#1 Jade Owens - So. - G

Owens reached double-figures for the third time in her career with 11 against St. John's on Dec. 29. She also led the Bluejays with six rebounds.

#2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman provided a spark from the bench with two trifectas against the Red Storm. Myah played eight minutes, scoring six points on Dec. 29.

#3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

MC delivered her best game as a Bluejay against Utah on Dec. 9, scoring a career-high 24 points. McGrory hit her first nine shots against the Utes, missing just her last offering.

#4 Aimee Rischard - So. - G

Aimee has appeared in four games for the Bluejays this season, scoring nine points in a combined 15 minutes.

#11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Over the past seven contests Norby is shooting over 60% from the field (17-of-28).

#12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Lauren owns better than a 2-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio (20-to-9). Against St. John's she delivered eight points

#14 Sydney Lamberty - So. - G

Lamberty seemed found a spark after the holidays, scoring 15 points and dishing five assists against St. John's (Dec. 29).

#20 Tessa Leytem - Sr. - G

Leytem set new career-highs with nine points on 3-of-4 from the field against Marist. Tessa set marks in FG (3)/FGA (4)/3FG (3)/3FGA (4) and minutes played (15)

#21 Olivia Elger - Fr. - G

Olivia got her first points as a Bluejay, scoring four at Omaha on Dec. 20.

Marissa has been sidelined since Nov. 28 as she suffered a fractured fibula in the win over Eastern Washington.

Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

Series with Seton Hall: Creighton leads 3-1

Facing off twice in the past two seasons, the Bluejays swept Seton Hall in 2013-14 and split two games last season.

Creighton is 1-1 against the Pirates at home, falling 79-74 last season (Dec. 3, 2014). The Bluejays rebounded to give the Pirates their only home loss of the season, 81-73, on Feb. 8.

Scouting Seton Hall (11-1, 1-0 BIG EAST)

Coming off an NCAA Tournament appearance and a regular season BIG EAST crown last season, the Pirates had raised the bar for 2015-16. Amazing Seton Hall has started off this season even better, winning 11 of its first 12 contests.

Four of the Pirates starting five average 11.3 points or more per game, led by Tabitha Richardson-Smith (15.8 ppg).

If there is a hole in the Seton Hall game it is the minutes the starters play. The Pirates starting group has played over 1400 of 2400 minutes this season. In addition Seton Hall can fall victim to the turnover, committing 178 (14.8 per game)

Keys to the Game w/Seton Hall

- Take care of the ball: In the loss to St. John's, Creighton committed a season-high 19 turnovers. Like the Red Storm, the Pirates like to score in transition. In Seton Hall's win over Providence the Pirates forced 21 turnovers, scoring 22 points on them.
- Get Faber Back on Track: With Janning and Rollerson still on the shelf, Creighton needs to shake off the 1-for-6 outing against St. John's.
- Protect the Paint: Creighton is 0-6 when the Bluejays are outscored in the paint by 15 points or more.

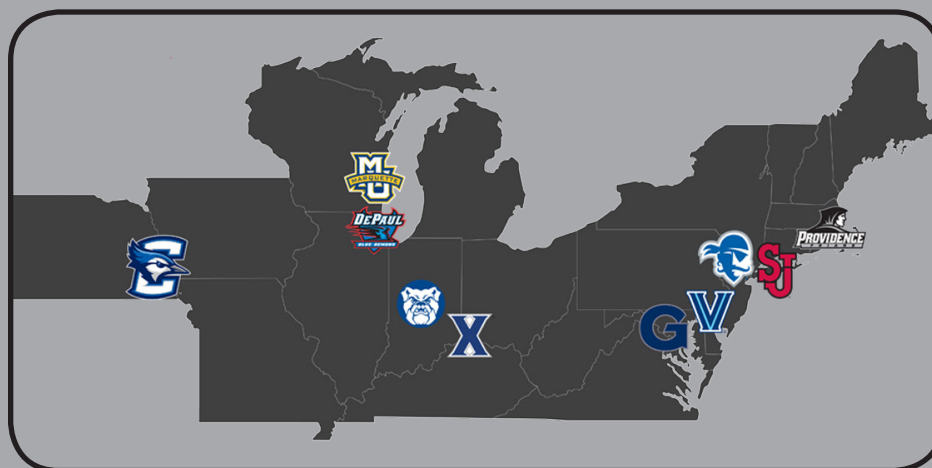
A Passion for Your Alma Mater

Both Seton Hall and Creighton have former graduates leading their respective teams into battle on Thursday as the Pirates' Anthony Bozzella graduated from Seton Hall in 1989. Creighton's Jim Flanery, meanwhile, was a Bluejay graduate in 1987.

Bluejays' Last Time Out: St. John's 69, Creighton 55

Despite 15 points from sophomore Sydney Lamberty, the Creighton women's basketball team dropped its BIG EAST opener to St. John's 66-55 on Tuesday, Dec. 29.

Following the loss Creighton is 6-7 on the season and 0-1 in BIG EAST play, while St. John's is 10-2 overall and 1-0 in conference play.

St. John's jumped out on the Bluejays quickly in the opening period, bouncing out to a 12-4 edge with 4:47 left. The Red Storm closed the quarter with a 19-12 advantage and held a 26-17 lead with 4:40 left in the second period.

The Bluejays rallied down the stretch of the second quarter, outscoring St. John's 8-2 down the stretch. Sophomore Bailey Norby got the Bluejays going with a 15-foot jumper from the left wing, then Lamberty knocked a trifecta from the extended wing to make it 26-22 (2:35). Following a Red Storm running layup by Aaliyah Lewis, junior Lauren Works drained a trey from the right corner to send the Bluejays into halftime down just three (28-25) at the break.

Lamberty started to shine in the opening moments of the second half, scoring the Bluejays' first three buckets to propel Creighton to its first lead since the opening moments at 31-30 (6:10). Down 36-33 moments later the Bluejays surged out to its largest lead of the game with a quick 7-0 burst. Sophomore Kylie Brown dropped in a 12-footer to get things going, Lamberty followed with a running jumper and MC McGrory capped the run by draining a trey from the top of the key to put the Bluejays up 40-36 (2:55).

The fourth quarter, however, belonged to the Red Storm as St. John's used a 13-0 run to take control, 56-45 (3:28).

Lamberty's 15 points led Creighton, while sophomore Jade Owens finished with 11.

St. John's got 18 points from Lewis and Aliyyah Handford, while Danaejah Grant finished with 17 points.

Creighton returns to action on Thursday, Dec. 31 as the Bluejays host Seton Hall at 1:00 pm.

Faber Sits Seventh in NCAA from Range

Freshman Audrey Faber is the best post player in the country from long range this season and ranks seventh overall at 50.0% from three-point distance. The next post player (forward or center) is Jean Parker of Army in 11th (48.8%). Four of the top ten (Nogic, Mehta, Faber and Sahar) are freshmen.
