FIRST PITCH

- ▶ Cornell (4-16, 2-4 Ivy League) returns to Booth Field this weekend for a three-game series against Dartmouth (5-13, 2-4 Ivy League), looking to secure its first series win of the season.
- ▶ With both programs sharing identical Ivy League records, this weekend's series serves as an early opportunity for either team to inch closer to playoff contention.
- ▶ Due to inclement weather, the series format has been adjusted to a single game Friday at 1 p.m., followed by a doubleheader Saturday beginning at 11:30 a.m. All three games will be streamed live on ESPN+ with **BRAD ROMANO** calling Friday's action before **ELI FASTIFF** (play-by-play) and **AUSTIN CURTIS** (analyst) provide the call for Saturday's doubleheader.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Cornell junior infielders **KEVIN HAGER** and **LUKE JOHNSON** each had three hits and two RBI, but Army pulled away with five unanswered runs across the fourth and sixth innings to defeat Cornell, 12-6, on Tuesday afternoon at Johnson Stadium at Doubleday Field.
- ▶ Hager finished with two solo home runs and Johnson added a double as nine Cornell batters combined for 13 hits.
- ▶ Senior left-hander **NOAH KELLER** struggled in his first start after 14 consecutive relief appearances, dating back to last season, yielding 4R/ER on 1H in 0.2IP. Freshman right-hander **ROSS YOSHIDA**, junior southpaw **ANDREW HOUGHTON** and junior right-hander **GRAHAM BIBEN**, making his collegiate debut, combined to allow one run over the final two innings.
- ▶ The contest at Army was the Big Red's fourth game in three days as Cornell went 1-2 against Harvard last weekend in its home-opening series. The Big Red and Crimson split last Sunday's doubleheader, Harvard winning the opener 2-1 before Cornell took the nightcap 9-4. Harvard claimed the rubber match resoundingly, 16-3, behind 13 unanswered runs.
- ▶ Junior left-hander **HUXLEY HOLCOMBE** recorded Cornell's first quality start of the season in the opening game of last weekend's twin bill, allowing 1R on 1H over 6.0IP while posting a career-high 7K. A two-out solo home run by Jack Rickeim in the eighth inning was the decisive play in the Crimson's 2-1 win. Yoshida took the loss despite allowing just 1R in 3.0IP of relief.

- ▶ Bouncing back in the nightcap, Cornell scored three times in the first inning en route to its 9-4 win. Johnson, freshman right fielder **JAKE HOWER** and senior second baseman **TJ SWIDORSKI** combined to go 6-for-10 with 5R and 6RBI to carry the offense, with Johnson finishing 2-for-3 with 1HR and 3RBI. Junior right-hander **ETHAN VAN SICE** also notched a quality start (6.0IP, 2ER) to record his first win of the season.
- ▶ Harvard closed out the series last Monday afternoon with a 16-3 victory, scoring 13 unanswered runs after Cornell trimmed its deficit to one, 3-2, in the first inning.

- ▶ The Big Green and Big Red have traded sweeping the regular-season series each of the last two seasons, with the home team winning the last seven games.
- ▶ Cornell swept Dartmouth in a three-game series at Booth Field in 2024, outscoring the Big Green 35-11.

ON THIS DATE: APRIL 3

- ▶ Friday will be the Big Red's 46th all-time game on April 3. Cornell is 20-25 on the date and has won two of its last three.
- ▶ April 3 has been common home date for Cornell, with 14 of the past 15 games being played at Hoy Field. It is the Big Red's first time playing on April 3 since falling to Yale, 18-5, in 2022.
- ▶ Cornell and Dartmouth have played four times previously on April 3, all of which have been in Ithaca. The Big Red are 2-2 against the Big Green, with doubleheader splits coming in 2000 and 2010.

- ▶ The Quakers defeated Delaware State, 10-5, on Tuesday in the first portion of the Liberty Bell Classic.
- ▶ As a pitching staff, Penn's 4.12 walks-per-9-innings leads all Ivy League programs and ranks in the top 100 nationally in ERA (4.88, 71st) WHIP (1.49, 84th) and SB/game (1.64, 90th).

- ▶ Next Saturday is slated to be the Big Red's 46th and 47th games on April 11. Cornell is 14-31 on the date and has one win in its last 12 games and three victories in its last 14 games on April 11.
- ▶ Cornell will be playing at Penn on April 11 for the third time in program history, joining a 10-1 loss in 1931 and splitting a 1983 twin bill (8-7 win in 8 innings; 5-1 loss in 7 innings).

CORNELL BASEBALL

WELCOME TO HAGERTOWN

► One of the Ivy League's toughest outs, junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** enters this weekend's series with a hit in each of his last five games — the longest active hit streak on the Big Red and his second streak of five-plus games this season. Over that stretch, Hager is hitting .412/.545/.882 (7-for-17) with 6R, 2 doubles, 2HR, 4RBI and 2HP.

► Hager's production extends well beyond his current streak. He has reached base safely in 65 of his last 70 games dating to the 2024 season, including 32 of his last 34, 47 of his last 50 and 57 of his last 61. Across his last 61 games, Hager is hitting .306/.417/.446 with 46R, 10 doubles, 7HR, 35RBI, 31BB, 14HP and 5SB.

USE THE FORCE, LUKE

► Junior infielder **LUKE JOHNSON** hit .400/.471/.667 (6-for-15) with 1 double, 1HR, a team-leading 5RBI and 3SB across Cornell's four-game stretch against Harvard and Army over the past week.

► Johnson has carried that production throughout his last 13 games, hitting .356/.442/.511 (16-for-45) with 12R, 4 doubles, 1HR, 8RBI, 5BB, 7SB and 2HP. Three of those steals came in Cornell's win over Harvard in the nightcap of last Sunday's doubleheader, making Johnson the first Big Red player to steal three bases in a game since **RYAN PORTER** '25 against Princeton on April 22, 2023 — the first-ever game at Booth Field.

► Highlighted by his three-hit effort against Army on Tuesday, Johnson has recorded three hits in a game four times in his collegiate career, joining efforts against Yale (April 20, 2024), Dartmouth (April 27, 2025) and VMI (March 14, 2026).

► Cornell enters this weekend's series at Dartmouth having been swept in last year's three-game series in Hanover, though Johnson was a bright spot, batting .400/.455/1.000 (4-for-10) with 2R, 2HR, 4RBI and 1BB.

BARELA-ZING HOT

► Sophomore catcher **MASON BARELA** has been one of Cornell's most consistent offensive contributors of late, hitting .348/.362/.439 (23-for-66) with 5R, 2HR and 8RBI over his last 16 games, recording a hit in 13 of those outings.

► Barela's current stretch dates to a nine-game hitting streak — a career high — that ran from Feb. 27 to March 15 before coming to an end in Cornell's series at Princeton (March 21-22). The highlight of that run came in the series finale at Fordham on March 8, when Barela went 5-for-6, marking the program's first five-hit game in seven years.

► Over his last 24 games, all starts, Barela is hitting .302/.324/.448 (29-for-96) with 8R, 2 doubles, 4HR, 14RBI and 4BB.

BIG RED BATS AMONG IVY'S BEST

► Cornell boasts two of the top five hitters in the Ivy League entering this weekend, with junior second baseman **OWEN CARLSON** and junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** ranking among the conference leaders in average, on-base percentage and OPS.

► Carlson leads the Ivy League in on-base percentage at .472 and ranks second in batting average at .373, trailing Brown's Alex Benevento by two percentage points. His .964 OPS ranks fourth in the conference. Hager is right behind, posting a .351/.435/.514 slash line — good for fifth, fifth and third in the Ivy League, respectively — and his .949 OPS ranks fifth.

► The Big Red join Yale's Kaiden Dossa and Garrett Larsen as the only Ancient Eight programs with multiple hitters in the top five in conference OPS.

► Hager's 26 hits are tied for seventh in the Ivy League. Senior outfielder **CADEN WILDMAN** is tied for fifth with 6 doubles and freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER**'s 8HP are tied for third in the conference. Junior infielder **LUKE JOHNSON**'s 7SB are tied for 10th.

HEG-ART AND SOUL

► In six relief outings this season, sophomore right-hander **JOHN HEGARTY** has yet to allow an earned run in all but one contest, tossing multiple innings in each such appearance. Hegarty has not allowed a run across his last 10.1IP, going 2-0 with a 0.48 WHIP (2H, 3BB) and 7K over that stretch, dating back to his outing at Fordham on March 7.

► Hegarty opened his season with 4.0 hitless IP against Northwestern in the Hub City Invitational on Feb. 21 before allowing 3H and 3ER at Richmond on March 1. He has not allowed a run since, holding opponents to 2H over his last four appearances (.067 BAA — 2-for-30).

► Among Cornell pitchers with at least 10.0IP, Hegarty owns the team's lowest ERA at 1.76 and a 0.91 WHIP. Opponents are hitting just .104 against him on the season (5-for-48).

FOSTERING SAVES

► Junior right-handed pitcher **MAX FOSTER** picked up his third save of the season in Cornell's 6-3 win at Princeton on March 21. Foster enters this weekend tied with Dartmouth's Mac Burke and Penn's Connor Darling for the second-most saves in the Ivy League. Brown's Christian Keel (four) owns the conference lead in the category. Foster is one of seven Ivy League pitchers with multiple saves this season.

► With another save, Foster would become Cornell's first pitcher to register four saves in a season since **JOHN NATOLI** in 2019 (seven). Foster's next save would make him the eighth Big Red pitcher since 1995 with at least four saves, joining **KELLEN URBON** (9 in 2012), **PETER LANNOO** (8 in 2017), **DAVID ROCHEFORT** (8 in 2009), Natoli, **DAVID SHARFSTEIN** (5 in 2002), **JOHN DOUGLAS** (4 in 1995) and **PAUL BALESTRIERI** (4 in 2015).

WE'VE GOT ICE!

► Freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER** has been hit by eight opposing pitches so far this season, tied for the 21st-most HP in a single season by a Big Red hitter. Among freshman batters, Hower is tied with **BRANT MCKOWN** (2006) for the fourth-most HPs by a first-year hitter. Only **MARLIN McPHAIL** (program-record 15 in 1979), **MARK QUATRANI** (11 in 2024) and **KALEB HUTCHINSON** (9 in 2004) had higher totals.

► With two more HPs, Hower would become the 11th player (13th instance) in program history to be hit by at least 10 pitches in a season. It would be the fourth time in the last three seasons it has happened, joining Quatrani (11 in 2024; 13 in 2025) and **KEVIN HAGER** (10 in 2025).

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

► Senior right-handed pitcher **CARSON MAYFIELD** and senior left-handed pitcher **NOAH KELLER** enter this weekend having already surpassed the century mark for strikeouts, as the duo continue to climb Cornell's all-time strikeout leaderboard.

► With his four-strikeout outing in the opening game of Cornell's March 21 doubleheader at Princeton, Mayfield upped his career strikeout total to 139, matching **TIM WILLITTES** (139, 2014-18) for 18th place in program history. With his next strikeout, Mayfield will tie **BLAKE HAMILTON** (140, 2004-07) for 17th place and is five strikeouts away from being even with outputs by **EDWARD WINNICK** (144, 1949-51) and **NICK BAYER** (144, 1997-00) for entering the top 15 all-time.

► Keller enters this weekend with 115 strikeouts, tied with **DAN GALA** and **TED THELANDER** for 30th place in program history. He broke his tie with **BRIAN McAFEE** on Tuesday at Army with his one strikeout.

JUST A LITTLE BIT MORE...

► Cornell's 11-inning contest against Northwestern on Feb. 21 was the Big Red's first game that needed multiple extra innings since defeating Navy in 11 innings, 3-2, in the nightcap of a doubleheader on March 9, 2019, doubleheader, snapping the nation's longest active streak without playing multiple extra innings.

► The Big Red have not gone to extra innings much since 2019, as it is tied with Princeton for the third-fewest extra-inning games during the span (11 games). Only Alabama A&M and Saint Peter's (eight each) have played fewer such games.

► Cornell's last extra-inning win came in a 13-12 slugfest at Yale on March 22, 2025, while its last win in a game that went at least 12 innings was against Princeton in 14 innings, 4-2, on April 27, 2014. The last time the Big Red played a 12-inning game was March 13, 2015, when it lost to LIU Brooklyn, 5-4, in the RussMatt Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla.

WHEN IT RUNS, IT POURS

► Through 20 games this season, Cornell is averaging 4.26 runs per game after posting back-to-back seasons of at least 6.70 runs per game in 2024 (7.11) and 2025 (6.74) — the program's first such stretch since 1899-1902.

► The Big Red have continued to score in bunches, with 59 of its 87 runs this season (67.8 percent) coming in multi-run innings after 77.7 percent of their runs in 2025 and 79.1 percent since the start of 2024 were scored in multi-run frames.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

► Cornell hit 45 home runs last season, the second-most in program history, trailing only the record of 52 set in 2024. The Big Red have hit at least 30 home runs in four consecutive seasons (2022 — 33; 2023 — 30; 2024 — 52; 2025 — 45), a program first, and have averaged at least one home run per game in each of the last two seasons — only the eighth and ninth times since 1947 that Cornell has reached 0.75 home runs per game.

► With 14 home runs through 20 games this season, Cornell has combined to hit 109 home runs over the past two-plus seasons — surpassing the program's total from the six seasons spanning 2018-23 (97), a stretch that did not include a 2021 campaign.

STAYING STRONG IN THE FIELD

► Cornell has been one of the Ivy League's steadiest defensive teams over the past two-plus seasons. After posting back-to-back program-record fielding percentages of .975 (35E in 1407 chances) in 2024 and .976 (30E in 1229 chances) in 2025, the Big Red own a collective .972 fielding percentage (95E in 3338 chances) since the start of the 2024 campaign, leading all Ivy League programs over that span.

► Cornell's 95 errors since the beginning of the 2024 season are the second-fewest in Division I and are 28 fewer than the next-closest Ivy League program (Yale — 123). Its .972 fielding percentage is also nearly three points higher than the Bulldogs' .969 mark.

► Through 20 games this season, Cornell has a .957 fielding percentage (511PO, 161A, 30E).

FUN WITH GEOGRAPHY

► The Big Red's seven Massachusetts natives on its 2026 roster set a program record for most Bay Staters, surpassing the previous mark of four set on multiple occasions (1950, 1980, 1990, 2025).

► Cornell has three sets of players who attended the same high school or prep school this season — seniors **CADEN WILDMAN** and **T.J. SWIDORSKI** (East Ridge HS, Minn.); freshman right-hander **CONNOR NIEMIEC** and freshman infielder **AIDEN BARCLAY** (Deerfield Academy, Mass.); and senior infielder **BECK UROFSKY** and freshman outfielder **TRENT LOPEZ** (Bethesda-Chevy Chase HS, Md.) — marking the first time in program history the roster has featured at least three such pairings.

"14 LEGACY" PROGRAM

► Cornell baseball has established the "14 Legacy Program" to honor **TOM FORD**, who retired last spring after 35 years with the program (1991-2025).

► Ford was hired as Cornell's 15th head coach on Jan. 21, 1991 — just one week before the Big Red began indoor workouts and seven weeks before the season opener. Despite the quick turnaround, Cornell posted a 23-17 record in Ford's debut season, including an 11-2 start — the best 13-game start in program history — and a come-from-behind victory over No. 6 Georgia Tech.

► During his 18 years as head coach (1991-2008) and 17 as associate head coach (2009-25), Ford helped guide Cornell to three division titles (2005, 2009, 2012) and the program's first Ivy League championship in 2012, which sent the Big Red to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1977. He coached 133 All-Ivy honorees, including all three of Cornell's Ivy League Rookies of the Year.

► Each fall, the coaching staff will select a player who best embodies Ford's defining traits — a tough mindset and daily dedication to improvement — and award him the honor of wearing Ford's No. 14 jersey for the spring season. The chosen player will also have his name placed on the Wall of Honor inside the batting tunnels at Booth Field.

► Junior shortstop **KEVIN HAGER** was named this year's recipient of the No. 14 jersey, becoming the first position player to don a No. 14 jersey since pitcher **GREG CONTI** in 1994 and the first non-pitcher since infielder **JACK JANASIEWICZ** in 1990.

► "Tom has been a tremendous representative of our program," said **DAN PEPICELLI**, the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Cornell Baseball. SCOUTING DARTMOUTH

▶ Dartmouth enters this weekend at 5-13 overall and 2-4 in Ivy League play. The Big Green are also coming off a stretch where it played four games in three days, dropping a 4-3 contest on Tuesday at UMass Lowell after earning its first series win over Columbia since 2022 with a 5-0 shutout on Monday in Hanover.

▶ Nate Kugler earned the starting nod in Monday's win (5.0IP, 2H, 0R, 0BB, 2K) before Mac Burke closed it out with his third save of the season (4.0IP, 0H, 0R, 1BB, 4K). Chris Miller opened the scoring with a two-run home run in the second, and RBI contributions from Tair Rodriguez, A.J. DeMastrie and Alejandro Puig extended the lead through the sixth.

▶ Dartmouth owns an Ivy League-leading 3.88 ERA (65ER in 150.2IP) and ranks 24th nationally. Nate Isler leads the Ancient Eight with 41K and 39.2IP across five starts, including a conference-best 14 strikeouts looking. His 3.63 ERA ranks seventh in the Ivy League. Marco Dumsky has made three starts in five outings, posting a 5.30 ERA (18.2IP, 11ER).

▶ Despite a collective .214 batting average, Dartmouth has been effective at getting on base, posting a .327 on-base percentage as a team. DeMastrie paces the offense, hitting .297/.375/.391 (19-for-64) with 3 doubles, 1HR and 10RBI. Milo Suarez leads the club with 5 doubles, while Henry Murray accounts for both of the Big Green's triples.

120 YEARS, 301 MILES, 194 MEETINGS

▶ Dartmouth leads the all-time series, 104-89-1, and has won each of the last three matchups, including a sweep of last year's series at Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park. The home team has won each of the last seven games between the programs — a stretch that includes Cornell outscoring Dartmouth 35-11 in a three-game sweep at Booth Field in 2024.

▶ A win Friday would give Cornell four consecutive home wins over Dartmouth for the first time since a seven-game stretch at Hoy Field between May 7, 1983, and April 1, 1994. Dartmouth, meanwhile, is seeking its fourth straight win over Cornell, a feat the Big Green last accomplished with five consecutive victories from March 30, 2008, to May 2, 2009.

A HOUSE DIVIDED

▶ When freshman outfielder **JAKE HOWER** takes the field this weekend, he will face the program where his older brother, Jackson, spent his collegiate career. Jackson appeared in 124 games for the Big Green from 2022-25, batting .245/.333/.340 with 61R, 21 doubles, 5HR, 50 RBI and 15SB. He had his best season in 2024, hitting .310/.385/.389 over 35 games with 26R, 7 doubles, 1HR and 24RBI.

Under Pepicelli's tutelage, Cornell has produced 30 All-Ivy League selections — including nine First Team and nine Second Team selections. Four Big Red players have also been selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft.

Before his arrival on East Hill, Pepicelli spent six seasons at Clemson where he had three coaching titles during his six-year stay. The final three years with the Tigers were as the associate head coach.

He became the Tigers' first pitching coach to lead a staff to Omaha in his first season with the squad. That year, Clemson's pitching staff posted the first of four consecutive seasons with a sub-4.00 ERA. Pepicelli recruited and developed Matt Crownover, who earned freshman All-America accolades in 2013 and ACC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2015, and was instrumental in assembling *Baseball America's* ninth-ranked recruiting class in 2015. Ten Clemson pitchers were selected in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft in Pepicelli's tenure at Clemson.

By joining the Big Red, Pepicelli returned home to upstate New York, where he previously had 11 years of head coaching experience at the Division III level between St. John Fisher and Hartwick.

After serving as an assistant coach for three seasons at Hartwick, Pepicelli was promoted to head coach for the 1999 season. Following his two-year tenure at Hartwick, Pepicelli was head coach and assistant athletic director at St. John Fisher for nine seasons (2001-09). Pepicelli was a two-time Empire 8 Coach of the Year (2001, 2007), with the latter coming when the Cardinals advanced to the NCAA Division III College World Series for the first time in program history.

Pepicelli's teams at St. John Fisher had winning records in each of his last seven seasons. His team garnered national recognition for sportsmanship in 2008 after a line-drive foul ball struck the opposing team's third-base coach in the head during the ninth inning of the play-in game of the 2008 ECAC Upstate Championship. Despite the fact the Cardinals were trailing, Pepicelli and the Cardinals elected to concede the game, ending any hope of clinching a berth an NCAA Tournament berth. The Committee on Sportsmanship and Ethical Conduct presented Pepicelli's team with the NCAA All-Divisions Sportsmanship Award.

Along with being the baseball coach at St. John Fisher, Pepicelli was the head strength and conditioning coach where he spent three years on the NCAA Competitive Safeguards Committee. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a member of the National Strength & Conditioning Association.

A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Pepicelli is married to the former Robyn Molloy, who played for and served as an assistant coach with the Syracuse women's soccer team. The couple has a daughter, Mia, and a son, Owen.

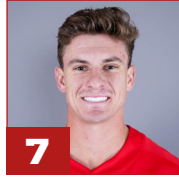
