2011-12 Season Preview

The 2011-12 Cortland men's hockey team returns a large contingent from last year's squad that showed moments of great promise, including a 2-0 win at nationally seventh-ranked Plattsburgh and taking top-ranked Oswego to overtime at home the next weekend. After missing the SUNYAC playoffs the last three seasons, the Red Dragons, under fifth-year head coach Joe Baldarotta, look to play 60 minutes of disciplined and focused hockey every night in an effort to regain a foothold in the conference playoffs. As is the usual case, wins will come only with hard work as 10 of Cortland's 25 regular-season games come against teams ranked in the USCHO Div. III preseason poll, including six versus SUNYAC foes.

Baldarotta continues to search for a goaltender who takes ownership of the position. Senior Mike Reilly and junior Brittan Kuhlman return this season, while freshman Jeff Molner joins the team. Kuhlman saw the most minutes in net last season, posting a 3-7-1 record with an .894 save percentage and a 4.48 goals against average. His best performance came when he turned aside 40 shots in the win at Plattsburgh. Reilly played in seven games with five starts as a junior, highlighted by a 41-save performance at Oswego. Molner won two New Jersey state titles in high school and played junior hockey with the NY Apple Core.

Defensively, Cortland brings back six players and welcomes three newcomers. Senior captain Peter Lompado is in his second year with the program. He skated in 24 games last season and led all defensemen with 11 points on five goals and six assists, including nine points in SUNYAC play. Junior Matt Tardiff has seen action in 22 games in each of his first two seasons.

Sophomores Stephen Nardi and Matt McNamee each skated in all 25 games as freshmen. Nardi supplied eight points on two goals and six assists, while McNamee chipped in with a goal and four assists. Sophomore Joel Zangara had two goals in 16 games. Freshman Tyler Virgoe appeared in three games during the 2010-11 season, but missed most of the year due to injury.

Senior Scott Wentworth joins the team after playing a combined 42 games at Utica College and Curry College. Freshman Kevin Antonik last played for the Jersey

Hitmen. Freshman Erik Augspurger won a state title with his U18 AAA hockey team and last played at Northwood Prep.

Baldarotta brings back loads of experience at forward with 13 returnees on the roster. Senior captain Jake Saville has not missed a game in his first three seasons. In 2010-11, Saville led the team with 11 assists and added four goals in 25 games. Junior captain Chris Kaleta has played in all 50 games during his first two seasons. As a sophomore, he scored 11 points on five goals and six assists. Senior Joey Christiano tied for the team lead in scoring last season with 18 points on a team-high 10 goals and eight assists in 25 games.

Junior Michael Lysyj followed up a solid rookie campaign with 13 points on eight goals and five assists in 23 games as a sophomore. Seniors Ryan Markell and Ryan Durocher saw the ice in 25 and 24 games, respectively, last season with Markell recording five goals and four assists and Durocher contributing two goals and four assists. Junior Matty Davie played in 13 games, scoring four points on three goals and one assist. Senior Erik Nordqvist skated in 21 games as a junior and had a goal and three assists.

Senior twins Marcus and Martin Oeberg saw the ice in 12 and nine games, respectively, last season with Martin picking up a goal and Marcus recording an assist. Junior Mack Swartz joined the team second semester, collecting one assist in eight games. Sophomore A.J. Moyer appeared in all 25 games as a freshman, scoring six points on two goals and four assists, all in conference play.

Sophomore Brian Roller contributed a goal and an assist in 20 games.

Four newcomers join the program at forward this season. Junior Adam Bevilacqua last played with St. Norbert, the 2011 NCAA Div. III national champion. Freshman Josh LaRose was a member of the Syracuse Stars, freshman Danny Bailey most recently played for the CD Selects, while freshman Nick Zappia last skated with the Kingston Voyageurs.

Coaching Staff

Joe Baldarotta Head Coach

Joe Baldarotta was named the men's ice hockey head coach at SUNY Cortland in June 2007 after coaching for 16 years at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point.

During Baldarotta's tenure at Cortland, the Red Dragons featured their first-ever four-time All-SUNY-AC selection and have had two players move into the top 15 in career scoring.

While at Wisconsin-Stevens Point, he posted the most wins in school history, and his overall record stands at 297-233-45 and includes 10 consecutive campaigns with a .500 or better record and 14 in total. His 297 wins rank 22nd all-time among Division III coaches.

Baldarotta led the Pointers to the 1993 NCAA Division III national championship, earning American Hockey Coaches Association national coach of the year honors. The program also finished as national runner-up in 1992 and 1998 and captured three Northern Collegiate Hockey Association (NCHA) regular-season titles and two playoff crowns under Baldarotta, who was a four-time NCHA coach of the year.

Prior to accepting the head coaching position at Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Baldarotta was an assistant for the Pointers for five seasons, helping the team to three straight Division III national titles. Before Wisconsin-Stevens Point, he served as an assistant coach and head coach at Madison West High School. As the team's head coach for four seasons, Baldarotta compiled a 62-22-1 record and won the 1983 Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association State Championship, earning Wisconsin State High School Coach of the Year honors.

A highly regarded camp instructor, Baldarotta has been involved in numerous off-season camps and clinics and twice has been a member of the coaching staff for the U.S. Olympic Festival.

A native of Madison, Wis., Baldarotta competed in ice hockey at Wisconsin-Stevens Point and received his bachelor's degree from the University in 1989. Baldarotta and his wife, Cindy, have a son, Nicolo.

Where Are They Now?

The Red Dragons have produced numerous players who have gone onto the coaching ranks, including Chadd Cassidy, Derek Lalonde and Nate Leaman.



CHADD CASSIDY, FORWARD YEARS AT CORTLAND: 1993-95

After his playing career, Chadd Cassidy's first coaching job was as an assistant at Cortland from 1999-2001. He moved to Potsdam as an assistant during the 2001-02 season before serving as head coach at the National Sports

Academy for four seasons, where his teams compiled a 124-71-15 record.

Cassidy, who has served as both on-ice instructor and team coach at USA Hockey's New York District camps and select festivals, joined head coach Ron Rolston's staff as an assistant coach for USA Hockey's National Team Development Program (NTDP) in December, 2005. He served as assistant coach for the U.S. National Under-17 Team that won the silver medal at the 2006 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge and the silver-medal winning U.S. National Under-18 Team at the 2007 International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF) World Under-18 Championship. Cassidy culminated his five-year career with USA Hockey by capturing a gold medal at the 2011 IIHF Under-18 World Championship in Germany

In August, 2011, Cassidy was hired as an assistant coach for the American Hockey League's (AHL) Rochester Americans by Rolston, who was named head coach of the Amerks earlier in the year. The Amerks are the AHL affiliate of the National Hockey League's (NHL) Buffalo Sabres.

Cassidy and his wife, Tara, have two children, Sheldon and Ireland.



DEREK LALONDE, GOALTENDER YEARS AT CORTLAND: 1990-95

After five seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Denver in which he helped the Pioneers to two conference titles and four straight NCAA appearances, Derek Lalonde has taken the position as head coach/general manager of

the Green Bay Gamblers of the United States Hockey League (USHL). Prior to Denver, Lalonde spent four seasons at Ferris State under long-time head coach Bob Daniels.

Lalonde arrived at FSU after serving two seasons (2000-02) as an assistant coach at Hamilton College. Lalonde was Hamilton's junior varsity head coach and served as director of the program's summer hockey school. Prior to his coaching stint at Hamilton, Lalonde held the same position at Lebanon Valley College from August 1998 through July 2000. He assisted with the establishment of the NCAA Division II-III's men's ice hockey program from its inception.

From 1995-98, Lalonde was a graduate assistant coach at the Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts in North Adams, Mass. Lalonde coached at a Prospects Camp for 16-year olds, while a member of the selection committee for the Empire State Games and the New York State Select 16/17-year old group.

Lalonde and his wife, Melissa, the former head coach of the Ferris State women's soccer team, have two sons, Alex and Luke, and a daughter, Abby.



NATE LEAMAN, FORWARD YEARS AT CORTLAND: 1993-97

Nate Leaman enters his first season as the head coach at Providence College after eight campaigns as the head coach of Union College, where he coached 16 NHL draft picks, five All-Americans and one Hobey Baker finalist.

Leaman, Union's all-time winningest coach, received the 2011 Spencer Penrose Award as the Division I Men's Coach of the Year, as well as a second straight ECAC Coach of the Year honor, after guiding the Dutchmen to their first-ever Cleary Cup as the ECAC regular-season champions and NCAA Division I playoff berth.

Leaman also served as an assistant coach for the 2007 U.S. National Junior Team, helping the team win a bronze medal at the International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship in Sweden.

Leaman has been active in USA Hockey, also serving as an assistant coach on the U.S. National Under-18 Team that captured gold at the 2005 IIHF World U-18 Championship in Plzen, Czech Republic. He also coached teams at USA Hockey's Select 14 Player Development Camp in 2001 and 2002.

Leaman came to Union after four seasons as an assistant coach on Mark Mazzoleni's staff at Harvard.

A native of Centerville, Ohio, Leaman and his wife, Alice, have a son, Ty.

About SUNY Cortland

Located atop one of the rolling hills in central New York's "City of Seven Valleys," the State University of New York College at Cortland was founded in 1868 as the Cortland Normal School, which included among its earliest students inventor and industrialist Elmer A. Sperry of Sperry-Rand Corp. fame.

Over the decades, the campus expanded and in 1941, by an act of legislature and the Board of Regents, the institution officially became a four-year college providing courses leading to the bachelor's degree. In 1948, Cortland was a founding member of the State University of New York.

Today, more than 7,200 students are pursuing degrees within the College's three academic divisions — arts and sciences, professional studies and the school of education. Twenty-three departments with a faculty of more than 400 offer the SUNY Cortland student body 70 majors and 44 minors from which to choose.

The College's main campus covers 191 acres and includes 31 traditional and modern buildings. Fifteen of these structures are residence halls providing on-campus housing for approximately 3,000 students. Cortland also operates its Outdoor Education Center at Raquette Lake in the Adirondacks, the Hoxie Gorge Nature Preserve outside Cortland, and the Brauer Education Center on the Helderberg Escarpment near Albany.

At Cortland, athletics are viewed as having an important role in the educational mission of the College. During the fall, winter and spring seasons, Cortland participates in 25 intercollegiate sports — 14 women's and 11 men's — in an attempt to provide a broad program which meets the needs, interests and abilities of its students.

The Cortland athletic program placed 16th nationally out of approximately 440 colleges and universities in the 2010-11 all-sport Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Division III standings. Cortland is the only New York school and one of only five nationwide to finish in the top 20 each of the last 16 years. Since 1989, the Red Dragons have captured 15 NCAA Division III team titles.

The College offers its student-athletes excellent athletic facilities. The newly-constructed on-campus stadium features two artificial turf fields. One field seats 6,500 spectators, the other 1,500. The Cortland football, field hockey, men's and women's soccer, men's and women's lacrosse and men's and women's track and field teams are among those who utilize the facility, which the *New York Times* called "...a new stadium worthy of a major university power."

The Bessie L. Park Physical Education and Recreation Center, opened in 1973, features the Whitney T. Corey Gymnasium with a 3,500 seating capacity; the Olympic-sized Harriet Holsten swimming pool with gallery seating for 1,500; the Alumni Ice Arena, a facility which can accommodate 2,500 spectators; a 500-seat gymnastics arena; racquetball and squash courts; a wrestling room; modern athletic training facilities; and the state-of-the-art Francis Woods Fitness Facility.

Nearby Clayton R. Lusk Field House, with its tartan-textured surface, is home for the indoor track teams, varsity practice sessions and recreational activities. Cortland's soccer teams play on T. Fred "Prof" Holloway Field, which has lights for night contests and newly installed bleachers. The College also has 22 outdoor tennis courts and two outdoor basketball courts and boasts Robert H. Wallace Field (baseball) and Dragon Field (softball) as part of its 51 acres of athletic fields.
