Series History: Creighton leads series, 2-1-0

The Bluejays and Friars have met three times, with Creighton taking the first two and Providence claiming the match last season. The lone meeting in Rhode Island came in 2013 as Creighton earned a 3-2 win on Oct. 3rd. Last year the Friars not only downed the Bluejays (3-2 on Oct. 17th), Providence also won both matches in the BIG EAST Tournament (played at Morrison Stadium) to go 3-0 in Omaha.

Scouting Providence (9-4-2, 3-1-1 BIG EAST)

Despite getting off to an o-2-1 start, the Friars have been one of the most successful team in the BIG EAST. Since those opening three matches Providence has gone 9-2-1, including 3-1-1 in BIG EAST play.

Over its last 12 matches the Friars have allowed just seven goals, just three in four BIG EAST matches. Goalkeeper Kristyn Shea has played every second in the net (1,416:25), recording 75 saves and posting a 0.89 goals against average.

Offensively Rachel Ugolik and Kathryn Hiller have paced the Friars with six goals each. Ugolik leads Providence with 15 points as she has three assists. In their last contest the Friars dropped a 2-0 decision to Marquette at home on Oct. 9. Providence is 5-3-0 on its home field.

Bluejays Reach Three BIG EAST Wins for First Time

The 2-0 victory over St. John's on Oct. 9th gave Creighton its third win in BIG EAST play for the first time since the Bluejays joined the conference prior to the 2013 season. Creighton finished its first season in the conference in 2013 at 2-6-1. Creighton followed that with a 2-5-2 record in 2014 and a 2-7-0 mark last season.

With four matches remaining, the Bluejays control their own destiny as Creighton sits in fifth place in the conference.

Sullivan Alone in Third in Goals Scored

Sullivan's continued her ascent up the Bluejay record book with a goal against St. John's, she is now alone in third and just one away from tying Gretta Matthews for second all-time.

Last Time Out: Bluejays Claim Defensive Battle with St. John's, 2-0

Sophomore Kaira Houser provided the spark on offense to lift the Creighton women's soccer squad to a 2-0 win over St. John's on Sunday, Oct. 9.

The Red Storm came out as the early offensive aggressor in a key contest for both squad, but the Bluejay defense proved equal to the challenge. Freshman goalkeeper McKenzie Meola kept St. John's off the scoreboard with two of her season-high seven saves in the opening five minutes of play.

After working through the opening flurry from the Red Storm, the Bluejays mounted their own attack. Junior Darby Hugunin fired off the Bluejays' first shot in the sixth minute, then Creighton created two corners in the 15th and 23rd minute.

Houser made an immediate impact after coning on to the field in the 28th minute (27:30) as she fired off a shot in her first minute on the pitch. Moments later Houser executed a give-and-go with freshman Hannah Miller to put Creighton in front 1-0. Houser sent a pass to Miller in the just inside the box, the Kansas native returned the pass to Houser on the left side. Houser quickly fired a shot off the hands of St. John's goalkeeper, Diana Poulin, from eight yards away with 34:15 showing on the clock.

Creighton held the 1-0 edge into halftime despite St. John's having a 6-3 edge on shots in the first period.

The second half followed the pattern laid out in the opening frame as St. John's was the early aggressor, but the insertion of Houser at 69:01 gave Creighton a needed edge. Houser's impact was evident even faster in the second half as her first touch led to Creighton's second goal. Houser fielded the ball along the left side of the pitch, sending a long crossing pass to senior Lauren Sullivan near the right side of the box. Houser's pass put Sullivan in a one-on-one battle with Poulin, Sullivan won the exchange for her 10th goal in her last eight matches. It was also Sullivan's eighth consecutive match with a goal and ninth with at least one point.

Creighton's third victory in conference play is the most BIG EAST wins in one season for the Bluejays. It is also the most conference victories for Creighton in conference play since the Bluejays went 4-1-1 in Missouri Valley Conference play in 2011.

Meola posted her second consecutive shutout, also the second clean sheet in her career. Meola faced 13 shots by the Red Storm, making seven saves.

Back-to-Back Shutouts Offer Individual Accolades for Meola and Sullivan

Coming off shutout victories over Seton Hall (4-0 on Oct. 6) and St. John's (2-0 on Oct. 9) senior Lauren Sullivan and freshman McKenzie Meola were named the BIG EAST Offensive and Goalkeeper of the Week on Monday, Oct. 10.

Sullivan was the BIG EAST's points leader last week with six over two games. The senior scored a goal in each win for the Bluejays, beginning Thursday against Seton Hall in which she totaled a goal and two assists. Sullivan followed on Sunday in a notable win over St. John's, scoring Creighton's insurance goal in the 70th minute of the 2-0 victory. Sullivan leads all BIG EAST players with 27 points this season, while her 11 goals are also a league high. She has scored in eight consecutive matches to break a Creighton program record.

Meola earned back-to-back shutout wins over Seton Hall and St. John's last week, totaling eight saves on the week. The clean sheets were her first two of the season, highlighted by a seven-save performance against the Red Storm on Sunday in Omaha.

Sullivan Becomes First Bluejays to Notch a Goal in Eight Straight Matches

Over the last eight matches for senior Lauren Sullivan has been lights out. She has at least one goal in each contest, 10 over the stretch, and even scored at goal at Rhode Island before a power outage cancelled the match in the 25th minute.

The goal streak she is currently on is the longest in Creighton history. The previous record was held by Gretta Matthews, who scored in seven consecutive matches from Sept. 3, 1989 to Sept. 24, 1989.

Sullivan's scoring run has elevated her to the top of the BIG EAST in goals scored with 11 and points per game at 2.08. Her 11 goals puts her in a tie for 6th in the NCAA, just one away from third overall. The NCAA leader, Ashley Hatch (BYU), has 15 goals.

Creighton's Defensive Standing Up

The Bluejays' defense has gotten steadily better as the season has progressed. Creighton has held opponents off the scoreboard for the last 210:18 minutes, stretching back to the Bluejays' match at Villanova on Oct. 2.

Meola Continues to Shine

One of the reasons that Creighton's defense continues to improve is the play of freshman McKenzie Meola. The Omaha native is 6-1-1 on the season, limiting opponents to a 1.23 GAA. She has been in net for each of the Bluejays' two shutouts.

No Time To Waste

Junior Kaira Houser made the most of her 28 minutes on the pitch against St. John's on Oct. 9. Houser entered the match in the 28th minute and converted her second goal of the season with 34:15 showing on the clock.

Houser's impact was felt even faster in the second period as she entered at 69:01, assisting on the Bluejays' goal 22 seconds later.

More Streaking for Sullivan

While Sullivan's run of goals is at eight matches, her streak of points in a match is one better at nine.

The last time a Creighton player had a streak of more than eight consecutive matches with at least one point was in 2010, when Andrea Zuniga scored in nine straight from Oct. 2 to Nov. 12.

Sullivan's Star on the National Scene

In addition to Sullivan sitting in sixth in the NCAA in goals scored, she sits in the top-10 in three other categories.

Turning Sundays Into Fun Days

After dropping the first two matches on Sunday this season, attention began to mount about the Bluejays 4-7 mark on Sunday under head coach Ross Paule.

Since the 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Sunday, Aug. 28, the Bluejays have taken four of their last five Sunday matches to move to 9-8-0 on Sunday.

Sullivan Climbs Into Top-10 in Points

Sullivan also continues to climb the Bluejays' ladder in career points. She enters the match at Providence with 73 career points, tied for third all-time.

Paule Off to Second Best Start

Over his first 33 matches as the head coach of Creighton, Ross Paule amassed a record of 18-13-2 (.576). That is the second best start (at least 33 matches) in Creighton history. Paule trails only Ray Leone, who went 19-13-1 (.591) in the first 33 matches of his tenure. Cathy Klein led Creighton to a 14-4 record in 1994, but did not return for a second season.

Go Ahead and Call it a Comeback

The Bluejays comeback win over Marquette marked just the second time in school history that Creighton erased a two-goal deficit to claim a victory. The only other time was back in 1993, when Creighton rallied from down 2-0 to defeat Minnesota on the Golden Gopher's home field in the season opening contest on Sept. 4.

Sullivan's Goal Came Late, but Not Latest

The golden goal in double overtime by Lauren Sullivan to down Marquette (Sept. 25) caxme with under three minutes remaining until the match was declared a draw, but it wasn't the latest goal to give the Bluejays a victory.

Sullivan's goal came at 107:32, while in 2011 Kelly Connolly gave the Bluejays a 1-0 win over South Dakota in the 109th minute (108:13) on Sept. 4.

The NCAA adopted the golden goal format prior to the 1999 season.

Cearlock Claims Another BIG EAST Freshman of the Week for Bluejays

For the third time in 2016 a different Bluejay claimed the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor as Ashleigh Cearlock nabbed the honor on Sept. 26 to join McKenzie Meola (Sept. 4) and Taryn Jakubowski (Sept. 19).

Cearlock earned the award with her game-tying goal against Marquette one day earlier. The Creighton rookie took a pass from Jakubowski before putting it home from 12 yards out.

Sullivan's Five Point Effort, the First By A Bluejay Since 2014

Sullivan closed the match against Yale with five points on two goals and one assist. It marked the first time since 2014 that one Bluejay accounted for at least five points. The last player to notch five points in a contest was Alyssa Jara (2G/1A) against New Mexico State on Sept. 5, 2014.

Golden Goals

Creighton's success this season combined with a doubleheader with the men's squad, yielded 1,444 fans in attendance to watch Creighton's 2-1 win over South Dakota on Sept. 9. That number ranks as the third largest home crowd in Bluejay history.

The largest crowd came on Sept. 20, 2013 as Creighton bested Nebraska-Omaha, 3-2.

Meola Earns BIG EAST Freshman of the Week

Goalkeeper McKenzie Meola nabbed the first BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor on Monday, Sept. 4.

Making just her second and third appearances in a Creighton uniform, Meola played all 200 minutes of Creighton's 1-0-1 week, making six saves and posting a .750 save percentage. Meola made four stops against Kansas State in a 1-1 draw before denying two shots in a 2-1 victory at South Dakota State on Sunday. McKenzie moved her record on the season to 2-0-1.
