FIRST PITCH

► The Cornell baseball team (0-7) concludes its string of six consecutive games against Atlantic 10 opposition this weekend when it travels to the Bronx, N.Y., to face Fordham (2-8) in a three-game series at Houlihan Park.

► Saturday will feature the Big Red and Rams playing a doubleheader beginning at noon, before the series finale takes place Sunday, also at noon. None of the games on the weekend will be live streamed.

WEEKEND REWIND

► Cornell is coming off its second winless weekend of the season, where it was swept in a three-game series against Richmond at Pitt Field.

► Despite the results, Cornell's offense had an impressive weekend, where it batted .308 as a team, highlighted by sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** (.462, 6-for-13, home run, RBI), senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** (.455, 5-for-11, two doubles, one stolen base) and junior infielder **OWEN CARLSON** (.455, 5-for-11, two RBI) each batting at least .450. Freshman **AIDEN BARCLAY** (.364, 4-for-11, double) and junior infielder **KEVIN HAGER** (.333, 4-for-12, home run, 3 RBI) also posted batting averages north of .300 on the weekend.

► Richmond mustered 37 hits off Cornell pitching last weekend across 23-plus innings of work, posting a .350 average as a team. Nine of the Spiders' 37 hits were home runs.

► A bright spot of the Big Red's pitching corps last weekend was freshman right-handed pitcher **ROSS YOSHIDA**, who shined out of the Big Red bullpen. Yoshida allowing just one run on two hits across 3 2/3 frames, walking two and striking out four, while holding Richmond batters to just a .167 average.

JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

► Cornell's 11-inning contest against Northwestern on Feb. 21, as part of its season-opening four-game series in the Hub City Invitational in Spartanburg, S.C., was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since defeating Navy, 3-2 in 11 innings, in the nightcap of a doubleheader on March 9, 2019, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.

► In fact, Cornell has not gone to extra innings much since 2019, as the Big Red are tied with Alcorn State and Dartmouth for the fifth-fewest games beyond the required inning total. Only Alabama A&M and Saint Peter's (seven apiece) and Mississippi Valley State and Princeton (nine each) have played fewer extra-inning games over that span. Cornell's last time it played at least 12 innings was March 13, 2015, against LIU Brooklyn.

- ▶ It will be Cornell's fourth time playing an Atlantic 10 opponent on March 7, having played La Salle in 2008 (7-inning 1-0 loss; 4-0 win in five innings) and 2009 (7-2 loss).
- ▶ Saturday will be the third time Cornell is playing a doubleheader on March 7 after also splitting a twin bill against Villanova in 2004 (4-2 loss; 3-2 win).

ON THIS DATE: MARCH 8

- ▶ Cornell is 1-4 all-time on March 8, with its lone win coming against George Washington, 6-2, in a seven-inning contest to conclude a doubleheader in 2014.
- ▶ It is Cornell's first time playing on March 8 in successive seasons as the Big Red dropped a 13-12 slugfest against UAB last season on March 8 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C.
- ▶ Two of Cornell's five games played on March 8 have resulted in one-run contests.

CORNELL BASEBALL

STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has established itself as one of the nation's premier defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons. After setting a then-program record with a .975 fielding percentage in 2024 (35 errors in 1,407 chances), the Big Red improved to .976 last season, committing just 30 errors in 1,113 opportunities.

► The Big Red's 30 errors last season were the fewest in Division I baseball, two fewer than Charlotte (32). Its .976 fielding percentage ranked 49th nationally, leading all Ivy League teams by four-plus points (Dartmouth, .971).

► Since 2024, Cornell's .974 fielding percentage (75E in 2,873 chances) ranks 78th nationally and leads all eight Ivy League programs by nearly six points (Yale, .967).

► Posting at least a .975 fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons, Cornell is one of 22 Division I programs to reach that threshold, while being one of six that are not Power Four programs, joining Cal Poly, Dallas Baptist, Fresno State, San Diego and UC Irvine.

► The 75 errors committed by Cornell over the past two-plus seasons are the fewest in Division I baseball, one fewer than Notre Dame (76). Cornell is one of six programs that have committed under 95 errors over the past two-plus years, joining Notre Dame, Arkansas and Northwestern (86 each), Dallas Baptist (89) and Auburn (92). Among Ivy League programs, Cornell's 75 errors committed are a staggering 34 fewer than Dartmouth and Penn, who are tied for the second-highest total with 109 errors.

LOOK AT WHO'S BACK

► Cornell returns 81.8 percent of innings pitched from 2025 — the seventh-highest percentage in Division I baseball. The Big Red bring back 10 of 12 wins, 234 2/3 of 287 innings pitched, and 82.7 percent of its strikeouts (186 of 225) from last season.

► Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** (2-2, 4.26 ERA) leads the returning rotation after striking out 56 batters in 61 1/3 innings while limiting opponents to a .191 batting average in 2025. Senior right-hander **ETHAN HAMILL** returns after missing all of 2025 to injury. In 2024, Hamill logged a team-high 58 1/3 innings pitched with a 5.71 ERA across 12 appearances (nine starts).

► Offensively, Cornell brings back 41.8 percent of its production from 2025, including four of eight primary starters. The Big Red return 41.0 percent of its hits (132 of 322), only 12 of its 45 home runs (26.7 percent) and 74 of 207 RBIs (35.7 percent). Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** leads all returning hitters after posting a .282 batting average with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, and nine stolen bases.

► Key departures include catcher **MARK QUATRANI**, who transferred to Notre Dame and had a .318 batting average with six home runs and 24 RBI; outfielders **JAKOBI DAVIS** (.246, 5 HR, 19 RBI, 9 SB) and **JOHN QUINLAN** (.246, 5 HR, 25 RBI, 11 SB); utility player **RYAN PORTER** (.324, 7 HR, 23 RBI); and infielder **MAX JENSEN**, who is playing at Vanderbilt after an injury cut his 2025 campaign short.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

► The Ivy League preseason poll was announced Feb. 12, with Columbia pitted as the favorite for a second consecutive season following a vote of 16 pollsters.

► The Lions, who edged out last year's regular-season champion, Yale, garnered nine first-place votes and had 118 points. The Bulldogs received the remaining seven first-place votes and had 116 points. Penn (100 points) finished behind both Columbia and Yale for third place, serving as the other Ancient Eight program to receive over 100 points.

► After Harvard (73 points) was picked to finish fourth, Princeton (49 points), Cornell (45 points) and Dartmouth (41 points) were only separated by eight points. Brown rounded out the eight-team poll with 34 points.

DYNAMIC DUO

- ▶ While junior infielders **OWEN CARLSON** and **KEVIN HAGER** have made their homes defensively at second base and shortstop, respectively, for the Big Red, but also found their second home — getting on base.
- ▶ Despite having his 20-game on-base streak snapped last Sunday, Hager has also reached safely in 35 of his last 37 and in 56 of his 64 career games with at least one plate appearance.
- ▶ Carlson has reached safely in each of his last 18 contests and has been on base in 31 of last 32 and 37 of previous 39, dating back to the beginning of last season. During his current on-base streak, Carlson is slashing .307/.381/.387 with two home runs — both of which came in the opening weekend against Northwestern and Boston College, 11 RBI and drawing nine walks.
- ▶ Hager and Carlson became the first Big Red players with at least 15-game on-base streaks since **JOHN QUINLAN** '25 (35 games) and **JAKOBI DAVIS** '25 (24 games) each had their respective streaks spanning the 2024 and 2025 campaigns.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ Cornell is scheduled to begin its 2026 season playing its first 16 games away from Booth Field before its home opener, a doubleheader, against Harvard on March 28.
- ▶ If the Big Red ends up playing all 16 games before its home opener, it would be the program's longest season-opening road trip since 2023, when it played its first 18 games away from Ithaca.
- ▶ It would be tied for the fifth-longest road trip to begin a season, matching outputs from 2007 and 2013. Only the teams from 1984 (21 games), 2012, 2019 and 2023 (19 each) had to wait longer to play their first game in front of the Big Red faithful at home.
- ▶ In total, Cornell will register just under 4,000 miles of travel (3,859) over the opening five weekends of play before hosting Harvard.

MAYFIELD EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Senior right-hander **CARSON MAYFIELD** was named one of D1Baseball.com's top 200 starting pitchers in the nation on Feb. 5, becoming one of two Ivy League representatives on the preseason list alongside Yale sophomore Jack Ohman.
- ▶ After an injury-shortened 2024 season, Mayfield emerged as the ace of Cornell's rotation in 2025, posting a 2-2 record with a team-best 4.26 ERA over 61 1/3 innings. He struck out 56 batters while issuing just 26 walks and limited opponents to a .191 batting average — the 16th-lowest mark among qualifying Division I pitchers.
- ▶ Mayfield's dominance was further reflected in his nation-leading .213 BABIP (batting average on balls in play), which measures how often batted balls result in hits excluding home runs. His mark was six points lower than East Tennessee State's Brady Frederick, who ranked second nationally.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

- ▶ Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** each surpassed the century mark for strikeouts during the Big Red's three-game series against Penn last season on April 13-14.
- ▶ Following his six-strikeout outing in last Friday's loss to Richmond, Mayfield enters this weekend assuming sole possession of 22nd place with his 129 career punchouts. If he matches his strikeout total from last week, he would jump both **WILLIAM DeGRAAF** (134, 1954-56) and **JAY KOBYLARZ** (133, 1979-82) to assume sole possession of 20th place in program history.
- ▶ With his next strikeout, Mayfield would become the 22nd Cornell pitcher since 1947 to register at least 130 career strikeouts. Mayfield's 129 career strikeouts are the most by a Big Red hurler since Tim Willittes concluded his four-year career with the Big Red from 2014-18 with 140 punchouts.

- ▶ Keller, who struck out three batters in his relief outing against Richmond last Sunday, upped his career strikeout total to 110, breaking his tied with **THOMAS MacLEOD** (1969-70) and leaping ahead of **NICK BUSTO** (109, 2012-15) for sole possession of 38th on the Big Red's strikeout list.
- ▶ Mayfield and Keller are the first pair of Big Red teammates to simultaneously have at least 100 strikeouts since **TIM WILLITTES** (139 — 2014-18) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (122 — 2014-17) in 2017.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

▶ Cornell plated 229 runs in 34 games last season, averaging 6.74 runs per game — the fifth-highest mark in program history (minimum 25 games). Only the 1891 (9.28), 1900 (7.45), 2024 (7.11) and 1902 (6.96) teams averaged more. It marked just the ninth time in program history Cornell averaged at least 6.50 runs per game.

▶ The Big Red have excelled at scoring in bunches recently, as 174 of Cornell's 229 runs in 2025 came during multi-run innings (77.7 percent). Six of the Big Red's 11 runs scored in last weekend's three-game series at Richmond came in multi-run frames. Since the beginning of the 2024 season, 79.7 percent of Cornell's runs (420-of-527) have come in multi-run innings.

▶ Another 200-plus-run season would be Cornell's first time with at least 200 runs in three straight seasons since a three-year span from 2008 to 2010.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

▶ Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first.

▶ Last year marked the second time in program history and in as many seasons it registered at least one home run per game. It was only the ninth time since 1947 that Cornell had averaged at least 0.75 home runs per game.

▶ The Big Red have hit a combined 99 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — two more than the total the program hit across 2018-23 combined (2018 — 18; 2019 — 13, 2020 — 3; 2022 — 33; 2023 — 30).

▶ In the opening game of Cornell's final regular-season series against Princeton last year, the Big Red launched six home runs in a 15-1 victory, highlighted by two home runs apiece from **MARK QUATRANI** and **KYLE MUSSER**. It marked Cornell's third game with at least six home runs in program history, joining a seven-home run effort against Dartmouth on March 30, 2024, and a six-homer outing at Wofford on March 12, 2016.

▶ Cornell has hit at least five home runs in a game six times in program history, four of which have come since 2016.

"14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

▶ Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

▶ Ford was hired as Cornell's 15th head coach on Jan. 21, 1991 — just one week before the Big Red began indoor workouts and seven weeks before the season opener. Despite the quick turnaround, Cornell posted a 23-17 record in Ford's debut season, including an 11-2 start — the best 13-game start in program history — and a come-from-behind victory over No. 6 Georgia Tech.

▶ During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

▶ Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

▶ Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990.

▶ In 61 career games (59 starts) for Cornell, Hager has batted .256 with eight doubles, six home runs and 33 RBI. Last season, he hit .276 with seven doubles, two home runs and 21 RBI.

▶ "Tom has been a tremendous representative of our program," said **DAN PEPICELLI**, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball. "Nobody has been more committed than Coach Ford to developing our guys into better players and men. He has been an absolute rock of stability and wisdom in our program."

ALL-IVY AWARDS

- ▶ Five Cornell players earned All-Ivy recognition last season — the program's most since 2018 — led by catcher **MARK QUATRANI**'s second consecutive First Team selection.
- ▶ Quatrani became the first Cornell player to repeat as a First Team All-Ivy honoree since **RYAN KRAINZ** (2017-18) and just the 10th Big Red player to earn consecutive first-team selections. He was also the first Cornell catcher to achieve back-to-back first-team honors since **ED COTT** did so in 1968 and 1969.
- ▶ Two-way player **RYAN PORTER** was named Second Team All-Ivy as a utility player and earned Academic All-Ivy honors with a 3.93 GPA as an applied economics and management major.
- ▶ Right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD**, first baseman **KYLE MUSSER** and outfielder **JOHN QUINLAN** received Honorable Mention All-Ivy recognition.
- ▶ Of the five honorees from last season, only Mayfield returns for this season.

FUN WITH GEOGRAPHY

- ▶ Senior utility player **T.J. SWIDORSKI** and senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** are both from Woodbury, Minn., and attended East Ridge High School before arriving at Cornell in 2023. They are the second pair of Minnesota teammates in program history, joining a trio of Minnesotans — senior pitcher **TOM LAUGHLIN**, freshman infielder **JUSTIN MILO**, and freshman pitcher **MATT HILL** — who played together in 2007.
- ▶ The Big Red's nine New York natives are its most for a single season since having 10 New Yorkers on the 1994 roster. Cornell's seven Massachusetts natives on its 2026 roster, breaks the previous record for the most Bay Staters of four set on four occasions, which included last season (1950, 1980, 1990, and 2025).
- ▶ Staying in New England junior left-handed pitcher Andrew Houghton, who transferred from UMass, is the first New Hampshire native on the Big Red since right-handed pitcher **TAYLOR WOOD** in 2011.
- ▶ Sophomore right-hander **TAVIAN RAMOS** (Neenah, Wis.) is the fourth Wisconsin-born player in program history, joining infielders **THOMAS BOETTCHER** (1970-72, Madison) and **CURT STAUTZ** (1979, Madison), and right-hander **JONATHAN ZACHARIAS** (2019-22, Green Bay).
- ▶ Cornell has three sets of players who attended the same high school or prep school this season (seniors **CADEN WILDMAN** and **TJ SWIDORSKI** — East Ridge HS (Minn.); freshman right-handed pitcher **CONNOR NIEMIEC** and freshman infielder **AIDEN BARCLAY** — Deerfield Academy (Mass.); senior infielder **BECK UROFSKY** and freshman outfielder **TRENT LOPEZ** — Bethesda-Chevy Chase (Md.) HS), marking the program's first-ever time having at least a trio of graduates from the same high school on the same team.

- ▶ Fordham enters this weekend with a 2-8 overall record. After being swept by New Mexico in a four-game series in Albuquerque to begin the season, the Rams have registered at least one win in their last two weekend series against UNCW and Stetson, respectively.
- ▶ Despite only having a .229 batting average as a team, Anthony Grabau leads Fordham offensively with an impressive .484/.550/.710 slash line with one double, two home runs and 13 RBI. His RBI are nine more than the second-place holder on the team.
- ▶ Fordham pitchers have struggled to begin the season, registering more walks (74) than strikeouts (68), while allowing opponents to post a .350 batting average. The Rams pitching staff has a team ERA of 13.80, which stands as the Xth-worst figure in Division I baseball.

135 YEARS, 232 MILES, 20 MEETINGS

- ▶ Cornell and Fordham are playing against each other for the first time since 2019, when Cornell edged Fordham, 1-0, in Towson, Md., behind an impressive pitching performance from **COLBY WYATT**, who hurled 7 2/3 scoreless innings to earn his first victory of the season. Freshman **JUSTIN TAYLOR** led the game off reaching on a Rams throwing error before scoring on a sacrifice bunt by **KALANI MATTON**. Junior **ANDREW ELLISON** recorded the final four outs to register the save.
- ▶ It is the Big Red's first trip to Houlihan Park since a three-game series in 2018, which began with a pair of 4-3, 10-inning contests that were split evenly. The Rams ended up winning the rubber match, 5-3.
- ▶ The Big Red own a 13-7 lead the series, dating back to the first meeting at Fordham Field on May 28, 1891, which resulted in a 4-3 Fordham victory. Cornell is 10-6 all-time in the Bronx and 4-2 at Houlihan Park.

BOOTH FIELD



► After spending over 100-plus years at Hoy Field, Cornell's legendary, and storied, on-campus field, the Cornell baseball team officially moved to Booth Field, the program's brand-new, \$17.5 million off-campus facility on Friday, April 21, 2023.

► Booth Field is named in honor of former Cornell pitcher **RICH BOOTH** '82, who has shown "extraordinary leadership and generosity — much of its anonymous — over the last four decades."

► The facility features many state-of-the-art amenities for the Cornell baseball team, including a 1500-square foot team room and lounge, 1500-square foot locker room, and a 7000-square foot indoor area for batting cages and pitching mounds. A nutrition station, Hall of Fame area, and a coaches room is included at the facility, which was completed this past summer.

10TH SEASON AT CORNELL

DAN PEPICELLI, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball, was named the 17th head coach in Cornell baseball history on Aug. 10, 2015, and is entering his 11th season at the helm of the Cornell baseball program.

Pepicelli's 112 wins as the Big Red's head coach stand as the fourth-most in program history, trailing **TED THOREN** (515), **TOM FORD** (264), and **BILL WALKENBACH** (130).

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.
