- The Bluejays are considered a young team with three sophomores and one freshman in the starting lineup. Yet Marquette takes that notion to the extreme by starting four freshmen and one junior.

#### #1 Jade Owens - So. - G

Playing in her second game in front of her hometown crowd on Friday, Jade had eight points and six rebounds at DePaul last season.

#### #2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman posted her best game as a Bluejay in Creighton's 72-48 win over Providence on Jan. 17. She closed the game with a career-high 14 points, including 6-of-7 from the free throw line.

#### #3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

One of the Bluejays' two captains, MC has embraced her role as a leader on the floor this season. She leads the Bluejays in steals in BIG EAST play with eight.

#### #4 Aimee Rischard - So. - G

Aimee has appeared in seven games for the Bluejays this season, scoring 11 points in a combined 35 minutes.

#### #11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Bailey reached double figures for the second time in her career with 10 points against Butler on Jan. 10.

#### #12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Pressed into the starting lineup for the fourth time this season, Works shined with a career-high 19 points against in the Bluejays' 72-48 win over Providence on Jan. 17.

#### #14 Sydney Lamberty - So. - G

Sydney was sidelined against Providence on Jan. 17 with an illness.

#### #20 Tessa Leytem - Sr. - G

Tessa reached double-figures for the first time in her career, posting 14 points in Creighton's 72-48 win over Providence on Jan. 17.

#### #21 Olivia Elger - Fr. - G

Olivia set a host of career-highs in the win over Butler on Jan. 10, highlighted by two three-balls and six points.

#### #23 Marissa Janning - Sr. - G

Marissa has been sidelined since Nov. 28 as she suffered a fractured fibula in the win over Eastern Washington.

#### #33 Kylie Brown - So. - F

Kylie closed the game with Xavier with four points, three rebounds, two assists and one block.

#### #40 Ali Greene - Fr. - F

Ali has continued to improve as the season has progressed, grabbing eight rebounds and five points against Providence.

#### #45 Audrey Faber - Fr. - F

Faber became the earliest freshman to start under Flanery, moving into the starting five in the fourth game of the season. She has reached double-figures 15 times this season, topping 20 in six games.

### Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

In a league full of young squads, the Marquette Golden Eagles are one of the most youthful. Of the 11 players on the Marquette roster, eight are freshmen. The remaining three feature two juniors and one sophomore.

Further four of the Golden Eagles starting five are in their first year of college. Marquette's coach equally brings a youthful exuberance as Carolyn Kieger graduated from MU in 2006.

Marquette has played a young team, posting impressive numbers against Oregon State earlier this season (a 65-58 loss) and topping the 100-point mark twice. One of those contests was Friday against Providence (105-75). Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman lead the way for the Golden Eagles with 18.9 ppg and 14.2 ppg respectively.

### Keys to the Game w/Marquette

- Defend every possession: The Golden Eagles do not defend particularly well, they'd prefer to play a game in the 80s-90s. Creighton wants to keep the game in the 60s-70s.
- Take care of the basketball: High scoring games are boosted by poor ball security. Creighton has to take care of the ball to prevent fast break chances.
- Spread out the scoring load: The Bluejays are at their best when three or more players reach double figures. To do that Creighton must move the ball and create shots for multiple players, not rely on Faber and McGrory.

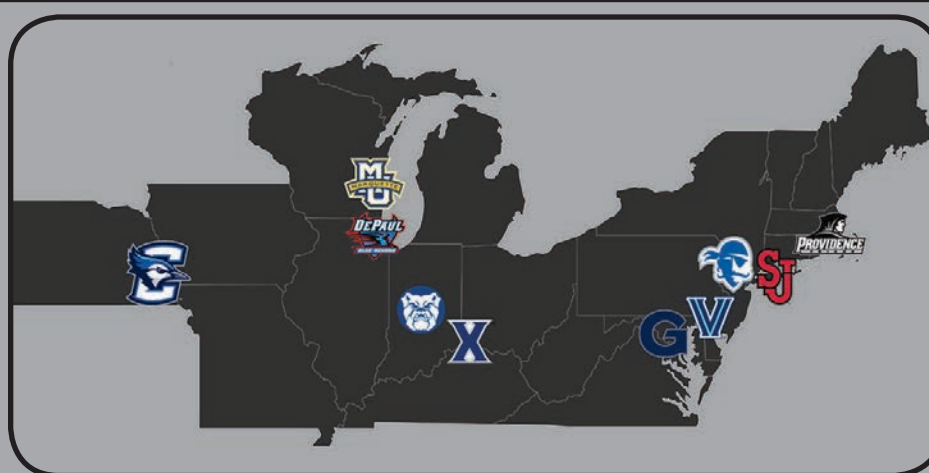

Freshman Audrey Faber finished just missed a double-double with 17 points and eight rebounds, but it wasn't enough as the Creighton women's basketball team fell to #24 DePaul 81-63 on Friday, Jan. 22.

The loss ended Creighton's four-game win streak as the Bluejays dropped to 10-10 on the season and 4-4 in BIG EAST play. DePaul, meanwhile, moved to 15-6 overall and 7-1 in conference action.

After trading buckets through the opening four minutes of play, Creighton seized its first lead of the game with 5:43 showing on the clock as sophomore Sydney Lamberty knocked down the first three-pointer attempted in the game. Another trey from junior Lauren Works pushed Creighton's lead to 12-8 (3:48). DePaul, however responded with a 29-6 run over the next 8:52 to take control of the opening.

The Bluejays tried to ignite a rally with back-to-back three-pointers from sophomore Myah Mellman and junior MC McGrory. DePaul proved equal to the challenge, pushing its lead to 47-25 at the break.

Down 54-29 with just under eight minutes remaining in the third quarter, Faber scored five straight to pull the Bluejays back. Sophomore Jade Owens added in two free throws to extend the Creighton run to 7-0 (54-36), but that was as the Bluejays got the rest of the way.

Four players finished in double figures for DePaul, led by 16 points from Megan Podkova and Jessica January.

### Bench Contributions

The win over Providence, 72-48, on Jan. 17 put Creighton's depth on display as the Bluejays got 37 points from its bench. Senior Tessa Leytem and sophomore Myah Mellman each reached double-figures for the first time with 14 points, while freshman Ali Greene chipped in another five.

Add to that number an additional 19 points from Lauren Works who was pressed into the starting lineup due to Sydney Lamberty's illness and 56 of Creighton's 72 points came from role players.

### Defense in 3D

Under head coach Jim Flanery the Bluejays have become known for three-point shooting, while that is still a hallmark of this team, the key to Creighton's four-game win streak has been defense.

Against Xavier, Butler and Providence, the Bluejays took its D to a new level, holding each of the BIG EAST rivals under 50 points.

The last time the Bluejays held three straight opponents under 50 was the Bluejays magical MVC Tournament run in 2011-12.

After opening the BIG EAST season with three straight losses, one startling comparison arose. The last time Creighton opened a conference season 0-3 was in 2011-12.

Sophomore Jade Owens exploded for a career-high 14 points, all in the first half, against South Dakota State on Dec. 12. It was the second time that Owens has reached double figures in her career.

### **McGrory Drops the Mic**

MC McGrory made a statement worthy of dropping the mic (microphone) against Utah on Dec. 9, scoring 24 points. McGrory's efforts opened the game 9-of-9 from the field and 2-for-2 from the free throw line. After missing her only field goal of the night, she canned two more from the charity stripe.

### **Staggering Numbers for Faber at Nebraska**

Audrey Faber is delivering some staggering numbers early in her career. The freshman's six blocks against Nebraska on Sunday rank second all-time for most blocks in a game. Just one behind the school record of seven, held by Kris Kugel against Northern Iowa on Dec. 20, 1991.

Faber finish the game against Nebraska with 22 points, five rebounds, six blocks and six assists.

### **Faber's Cracks Starting Lineup in Fourth Game**

Making her first start in the Bluejays' fourth game of the season, freshman Audrey Faber cracked the starting unit earlier than any previous player under the direction of Jim Flanery.

Last season Bailey Norby earned a start in her fifth game as a Bluejay, while Sydney Lamberty started in her sixth contest. Consider that Marissa Janning did not start until game number 23.

### **Starting Five Entirely From Minnesota?**

With six of the Bluejays 15 players hailing from Minnesota, could the 2015-16 ever see an enter unit from the Gopher state start a game?

Consider that guards MC McGrory, Sydney Lamberty and Marissa Janning started the majority of the Bluejays contests last season. That leaves the front court. Sophomores Bailey Norby and Kylie Brown are joined by freshman Ali Greene as options.

The last time Creighton sent a starting unit out from the same start was in the final game of the 2009-10 season. The quintet all hailed from Nebraska (Chevelle Herring, Kellie Nelson, Megan Neuvirth, Sam Schuett and Kelsey Woodard).
