ABOUT THE 12-TEAM COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF FORMAT



COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

- The 12 participating teams will be the five conference champions ranked highest by the CFP selection committee, plus the next seven highest-ranked teams.
- The ranking of the teams will continue to be done by a selection committee.
- The four highest-ranked conference champions will be seeded one through four and will receive a first-round bye. The fifth conference champion will be seeded where it was ranked or at No. 12 if it is outside the top 12 rankings. Non-conference champions ranked in the top four will be seeded beginning at No. 5. Because of this, the seeding, 1 through 12, could look different than the final rankings.
- The eight teams seeded No. 5-12 will play in a first round with the higher seeds hosting the lower seeds either on campus or at other sites designated by the higher-seeded institution (No. 12 at No. 5, No. 11 at No. 6, No. 10 at No. 7 and No. 9 at No. 8.).
- The selection committee will assign the four highest-ranked conference champions to Playoff Quarterfinals hosted by bowls. This will be done in consideration of historic bowl relationships, then in consideration of rankings. For example, if the Sugar Bowl hosts a Playoff Quarterfinal and the SEC champion is ranked No. 1 and the Big 12 champion is ranked No. 3, the SEC champion would be assigned to the Sugar Bowl and the Big 12 champion would be assigned elsewhere.
- With the four highest-ranked conference champions assigned to bowls, their four Playoff Quarterfinal opponents will be dictated by the bracket (i.e., No. 1 vs. No. 8/9 winner, No. 4 vs. No. 5/12 winner, No. 2 vs. 7/10 winner; No. 3 vs. 6/11 winner.)
- The College Football Playoff bracket will follow the selection committee's rankings, with no modifications made to avoid rematches between teams that may have played during the regular season or are from the same conference.
- The bracket will remain in effect throughout the playoff (i.e., no re-seeding).
- The highest seed will receive preferential placement for the Playoff Semifinal bowl assignment.
- All 11 games will be under the CFP umbrella with the administrative policies determined by the CFP.

AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS OF THE COTTON BOWL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE ONE NAME

Section 1. The name of the corporation is the Cotton Bowl Athletic Association (the "Corporation"), as stated in its Restated Certificate of Formation.

ARTICLE TWO REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

Section 1. The street address of the registered office of the Corporation is One AT&T Way, Arlington, Texas 76011, and the name of its registered agent at such address is Rick Baker.

ARTICLE THREE POWERS, PURPOSES AND MEMBERS

POWERS

Section 1. The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation and shall have all of the powers, duties, authorizations and responsibilities as provided in the Texas Business Organizations Code (as may be amended, the "TBOC"); provided, however, the Corporation shall neither have nor exercise any power, nor shall it engage directly or indirectly in any activity, that would invalidate its status as a Corporation that is exempt from federal income taxation as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") or, as may be applicable, a private foundation under Section 509(a) of the Code.

PURPOSES

Section 2. The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- a. To promote, sponsor and stage, an annual post-season college football game and related activities;
- b. Subject to Section 2(a) above, to operate exclusively for religious charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Code, by engaging directly in support of such purposes or by making distributions to other organizations for use by the distributees, in support of such purposes;

- c. To engage in any and all lawful activities incidental to the foregoing purposes, except as otherwise restricted herein; and
- d. The Corporation shall not carry on, other than as an insubstantial part of its activities, activities that are not in furtherance of its purposes.

MEMBERS

Section 3. The Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE FOUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

GOVERNING BODY

Section 1. The Board of Directors of the Corporation (the "Board") shall constitute its governing body and shall have such powers and authority as shall be conferred upon the directors of the Corporation (the "Directors") by the Restated Certificate of Formation of the Corporation, these Bylaws, and the TBOC.

CLASSES OF DIRECTORS

Section 2. The Directors shall be divided into three (3) classes, which are hereby designated as "Elected Directors", "Corporate Directors" and "Life Directors". To be qualified to serve as a Director, a person must be at least eighteen (18) years old. Directors need not be residents of Texas absent a provision to the contrary in the Restated Certificate of Formation of the Corporation or the TBOC.

ELECTED DIRECTORS

Section 3. The class of Elected Directors shall consist of such number of Directors as shall be determined from time to time by resolution of the Board; provided, however, such number in no case shall be less than three (3) or more than sixty (60), and no decrease in number shall have the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent Director. Each Elected Director may serve no more than three successive two-year terms and may not be reappointed to the Board until the expiration of two years between the end of his/her third successive two-year term and the beginning of his/her new term upon reappointment. This provision shall in no way preclude an individual being elected to serve the unexpired term of office created by a vacancy on the Board to serve three complete successive two-year terms. Terms of Elected Directors will commence on February 1st of even

numbered years. Elected Directors should contribute financial and time support for the Corporation. Criteria for nomination and election of Elected Directors should include university affiliation/relationships, civic involvement, corporate/business involvement, time and financial support.

CORPORATE DIRECTORS

Section 4. The class of Corporate Directors shall consist of the following:

- Chair
- Chair-Elect
- Vice Chairs (4)
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- President
- Corporation's legal counsel
- Sponsor representatives
- Team hotel representatives
- Stadium landlord representatives

As a Corporate Director, the term of each Chair, Chair-Elect, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and President shall be concurrent with the term of such person holding office as an Officer (as defined below). All other Corporate Directors will serve a term of one year (February 1 -January 31), with no limits on the number of reappointments.

LIFE DIRECTORS

Section 5. The class of Life Directors shall consist of all past Chairs, including the Immediate Past Chair. Also, the Board may by resolution, adopted in its sole and absolute discretion, appoint as a Life Director any person who previously served as a Director, and who, as a result of such service, distinguished themselves as a Director. Each Life Director shall hold office until the death, resignation, retirement or disqualification of such person, or upon the Board's removal of such Life Director. Each Life Director appointment shall terminate upon the death, resignation, retirement or disqualification of such person, or upon the Board's removal of such Life Director.

VACANCIES

Section 6. Vacancies on the Board from any class of Directors caused by any reason shall be filled in the same manner as provided for the election of a Director to such class; and each person so elected shall serve the unexpired term of his/her predecessor in office.

REMOVAL

Section 7. Any Director may be removed, either with or without cause, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Directors then holding office at a regular or special meeting of the Board called for that purpose, whenever in the Board's judgment the best interests of the Corporation will be served thereby. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any Corporate Director who is an Officer may only be removed in accordance with Article Five, Section 9 below.

RESIGNATION

Section 8. Any Director may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chair. Unless otherwise specified in such written notice, such resignation shall be effective as of the date of delivery of such notice.

EX-OFFICIO APPOINTMENTS

Section 9. Ex-Officio appointments by the Board are honorary in nature. Ex-Officio members are entitled to notice of and to participate in meetings of the Board, as the case may be, but Ex-Officio members shall not be entitled to vote on any matter, shall not be counted for quorum purposes, shall have no fiduciary duties to the Corporation, and shall have no authority to transact business on behalf of the Corporation absent further express authority granted to such individual by the Board. Ex-Officio members of the Board shall not receive a salary for their service. Ex-Officio members shall be entitled to indemnification on the same basis as directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE FIVE OFFICERS

NUMBER/OFFICES/ELECTION/TERM

Section 1. The Chair, the Chair-Elect, the four Vice Chairs, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Immediate Past Chair and the President shall be the officers of the Corporation (collectively, the "Officers"). The Board shall elect the Officers (other than the President) by majority vote of a quorum of Directors at a called meeting held between October 1 and December 31 of every odd number year; provided, however, the Board's action in electing such Officers shall be limited to approving or rejecting the slate of Officer nominees proposed by the Nominating Committee. To be qualified to serve as an Officer (except for the President, to whom such qualification shall not apply), a person must be either a Corporate Director or an Elected Director. The Chair holding office at the time of such election shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee as the proposed Immediate Past Chair. The Chair-Elect holding office at the time of such election shall be nominated by

the Nominating Committee as the proposed Chair. Each Officer (except for the Vice Chairs, the Secretary, the Treasurer and the President) shall serve a single term of two years, and may not be reelected to the same Officer position. Each Vice Chair, Secretary and Treasurer shall serve not more than two terms of two years each. The term of each such Officer shall commence on February 1 of the calendar year immediately following such election. The term of the President shall be as set forth in Section 8 of this Article Five.

CHAIR

Section 2. The Chair shall have general supervision over the governance and policies of the Corporation, subject to the control of the Board; shall preside at all Board and Executive Committee meetings; shall sign all material written contracts of the Corporation; shall countersign all checks or otherwise approve all payments over \$10,000; shall perform social and media duties representing the Corporation to stakeholders and the public; shall promote the Corporation and its services to the business, government and nonprofit communities; shall work with the Board to effectuate the purposes of the Corporation; and shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the Board incident to his/her office. The Chair shall work closely with the President and shall at all times uphold and advance the interests, policies, quality, integrity and reputation of the Corporation. The Chair shall not have day-to-day supervision of the business and affairs of the Corporation or general and active control thereof.

IMMEDIATE PAST CHAIR

Section 3. The Immediate Past Chair shall perform all duties of the Chair in case of the absence or disability of the Chair; this shall include signing of material written contracts and countersign all checks or otherwise approve all payments over \$10,000; and shall perform such other duties as the Chair and/or the Board shall designate from time to time.

CHAIR-ELECT

Section 4. The Chair-Elect shall perform all duties of the Chair in case of the absence or disability of the Chair and the Immediate Past Chair; and shall perform such other duties as the Chair and/or the Board shall designate from time to time.

VICE CHAIRS

Section 5. The Board shall elect four (4) Vice Chairs. Vice Chairs shall perform all the duties commonly incident to such office and shall perform such other duties and have such other powers as the Chair and/or the Board shall designate from time to time.

SECRETARY

Section 6.

The Secretary shall keep or cause to be kept, at the principal executive office or such other place as the Board may direct, a book of minutes of all meetings and actions of the Board and each committee, task force and working group, with the time and place of holding, whether regular or special, and, if special, how authorized, the notice given, the names of those present and the proceedings thereof. The Secretary shall give, or cause to be given, notice of all meetings required by the Bylaws to be given. The Secretary in general will perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board. The Board may appoint one or more Assistant Secretaries to perform such duties as shall be assigned to them by the Board.

TREASURER

Section 7.

The Treasurer shall:

- a. Cause to be kept and maintained adequate and correct books and records of accounts of the properties and business transactions of the Corporation, including accounts of its assets, liabilities, receipts, disbursements, gains, losses, capital, retained earnings and the like;
- b. Make the books of account available at all reasonable times for inspection by any Director;
- c. Cause to be deposited all money and other valuables in the name and to the credit of the Corporation with such depositories as may be designated by the Board;
- d. Disburse the funds of the Corporation as may be ordered by the Board;
- e. Render to the Chair, the Executive Committee or the President, whenever they request it, an account of all of his or her transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the Corporation; and
- e. Perform all other duties incident to the office of Treasurer.

The Board may appoint one or more Assistant Treasurers to perform such duties as shall be assigned to them by the Board. The Treasurer may delegate, on a day to day basis, the powers or duties of the Treasurer to the chief financial officer of the Corporation (*i.e.*, the employee of the Corporation assigned primary responsibility for managing the Corporation's finances).

PRESIDENT

Section 8.

The Board, upon the nomination of the Executive Committee, shall hire a President to serve as an Officer and as the professional manager of the Corporation. The Board's election of the President shall be by majority vote of a quorum of Directors at a called meeting; provided, however, the Board's action in electing the President shall be limited to accepting or rejecting the nomination of the Executive Committee. The term of the President shall commence upon election by the Board and the President shall hold office until his or her death, resignation, retirement, disqualification or removal from office. The President shall, subject to the control of the Board, be the chief executive officer of the Corporation and shall have general supervision of the business and affairs of the Corporation and shall have general and active control thereof. The President shall have general authority to execute bonds, deeds and contracts in the name of the Corporation, subject to the terms of the TBOC, the Certificate of Formation of the Corporation and these Bylaws; to cause the employment or appointment of such employees and agents of the Corporation as the proper conduct of operations may require; to remove or suspend any employee or agent; to represent the Corporation at functions and meetings; to promote the Corporation and its services to the business, government and nonprofit communities; to organize, develop and supervise the Corporation's efforts to host sporting and non-sporting events and ancillary or related activities and events; to work with the Board to effectuate the purposes of the Corporation; and in general, to exercise all the powers usually appertaining to the office of president, except as otherwise provided by the TBOC, the Certificate of Formation of the Corporation or these Bylaws. The President shall see to it that all orders and resolutions of the Board (or any duly authorized committee thereof) are carried into effect. The President shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned by the Board. The President may call special or emergency meetings of the Board or the Executive Committee.

REMOVAL

Section 9.

Any Officer may be removed, either with or without cause, by a vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the Directors then holding office at a regular or special meeting of the Board called for that purpose, whenever in the Board's judgment the best interests of the Corporation will be served thereby.

RESIGNATION

Section 10.

Any Officer may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chair, or, in the case of the Chair, to the President. Unless otherwise specified in such written notice, such resignation shall be effective as of the date of delivery of such notice.

VACANCIES

Section 11. Each Officer shall hold office until his or her successor, if any, shall have been duly elected and qualified or until his or her earlier death, resignation, retirement, disqualification or removal from office. Each Officer shall be deemed automatically removed when his or her successor's term commences. If the office of any Officer (other than the President) becomes vacant for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled by the Board based on the approval or rejection of the candidate proposed by the Nominating Committee.

ARTICLE SIX FISCAL YEAR

Section 1. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall begin on the first day of May and end on the last day of April in the following year.

ARTICLE SEVEN COMMITTEES

GENERAL

Section 1. The Board shall maintain the permanent standing committees set forth in this Article Seven and may create such additional committees, task forces and working groups as the Board shall by resolution determine from time to time; provided, however, that no such committee, task force or working group shall have the authority to: (i) fill vacancies on the Board or elect Officers; (ii) amend or repeal these Bylaws; (iii) amend the Certificate of Formation of the Corporation; (iv) dissolve, merge or consolidate the Corporation; (v) approve any matter requiring the approval of the Board hereunder; and/or (vi) take any other actions prohibited under the TBOC. Any such additional committee, task force or working group may exist for a fixed term or an indefinite term and be disbanded at any time by resolution of the Board. Each such additional committee, task force or working group shall cause regular minutes to be kept of its proceedings and report to the Board when required or as may be requested by the Chair or the President.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section 2. The Chair, the Immediate Past Chair, the Chair-Elect, the Vice Chairs, the Secretary, the Treasurer and the President shall be the management committee (within the meaning of TBOC Sec. 22.218) of the Corporation (the "Executive Committee"), and shall have and exercise all authority of the Board in the management of the business and affairs of the Corporation, except where action of the full Board is required by TBOC, these Bylaws or the Restated Certificate of Formation of the Corporation. The Executive Committee shall recommend the proposed annual budget of the Corporation to the full Board. Notwithstanding the

general grant of authority contained in this Section, the Executive Committee shall not have the authority to elect or remove any Directors or members of any committee, to nominate Officers (other than the President), to elect or remove any Officers, to approve the annual budget of the Corporation, to employ or terminate the employment by the Corporation of the President, or to make any material changes in policy, such authority being vested solely in the full Board.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Section 3. The Nominating Committee shall be chaired by the Immediate Past Chair and will consist of the Chair, the Immediate Past Chair and the Chair-Elect. The President will be an ex-officio member of the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall have the responsibility of nominating Directors and Officers (other than the President) and nominating the Directors to serve on the Audit and Finance Committee. The unanimous vote of all members of the Nominating Committee shall be required for any action of the Nominating Committee. Nominations will be proposed to the full Board for a vote at the fall Board meeting of odd numbered years. If by thirty (30) days before the fall Board meeting of any odd numbered year the Nominating Committee has failed to nominate a candidate for each open position over which it has responsibility, the Executive Committee shall make such unfilled nomination(s). At the fall Board meeting, such nomination(s) by the Executive Committee shall be deemed the nomination(s) of the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall also conduct an annual review of all Directors' performances and notify any Director of any deficiencies of performance.

AUDIT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

Section 4. The Audit and Finance Committee shall be chaired by the Treasurer and will consist of the Chair, the Chair-Elect, Treasurer and four Directors. The nominations for the four Directors to serve on the Audit and Finance Committee will be proposed by the Nominating Committee to the Board for a vote at the same Board meeting of odd numbered years as Officers are elected; provided, however, the Board's action in electing such Directors to serve on the Audit and Finance Committee shall be limited to approving or rejecting the slate of nominees proposed by the Nominating Committee. Each such Director shall serve not more than two terms of two years each. The term of each such Officer shall commence on February 1 of the calendar year immediately following such election. The President will be an ex-officio member of the Audit and Finance Committee.

The purpose of the Audit and Finance Committee is to assist the Board in its oversight of the Corporation's financial affairs, including the Corporation's annual audit, 990 reporting, financial condition, financial planning, investment practices, and other significant financial matters involving the Corporation. The committee is responsible for recommending financial policies and goals that support the mission, values, and strategic goals of the Corporation; provided, however, the committee shall have no responsibility for the annual budget of the Corporation.

The Board may assign other duties to the committee from time to time as it deems appropriate and in the best interest of the Corporation.

The committee shall make recommendations to the Board regarding the engagement of outside auditors and may be authorized by the Board to negotiate the auditor's compensation. The Committee shall approve all services provided by the auditors, review all auditor reports and discuss all significant issues identified by the auditors and monitor to ensure that the auditor's recommendations agreed to by the Board are acted upon. The Committee shall confer with the auditor to satisfy its members that the Corporation's financial affairs are in order and shall review and determine whether to accept the audit. The Committee is responsible for ensuring that the Corporation's financial statements and procedures are evaluated to determine that adequate fiscal controls and procedures are in place and that the Corporation is in good financial health.

In the event that the auditor's firm provides non-audit services to the Corporation, the committee shall ensure that the auditor's firm adheres to the appropriate professional standards for auditor independence.

COMPENSATION COMMITTEE

Section 5. The Compensation Committee shall be comprised by all members of the Executive Committee and chaired by the Chair. The Compensation Committee shall make recommendations to the Executive Committee and Board regarding compensation, including base salary and bonuses, and benefits of Corporation employees. The Compensation Committee's responsibilities shall include (a) assessment of the reasonableness of all elements of compensation for Corporation employees based on comparable market data and comparisons to the marketplace; (b) establishment and oversight of bonus and incentive plans for Corporation employees; (c) establishment and oversight of qualified and non-qualified employee retirement programs for Corporation employees; and (d) review of the reasonableness of other benefit programs (including life, health and other welfare benefits) of Corporation employees. The Compensation Committee may employ the services of independent third-party compensation consultants to assist the Committee in determining appropriate and reasonable compensation and benefits for Corporation employees.

ARTICLE EIGHT MEETINGS

REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS

Section 1. There will be three (3) regular meetings of the Board each year - spring, summer, and fall. The exact time and place of such regular meetings will be determined by the Chair. The order of business when the Board shall meet in regular session shall be as follows: (a) reading and approval of minutes of preceding Board

meeting; (b) report and recommendations of the Chair; (c) report of the President; (d) audit/financial report; (e) unfinished business; and (f) new business.

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Section 2. Special meetings of the Board may be held at the request of at least one-third of the members or at the request of the Chair or at the request of the President. For all special meetings, the Chair shall direct the President to send written notice to each member of the Board by mail, email or fax at least 72 hours before the time of the meeting, stating the time, place and purpose of each meeting.

QUORUM AT MEETINGS

Section 3. At meetings of the Board, forty percent (40%) of the Directors holding office shall constitute a quorum and the affirmative vote of a majority of those in attendance at any meeting where a quorum is present shall be sufficient for any action by the full Board. A lesser number than a quorum may adjourn from day to day until a quorum shall be present and any action may be taken at any adjourned meeting which could have been taken at the time for which the meeting was originally called. At meetings of any committee, task force or working group, a majority of the members of such committee, task force or working group shall constitute a quorum and the affirmative vote of a majority of those in attendance at any meeting where a quorum is present shall be sufficient for any action by such committee, task force or working group.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Section 4. The Executive Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings, with time and place determined by the Chair. The Executive Committee shall keep minutes of its proceedings, and the minutes of the proceedings of the Executive Committee shall be placed in the minute book of the Corporation. The Executive Committee may be called into meeting by the Chair or the President at any time. The Chair shall serve as chairperson of the Executive Committee, or the Immediate Past Chair in the absence of the Chair or the President in the absence of the Chair and the Immediate Past Chair. The Executive Committee shall meet once a month for the purpose of transacting routine business, as well as for the purposes of making recommendations to the Board and acting on urgent matters that require immediate action that cannot await the next Board meeting, whether regularly scheduled or called. The Executive Committee shall report its actions to the Board at the next meeting of the Board, whether regular or special.

ACTION WITHOUT A MEETING

Section 5. No action permitted to be taken by the Board or by any committee, task force or working group shall be taken without a meeting (e.g., action by written consent is prohibited).

TELEPHONE AND ELECTRONIC MEETINGS

Section 6. Any action permitted to be taken by the Board or by any committee, task force or working group may be taken by telephone or electronic methods provided that: (a) each Director or committee, task force or working group member may hear and be heard by every other Director or committee member; (b) all Directors or committee, task force or working group members in attendance at the meeting may hear all other Directors or committee, task force or working group members; and (c) the notice of the meeting provides instructions to all Directors or committee, task force or working group members on how to access the electronic or telephonic communication method used in the meeting. Participation in such a meeting constitutes presence in person at the meeting, except where a person participates in the meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business on the ground that the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

METHODS OF VOTING AND PROXIES

Section 7. Voting on any action permitted to be taken by the Board or by any committee, task force or working group may be cast or given in person at a meeting by electronic voting methods, if such votes are considered present at the meeting as further set forth in Section 6 of this article. Proxy voting is prohibited and no proxy will be valid.

ARTICLE NINE INDEMNIFICATION

Section 1. To the fullest extent permitted by Texas law, but subject to such limitations as may be applicable under the Code, any person who is or was a member, Director officer or employee of the Corporation, may in accordance with subparagraph (b) below be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all liability and reasonable expense (including, but not limited to, counsel fees and disbursements and amounts paid in settlement or in satisfaction of judgments or as fines or penalties) paid or incurred by him in connection with or resulting from any claim, action, suit or proceeding, civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, including any appeal relating thereto, in which he or she may be involved, or threatened to be involved, by reason of his being or having been a member, Director, officer or employee of the Corporation, or by reason of any action taken or not taken in the course and scope of his employment, as such officer or employee or in his capacity as such member, Director, provided that such person has not been adjudged to be liable

for negligence or misconduct in the performance of duty to the Corporation. In any criminal action or proceeding, such person shall be deemed not to have met the standard set forth herein if he had reasonable cause to believe that his or her conduct was unlawful. The termination of any claim, action, suit or proceeding, civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by judgment, order, settlement (whether with or without court approval), conviction or upon a plea of guilty or of nolo contendere, or its equivalent, shall not of itself create a presumption that a member, Director, officer or employee did not meet the standards of conduct set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Any person referred to in Section 1 of this Article who has been wholly successful on the merits with respect to any claim, action, suit or proceeding of the character described in Section 1 shall be entitled to and be granted indemnification as of right, except to the extent he has otherwise been indemnified. Except as provided in the preceding sentence, the grant of indemnification under these Bylaws, unless awarded by a court, shall be at the discretion of the Board, but may be granted only (a) if the Board, acting by a quorum consisting of Directors not parties to such claim, action, suit or proceeding, shall have determined that in its opinion the member, Director, officer or employee has met the applicable standards of conduct set forth in Section 1 of this Article, or (b) alternately, if the Board shall have received the written advice of independent legal counsel that in the latter's judgment such applicable standards of conduct have been met.

Section 3. Expenses incurred with respect to any claim, action, suit or proceeding of the character described in Section 1 of this Article may be advanced by the Corporation prior to the final disposition thereof upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the member, Director, officer or employee to repay such amount unless it shall ultimately be determined that he is entitled to, and is granted, indemnification under these Bylaws.

Section 4. The rights of indemnification provided in this Article shall be in addition to any other rights to which any such member, Director, officer or employee may otherwise be entitled by contract or otherwise; and in the event of such person's death, such rights shall extend to his heirs and legal representatives. The foregoing rights shall be available whether or not such person continues to be a member, Director, officer or employee at the time of incurring or becoming subject to such liability and expenses, and whether or not the claim asserted against him is based on matters, which antedate the adoption of these Bylaws.

ARTICLE TEN AMENDMENTS

Section 1. These Bylaws may be amended by the Board by a two-thirds' vote of all present at a regular or special meeting of the Board, provided notice in writing of the

amendments is mailed, emailed or faxed to members of the Board not less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting.

Section 2.

All Bylaws heretofore adopted or parts thereof that are inconsistent or in conflict with these Bylaws are hereby repealed.

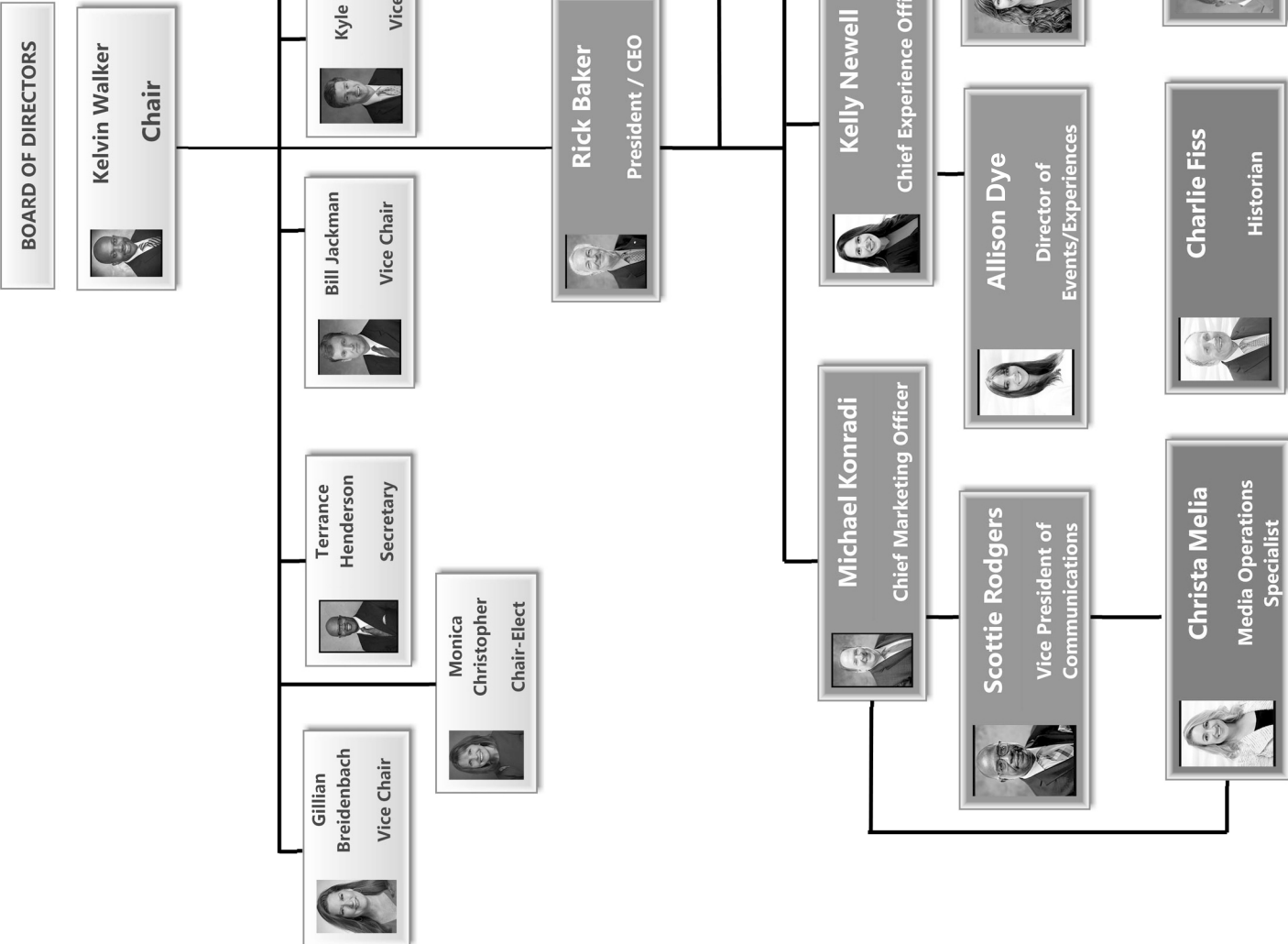
