- Creighton last opened a conference season 0-3 during the 2011-12 season. That year the Bluejays finished Missouri Valley action with an 11-7 mark, winning the Valley Tournament to earn a berth into the NCAA Tournament.
- Freshman Audrey Faber is on pace (15.6 ppg) to become just the second freshman in Creighton history to score at least 500 points in her first season as a Bluejay. You may have heard of the other, Connie Yori (former Creighton head coach and current head coach of Nebraska).
- Tuesday's contest features two of the best teams in the NCAA at taking care of the ball. Villanova's 7.5 turnovers per game leads the NCAA, while Creighton ranks in the top ten at 11.8.

#1 Jade Owens - So. - G

After hitting just 1-of-5 three-point shots last season, Owens off-season work has drastically improved that portion of her game. Through 15 contests she is 10-22 from long range.

#2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman has been a spark off the bench the last two game, delivering a combined 10 points.

#3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

McGrory offered another dynamic performance against Georgetown, hitting her first six field goals, with 20 points. She also delivered five rebounds and five assists versus the Hoyas.

#4 Aimee Rischard -So. - G

Aimee has appeared in four games for the Bluejays this season, scoring nine points in a combined 15 minutes.

#11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Bailey posted a career-high 10 points in the Bluejays' 69-46 win at Omaha on Dec. 20.

#12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Works delivered a career-high 16 points against Seton Hall on Dec. 31.

#14 Sydney Lamberty - So. - G

Lamberty seemed found a spark after the holidays, scoring 15 points and dishing five assists against St. John's (Dec. 29). Two days later she grabbed a team-high 13 rebounds against Seton Hall.

#20 Tessa Leytem - Sr. - G

Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

Scouting Villanova (8-5, 2-1 BIG EAST)

Season after season the Villanova are a team that remains constant, the Wildcats are a disciplined team that uses the slows the game down and forces the opposition to execute efficiently. Villanova takes care of the basketball better than any team in the country, 7.5 turnovers per game.

Villanova is led by senior Caroline Coyer (14.2 ppg), who played for Team USA this summer. Coyer not only leads the Wildcats in scoring, she runs the offense with a team-high 65 assists.

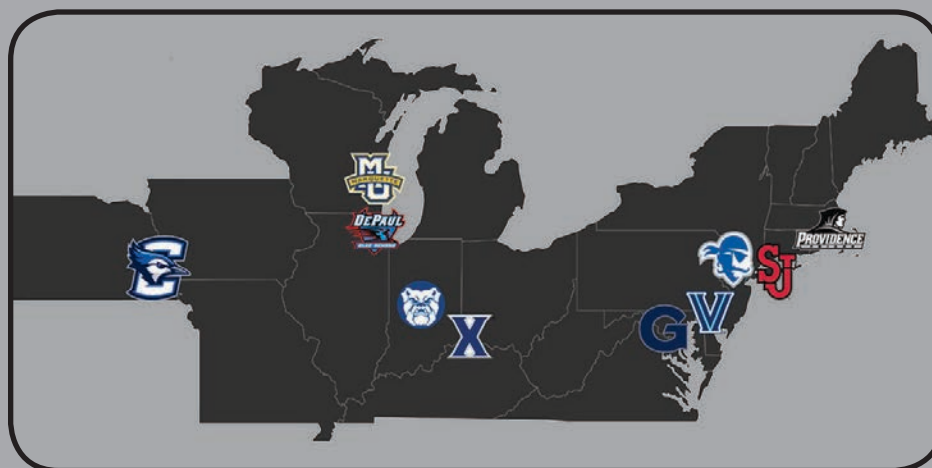
Villanova also relies on freshman Adrianna Hahn (11.5 ppg) to provide production off the bench, while center Megan Quinn averages just shy of a double-double in BIG EAST play with 9.3 ppg and 10.0 rpg.

Keys to the Game w/Villanova

- Offensive execution: The lower volume of possessions against the Wildcats puts a premium on executing. The Bluejays have struggled to consistently score this season and Villanova thrives if it can get out to a lead.
- Protect the interior: Creighton matches up well with the Wildcats athletically. That makes the paint a battle of will. Creighton is 0-8 when getting out-scored by 10 or more in the paint. The Bluejays are 6-1 when Creighton has is within 10 in the paint.
- Transition defense: The Bluejays were hurt by Georgetown's fast pace. Although Villanova is less likely to run, Creighton cannot give away easy buckets either on turnovers or fast breaks off made baskets.

Bluejays' Last Time Out:

Jan. 3 - Georgetown 69, Creighton 57

Junior MC McGrory delivered 20 points on 7-of-10 from the field but the Creighton women's basketball team dropped a 69-57 contest at Georgetown on Sunday, Jan. 3

The loss dropped the Bluejays to 6-9 on the season and 0-3 in BIG EAST play, while Georgetown moved to 8-5 overall and 1-2 in conference play.

The game began in exactly the fashion the Bluejays wanted as Creighton was 5-of-10 from long range in the first 10 minutes to race out to a 21-14 edge. McGrory led the charge with eight points in the opening frame, including 3-of-3 from the field. Moments into the second period the Bluejays pushed their lead to double-digits at 30-20 (7:14) when McGrory sank her fourth trey of the game. Georgetown, however, rallied behind interior toughness to score 11 of the next 13 points to make it a one-point game at 32-31 (3:27). The Hoyas continued to take advantage down the stretch of the second period, seizing its first lead of the game on a trey from Faith Woodard with 17 seconds remaining in the half.

The third quarter was owned by the Hoyas. Georgetown held the Bluejays without a point for the opening five minutes, pushing its lead to 46-35 (5:00). Creighton broke the second half seal with 4:27 remaining when sophomore Jade Owens knocked down a three-pointer from the top of the key. Georgetown answered with back-to-back buckets to build its largest margin of the contest, 50-38, with 2:34 left in the third.

Trailing 58-46 midway through the final period (5:12), the Bluejays got going thanks to a trey from sophomore Myah Mellman. Following a defensive stop, junior Lauren Works broke through the Hoyas defense for a driving layup. Freshman Audrey Faber capped an 8-0 spurt with a traditional three-point play via a driving layup and a free throw (3:08). Georgetown answered the Bluejays with back-to-back buckets from Dorothy Adomako to salt away the game.

McGrory's 20 points led Creighton, while Faber finished with 11 points. Georgetown got a game-high 22 points from Dionna White and 18 from Adomako.

Faber Rule: Don't Make Her Angry

Although she may not turn green, Audrey Faber has sent a warning to the opposition. If she was held down in the previous game, look out. Three times this season Faber has been limited to single-digits, each time she has responded with 21 or more the next time out.
