- The Bluejays have claimed the last nine meetings with the Omaha Mavericks, dating back to 1982.
- Northern Iowa head coach Tanya Warren returns to D.J. Sokol Arena for the first time since 2013. This will be her first opportunity to view the new banner that bears her name. Warren and Connie Yori are the only two players in Creighton WBB history to have their numbers retired. The banner displaying those numbers was revamped last season.

### Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. • Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

### Series with Omaha:

Omaha leads the overall series with Creighton 15-10, but the Bluejays have won the last nine meetings. The last time the Mayericks claimed a battle between the two squads came in 1982. Creighton's victory in 1983, starting the current stretch, broke a 14-game win streak by Omaha.

The Bluejays are 4-9 on the Maverick's home floor.

# Scouting Omaha (7-3)

The Mavericks have a nice record, but that record may be a bit misleading. Omaha has faced two teams outside of division I. Waldorf and Midland.

Omaha is coming off a tough loss to SIUE that saw the Mavericks surrender a 17-point halftime lead, falling 90-86 in overtime.

Mikaela Shaw is the driving force for the Mavericks, 18.7 ppg & 7.5 rpg. The next leading scorer is Remy Davenport with 9.2

The Mavericks have yet to suffer a loss at their new home, Baxter Arena, opening the season with five straight wins at home.

# Keys to the Game w/Omaha

- Slow down Shaw: Creighton limited Shaw to eight points and eight rebounds in its victory last season. Omaha runs much of its offense through her.
- Consistent scoring: The Bluejays tightened up their defensive effort against South Dakota State, but still had long stretches of difficulty getting the ball in
- Get Lamberty & Faber going: Sophomore Sydney Lamberty has struggled recently as did freshman Audrey Faber against the Jackrabbits. With Janning and Rollerson sidelined with injuries these two young Bluejays must fly.

### Series with Northern Iowa:

Creighton holds a 36-16 edge on Northern Iowa. The Bluejays have won the last six meetings and hold a 21-3 edge in Omaha. Last season the Bluejays rallied from a 17-point second deficit to claim the win in Cedar Falls, Iowa. Creighton scored the final 10 points of the game, holding UNI scoreless for the final 4:10.

### Scouting Northern Iowa (4-5)

After opening the season with three victories in its first four game, Northern Iowa suffered a four-game losing streak. The most difficult loss of that run may have come on Dec. 9 as the Panthers deopped a double-overtime contest at South Dakota

Northern Iowa forced overtime with the final seven points of regulation, then led the Jackrabbits 77-73 with 13 seconds remaining in the first overtime. Poor free throw shooting, 2-of-4, in the final 20 seconds opened the door for South Dakota State to force a second overtime session.

Madison Weekly and Amber Sorenson have formed an impressive one-two punch on offense this season, averaging 31.1 ppg as a duo. Weekly leads the way with 15.7 ppg.

### Keys to the Game w/Northern Iowa

- Rebounding: The Bluejays won the game in Cedar Falls last season by winning the battle on the boards and in the paint. Creighton outscored Northern Iowa 32-22 in the paint, claiming 16 offensive rebounds.
- Force Lamar to Shoot: Point guard Sharnae Lamar has taken just 41 shots in nine games and has made only 13. She however has 46 assists, the Bluejays must make Lamar keep the ball a bit more.
- Take away Weekly or Sorenson: While simple to say, Creighton must limit at least one of the Panthers top scoring threats.

# Bluejays' Last Time Out: South Dakota State 53, Creighton 51

South Dakota State held Creighton without a field goal over the final 5:21 and escaped D.J. Sokol Arena with a 53-51 win i.

SDSU scored the game's first four points before Creighton rallied to take an 11-8 lead by the end of the first quarter, and 24-22 lead into the break. CU led by as much as 24-16 in the final two minutes of the second period before the Jackrabbits closed the period with a 6-0 run to draw within two. Jade Owens made 6-of-7 field goals and had a career-high 14 points at the break for CU, carrying the load for the Jays.

SDSU kept up the pressure to open the second half, retaking the lead in just over two minutes on a backdoor lay-up by Ellie Thompson. The run extended into a 16-2 surge that gave the Jacks a 32-26 lead before Creighton's leading scorer Audrey Faber finally cracked the scoring column and tied the game with consecutive three-pointers. The game would be tied heading to the fourth quarter at 40-all as CU made 4-of-5 three-pointers in the period.

Lauren Works gave Creighton its final lead of the game with 5:21 left, following her own miss with a lay-in to give the Bluejays a 47-46 lead. But on the ensuing possession, Ellie Thompson scored off an offensive rebound and SDSU would not trail again. SDSU would add insurance on a threepoint play by Clarissa Ober with 2:41 to go, making it 51-47. Creighton would halve the deficit with 2:15 left on two McGrory free throws, only to come up empty on its next two trips. A jumper by Macy Miller with 19.1 ticks left gave SDSU a four-point margin. The teams would trade scoreless trips until Works sank two foul shots with 0.9 seconds left. SDSU then used its final timeout to advance the ball and ran out the clock.

Owens went scoreless in the second half but was the lone Bluejay in double-figures with 14 points on the evening, making 6-of-9 shots from the floor. Works and McGrory each scored nine points for CU, which shot 40.8 percent in the game, and owned an 11-3 edge in bench points.

SDSU was paced by 15 points from Miller, whlie Kerri Young and Thompson both added a dozen points. SDSU shot 44.0 percent for the game and won the rebound battle, 32-30.


