Series History: St. John's leads 5-3

St. John's won last meeting, 57-54 on March 8, 2015 in the BIG EAST Tournament

### **Bird Seeds**

- The Red Storm and Bluejays have developed into one of Creighton's budding rivalries since joining the BIG EAST. St. John's has bounced the Bluejays in each of the past two seasons from the BIG EAST Tournament in a hotly contested matchup.
- The two squads split the first two regular season meeting in each of the past two years. Last season the Red Storm took the first battle, 61-38 in Omaha, but Creighton claimed the victory in New York (75-50).
- This is the third consecutive season that Creighton has opened BIG EAST play at home. The Bluejays are 1-1 in BIG EAST openers, defeating Villanova (65-58) in 2013-14 and dropping a battle with Seton Hall (79-74) last season.
- Both teams enter Tuesday's contest coming off a victory. Creighton downed former Missouri Valley Conference rival Northern Iowa, 69-61 on Dec. 22. St. John's, meanwhile, defeated Fairfield 73-54 on the same day.
- The Red Storm are led by by Danaejah Grant (19.4 ppg) and the preseason player of the year, Aliyyah Handford (18.5 ppg).
- Tuesday will offer an interesting contrast as Creighton has hit 108 three-pointers in 12 games, while St. John's has knocked down just 38 in 11 games.

### **Head Coach Jim Flanery**

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Blueiavs second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth • consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

### Series with St. John's: Red Storm lead 5-3

St. John's leads this series with Creighton, 5-3. This series was intense before the Blueiavs joined the BIG EAST as the Red Storm eliminated Creighton from the NCAA Tournament on a coast-to-coast layup in the closing seconds in 2012.

Since then the Red Storm have continued to be the Bluejays nemesis, knocking Creighton out of the BIG EAST Tournament in each of the last two seasons.

The series, however, has been far from one sided. Creighton handed St. John's losses in each of the last two seasons, including a 75-50 win in New York last February.

### Scouting St. John's (9-2)

A team that has started strong each of the past two seasons, St. John's is off to a 9-2 start. The Red Storm's two losses came in the the season opener at UCLA (73-58) and at Duquesne (76-57) on Dec. 19.

The Red Storm are heavily reliant on Danaejah Grant and Aliyyah Handford as the duo average a combined 37.9 ppg. In the middle St. John's has seen Jade Walker step up her game as well (12.2 ppg). The trio combine to make up (50.1 ppg) just under 72% of the Red Storm offense.

If there is a hole in the St. John's attack it is the inability to shoot from long range. St. John's has 32 treys in 11 contests (less than three per game).

### Keys to the Game w/St. John's

- Slow down Grant: In St. John's two losses the senior guard was 3-for-12 (at UCLA) and 4-of-18 (at Duquesne). In St. John's other nine contests she is 71-for-130 (55%) from the field.
- Force Red Storm into tough shots: In the loss at home last season the Red Storm shot 74% in the second half. The speed of Handford and Grant forces a team to be disciplined defensively.
- Win the battle on the glass: In five of the last six meetings between St. John's and Creighton, including all three last season, the team to win the rebounding battle claimed a victory. This becomes even more important on the defensive end as the Bluejays cannot allow second chance buckets to the Red Storm.



### Bluejays' Last Time Out: Creighton 69, Northern Iowa 61

Led by 22 points from freshman Audrey Faber and a career-high nine rebounds from sophomore Jade Owens, the Creighton women's basketball team evened its record (6-6) with a 69-61 win over Northern Iowa on Tuesday, Dec. 22.

After owning the first quarter for much of the season, the Bluejays found themselves down 15-8 after the opening frame. The deficit quickly dissipated as Creighton opened the second period of play with a 9-2 run to pull even at 17-17.

The two teams traded buckets over the next three possessions, but a block by Faber gave Creighton a chance to claim its first lead since the opening moments.

Junior MC McGrory made sure the opportunity was not wasted, converting two free throws. The Bluejays pushed their lead to three twice down the stretch, but settled for a 31-30 edge at the half.

Northern Iowa struck first via a jumper from Jen Keitel to retake the lead early in the third, 32-31. Down 36-35 moments later, with 6:18 left, Creighton seized control of the game with an 8-2 outburst. Faber opened things up with another trifecta, followed by a 15-foot jumper from sophomore Kylie Brown to make it 40-36.

The Bluejays took a 47-42 lead into the final quarter, but Northern Iowa got a three-ball from Amber Sorenson and driving layup from Sharnae Lamar to pull even at 47-47 with 8:11 left. Faber and Brown answered immediately with a knock out blow. Brown gave Creighton the lead back with a spot-up jumper, then Faber delivered five straight on a three-ball and a driving jumper to push the Bluejay lead to its largest margin (54-47) with just over six minutes left.

The Panthers last gasp came on another three-pointer from Sorenson, but Creighton refused to take its foot off the gas. The Bluejays delivered the next six points, highlighted by another trey from Works to earn their first double-digit margin (60-50) with 4:08 remaining.

Faber's 22 points led all scorers, while McGrory finished with 11 points. Owens approached a triple-double with eight points, nine rebounds and five assists.

### Faber's 20/20 Mirrors Janning's Work from 2014-15

Freshman Audrey Faber may not have ever watched the ABC show 20/20, but her performance over the past two games has been as crystal clear as the prescription would indicate.

Faber delivered 21 points in the Bluejays' 69-46 win over Omaha (Dec. 20), then put up 22 points in Creighton's 69-61 win over Northern Iowa (Dec. 22). The last Bluejay to score 20 points in back-to-back contests was teammate Marissa Janning, last season against Omaha (Dec. 20) and Kansas (Dec. 22).

Janning has scored 20 or more in consecutive games six times in her career, but has never done it in three consecutive contests.

The last Bluejay to reach that height was Angie Janis, who topped the 20-point plateau in four straight from Feb. 19-March 2 in 2006.

### Bluejays Paint Omaha Blue

On Dec. 20 the University of Nebraska, Omaha hosted Creighton in a battle for Homaha bragging rights. See the Mavericks call the city of Omaha their campus, while the Bluejays have owned the basketball town for some time.

Thanks to 21 points from Faber and 10 more from Bailey Norby, the Bluejays colored the town blue.

### Owens Owns the Night

Sophomore Jade Owens exploded for a career-high 14 points, all in the first half, against South Dakota State on Dec. 12. It was the second time that Owens has reached double figures in her career.

### Three-Way Coaching Trade

While Creighton, Northern Iowa and Drake are no longer in the same conference the three teams have turned one of the best players in another's team history into a member of the coaching staff.

Creighton assistant coach Linda Sayavongchanh was once a star at Drake. Drake's coordinator of basketball operations was an MVC Player of the Year for Northern Iowa. While the Panther's head coach Tanya Warren is one of just two Bluejays to have her number retired.
