Series History: Georgetown leads series, 3-0-0

The Hoyas have handled Creighton in the first three meetings as conference foes. Georgetown has limited the Bluejays to one combined goal in the first three battles, claiming a 3-1 contest last season in Washington, DC on Oct. 30.

Scouting #10 Georgetown (13-2-2, 5-1-2 BIG EAST)

The Hoyas enter Friday's contest following a loss in BIG EAST play for the first time this season. Georgetown posted impressive wins (No. 12 Rutgers, No. 3 Virgina and No. 1 West Virginia) during the non-conference season to climb as high as sixth in the national polls. Georgetown's lone loss in non-conference play was to then No. 1 Stanford (3-0) on Aug. 21.

The Hoyas offense has several options, led by 11 goals and 26 points from Grace Damaska. Rachel Corboz is just a step back with eight goals and eight assists for 24 points. Three other Hoyas enter Friday's match with at least 10 points on the season.

Defensively Georgetown has posted 10 clean sheets (shutouts), including six in BIG EAST play. In fact, Georgetown has allowed a total of five goals in conference action, with four coming in the loss to DePaul on Sunday.

The Paule Effect

In just his second season at the helm for the Bluejays, head coach Ross Paule has Creighton knocking on the door of a spot in the BIG EAST Tournament at 4-4-0. The last time the Bluejays posted four conference victories came in 2011 (4-1-1) as members of the Missouri Valley Conference. The last time Creighton had five conference wins was in 2010 (5-1-0).

Path to the BIG EAST Tournament

If the regular season was complete, the Bluejays would be in the BIG EAST Tournament. Thus with one match remaining, Creighton controls its own destiny.

If the Bluejays defeat Georgetown on Friday, Creighton will earn the final berth into the BIG EAST Tournament.

With a loss or a draw against the Hoyas, the Bluejays still have a chance. In that instance Creighton would need a loss by Butler to Xavier on Friday.

Jakubowski's Goal was Fastest Since 2002

In Sunday's 6-1 win over Xavier, freshman Taryn Jakubowski put the Bluejays on the board with a goal just 73 seconds into the match. The tally was the earliest goal in the two seasons under Paule, but not the fastest goal by a Bluejay. On Oct. 18, 2002 Franny Hylok scored in just 35 seconds against Drury. The Bluejays' also had an goal against Portland State on Sept. 12, 2008 in 70 seconds, but it was an own goal by the Vikings.

Last Time Out: Bluejays Celebrate Senior Day with a 6-1 Win over Xavier

Looking for the perfect gift on senior day, freshman Taryn Jakubowski delivered two goals and an assist to spark the Creighton women's soccer squad to a 6-1 win over Xavier on Sunday, Oct. 22.

It took a mere 73 seconds for the Bluejays to claim a 1-0 lead, turning a Musketeer foul into a goal. Sachau sent a free kick towards the box from 35 yards away, where Jakubowski came crashing toward the goal to touch in her third of the season.

Creighton pushed its lead to 2-0 in the fourth minute when Sachau turned a failed clear on a corner into an unassisted goal from 15 yards.

Xavier pulled back within one in the 19th minute as Andie Kenard fielded a crossing pass from Maddie Tierney, then beat Bluejay goalkeeper McKenzie Meola from 12 yards out.

Knowing that it was her mark that got the Musketeers on the board, Jakubowski fielded a pass from Sullivan less than one minute later and streaked down the right side. The Illinois native beat her defender and notched her second goal from 20 yards out.

The game remained 3-1 through halftime and well into the second half, until a goal in the 65th minute by Sullivan put the match away. Creighton tacked on goals in the 84th and 85th minutes from freshmen Kate Johnson (her first) and Hannah Miller's fourth of the season.

The Bluejays wrap up the regular season on Friday, Oct. 28 as Creighton hosts Georgetown at 7:00 pm in Morrison Stadium. The Bluejays can qualify for the BIG EAST Tournament with a win over the Hoyas or a loss by Butler.

One Box Remains for Sullivan

Lauren Sullivan has scored at least one goal against each BIG EAST opponent save one, Georgetown.

She has three goals against Marquette and Villanova, two versus Seton Hall and one against Butler, DePaul, Providence, St. John's and Xavier.

Sullivan Moves Into a Tie for 2nd in Goals Scored

Lauren Sullivan's goal against Xavier on Oct. 23rd moved her into a tie with Gretta Matthews for second all-time.

Turning Sundays Into Fun Days

After dropping the first two matches on Sunday this season, tention began to mount about the Bluejays' 4-7 mark on Sunday under head coach Ross Paule.

Since the 3-1 loss to Iowa State on Aug. 28, the Bluejays have taken five of their last six Sunday matches to move to 10-8-0 under Paule. This season Creighton is 5-2-1 on Sunday.

Back-to-Back Shutouts Offer Individual Accolades for Meola and Sullivan

Coming off shutout victories over Seton Hall (4-0 on Oct. 6) and St. John's (2-0 on Oct. 9) senior Lauren Sullivan and freshman McKenzie Meola were named the BIG EAST Offensive and Goalkeeper of the Week on Monday, Oct. 10.

Sullivan was the BIG EAST's points leader with six over two games. The senior scored a goal in each win for the Bluejays, beginning Oct. 6 against Seton Hall in which she totaled a goal and two assists. Sullivan followed on Oct. 9 in a notable win over St. John's, scoring Creighton's insurance goal in the 70th minute of the 2-0 victory. Sullivan leads all BIG EAST players with 27 points this season, while her 11 goals are also a league high. She scored in eight consecutive matches to break a Creighton program record.

Meola earned back-to-back shutout wins over Seton Hall and St. John's totaling eight saves on the week. The clean sheets were her first two of the season, highlighted by a seven-save performance against the Red Storm on Sunday in Omaha.

Creighton's Scoreless Streak Sits at 209

Coming off its first shutout of the season at Providence (Oct. 15), the Bluejays suffered a second clean sheet on Thursday at Butler. Creighton would like to quickly end its current scoreless streak of 209:09 against Xavier.

Newcomer Heavy Lineup

The Creighton starting lineup has consistently featured newcomers. Five freshmen started the Bluejays' last match at Butler (Bosak, Grubb, Jakubowski, Lordemann and Meola), each of that group have started at least 10 matches this season..

Meola's Scoreless Streak Snapped

Providence's goal during the 99th minute on Saturday snapped McKenzie Meola's longest scoreless streak of her young Creighton career. The freshman held opponents off the scoreboard for nearly 309 consecutive minutes (308:50), stretching back to the Bluejays' match at Villanova on Oct. 2.

Senior's Streak Snapped

Senior forward Lauren Sullivan's school-record streak of eight matches with a goal was snapped on Saturday afternoon at Providence.

Prior to Saturday, Sullivan had scored 10 goals during eight matches dating back to Sept. 4.

The eight-match goal streak was the longest in Creighton history. The previous record was held by Gretta Matthews, who scored in seven consecutive matches from Sept. 3, 1989 to Sept. 24, 1989.

Sullivan Also Third in Points

Sullivan also continues to climb the Bluejays' ladder in career points. She enters the match with Xavier with 73 career points, tied for third all-time.

No Time To Waste

Junior Kaira Houser made the most of her 28 minutes on the pitch against St. John's on Oct. 9. Houser entered the match in the 28th minute and converted her second goal of the season with 34:15 showing on the clock.

Houser's impact was felt even faster in the second period as she entered at 69:01, assisting on the Bluejays' goal 22 seconds later.

Go Ahead, Call it a Comeback

The Bluejays comeback win over Marquette marked just the second time in school history that Creighton erased a two-goal deficit to claim a victory. The only other time was back in 1993, when Creighton rallied from down 2-0 to defeat Minnesota on the Golden Gophers' home field in the season opening contest on Sept. 4.

Sullivan's Goal Came Late, but Not Latest

The golden goal in double overtime by Lauren Sullivan to down Marquette (Sept. 25) came with under three minutes remaining until the match was declared a draw, but it wasn't the latest goal to give the Bluejays a victory.

Sullivan's goal came at 107:32, while in 2011 Kelly Connolly gave the Bluejays a 1-0 win over South Dakota in the 109th minute (108:13) on Sept. 4.

The NCAA adopted the golden goal format prior to the 1999 season.

Cearlock Claims Another BIG EAST Freshman of the Week for Bluejays

For the third time in 2016 a different Bluejay claimed the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor as Ashleigh Cearlock nabbed the honor on Sept. 26 to join McKenzie Meola (Sept. 4) and Taryn Jakubowski (Sept. 19).

Cearlock earned the award with her game-tying goal against Marquette one day earlier. The Creighton rookie took a pass from Jakubowski before putting it home from 12 yards out.

Sullivan's Five Point Effort, the First By A Bluejay Since 2014

Sullivan closed the match against Yale (Sept. 18) with five points on two goals and one assist. It marked the first time since 2014 that one Bluejay accounted for at least five points. The last player to notch five points in a contest was Alyssa Jara (2G/1A) against New Mexico State on Sept. 5, 2014.

Speaking of Golden Goals

Sullivan also knocked in a golden goal during the 2014 season, defeating Nebraska-Omaha on Sept. 21. She is one of just three players with more than one golden goal. The others are Regina Moench and Lulu Quigley.
