- Creighton is 2-0 against Xavier in Omaha, posting a nine-point win last season (74-65) and a 29-point victory in 2013-14 (79-50).
- Xavier is one of just two teams, joining DePaul, that remain undefeated in BIG EAST play at 3-0. There are also two teams yet to claim a victory, Marquette and Providence.
- While Creighton does not start one senior, just two on the Bluejays' roster, Xavier's projected starting group features three seniors.
- The Musketeers' Jenna Crittendon averaged 13.0 points per game against the Bluejays over two contests last season.
- Coming off their first BIG EAST win at Villanova on Tuesday, Creighton begins a three-game homestand against the Musketeers.

#1 Jade Owens - So. - G

After hitting just 1-of-5 three-point shots last season, Owens off-season work has drastically improved that portion of her game. Through 15 contests she is 10-22 from long range.

#2 Myah Mellman - So. - G

Mellman has seen her role grow as the season has progressed. Myah took her first two-point shot of the season at Georgetown and collected her first career steal at Villanova.

#3 MC McGrory - Jr. - G

With 20 points or more in back-to-back games, McGrory has the chance to become the first Bluejay since 2006 to top 20 in three straight.

#4 Aimee Rischard - So. - G

Aimee has appeared in four games for the Bluejays this season, scoring nine points in a combined 15 minutes.

#11 Bailey Norby - So. - F

Norby opened the contest at Villanova with her first career three-pointer. The post player finished with eight points, including six in the first quarter.

#12 Lauren Works - Jr. - G

Works delivered a career-high 16 points against Seton Hall on Dec. 31.

#14 Sydney Lamberty - So. - G

Lamberty is the lone Bluejays to reach double-digits on the glass this season, grabbing a team-high 13 rebounds against Seton Hall on Dec. 31.

#20 Tessa Leytem - Sr. - G

Leytem set new career-highs with nine points on 3-of-4 from the field against Marist. Tessa set marks in FG (3)/FGA (4)/3FG (3)/3FGA (4) and minutes played (15)

#21 Olivia Elger - Fr. - G

Olivia got her first points as a Bluejay, scoring four at Omaha on Dec. 20.

#23 Marissa Janning - Sr. - G

Marissa has been sidelined since Nov. 28 as she suffered a fractured fibula in the win over Eastern Washington.

#33 Kylie Brown - So. - F

Brown tallied a career-high six points in the win over Northern Iowa on Dec. 22. Kylie finished the game 3-of-5 with five rebounds.

#40 Ali Greene - Fr. - F

Greene has seen action in each game for the Bluejays this season, collecting 13 offensive rebounds.

#45 Audrey Faber - Fr. - F

Faber became the earliest freshman to start under Flanery, moving into the starting five in the fourth game of the season. She has reached double-figures 13 times this season, topping 20 in six games.

#50 Brianna Rollerson - Jr. - F

Brianna suffered a Jones fracture in her right foot during practice in late November. She is recovering well with plans to return later this season.

Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 14th season as the Creighton head coach and his 24th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (252 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the postseason 11 times, recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays second season in the BIG EAST (2014-15) was one of change, featuring five freshmen on the bench. Creighton closed the season with a 17-14 mark and a 10-8 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

Creighton has won three of the four meetings with Xavier, all four matchups have come since the two teams became members of the BIG EAST. The Bluejays are 2-0 against the Musketeers in Omaha.

Scouting Xavier (12-2, 3-0 BIG EAST)

The Musketeers are a different team this season than Creighton has seen its first two years in the BIG EAST. Xavier is off to a 12-2 start thanks in large part to the improved play of guards Aliyah Zantt and Raeshaun Gaffney. The tandem averaged a combined 16.9 ppg last season, this year that number 24.3.

The biggest individual jump has come from Zantt. Last season she put up 214 points in 33 contests (6.5), this year she already has 155 in 14 games (11.1 ppg)

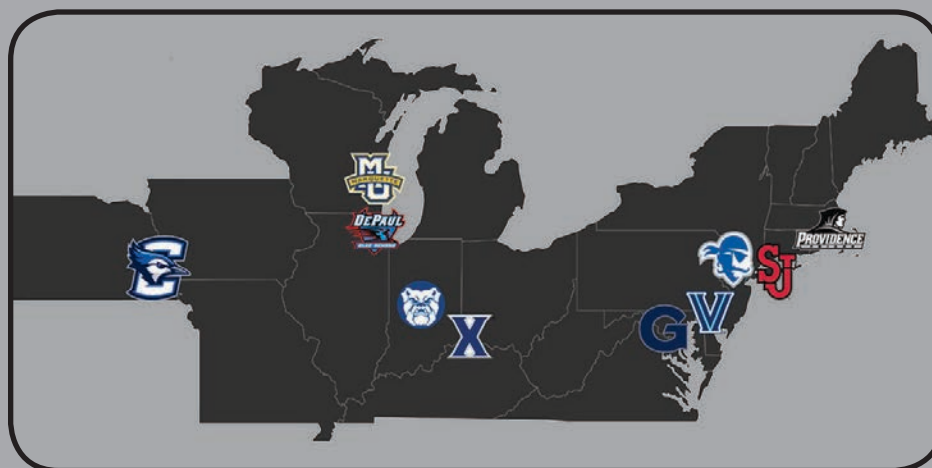
Xavier is a disciplined team that doesn't have a star, rather Zantt, Gaffney and Briana Glover (11.1 ppg) share the bulk of the scoring load. The Musketeers also attack the glass well (40.4 rpg) and finally shoot very well from the charity stripe 77.0%.

Keys to the Game w/Xavier

- **Offensive execution:** One of the big reasons the Bluejays bested Villanova was Creighton's ability to execute the offense consistently. Too many times this season the Bluejays have seen long stretches (four minutes or more) without a field goal. To win in the BIG EAST the Bluejays will need to execute.
- **Protect the interior:** In both games with Xavier last season, Brianna Rollerson delivered big games. Without Rollerson on the floor the Bluejays must keep the Musketeers from dominating the paint excessively.
- **Rebound:** This one is as simple as it sounds, Xavier is averaging 40.4 boards per game, while the Bluejays are at 33.3. Extra possessions often lead to easy buckets on both ends of the court.

Bluejays' Last Time Out:

Jan. 5 - Creighton 65, Villanova 62

Led by a combined 41 points from MC McGrory (22) and Audrey Faber (19), the Creighton women's basketball team posted its first BIG EAST victory of the season, 65-62, at Villanova on Tuesday, Jan. 5.

Sophomore Bailey Norby got the Bluejays off to a quick start right out of the gate, knocking down the first three-pointer of her career on Creighton's first possession. Norby went on to score six in the opening period, leading Creighton to a 16-11 lead. Despite a slower pace in the second period, Creighton held its lead through the period, taking a 24-21 edge into the break thanks to a mid-range shot from senior Tessa Leytem in the final minute of the half.

In the opening moments of the second half the Bluejays used a five-point burst to create some separation. Faber opened the quarter with a trey from the right corner, followed by a jumper in the paint from McGrory. Up 33-28 moments later, Creighton delivered another body blow as Norby knocked down a driving layup, McGrory tossed in the next five as the Bluejays pushed their lead to its largest margin (40-28) with 5:14 left. Late in the third Creighton pushed the lead to 15 via a trey from junior Lauren Works, while the Bluejays took a 49-36 lead into the final frame.

Villanova came out with pressure at the onset of the fourth; scoring the first six points to force Bluejay head coach Jim Flanery to use a timeout. Creighton rallied behind the guidance of their coach with a 6-0 to push the lead back to 13 (55-42) with just under seven minutes left. Down the stretch the Wildcats chipped away at the lead, getting within two in the final minute, but the Bluejays knocked down six of eight from the charity stripe in the final minute to claim the win.

McGrory's 22 led Creighton, while Faber was just a step behind with 19 points.

Villanova got a game-high 25 points from Megan Quinn, while Caroline Coyer delivered 16 points and Alex Louis had 14.

McGrory joins the 20/20 Club

Earlier this season it was freshman Audrey Faber posting back-to-back games of 20-points or more. Now its junior MC McGrory that enters Friday's game with a shot at becoming the first Bluejays since 2006 to record three consecutive games with at least 20 points.

The last Bluejay to reach that height was Angie Janis, who topped the 20-point plateau in four straight from Feb. 19-March 2 in 2006.

McGrory set the stage with 20 points at Georgetown, then put up 22 at Villanova on Jan. 5 to help the Bluejays claim the 65-62 win.

Earlier this season Faber delivered 21 points in the Bluejays' 69-46 win over Omaha (Dec. 20), then put up 22 points in Creighton's 69-61 win over Northern Iowa (Dec. 22).

One other current Bluejay has scored 20 points in back-to-back contests Marissa Janning, last season against Omaha (Dec. 20) and Kansas (Dec. 22).

Janning has scored 20 or more in consecutive games six times in her career, but has never done it in three consecutive contests.

Battle for Ultimate Supremacy

For the second time in three games the Creighton Bluejays will be taking on one of their Jesuit brethren, Xavier. The BIG EAST Conference features four Jesuit Institutions (Creighton, Georgetown, Marquette and Xavier). The Bluejays fell to 0-1 in the four square dance, dropping a game at Georgetown on Jan. 3.
