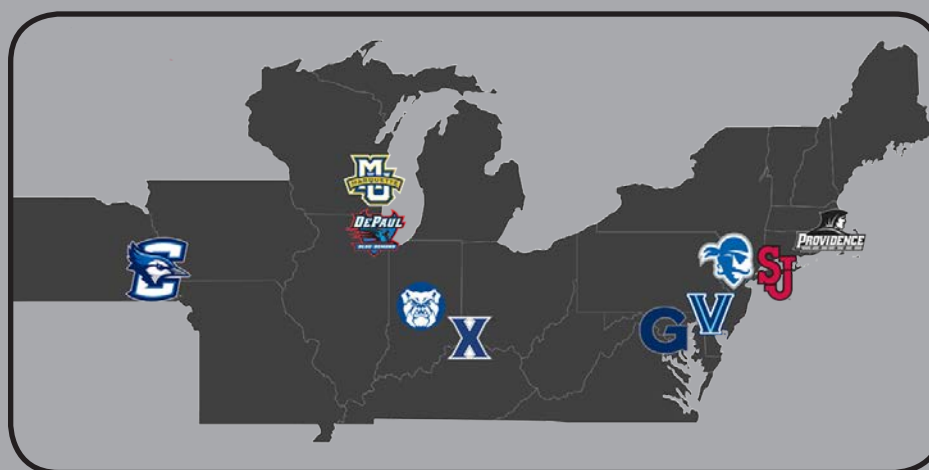

#1 Jade Owens - So. - G

Owens equalled a career-high with nine rebounds in the Bluejays' 53-48 win over Villanova on Jan. 29. Jade has led Creighton in rebounding seven times in 2015-16.

#2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman posted her best game as a Bluejay in Creighton's 72-48 win over Providence on Jan. 17. She closed the game with a career-high 14 points, including 6-of-7 from the free throw line.

#3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

MC delivered 10 points, including a critical 6-of-6 from the free throw line in the win over the Wildcats.

#4 Aimee Rischard - So. - G

Aimee has appeared in eight games for the Bluejays this season, scoring 12 points in a combined 41 minutes.

#11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Bailey reached double figures for the third time in her career with 12 points against Villanova on Jan. 29.

#12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Works teamed with Norby for 12 points each in the win over the Wildcats on Jan. 29. Lauren also grabbed six rebounds.

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

After claiming just four wins (4-27) last season, the Hoyas are one of the most improved teams in the BIG EAST. Georgetown enters Sunday's game on a two-game winning streak (Villanova & Providence).

The Hoyas are led by freshman Dionna White (14.9 ppg) and sophomore Dorothy Adomako (14.4 ppg). The numbers of the dynamic duo have increased during BIG EAST play to 15.4 & 14.7 respectively.

Led by 12 points from sophomore Bailey Norby and junior Lauren Works, the Creighton defeated Villanova 53-48.

After opening the game 1-for-15 from the field, the Bluejays found themselves down just 11-4 in the opening moments of the second quarter.

Back-to-back treys from Works and sophomore Myah Mellman sent Creighton on an 11-3 run to claim their first lead of the game at 15-14 with 5:56 left in the first half. Following Mellman's trey, Villanova's Caroline Coyer knocked down a trifecta of her own. Norby responded with the next five points of the game, capped by a traditional three point play. The Wildcats recovered to take a 21-19 lead in at the half.

The first few minutes of the third quarter was a back-and-forth battle but a six point burst by Villanova gave the Wildcats a 34-27 lead with 3:42 showing on the clock. Creighton head coach Jim Flanery called a timeout and made an adjustment in the lineup to go small. Junior Sydney Lamberty slid to the center position and the Bluejays took off. Lamberty drove the lane late in the shot clock for a layup with 2:01 left, the bucket started a 10-0 Bluejay run to close the quarter. Following a Wildcat turnover Works knocked down a three-ball from the corner. The next Bluejay possession saw Works drive the lane for two as she was fouled. The ensuing free throw gave Creighton the lead. Lamberty closed the quarter with another driving layup in the final two seconds to put Creighton up 37-34 heading to the fourth quarter.

Villanova opened the final period with two free throws by Coyer, but it didn't even slow down the Bluejays. Mellman and Works responded with back-to-back treys as Creighton opened up a 42-36 edge (7:36). Coyer countered with a jumper from the wing, but a Norby knocked down her second three-point shot of the season, followed by buckets from junior MC McGrory and Lamberty to push the Bluejay lead to 49-38 (3:56).

The Wildcats charged back in the closing moments, getting within one point at 49-48 with 23 seconds left on the clock. Creighton, however, got four clutch free throws from McGrory and Lamberty down the stretch to secure the win.

Work and Norby's 12 point efforts led the way for Creighton, while McGrory finished with 10. Coyer finished with a game-high 15 points for Villanova. While the night started off cold for the Bluejays, Creighton hit 17 of its final 35 shots (49%) to finish the night 18-of-50 (36.0%).

Battle for Jesuit Supremacy

The BIG EAST Conference features four Jesuit Institutions (Creighton, Georgetown, Marquette and Xavier).

Following the first round of BIG EAST action, Xavier and Marquette is 2-1, while Creighton and Georgetown are 1-2.

Sunday's contest featuring Georgetown and the Bluejays begins the second round of BIG EAST play amongst the Jesuit Institutions.

Creighton Shows the Beginning Isn't Nearly as Important as the Finish

In Creighton's 53-48 win over Villanova on Jan. 29, the Bluejays opened the game 1-of-15 from the field (6.7%). Creighton went on to close the first half 6-of-10 (60%) and hit 17-of-35 (48.6%) over the remainder of the game to secure the victory.

Great Way to Start the Second Half

The last time Creighton and Villanova faced off it sparked a four-game win streak for each team. Friday's battle with Villanova marked the beginning of the second half of BIG EAST play.

Defense in 4D

Under head coach Jim Flanery the Bluejays have become known for three-point shooting, while that is still a hallmark of this team, the key to Creighton's four-game home win streak has been defense.

Against Xavier, Butler, Providence and Villanova, the Bluejays have taken their defense to a new level, holding each of the BIG EAST rivals under 50 points.

The last time the Bluejays held three straight home opponents under 50 was the Bluejays magical MVC Tournament run in 2011-12.

The last time the Bluejays had a home stretch rivaling this strong of defensive effort was 2008-09 when Creighton held Wichita State (45), Northern Iowa (44) and Bradley (46) under 50.

Creighton's best stretch of home defense came from the start of the 1976-77 season through the final game of the 1977-78 year. The Bluejays did not allow a team to reach 50 points for 13 consecutive contests (Nov. 26, 1976 to Feb. 14, 1978).

Janning Sidelined for Remainder of 2015-16 Season

Creighton women's basketball head coach Jim Flanery announced that senior Marissa Janning will not be able to return from the broken left fibula she suffered early this season. Janning will pursue a medical hardship waiver, with hopes to return to the floor for the Bluejays next season.

Janning went down in the closing moments of regulation during Creighton's victory over Eastern Washington on Nov. 28. She has steadily attempted to get back onto the court, but her recovery has taken significantly longer than expected and both Janning as well as Flanery felt it was better to make this decision public.

"Marissa has been trying very diligently to work her way back to the court," said Flanery. "The pain she has been feeling has limited her more than we anticipated. She is far from getting through a practice and we no longer feel she can return this season."

"This has been a very difficult process in a lot of ways," said Janning. "I was hoping to get back on the floor with my teammates this season, but I'm so far from 100% it just isn't possible."

Bench Contributions

The win over Providence, 72-48, on Jan. 17 put Creighton's depth on display as the Bluejays got 37 points from its bench. Senior Tessa Leytem and sophomore Myah Mellman each reached double-figures for the first time with 14 points, while freshman Ali Greene chipped in another five.

Add to that number an additional 19 points from Lauren Works who was pressed into the starting lineup due to Sydney Lamberty's illness and 56 of Creighton's 72 points came from role players.

She's Back! Rollerson, that is.

There is no doubt that injuries have hampered the Bluejays this season, but one of the missing pieces returned on Jan. 17 as Brianna Rollerson saw action for the first time since Nov. 15. Sidelined for just over eight weeks by a Jones fracture to her right foot, Brianna played 11 minutes against the Friars.

Speaking of the 2011-12 MVC Tournament Run, Could 2015-16 Rival the Bluejays First NCAA Tournament Under Flanery?

After opening the BIG EAST season with three straight losses, one startling comparison arose. The last time Creighton opened a conference season 0-3 was in 2011-12.

That year the Bluejays rallied with six of seven victories in MVC play and went on to run the table in the MVC Tournament.

The last time Creighton sent a starting unit out from the same start was in the final game of the 2009-10 season. The quintet all hailed from Nebraska (Chevelle Herring, Kellie Nelson, Megan Neuvirth, Sam Schuett and Kelsey Woodard).
