Princeton enters this weekend's series having played the nation's 11th-most difficult schedule, with their past opponents combining for a 196-101 record.
- ▶ The Tigers have an Ivy League-best two shutouts on the season, tied for the 19th-highest total in Division I baseball.
- ▶ Cornell is seeking its first series victory over Princeton since taking three out of four games from the Tigers in 2015.

### ON THIS DATE: MARCH 21

- ▶ Cornell will be playing on March 21 for the 37th and 38th times next Saturday. The Big Red are 11-25 on the date, highlighted by a 4-2 win over Tennessee in 1972.
- ▶ Saturday marks the earliest the Big Red will ever play a conference opponent in program history, besting the previous record of March 22, set over each of the last two seasons.
- ▶ The Big Red have alternated results in each of the last five games played on March 21, dating back to 2009. Three of the last four March 21 games have been decided by one run.

- ▶ Sunday is slated to be the Big Red's 43rd all-time game on March 22, with Cornell having a 13-28-1 record.
- ▶ Cornell will be seeking its third consecutive win on March 22, matching the longest such streak since sweeping a 1979 twin bill from Hawai'i-Hilo and beating Clemson in 1980.

- ▶ Harvard enters its Ivy League-opening series at Columbia this weekend with a 1-12 overall record.
- ▶ The Crimson, currently in the midst of a season-opening 20-game road swing, snapped its 12-game losing streak with a 14-12 win at California Baptist on Monday.
- ▶ Despite losing last year's series in Cambridge, Cornell has won five of the last eight games against Harvard.

### ON THIS DATE: MARCH 28

- ▶ Cornell will be playing on March 28 for the 39th and 40th times next Saturday. The Big Red are 18-19-1 on the date and have won five of its last nine (5-4).
- ▶ Of the previous 38 games played on the date, only five have come in Ithaca (1996, 1998, 2009 doubleheader, 2025).
- ▶ The Big Red and Crimson will be playing on March 28 for the first time in program history. All three previous games against Ivy League competition on the date came against Brown, where Cornell has a 1-2 record.

# CORNELL BASEBALL

## BARELA-ZING HOT

► Sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** is riding a career-high nine-game hitting streak into this weekend's series, batting .475 (19-for-40) with a home run and three RBI over that span.

► During his current streak, Barela went 5-for-6 in Cornell's series finale at Fordham, marking the program's first five-hit game in seven years.

► Over his last 17 games — all of which have been starts, dating back to last season — Barela is slashing .357/.378/.514 with two doubles, three home runs and nine RBI in 70 at-bats.

► With a base hit in the series opener on Saturday, Barela will have the Big Red's first 10-game hit streak since former outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** last season.

## BIG RED BATS AMONG IVY'S BEST

► Cornell boasts five of the top 10 batting averages in the Ivy League entering this weekend, led by sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** (.368) and junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON** (.365). Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** (.327), junior third baseman **LUKE JOHNSON** (.313), and freshman right fielder **JAKE HOWER** (.311) round out the group — giving the Big Red five representatives in the league's top 10, more than any other program. Yale is the only other team with multiple players in the top 10, checking in with three.

► The statistical reach extends well beyond batting average. Carlson ranks among the Ivy League's best in multiple categories, sitting fourth in OPS (.943), seventh in slugging percentage (.500), eighth in on-base percentage (.443), third in hits (19) and tied for sixth in runs (10). Barela is second in the conference with 21 hits, one base knock away from tying Yale's Garrett Larsen (22) for the league lead in the category. Hower is tied for seventh in RBI (11) and tied for fourth in hit-by-pitches (5). Senior center fielder **CADEN WILDMAN**'s four doubles place him tied for fourth in the league.

## ON-BASE BRIGADE

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** and junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON** recently had their career-long on-base streaks snapped — Hager at 21 games and Carlson at 19 — making them the first Cornell teammates to each post on-base streaks of at least 15 games since **JOHN QUINLAN** '25 (35 games) and **JAKOBI DAVIS** '25 (24 games) across the 2024 and 2025 seasons.

► Despite the streaks ending, both have remained consistent producers, and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** has joined them as the Big Red's most reliable offensive contributors recently.

► Carlson has reached safely in 20 of his last 21 games, batting .299 with two home runs and 13 RBI over that span. Hager has reached safely in 56 of his last 60 games, slashing .294/.406/.422 with seven home runs, 35 RBI and six stolen bases. Wildman has reached safely in 24 of his last 27 games, slashing .324/.397/.451 with two home runs, 15 RBI and six stolen bases.

## REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

► Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** both enter this weekend's series having already surpassed the century mark for strikeouts, as the duo continues to climb Cornell's all-time strikeout leaderboard.

► Following his four-strikeout outing in the opening game of last Saturday's doubleheader at VMI, Mayfield became the 20th Cornell pitcher since 1947 to register at least 135 career strikeouts. He enters this weekend in sole possession of 20th place with his 135 career punchouts — the most by a Cornell pitcher since **TIM WILLITTES** concluded his career with 140 in 2018 — and is five strikeouts away from matching **BLAKE HAMILTON** (140, 2004-07) for 17th place in program history. He is also nine strikeouts away from tying **EDWARD WINNICK** (144, 1949-51) and **NICK BAYER** (144, 1997-00) from entering the top 15 all-time.

► Keller enters the weekend with 114 career strikeouts, tied with **BRIAN McAFEE** for 32nd place. He jumped ahead of six pitchers over his pair of relief outings at Fordham two weekends ago, where four of his five outs recorded came via strikeout.

► Mayfield and Keller are the first pair of Cornell teammates to simultaneously reach at least 100 career strikeouts since Willittes (139) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (122) accomplished the feat together in 2017.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

▶ Cornell plated 229 runs in 34 games last season, averaging 6.74 runs per game — the fifth-highest mark in program history (minimum 25 games). Only the 1891 (9.28), 1900 (7.45), 2024 (7.11) and 1902 (6.96) teams averaged more, marking just the ninth time in program history Cornell averaged at least 6.50 runs per game.

▶ The Big Red have now averaged at least 6.74 runs per game in back-to-back seasons, as the 2024 squad averaged 7.11 runs per game — the first time Cornell has averaged at least 6.70 runs per game in consecutive seasons since a four-year stretch from 1899 to 1902.

▶ Cornell has excelled at scoring in bunches recently, as 174 of Cornell's 229 runs in 2025 came during multi-run innings (77.7 percent). Since the beginning of the 2024 season, 79.0 percent of Cornell's runs (437-of-553) have come in multi-run innings, a trend that has continued into 2026, as six of the Big Red's 11 runs scored in last weekend's three-game series at VMI came in multi-run frames, all of which came in its 7-4 series-opening win over the Keydets.

▶ Entering this weekend, Cornell has scored 55 runs over its 13 games (averaging 4.23 runs per game) and another 200-plus-run season would mark the first time the Big Red have scored at least 200 runs in three straight seasons since a three-year stretch from 2008 to 2010.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

▶ Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first, and have hit at least one home run per game in each of the last two seasons — only the eighth and ninth times since 1947 that Cornell had averaged at least 0.75 home runs per game.

▶ Including six home runs through 13 games this season, the Big Red have hit a combined 101 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — four more than the program hit across the six seasons from 2018-23 combined (2018 — 18; 2019 — 13; 2020 — 3; 2022 — 33; 2023 — 30), which did not include a 2021 season due to the pandemic.

▶ In the opening game of Cornell's final regular-season series against Princeton last season at Booth Field in Ithaca, the Big Red launched six home runs in a 15-1 victory, highlighted by two home runs apiece from **MARK QUATRANI** and **KYLE MUSSER**. The output marked Cornell's third game with at least six home runs in program history, all of which have come in the last 10 years. Cornell posted its program-record seven-home run game against Dartmouth on March 30, 2024, also at Booth Field and a six-homer outing at Wofford on March 12, 2016.

▶ Cornell has hit at least five home runs in a game six times in program history, four of which have come since 2016.

JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

▶ Cornell's 11-inning contest against Northwestern on Feb. 21, as part of its season-opening four-game series in the Hub City Invitational in Spartanburg, S.C., was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since it defeated Navy in 11 innings, 3-2, in the nightcap of a March 9, 2019, doubleheader, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.

▶ In fact, Cornell has not gone to extra innings much since 2019, as the Big Red are tied with Alcorn State and Princeton for the fourth-fewest games beyond the required inning total. Only Alabama A&M (seven), Saint Peter's (eight) and Mississippi Valley State (nine) have played fewer extra-inning games over that span.

▶ Cornell's last extra-inning win came at Yale on March 22, 2025, a 13-12 slugfest, while its last win in a game that went at least 12 innings came on April 27, 2014, when it defeated Princeton, 4-2, in 14 innings. The Big Red's last time going at least 12 innings came on March 13, 2015, when it fell to LIU Brooklyn, 5-4, in the RussMatt Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla.

## STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has established itself as one of the nation's most consistent defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons, despite committing six errors in last Sunday's series finale against Fordham.

► After setting a then-program record with a .975 fielding percentage in 2024 (35 errors in 1,407 chances), the Big Red improved to .976 last season, committing just 30 errors in 1,113 opportunities — the fewest in Division I baseball, two fewer than Charlotte (32). Cornell's .976 fielding percentage ranked 49th nationally last season, leading all Ivy League teams by four-plus points over second-place Dartmouth (.971).

► Posting at least a .975 fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons, Cornell is one of 22 Division I programs to reach that threshold, while being one of six that are not Power Four programs, joining Cal Poly, Dallas Baptist, Fresno State, San Diego and UC Irvine.

► Since 2024, Cornell's .972 fielding percentage (86 errors in 3,088 chances) ranks 99th nationally and leads all eight Ivy League programs by nearly four points over second-place Yale (.968).

► The Big Red's 86 errors across that span are the second-fewest in Division I baseball, trailing only Notre Dame by one (85). Cornell is one of six programs to commit fewer than 100 errors over that stretch, joining Dallas Baptist and Northwestern (90 each), Arkansas and Auburn (95 each) and Georgia (98).

► Among Ivy League programs, Cornell's 82 errors are 31 fewer than Yale (117), who have committed the second-fewest miscues in the conference.

## "14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

► Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

► Ford was hired as Cornell's 15th head coach on Jan. 21, 1991 — just one week before the Big Red began indoor workouts and seven weeks before the season opener. Despite the quick turnaround, Cornell posted a 23-17 record in Ford's debut season, including an 11-2 start — the best 13-game start in program history — and a come-from-behind victory over No. 6 Georgia Tech.

► During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

► Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990.

► In 70 career games (68 starts) for Cornell, Hager is hitting .275 with eight doubles, seven home runs and 38 RBI. This year, Hager is batting .327 with one home run and five RBI through 13 games.

► "Tom has been a tremendous representative of our program," said **DAN PEPICELLI**, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball. "Nobody has been more committed than Coach Ford to developing our guys into better players and men. He has been an absolute rock of stability and wisdom in our program."

## ROAD WARRIORS

► Cornell is scheduled to begin its 2026 season playing its first 16 games away from Booth Field before its home opener, a doubleheader, against Harvard on March 28.

► If the Big Red plays all 16 games before its home opener, it would be the program's most games played before its season opener since 2023, when it played its first 18 games away from Ithaca, while tying for the fifth-longest road trip to begin a season, matching outputs from 2007 and 2013. Only the teams from 1984 (21 games), 2012, 2019 and 2023 (19 each) had to wait longer to play their first game in front of the Big Red faithful at home.

► In total, Cornell will register just under 4,000 miles of travel (3,859) over the opening five weekends of play before hosting Harvard.

## LOOK AT WHO'S BACK

► Cornell returns 81.8 percent of innings pitched from 2025 — the seventh-highest percentage in Division I baseball. The Big Red bring back 10 of 12 wins, 234 2/3 of 287 innings pitched, and 82.7 percent of its strikeouts (186 of 225) from last season.

► Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** (2-2, 4.26 ERA) leads the returning rotation after striking out 56 batters in 61 1/3 innings while limiting opponents to a .191 batting average in 2025. Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** returns after missing all of 2025 to injury. In 2024, Hamill logged a team-high 58 1/3 innings pitched with a 5.71 ERA across 12 appearances (nine starts).

► Offensively, Cornell brings back 41.8 percent of its production from 2025, including four of eight primary starters. The Big Red return 41.0 percent of its hits (132 of 322), only 12 of its 45 home runs (26.7 percent) and 74 of 207 RBIs (35.7 percent). Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** leads all returning hitters after posting a .282 batting average with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, and nine stolen bases.

► Key departures include catcher **MARK QUATRANI**, who transferred to Notre Dame and had a .318 batting average with six home runs and 24 RBI; outfielders **JAKOBI DAVIS** (.246, 5 HR, 19 RBI, 9 SB) and **JOHN QUINLAN** (.246, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 11 SB); utility player **RYAN PORTER** (.324, 7 HR, 23 RBI); and infielder **MAX JENSEN**, who is playing at Vanderbilt after an injury cut his 2025 campaign short.

## IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

► The Ivy League preseason poll was announced back on Feb. 12, with Columbia pitted as the preseason favorite for a second consecutive season following a vote of 16 pollsters, comprised of two representatives from each of the eight Ivy League programs.

► The Lions, who finished as co-regular-season champions with Yale last year, garnered nine first-place votes and concluded with 118 points. The Bulldogs received the remaining seven first-place votes and had 116 points.

► Penn (100 points) finished behind both Columbia and Yale for third place, serving as the other Ancient Eight program to receive over 100 points.

► After Harvard (73 points) was picked to finish fourth, Princeton (49 points), Cornell (45 points) and Dartmouth (41 points) were only separated by eight points. Brown rounded out the eight-team poll with 34 points.

## SCOUTING PRINCETON

- ▶ Princeton enters this weekend's series with Cornell having a 5-11 overall record. Over its first two weekends of play, Princeton took at least one game from both No. 17 NC State, 1-0, and Duke, 8-7.
- ▶ The Tigers, who have played the nation's 12th-hardest schedule so far (opponents are a combined 196-103, .656), have won three of their last five games after splitting a two-game weekday series with Winthrop and splitting a four-game set at Wofford this past weekend.
- ▶ Brady Kaufman leads Princeton's batting order with his .310 batting average. Jake Koonin owns the team lead in hits (15), doubles (three) and stolen bases (four). Will Robbins has the best slugging percentage (.459) and OPS (.808) and is tied with Bennett Crerar in home runs (two) and Isaac Lamson in RBI (seven).
- ▶ Justin Kim, the reigning Ivy League Pitcher of the Week after tossing seven shutout innings in a no-decision at Wofford last week, has a team-leading 4.43 ERA in 20.1IP, holding opponents to a .235 batting average.

## 139 YEARS, 232 MILES, 268 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell and Princeton have met 268 times prior to this weekend's three-game series, dating back to the inaugural game between the programs on May 19, 1888, in Princeton, N.J.
- ▶ Princeton owns the series lead over Cornell, 163-103-2, and has won 13 of the last 18 contests. Despite its recent success over the Big Red, Cornell has won three out of the last five in the series. The Big Red's three-game win streak, spanning between March 24, 2024, and May 3, 2025, was tied for the fourth-longest string of wins against the Tigers and its longest since posting a trio of wins between April 30, 2017, and March 31, 2018.
- ▶ A win in the opening game of Saturday's twin bill will mark Cornell's first time winning consecutive games on Princeton's home turf since having a 13-4 win in the nightcap of an April 24, 2015 twin bill and a 4-3 win in seven innings in the opening game of an April 30, 2016 doubleheader.
- ▶ The last time Cornell had won three straight road contests against the Tigers was during a four-game win streak between April 29, 2012, and April 27, 2014.

► After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

► Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher **RICH BOOTH** '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

► The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

**D**AN PEPICELLI, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball, was named the 17th head coach in Cornell baseball history on Aug. 10, 2015, and is entering his 11th season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 115 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.


