FIRST PITCH

► The Cornell baseball team travels to West Point, N.Y., to face former EIBL opponent Army (14-11) in a Tuesday midweek contest from Johnson Stadium at Doubleday Field. First pitch between the Big Red and Black Knights is scheduled for 3:30 p.m. Game action will be broadcast on ESPN+ with Nikolai Busko providing commentary.

WEEKEND REWIND

► Cornell baseball went 1-2 in its opening home series of the season, splitting a Sunday doubleheader with Harvard before dropping the series finale Monday at Booth Field.

► Junior left-hander **HUXLEY HOLCOMBE** set the tone for the weekend, recording the team's first quality start of the season in the doubleheader opener by allowing one run on one hit over six innings while striking out a career-high seven batters. The Big Red fell 2-1 on a two-out solo home run in the eighth inning, with freshman right-handed pitcher **ROSS YOSHIDA** taking the loss despite allowing just one run in three innings of relief.

► Cornell bounced back in the nightcap, scoring three times in the first inning and cruising to a 9-4 win. Junior third baseman **LUKE JOHNSON**, freshman right fielder **JAKE HOWER** and senior second baseman **TJ SWIDORSKI** combined to go 6-for-10 with five runs scored and six RBI to carry the offense, with Johnson finishing 2-for-3 with a home run and three RBI. Junior right-hander **ETHAN VAN SICE** tossed six innings of two-run ball for the win.

► Harvard closed the series on Monday afternoon with a 16-3 victory, scoring 13 unanswered runs after Cornell trimmed the deficit to one in the first inning. Swidorski hit .364 with two RBI across the three games to lead the Big Red offensively on the weekend. Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** (.333, 3-for-9, three runs, one double) and Johnson (.300, 3-for-10, three runs, home run, three RBI) also joined Swidorski in batting at least .300 on the weekend.

SALUTING THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

► Today's contest marks Cornell's first time it is facing a Patriot League opponent since April 3, 2019, when the Big Red traveled to West Point to face Army.

► In that contest, the Big Red registered a 4-1 victory as senior catcher **WILL SIMONEIT** went 5-for-5 with his second home run of the season and junior right-handed pitcher **JEB BEMISS** struck out a career-high eight batters across 5.2 scoreless innings.

► The Big Red are also scheduled to face Bucknell, a fellow member of the Patriot League, at Booth Field on April 28 before Cornell's final Ivy League series against Columbia (May 2-3).

► Last season, Cornell was scheduled to play at Bucknell in Lewisburg, Pa., for a midweek contest, but weather forced the game to be canceled.

NEWS AND NOTES

- ▶ Cornell and Army are meeting for the first time since April 3, 2019, when the Big Red posted a 4-1 win at Doubleday Field.
- ▶ The Big Red own a slim 38-37 series lead over the Black Knights, despite Army posting a 26-20 all-time home record against Cornell, including a 24-19 mark at Doubleday Field.
- ▶ Since the Black Knights departed the now-defunct EIBL in 1992, today is the 10th time Cornell and Army are facing each other. Eight of the last nine meetings have been held at West Point, with Cornell going 3-5 in the last eight.
- ▶ Army (14-11, 6-3 Patriot League) is coming off claiming the baseball star of the Star Series, presented by USAA, after taking the rubber match against Navy, 4-3, on Sunday.
- ▶ Josiah Overbeek is averaging 1.22 walks per game, good for the eighth nationally. Overbeek's .505 on-base percentage and .643 slugging percentage both lead all qualified Patriot League hitters.
- ▶ The Black Knights boast the nation's 19th-best fielding percentage in the country, committing just 17 errors in 935 fielding chances (.982 fielding percentage).

- ▶ Saturday is scheduled to serve as the Big Red's 52nd and 53rd all-time games on April 4. Cornell is 19-32 on the date, but has won three of its last four.
- ▶ Cornell and Dartmouth have played on April 4 four times prior to this weekend, with the Big Red going 3-1. The Big Red swept a 1998 doubleheader, 8-5 and 11-1, in Ithaca, before splitting a 2015 twin bill in Hanover, 1-0 win and 8-5 loss.
- ▶ The Big Red are 6-5 all-time at home on April 4 and have won its last two games, defeating Canisius, 6-5 in 10 innings, in 2018 and Ithaca, 13-3, in 2023.

ON THIS DATE: APRIL 5

- ▶ Sunday would be the Big Red's 55th all-time game on April 5. Cornell is 21-32-1 on the date and is 4-2 in its last six.
- ▶ Over its last three games on the date, Cornell is averaging 15.7 runs per game (47 total runs scored).
- ▶ It would be Cornell's first home game on April 5 since 2005, when it split a doubleheader with Yale. Each of the last 12 games on April 5 have been road contests.
- ▶ Cornell is 10-9 all-time at home on April 5, but has won just two of its last seven games in Ithaca.

► **THIS WEEKEND:** Keller is scheduled to make his 43rd career appearance and his 22nd career start this afternoon ... today will be Keller's first start since March 1, 2025, at UMBC, snapping his streak of 14 consecutive relief outings.

► **LAST TIME OUT:** Allowed 1R on 1H with 1BB in 0.1IP of relief in opening game of doubleheader at Princeton (March 21) ... four of 10 pitches went for strikes.

► **2025:** Started two of his 10 appearances, posting 1-1 record with 19.38 ERA over 13.0IP ... started first two outings against No. 17 Duke (Feb. 22) and UMBC (March 1), combining to throw 3.1IP ... lone scoreless outing came against Columbia (April 5) in 0.2IP ... lone win of season against Towson (March 15) after pitching 3.2IP and posting season-high 4SO ... other multi-strikeout outing came against Penn (April 13), fanning trio of Quakers batters in 1.1IP.

► **2024:** Started eight of his 13 appearances, registering 1-6 record with 6.55 ERA ... lone win came against Yale (April 20) after a six-inning outing, allowing 2R/ER on 4H with 6SO and 0BB; outing was second quality start of season, joining March 22 appearance at Princeton (6.0IP, 1ER), where he had season- and career-high 9SO ... 6.0IP was most on season, accomplishing feat against Princeton and Yale.

CORNELL BASEBALL

BARELA-ZING HOT

► Despite seeing his career-high nine-game hitting streak come to an end in the Big Red's series at Princeton two weekends ago, sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** continues to have a hot bat, batting .361 (22-for-61) with two home runs and seven RBI over his last 15 games, 12 of which have included him having at least one hit.

► During his nine-game hit streak that spanned between Feb. 27 and March 15, Barela went 5-for-6 in Cornell's series finale at Fordham (March 8), marking the program's first five-hit game in seven years.

► Over his last 23 games — all of which have been starts, dating back to last season — Barela is slashing .308/.330/.462 with two doubles, four home runs and 13 RBI in 91 at-bats.

BIG RED BATS AMONG IVY'S BEST

► Cornell boasts two of the top seven batting averages in the Ivy League entering this weekend, led by junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON**'s Ivy League-leading .373 average. After Brown's Alex Benevento (.369) and Yale's trio of Chris DiPrima (.360), Garrett Larsen (.354) and Colin Sloan (.345), Brown's Mika Petersen (.333) is right ahead of Big Red junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** (.329).

► The statistical reach extends well beyond batting average as Carlson ranks among the Ivy League's best in multiple categories, also leading in on-base percentage (.472), fourth in OPS (.964) and seventh in slugging percentage (.492). Hager also has the Ivy League's eighth-best on-base percentage (.413).

► Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** is tied for the fourth-most doubles (6), while freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER** is tied for second after being hit by eight opposing pitches this season. Junior infielder **LUKE JOHNSON**'s seven stolen bases are tied for the eighth-most in the Ivy League.

NO HIT, HEGARTY

► Of sophomore right-hander **JOHN HEGARTY**'s six relief outings so far this season, four have featured him pitching multiple innings and not yielding a run or hit. Three of his four such outings have come in his last four appearances.

► Hegarty opened his season with four hitless innings against Northwestern in Spartanburg, S.C., in the Hub City Invitational on Feb. 21 before allowing three hits and three earned runs at Richmond. Since that outing, Hegarty has not allowed a run or hit over his last 8 1/3 innings pitched, posting a 2-0 record with a 0.24 WHIP over that span. He has issued just two walks and has four strikeouts.

► Despite not being among Cornell's qualified pitchers to officially enter the Ivy League leaders, Hegarty has a team-leading 1.76 ERA and 0.91 WHIP among Big Red pitchers with at least 10 innings pitched. He has allowed five hits in 48 at-bats, yielding just a .104 batting average against.

ON-BASE BRIGADE

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** and junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON** recently had their career-long on-base streaks snapped — Hager at 21 games and Carlson at 19 — making them the first Cornell teammates to each post on-base streaks of at least 15 games since **JOHN QUINLAN** '25 (35 games) and **JAKOBI DAVIS** '25 (24 games) across the 2024 and 2025 seasons.

► Despite the streaks ending, both have remained consistent producers, and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** has joined them as the Big Red's most reliable offensive contributors recently.

► Carlson has reached safely in 26 of his last 27 games, batting .304 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, 24 RBI and drawn 27 walks over that span. Across his active seven-game on-base streak, Carlson has a .500/.645/.545 slash line with one double, two RBI, eight walks drawn compared to two strikeouts.

► Hager has reached safely in 56 of his last 60 games, slashing .298/.410/.413 with 10 doubles, five home runs, 33 RBI, 30 walks and 14 hit by pitches drawn, along with five stolen bases.

► Wildman has reached safely in 31 of his last 36 games, slashing .288/.391/.432 with 10 doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI and seven stolen bases.

FOSTERING SAVES

► Junior right-handed pitcher **MAX FOSTER** picked up his Ivy League-leading third save of the season in Cornell's 6-3 win at Princeton on March 21. Foster is tied with Dartmouth's Mac Burke and Penn's Penn's Connor Darling and Aidan von Zuben for the second-most saves in the Ivy League, behind Brown's Christian Keel (four). Foster is one of eight Ivy League pitchers with multiple saves this season.

► With another save, Foster would have the most saves by a Cornell pitcher since **JOHN NATOLI** had seven saves during the 2019 campaign.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

► Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** both enter this weekend's series having already surpassed the century mark for strikeouts, as the duo continues to climb Cornell's all-time strikeout leaderboard.

► Following his four-strikeout outing in the opening game of Cornell's March 21 doubleheader at Princeton, Mayfield upped his career total to 139, matching **TIM WILLITTES** (139, 2014-18). With his next strikeout, Mayfield will match **BLAKE HAMILTON** (140, 2004-07) for 17th place in program history. Mayfield is also five strikeouts away from tying **EDWARD WINNICK** (144, 1949-51) and **NICK BAYER** (144, 1997-00) from entering the top 15 all-time.

► Keller enters the weekend with 114 career strikeouts, tied with **BRIAN McAFEE** for 32nd place. He jumped ahead of six pitchers over his pair of relief outings at Fordham three weekends ago, where four of his five outs recorded came via strikeout.

► Mayfield and Keller are the first pair of Cornell teammates to simultaneously reach at least 100 career strikeouts since Willittes (139) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (122) accomplished the feat together in 2017.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

► Cornell plated 229 runs in 34 games last season, averaging 6.74 runs per game — the fifth-highest mark in program history (minimum 25 games). Only the 1891 (9.28), 1900 (7.45), 2024 (7.11) and 1902 (6.96) teams averaged more, marking just the ninth time in program history Cornell averaged at least 6.50 runs per game.

► The Big Red have now averaged at least 6.74 runs per game in back-to-back seasons, as the 2024 squad averaged 7.11 runs per game — the first time Cornell has averaged at least 6.70 runs per game in consecutive seasons since a four-year stretch from 1899 to 1902.

► Cornell has excelled at scoring in bunches recently, as 174 of Cornell's 229 runs in 2025 came during multi-run innings (77.7 percent). Since the beginning of the 2024 season, 79.1 percent of Cornell's runs (458-of-579) have come in multi-run innings, a trend that has continued into 2026, as 10 of the Big Red's 13 runs scored in this past weekend's three-game series against Harvard came in multi-run frames, including all eight of its nine runs in its 9-4 win in Sunday's nightcap.

► Entering today, Cornell has scored 81 runs over its 19 games (averaging 4.26 runs per game) and another 200-plus-run season would mark the first time the Big Red have scored at least 200 runs in three straight seasons since a three-year stretch from 2008 to 2010.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

► Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first, and have hit at least one home run per game in each of the last two seasons — only the eighth and ninth times since 1947 that Cornell had averaged at least 0.75 home runs per game.

► With 12 home runs in 19 games, the Big Red have hit a combined 107 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — 10 more than the program hit across the six seasons from 2018-23 combined (2018 — 18; 2019 — 13; 2020 — 3; 2022 — 33; 2023 — 30), which did not include a 2021 season due to the pandemic.

► In the opening game of Cornell's final regular-season series against Princeton last season at Booth Field in Ithaca, the Big Red launched six home runs in a 15-1 victory, highlighted by two home runs apiece from **MARK QUATRANI** and **KYLE MUSSER**. The output marked Cornell's third game with at least six home runs in program history, all of which have come in the last 10 years. Cornell posted its program-record seven-home run game against Dartmouth on March 30, 2024, also at Booth Field.

JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

► Cornell's 11-inning contest against Northwestern on Feb. 21, as part of its season-opening four-game series in the Hub City Invitational in Spartanburg, S.C., was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since it defeated Navy in 11 innings, 3-2, in the nightcap of a March 9, 2019, doubleheader, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.

► In fact, Cornell has not gone to extra innings much since 2019, as the Big Red are tied with Alcorn State, Mississippi Valley State and Princeton for the third-fewest games beyond the required inning total. Only Alabama A&M and Saint Peter's (eight each) have played fewer extra-inning games over that span.

► Cornell's last extra-inning win came in a 13-12 slugfest at Yale on March 22, 2025, while its last win in a game that went at least 12 innings came on April 27, 2014, in a 4-2 win over Princeton in 14 innings. The Big Red's last time going at least 12 innings came on March 13, 2015, when it fell to LIU Brooklyn, 5-4, in the RussMatt Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla.

STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has established itself as one of the nation's most consistent defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons, despite committing six errors in last Sunday's series finale against Fordham.

► After setting a then-program record with a .975 fielding percentage in 2024 (35 errors in 1,407 chances), the Big Red improved to .976 last season, committing just 30 errors in 1,113 opportunities — the fewest in Division I baseball, two fewer than Charlotte (32). Cornell's .976 fielding percentage ranked 49th nationally last season, leading all Ivy League teams by four-plus points over second-place Dartmouth (.971).

► Posting at least a .975 fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons, Cornell is one of 22 Division I programs to reach that threshold, while being one of six that are not Power Four programs, joining Cal Poly, Dallas Baptist, Fresno State, San Diego and UC Irvine.

► Since 2024, Cornell's .971 fielding percentage (95 errors in 3,305 chances) ranks 118th nationally and leads all eight Ivy League programs by nearly two percentage points over second-place Yale (.969).

► The Big Red's 95 errors across that span are the second-fewest in Division I baseball, trailing only Notre Dame by two (93). Cornell is one of five programs to commit fewer than 100 errors over that stretch, joining Northwestern (97) and Arkansas and Dallas Baptist (98 each).

► Among Ivy League programs, Cornell's 95 errors are 26 fewer than Yale (121), who have committed the second-fewest miscues in the conference.

"14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

► Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

► During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

► Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990. In 76 career games (74 starts) for Cornell, Hager is slashing .279/.387/.397 with 11 doubles, seven home runs and 39 RBI.

► This year, Hager is batting .329 with three doubles, one home run, six RBI and one stolen base through the Big Red's first 19 games.

LOOK AT WHO'S BACK

► Cornell returns 81.8 percent of innings pitched from 2025 — the seventh-highest percentage in Division I baseball. The Big Red bring back 10 of 12 wins, 234 2/3 of 287 innings pitched, and 82.7 percent of its strikeouts (186 of 225) from last season.

► Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** (2-2, 4.26 ERA) leads the returning rotation after striking out 56 batters in 61 1/3 innings while limiting opponents to a .191 batting average in 2025. Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** returns after missing all of 2025 to injury. In 2024, Hamill logged a team-high 58 1/3 innings pitched with a 5.71 ERA across 12 appearances (nine starts).

► Offensively, Cornell brings back 41.8 percent of its production from 2025, including four of eight primary starters. The Big Red return 41.0 percent of its hits (132 of 322), only 12 of its 45 home runs (26.7 percent) and 74 of 207 RBIs (35.7 percent). Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** leads all returning hitters after posting a .282 batting average with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, and nine stolen bases.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

► Columbia was pitted as the preseason favorite for a second consecutive season in the Ivy League preseason poll on Feb. 12, following a vote of 16 pollsters, comprised of two voters from the eight Ivy League programs.

► The Lions, who finished as co-regular-season champions with Yale in 2025, garnered nine first-place votes and had 118 points. The Bulldogs received the remaining seven first-place votes and had 116 points.

► Penn (100 points) finished behind both Columbia and Yale for third place, serving as the other Ancient Eight program to receive over 100 points.

► After Harvard (73 points) was picked to finish fourth, Princeton (49 points), Cornell (45 points) and Dartmouth (41 points) were only separated by eight points. Brown rounded out the eight-team poll with 34 points.

SCOUTING ARMY

- ▶ Army (14-11, 6-3 Patriot League) is coming off claiming the baseball star of the Star Series, presented by USAA, after taking the rubber match against Navy, 4-3, on Sunday in West Point.
- ▶ The Black Knights are concluding a stretch where they played 11 out 14 at Johnson Stadium at Doubleday Field. Since facing Merrimack in a two-game series on March 10-11, Army has posted a 9-4 record, which includes winning seven of its last eight games.
- ▶ Freshman two-way player Josiah Overbeek enters today's contest averaging 1.22 walks per game, good for the eighth-best average nationally. His 28 walks are the 21st-most free passes drawn in Division I baseball and are the second-most by a freshman in program history, trailing Daniel Cortez's record of 40 walks in 2012. Overbeek's seven home runs, which lead all Patriot League hitters, are the second-most by a first-year cadet, trailing Cole White's record of 10 from 2005.
- ▶ Overbeek also leads all qualified Patriot League hitters in on-base percentage (.505, 79th in NCAA) and slugging percentage (.643, 157th in NCAA), while ranking second in the league in saves (three).
- ▶ Thomas Schreck is the Patriot League's hardest batter to strikeout as he is averaging a punchout every 9.9 at bats, the 91st-best average in Division I baseball.
- ▶ Chris Barr, who has a team-leading 14 stolen bases this season, is two triples shy of matching Milan Dinga (2004-07) for Army's program record for the category. Barr is currently tied with Reggie Moore for the second-most triples. His 65 career steals are the fifth-most in program history.
- ▶ The Black Knights boast the nation's 19th-best fielding percentage in the country, committing just 17 errors in 935 fielding chances (.982 fielding percentage).

127 YEARS. 194 MILES. 75 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell and Army are meeting for the 76th time in program history and the first time in nearly eight years. The Big Red enter today's game owning a slight 38-37 edge in the all-time series, which began on May 27, 1899, also at West Point.
- ▶ In the last meeting between Cornell and Army on April 3, 2019, when it traveled to West Point and registered a 4-1 victory. Senior catcher **WILL SIMONEIT** went 5-for-5 with his second home run of the season and junior right-handed pitcher **JEB BEMISS** struck out a career-high eight batters through 5.2 scoreless innings.
- ▶ Simoneit recorded five of Cornell's then-season-high 13 hits on the day as four Cornell pitchers held the Black Knights to just five hits on the day.
- ▶ Today is the ninth consecutive time Cornell is playing Army at its home diamond as the Big Red's last time hosting the Black Knights in Ithaca came on April 27, 1992, a doubleheader that Cornell ended up sweeping, 5-4 in eight innings and 13-7 in seven innings. That was the final season Army was a member of the now-defunct EIBL.

BOOTH FIELD



► After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

► Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher **RICH BOOTH** '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

► The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

DAN PEPICELLI, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball, was named the 17th head coach in Cornell baseball history on Aug. 10, 2015, and is entering his 11th season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 115 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
