- The Friars, however, have played the third toughest schedule in the BIG EAST.
- One stat that shows the differing styles of play between the Friars and Bluejays is turnovers per game. Creighton ranks second in the NCAA with 11.0 per contest, Providence sits 307th with 19.3 per game.
- Creighton has held the last two opponents under 50 points, the last time the Bluejays did that was in 2012-13.

#### #1 Jade Owens - So. - G

After hitting just 1-of-5 three-point shots last season, Owens off-season work has drastically improved that portion of her game. Through 18 contests she is 10-22 from long range.

#### #2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman has seen her role grow as the season has progressed. Myah took her first two-point shot of the season at Georgetown and collected her first career steal at Villanova.

#### #3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

One of the Bluejays' two captains, MC has embraced her role as a leader on the floor this season. Over the Bluejays three-game winning streak she is averaging 17.7 ppg.

#### #4 Aimee Rischard - So. - G

Aimee has appeared in six games for the Bluejays this season, scoring 11 points in a combined 28 minutes.

#### #11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Bailey reached double figures for the second time in her career with 10 points against Butler on Jan. 10.

#### #12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Lauren has been a steady offensive threat this season, raising her average to just over seven points per game.

#### #14 Sydney Lamberty - So. - G

Despite struggling from the field against Butler, 1-for-10, Lamberty dished out a team-high seven assists in the win.

#### #20 Tessa Leytem - Sr. - G

Tessa drained two treys in the Bluejays' 77-49 win over Butler.

#### #21 Olivia Elger - Fr. - G

Olivia set a host of career-highs in the win over Butler on Jan. 10, highlighted by two three-balls and six points.

#### #23 Marissa Janning - Sr. - G

Marissa has been sidelined since Nov. 28 as she suffered a fractured fibula in the win over Eastern Washington.

#### #33 Kylie Brown - So. - F

Kylie closed the game with Xavier with four points, three rebounds, two assists and one block.

#### #40 Ali Greene - Fr. - F

Ali authored one of her best games against Butler, finishing with six points and three rebounds in 11 minutes.

#### #45 Audrey Faber - Fr. - F

Faber became the earliest freshman to start under Flanery, moving into the starting five in the fourth game of the season. She has reached double-figures 15 times this season, topping 20 in six games.

Brianna suffered a Jones fracture in her right foot during practice in late November. She is recovering well with plans to return later this season.

### Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

With just three upperclasswomen on the roster it is safe to call Providence a young team. The Friars, however, have been improving as the BIG EAST season has continued. Providence played their closest conference contest on Jan. 10, falling 62-54 to Xavier.

Junior Sarah Beal runs the offense for the Friars, leading the team with 11.9 ppg and 45 assists. Another impressive player is freshman Jovana "Yoyo" Nogie. Hailing from Portugal, Nogie is second on the squad with 11.5 ppg and is among the NCAA leaders from beyond the arc, shooting 48.2 % from long range this season.

### Keys to the Game w/Providence

- Which team controls the pace: Creighton is second in the NCAA with 11.0 turnovers per game, while Providence averages 19.3 per contest. While some of difference is ball security, it is also about pace of play. Providence plays at a chaotic pace, while the Bluejays prefer a slower tempo.
- Three-point shooting: Sunday's contest features four of the top five three-point shooters in the BIG EAST Conference, two on each team (Faber & McGrory for Creighton, Nogie & Che for Providence). Which duo is more prolific could significantly impact the game.
- Rebound: Providence is one of the few teams that Creighton holds a rebounding edge on. The Bluejays must exploit that advantage.

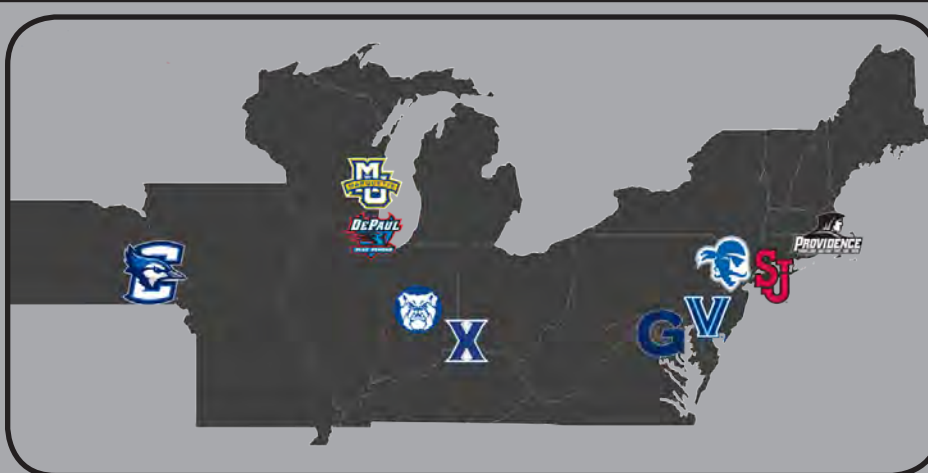

### Bluejays' Last Time Out:

Jan. 5 - Creighton 74, Xavier 47

Three Bluejays finished in double figures, while the defense held Butler to just 36% from the field in Creighton's 77-49 win on Sunday, Jan. 10.

Down 4-0 early on the Bluejays got turned to sophomore Bailey Norby to get things started. The Bluejays center delivered six of Creighton's first eight points as the Bluejays surged ahead with an 8-2 run. Norby got Creighton on the board with a 15-foot jumper. After two free throws from Norby, freshman Audrey Faber knotted the game at 6-6 with a jumper from the wing (6:18). The final bucket of the run belonged to Norby as the Minnesota native connected from just inside the three-point line to push the Bluejays up 8-6. Tied 13-13 moments later the Bluejays took the lead for good on a three-ball from junior MC McGrory, followed by a driving layup from junior Lauren Works (18-13 - 1:18).

Up 20-15 entering the second, Creighton took control of the game in the first four minutes of the period with a 9-0 run to claim a 29-15 edge. Ball movement was the key as four different Bluejays contributed buckets, while the Creighton defense forced Butler into two turnovers and three missed shots on the first five Bulldog possessions. Butler got as close as eight in the final minute of the half, but a jumper from McGrory and a free throw by sophomore Myah Mellman sent the Bluejays into half with a 36-25 lead.

Creighton bounced out of halftime in a similar manner to how the Bluejays started the second quarter, using an 8-0 run to push their lead to 44-25. The tandem of McGrory and sophomore Jade Owens each had four points during the run. Near the end of the quarter head coach Jim Flanery coaxed more production from the bench. Senior Tessa Leytem knocked down two trifectas in the final three minutes, while freshman Olivia Elger added one more from long range to send the Bluejays to the final period with a 61-35 edge.

The final period saw freshman Ali Green drop in six points as the Bluejays' bench held Butler at bay to send Creighton to the conference win.

McGrory (15), Faber (13) and Norby (10) each finished in double figures, while Butler's Brittany Ward led all scorers with 16 points.

### Defense! Defense!

Under head coach Jim Flanery the Bluejays have become known for three-point shooting, while that is still a hallmark of this team, the key to Creighton's three-game win streak has been defense.

Over the last two games Creighton has raised that portion of its game, holding Xavier and Butler under 50 points. Prior to the game with Xavier on Jan. 8, the last time the Bluejays held the opposition to 50 or less was Nov. 26, 2013 against South Dakota.

The last time the Bluejays held back-to-back opponents under 50 was during the 2012-13 season as Creighton limited Southern Illinois to 42 and 43 points in the regular-season finale and the opening game of the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC).

The last time Creighton held the opposition under 50 in three straight game was the Bluejays magical MVC Tournament run in 2011-12.

### Speaking of the 2011-12 MVC Tournament Run, Could 2015-16 Rival the Bluejays First NCAA Tournament Under Flanery?

After opening the BIG EAST season with three straight losses, one startling comparison arose. The last time Creighton opened a conference season 0-3 was in 2011-12.

That year the Bluejays rallied with six of seven victories in MVC play and went on to run the table in the MVC Tournament.

### Locked and Loaded: Faber vs. Nogic

Freshman Audrey Faber is the best player in the country from long range this season at 50.6% from three-point distance. Just a stone's throw away, however, is Providence's Jovana Nogic. Three of the top ten are freshmen (Faber, Nogic and Shayna Mehta).

### Staggering Numbers for Faber at Nebraska

Audrey Faber is delivering some staggering numbers early in her career. The freshman's six blocks against Nebraska on Sunday rank second all-time for most blocks in a game. Just one behind the school record of seven, held by Kris Kugel against Northern Iowa on Dec. 20, 1991.

### Faber's Cracks Starting Lineup in Fourth Game

Making her first start in the Bluejays' fourth game of the season, freshman Audrey Faber cracked the starting unit earlier than any previous player under the direction of Jim Flanery.

Last season Bailey Norby earned a start in her fifth game as a Bluejay, while Sydney Lamberty started in her sixth contest. Consider that Marissa Janning did not start until game number 23.

### Starting Five Entirely From Minnesota?

With six of the Bluejays 15 players hailing from Minnesota, could the 2015-16 ever see an enter unit from the Gopher state start a game?

Consider that guards MC McGrory, Sydney Lamberty and Marissa Janning started the majority of the Bluejays contests last season. That leaves the front court. Sophomores Bailey Norby and Kylie Brown are joined by freshman Ali Greene as options.
